

ESTIMATED STUDENT BUDGET FOR ONE ACADEMIC YEAR AT THE ASCSA

This estimate is a necessarily broad approximation. Individual student budgets will vary depending on eating and spending habits, as well as the number of optional trips taken. Other factors to consider, if applicable, when preparing a budget: US taxes, continuing enrollment costs at one's home institution, medical expenses (including prescriptions), storage of possessions in the US, and exchange rate fluctuations.

Notes

room in Loring Hall: *total costs* are based on single occupancy for 9 months.

Board in Loring Hall: *Breakfast, lunch, and dinner are served at Loring Hall Monday-Friday. No meals are served on weekends or holidays. The dollar amount is based on eating every meal M-F at Loring Hall for 31 weeks.*

Optional trips: *Trip costs vary considerably based on destination, duration, and level participation, but typically run \$1,500.00-\$2,500.00 per trip plus airfare and food. The more folks that go, the cheaper things are.*

International flights: *The high end for airfare reflects the cost for members who return to the USA for the winter break.*

Health Insurance: *Regular Members are required to provide their own health insurance. Cost depends on coverage.*

Board: Breakfast, lunch, and dinner are served at Loring Hall Monday-Friday. Fellowship holders supply their own meals on weekends and on all ASCSA trips, including: mandatory trips during the Fall term; optional trips; and short trips during the Winter term.

Optional trips: Trip costs vary considerably based on destination, duration, and level participation, but typically run \$1,500.00-\$2,500.00 per trip plus airfare and food. The more folks that go, the cheaper things are.

Health Insurance: Regular Members are required to provide their own health insurance. Cost depends on coverage.
