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Athens 1924-

As usual the journal begins late and has to be caught up as best it can.

- Oct. 6. Arrived SS "Bulgaria" at Piraeus 6 a.m. & soon afterwards B. appeared in a rowboat & patiently waited until we got off with luggage. Nothing opened in custom house. Came up in the Ford - put all other things in camion - Salonaki for trunk room, a rare mess. Fine reception here. Began to get settled. Mr Fowler for tea. Call from Miss Winsor & Miss Allen (Boston). School dinner on roof for 16, lovely night.
7. Explored the garden & saw the tombs - Saw School off for N. trip. Went with B to Am Ex for funds, checks, unpacking. Miss W. to tea. B, L & I explored Gennadeion, ending on roof. Eve. spent getting B's announcements lists in order.
8. Most of day unpacking - went 5.30 for shampoo. Caught in rain. Dinner for Mrs Sears, Mr Choate, Mme Sicilianou, Thompsons, Robinson. Mrs S. has given a new Ford.
9. Catching up what we do has a great simi-

Lonely although it hasn't been stupid or monotonous. Gradually getting clothes in order. Dined at C.B.B. with Mrs Sears and went by moonlight to Acrop. - wonderfully beautiful.

10. Went to tea in Annex with Mrs Thompson - she took us over the house. Eve. spent typing ann. lists, school applications, etc.

11. Went shopping with Mrs T. in search of clothes hangers - then spent most of the time cleaning salomaki of trunks - making it habitable. Took it easy in eve - read 4 T. Lit. Suppl.

12. Everyone very sleepy so the morning began late. Spent most of the day writing letters. Miss Morris (special?) arrived in a.m.

13. Shopping again in prep. for our proposed trip to Corinith - also to send supplies to 4 people by Miss M. Decided we could help clear the decks before Mr. F. went to C. While we were at tea Mrs Stewart called, also Mrs T. In eve. actually finished on basis of AmSch. mailing list.

14. Took noon train to Corinith, fine jour-

ney - weather unusually cold & very windy. Errands in New C. buying dishes, lamp etc. for the house. Got there about 5. Had tea & din. at Geo. K's, as there was nothing for our fire - Tost Marika to help. Very beautiful w.C. The house nice & clean & we got a lot in order before bed time.

15. Up early, lovely day - Sorted notebooks, plans, papers etc. - got them practically all done before the arrival of Mr. F. Lunched in house. L - I went to Mrs. to see what tea while the others had a nap - left after tea, but as train was very late didn't reach A. till about 11 - got to bed about 2.

16. Very domestic in a.m. pressing clothes etc. Cleaned up P's desk, also lost salon. papers. Tea at Mrs T.'s who had several other Am. people for us to meet. Laughlins, Denty, Kalipantz, Kyles, Eukleides, Demara, Schen, Fortan-dos, Allen, Miller, Cox. Very nice party. Eve. Lib & I looked over material for dis. up at - made a beginning sorting it out.

17. Was typing part of report when D Cox sug-
gested lunch at Phalleron - after we had been
inoculated by Dr. L. we went - had a fine
time out of doors at the Bar Russy, a little
restaurant looking over the water - park.
Did not get back until late, but spent rest
of time, typing my condensations of R.P.
which I had written in London.

18. Continued the report & got hold of the
Old Spring typed copy, a good part of
which we read. Felt a little lazy
after inoculation so read Galusha the
Magnificent for a bit. Peggy Hill
came to tea but on the whole it was
a quiet day without much news.

19. Spent morning clearing up B's bedroom,
changing L's bookcase etc. wrote letters, then
B. returned from Corinth & while L &
Cox made calls we had tea on balcony.

20. Odds & ends. Late in p.m. went calling
with B. & got a lot made as many
were out. Lit - I began Old Spring.

21. Wet day - Decided to hang curtains when
Mr. F. came along & I spent an hour or so
discussing Cabinet Guide; then we got-dining
room curtains & then ones in saloon up. Mrs
Laughlin called early, & Major Case after tea -
we took him to library.

22. Worked on Old Spring - L & I called on Mrs
Hewitley - the northern trippers returned -
tea on balcony. Called at Cos. - then at Annex.
Worked over A & A article on Corinth with B.

23. Cleaned out the clothes cupboard, a
family symposium, much was packed.
Wrote M. Went to the Euclides at Steph.
& took Mrs T. & D Cox with us. Very in-
teresting family, mother, 3 dau + 1 husband,
several other callers there - Dinner Laugh-
lins, Mr Allen, Miss Carter, Mr F, DC - Then
made B finish the Corinth A & A.

24. Suddenly decided to go to Nemea & Phl.
with B & Robinson. Fine drive. Lunch on
cliffs under pines, beyond Megara - Stopped at Co.
near house for a few supplies - Reached A. G.

fore dark - had a look at excavations, part of
gymnasium, bath, old walls, under Byz. church,
bench to temple, temple crypt; saw how the
brook has been diverted etc. Late tea, talk
with P. & B. B. went to buy see about bench,
after dinner made beds - cots - turned in early.

25. Up at 6.30, speedy breakfast & off to Phlius.
Both Ph. - & are beautiful valleys, the
vines all yellow, russet, brown - red - Ph.
more imposing because of Arcad. mts. near.
Village St. Geo. Some distance from Acrop.
Sat in Ford - sorted & marked plans, then
to trenches, which B decided to leave open.
Very hot. Went carefully over all stone
below slope, then up to Ruchiotrisa, part
"Palati", fountain etc. Fine breeze on top.
Rain began just when lunch arrived, so
we took shelter by church. Very wet for
1/2 hrs, or so, but finally cleared & we got
Mr F. which was in a field below. Road
dry wet but we eventually drove all the
way to Athens, as train was late.
[Invited to dine at Laughton's]

26. Miss Thomas arr. & B went to see her at tent.
Went to concert at Olympia, 10.45. Letter in p.m.
Miss T. & Mrs Stacey to tea at 4.30, out on bal-
cony. Others: Palli, Fitzgerald, Baltz, Hall. Finished
H. Water in eve.

27. Went to Bris. Hotel to see Mr Keasley's
Macedonian pottery. Then took Ada to West
& went over it with him. 2^d incubation by Dr
Lorandos. Mr F to lunch. Tel went to town for
errands, L & J shopped, back for tea. Terrible
chills until bedtime. Fire in saloniki - h
tucked me up in bed early -

28. Felt rather weak - got up about 12 -
Miss T & Mrs S came to lunch & we discussed
hotel plans afterwards & then showed her
the students' quarters. Mr T to tea. Dinner
Kosmopoulos (2), Kyle (2), Morris, Broe, Broner,
Logan.

29. Slight rain - Southern trip started about 6.
O.S. went to see Mr F. Miss T. here doing
plans with W.S. Linen for bag. came & we
opened it. Write Trat.

30. Spent most of morning tidying the library (B, L, I) as it was in a sad mess, then L & I did Carl's coop till lunch time. Answered a lot of letters, then went to tea with The Halls. Apartment - around corner from Legation - Laughlin, Dickerson, Mrs Brown (from Coast.). Made rain - got a cargo from Legation. More letters in evening.

31. Spent a.m. tidying more things in treatment room. More letters. L & I did a few errands, had a walk to Zappion and got some towels & other linen done by refugees. Back late to tea on balcony. Brown & Gordon ^{late} called.

Nov. 1. Letters in a.m. But went to Comit at noon. Went out in the garden to see how things were going. Dorothy stayed to lunch and took some of the linen to be mended. L & I went to airport and read Holland's first - Eusebia. article on the spot, fine sunset. Tea on balcony. Telegram about 7 that MCT had been hurt, so we sent for Dr L. to go to her - after dinner L & I went to see her. Eve. read "Ann" in ATP

2. Gossiped with Mr T & Mr F, then shifted books to clear out Grapheron & one of L's cases. Letters all p.m. Mr F read aloud to us his historical sketch of Corinth - during tea time. Then we returned to letters. L & I read part of Miss Stowell's paper on Minoan script. B got back about 10 from Corinth, having secured the land.

3. Went in a.m. to Museum - took a general turn around, ending with room with Theophrastus. After lunch finished Miss Stowell, then had early tea intending to make calls. Before tea the Kyles came but did not stay long. Afterwards the Hermapes. As we were starting to town they took us - went to Mrs Miller (int) - Legation. For dinner had Mr Gordon from Am Ex.

4. Letters in a.m. Then we to say our goodbyes to Miss T., who found her shoulder had been broken & whose bruises were black & blue. Back late to lunch which was still further delayed by B. finishing report to Capps. Many copies of NYT arrived & L & I read them until tea time.

DC took more linen for hemming. At tea Mr F came, after going over part of C. in ~~not~~ with me. Mr. Wigram here for tea. After it, had began Holland's II Ezechth. which we finished after dinner, & then I hunted up in library a few references taken from ASA "Arch. News".

5. Started soon after 7 to visit Mrs Goldman's dig at Eutresis. Had Buick with Pasili, L, B, Rob & I. Beautiful day, fine drive via Eleutheræ. Avoided clouds on mt. & the sun came out soon on Boeotian side. Stopped at Thebes for errands, then to Eremokastro where we tried to drive to Eut. by field road, but soon had to walk ^{12.30-1.45} 1 1/2 hrs. across country, ploughed fields, vine yards etc. Warm welcome while they were at lunch. Buur, Hanem, de Jongh. Spent a couple of hours at dig, mostly Mingau, some (little) LH. Great difficulty in identifying walls. Much interesting stuff, but needs a great deal of interpretation. Left about 4, walk 1/4 stopping at Theopiea lion

& a few old blocks, to highway. Nearest village to Eutresis (now called Leuctra, is Para/poungia). Thebes about 7, dinner (good). Fine moonlight drive back, here about 11. Mail. Hot tub.

6. Wrote M in morning. After lunch some P.S. then left many cards on way to tea at Mrs Pasparis where we had a very nice time. Bridge in eve. 7. Begun Koch's article on TC's in Rom. Mitt. 30. (1945) After lunch was in habits R. with Stoy. when furniture arrived about 4 o'clock, & Correis - all put in front garden & garage. John ran the uncrating, much damage - Miss Demetropoulou came over for tea & after she left - we got the bookcase temporarily set up. Mrs T. called. Very weary by dinner time.

8. Up early, saw about boxes of pictures. After breakfast did china boxes in garage, sorted out - casualties etc. Hard work all day - B. went to Corinith with T. at noon. Went for Choclates before dinner but didn't really need exercise. Read myself sleepy on T. in eve. 9. Shifting garments in chests of drawers, bag

larger one now. Michael working on bookcase.
Chilly afternoon. Fire - tea in graphicon. Mr Baltz
came. In eve did some work, but not Man of Ath.
10. Mr T. came in and told us about C.R. Nense.
Marked & sorted plans of W Hotel, grounds etc.
Left early with Cox for Miss Eucleides's work-
shop, then she joined us & we lunched at GB.
Afterwards L & I did errands, ending at En-
gasterson where we looked at - certain stuff
Back for tea. Tired & lame after all unpacking,
glad to have quiet - eve. before Graphicon fire.
11. Made out inventory for insurance, mail B. &
long letter to Trub. Early tea & went to hairdresser.
Called at GB to enquire for Mr Baltz. Dined
with Thompsons, family + 1st Gold man.
12. Went to Am Ex, Henderson, Buick (ask abt
new camion), Police where long wait to get
E's license. Entertained by "hatless man".
Left at 3 for Ambrosia at Phaleron & ran
into their day at home so had tea and
met all the teachers. Home. Georganta called.
After dinner sat around fire. Rob gave us

large box of sweets. Got things ready to send B.
13. long letter to M. in a.m. About noon went to
Police again (still postponed) then ^{L.} made appt.
with Md. for medical exam. Insurance man
came 3.30 and we went carefully over items
& expect to have satisfactory settlement.
Tea at Annex, Sills, Case, Jacquith, Empedocles,
Cendourates, DC, Goods. WST brought us home -
"Pel. Trip" returned. C here in time for
dinner, also Bove. Men arr. by train about 10.
14. Translated certain pages of Judeich. Letter on
Nadriani's agreed. for Mr Case. In library
with many interruptions. Mrs Lytle called
(intro. by H Reynolds, New Haven). After lunch L & I
dug out some winter things. Bus arrived, 90
Dings. all sound. Mr & Mrs Sills for tea, also
Mother's House from Salonika, H Bove. L & I went
to doctor's but back before tea was over. Seven
for dinner, cold night sat long over fire in
dining room. Then I typed in graphicon.
15. Athanasie turned up so we had more
things to send B. Finished typing, then

washed curtains in trunk room & got couch
arranged in Ladies' Room for Miss Morris.
So cold & blowing we didn't go to Söppfeld,
but read papers before fire, then Peg Hill, F.
Kellogg & Miss Higbie came for tea, & Denby
dropped in. Mr Fowler came to dinner & we
played bridge, 6 tables, until nearly one.
16. A wonderfully beautiful day and we
spent a good part of the morning on the
roof selecting rug, a most pleasing per-
formance. Drove to Tabor and beyond along a
splendid road to the fountain, with mag-
nificent views over Africa and the sea -
Back in time to be taken by Thompsons &
Sills to Tephissia & Mme. Delta's where there
were many delightful people. She is most
charming herself. Letters in eve -
17. Met again. With Marika's assistance we
did some rearrangement in saloon, &
moving B's bookcase to s.w. corner. Hit &
I made calls, leaving cards & back to tea.
Mr F. here and we had bridge till dinner.

B. returned with Rob on evening train & we
all sat around talking a long while.
18. Late breakfast, then saw DL about embroi-
dery & then in library trying to find pop. of Ath.
in Hadrian's time, without success. Letter to G
in p.m. & when I went below found flood in
saloon from steam pipes. Damage
mapped up. Went to tea. Eve mostly planning
out campaign for week & trips etc.
19. Got B & C started for motor permit, then we went
over pictures trying what would do in each
room. After lunch went to Acrop. & while B & C
took pictures we went to the small museum
where there are many arch. tes. Back for tea, F.
Mr Woodcock came in & stayed till dinner
time. Says AJBW has Tipton at Stensington.
Finished his letter, Runderborn.
20. Up early putting pegs & shelves into the book-
case, (20x24 with stuffing). B & C off for C. on
noon train, hit in bed during a.m. with cold.
After lunch got books placed, a big job & was
pretty lame afterwards. L - I busy with till tea,
which were were having in Graph. when Mr & Mrs House came.

Rather fatigued in eve & glad to crawl in.

21. Still pretty stiff but went to picture frames, for concert tickets & to Miss Entelides where we borrowed a sample curtain. After lunch took DC & Bue a drive to Rephissia as it was a brilliant day. Stopped to see D's design for the Saloni curtains, home for tea. ^{Sills called to see.} Dressed & went to call on Mrs Taylor (out). Real fire-drawn story etc.

22. Put away summer clothes a.m. Went to Dr. Dörpfeld at 3, Bulli gate, approaches, Mike. He was most cordial & has not changed much. Stopped for ches. on way back to tea. B's train late & he walked up. He & I went to dinner at legation, in honor of Adm. Andrews of Am Fleet, (Flag-ship "Pittsburgh") 19 guests [See School Diary]

23. Went to rehearsal of Odion Symphony Orchestra, Sibelius Symph, Brahms viol. conc, Euryanthe, Leporello, Moussorgsky "Pictures from an exhibition." After lunch found Michael & Co setting up desk, readjusted papers from other desk. Thompsons for tea. Tacked a long time about Stearn's house. Wrote M.

After dinner L & I packed presents for DD to take & made list, also selected films to have printed for Tomas. Began letter to H.

24. Ordered curtains for salonaki from Proodos. Saw Mavromati to hasten him on repairs. Finished H letter after lunch. Gave B & C early tea & then went to Mme von Schoen's. Very charming. In eve very sleepy & read a lot of old diaries.

25. Most of morning went to straightening out the desk, cleaning a lot of old letters etc. In pm took Marika to Akirou's and we got household supplies, towels, aprons, dresses etc. Then I got 2 hats. After tea the two Holyoke girls from Phaleron called. Many letters rec'd. B & C did calls.

26. Errands in a.m. Called for hats, went to Ergasterion and took home material to measure for curtains. Bought grey gauge ³⁰⁰ seaf, saw modiste about blue velvet then ordered cards for Xmas at Pallis & Co. Wrote M. Then Mrs Helen's tea for School - In eve went to Phaleron to reception by Min. of Marine for Am. Fleet. Very wet. Large party, much dancing & supper. Back about 2.

27. Thanksgiving Day. Breakfasted late, Ben & I went back to Erg. and to P.C. for place cards. H. Hansen for lunch as she was to sail in p.m. & miss the dinner. Made out seating plan, wrote place cards & helped get table ready before we went to tea at Legation where we stayed until about 7, then had final look over things before dinner for 23 at 8.30. Yellow chrys. very fine. Music afterwards, party kept up till about 1, bed about 3.

28. Wrote letters & saw Mrs. Botkin for Cor. with T. After lunch L & I got the photos ready to mount for Xmas cards, she cut & I pasted, & we made out list. Took all p.m. & we slept - when Beulah & Peggy came to tea, & Mrs. Athanasaki called (both B & C out).

29. Slept in am. Amby, frames, stationers. Rather chilly so did not go to Aerop. but spent - until tea time doing Xmas cards. Stopped for 1/2 hr. to read papers, but returned to cards & letters in eve, having written notes on the backs of a great many.

30. Spent most of the day writing letters, had tea early and then B, L & I went to tea with the Dezas. In a.m. read students' reports while B. was having breakfast. Miss Burr in in eve planning trip & borrowing books.

Dec. 1. Letters in am. until we all rushed to Aerop. to take Evch. pictures by corner sun. lunch very late. Went out to see about planning new gates. Fr T for tea, then filed B's letters. Thru letters.

2. Letters, then to dressmaker for fitting - F to tea. Then L & I hung pictures while B. was out. Returned to work in eve.

3. Very wet. Worked on K and periodicals got from library for reference - Tea at Mrs. Goldman's, also de Jongh, very cold - Eve had bridge with R. for fourth.

4. Back to letters again in a.m. Finally got K done & later in eve addressed envelopes.

5. Spent most of the day in library looking up references from K, i.e. Olympia, Regina etc also got deep in 'Ep. on Thurmon. L brought

back the cards we had made at P & C, so we
put them into envelopes ready to post. Trip from
O. got back about 10.30.

6. Finally got blue durygn mended, ^{all but pieces -} worked on
Ed., leaving in Jdlost. in a.m. P.m. went to
Dirp. on Attemi Borraon, older Parth. etc.
Pagg - Olaf + Gordon came to tea, also WNF, but
Beulah never turned up. Dined with Seltas
in Kephissia, fine moonlight drive. Thomp-
sons, Photiades, Pallis heredis family.

7. Finished Ed. 1903, also some Schede, slow work.
Letters p.m. & after tea the 4 of us made
many calls. Eve finished H's letter, then L
& I wrote invitations for Tuesday.

8. Up reasonably early. Went to Museum
with Carl to his pottery course, got as far
as Thessalian A. Then he & I looked over
the large coll. of geom pots from Kymettus.
After lunch wrote up notes that had been
scribbled in my Mus. Muz. Catal. Cold & blowing
& was glad to stay in by the fire. F & T for
tea

9. Finished mending blue durygn. Spent large part
of a.m. in family symposium placing hall mirror
though the actual work was chiefly Thomas's.
Had second fitting & got the cards from P & C to send
to Europe. Busy with prep. for day at home. Great
success, about 30, ending with WNF playing. ^{Read's} ^{Carl's} ^{prurchase}

10. Lecture on early sculpture by Lib at 10.30, then
in library looking up period. references. After
lunch read some Picard & helped rearrange bookcase.
After tea looked through Sat. Rev. In eve measured
for hanging the Venetian mirror - made M.

11. Letters in a.m. & long one to Edith. Tea at Mrs
Thompson's, then a few calls. Eve "forgot what did".

12. L & I went to Nat. Mus. & did Theron & archaic
sculpture. Had fitting, stopped at Proodos but cur-
tains were not ready. L, C & I spent most of
p.m. measuring another place for mirror &
selecting pictures. B. I went to tea at Hallegas.
Find got stuck, walked home. Eve read Carl aloud
to L & B, then did some Mrs WB.

13. B & Stillwell to Cor. at 6.40. Spent a.m. in
library, on Theron & other t.c.'s, continued after

- lunch as rather cold for Acropolis. Went to Committee meeting for dance for Infant N. - tea at Mrs Petrocchino. Made out-list, then VB. Eve did cards for England & Italy.
14. That p.m. went for letters to M & T, then to H. Drove out on Dionysos road to village of very rough, but weather fine & beautiful lights on mountains. Found B. here on our return. Read a lot in Mrs VB until bedtime.
15. Went to Mrs. Wick hit for her archaic lecture, then had had fixed. After lunch got Ven. mirror hung thanks to WST's "Harry". Went to tea & had some discussion of Cor. Then addressed envelopes for Miss Cook's and I hope finished English cards & letters. VB in eve.
16. Mrs. to Carl's pottery course (Thurs.) then got B & F and went over Hym. miscribed pots & wrote late for lunch. Saw T about addresses etc. Day at home, about 35. Bridge in eve.
17. Mrs. for B's epigraphy. Had come home

- about 1.15 to dress for lunch at Rangabé - Giro's. Very pleasant man from For. Office made the light. Went to Mr Allen's first lecture in Theatre & also saw so-called Odeion of Pericles. F & T for tea. Rhomaios called on B. wrote M. between tea & dinner. After dinner Miss Burr came to borrow a book & then I went carefully over Robinson's paper with him, until 12, then we four tackled over VB's interview with R.
18. Am in library on all sorts of things. At 6 went to German School celebration of 50th Anniversary - Buschor spoke on Archaic Acrop. & Dr D. made daisy remarks. Other Schools well represented. Took home with us, after having had him to tea.
19. Did some mending before our late breakfast. Most of day on VB & in eve unearched my old paper on Arch tes to see what summary it has. Besides VB went through a lot of Lida's Cor. notes, much to arrange, but prospects good.
20. Library in am & also spent more time than need be on Schede. ^{Peggy called.} Early tea. Committee at 5.30 at Miss Cook's. Back before 7, L. Cont-shipping & I read Rhomaios's letter & look at Ash. plan - Bridge eve.

21. Went concert of Od. Hill, which had some interesting etc things by Barbosli, composer called out and presented with a lamb. After lunch went to see progress on Gen. To tea at Deltai - a fine day for out of doors. letters in eve.

22. Mus. with L. for 10.30 lecture. P.m. did all I intend to in Schede then went shopping for Christmas things. Very wearying, glad to get back for tea. Dinner with Thompson, Annex household, Deltas, laughlines -

23. Carls in Mus. 10.15-12.15, finished read. - began epl. Small but select number at day at home, on acct. of Christmas. Afterwards C, L, did a couple of errands & sent off cables.

24. Started soon after 9 for mistletoe on Parnes. Finest day of the season. but via Patisia - Mendoli, and a couple of miles beyond that the camion gave out, so did much extra climbing - L & I sat under pines for lunch while men went higher - had to walk into M., then got a car back here by 6.30 to tea & lute. Others

arr. in relays, but all property including the greens was bought. Started about 11 to trim tree (C. Brown) pop corn & string it, wrap presents, tree very pretty.

25. Fine Christmas. Breakfast in nursery, then opened the books from USA. At 11 had all School, Annex, children etc. to bring for the jokes, Students for lunch. P's sister & bro. called. Then hung curtains in saloni - helped arrange tables. After tea arr. seating & painted place cards. 20 for dinner, music afterwards.

26. Still very stiff so did not go to any lectures but began again on O.S. Tea at Mme Ararandino & afterwards at Miss Kalo-pothakes. Dance at Caprice for Infant Welfare, which we cut.

27. Got to work on O.S. for part of a.m, some of p.m. - all eve 9.15 - 2.45. C & L went to Coina on noon train. HNF talked about illustrations for little C. book. L & I went to Acrop. about 3.30 and did partly Mus. - partly outside, back for tea.

28. Had long sleep, then wrote M - then we took DE and NF to Rhipissia to lunch at Pante Ren. - after roads to Tatoi as far as the palace - back by Patissia. letters till dinner. After dinner finished bread.

29. A crop Mrs for hit at 10.30, porous sculps. Stopped at hairdresser's - proods. After lunch L & I did O.S., tea at Mrs Allen's (his Friday) hair done - late for dinner. B & C returned from C. about 9.30.

30. Mrs. with C., Cycladic, L came for us & we left the pictures of upper hall on ~~back~~ on Sat. at M's, got flowers. After lunch worked on Ann. Report - which Capps was in a hurry for. Day at home, about 32, long session. Eve, more report with B's assistance -

Jan 1, 1925.

Started new year well by cutting a ΠΙΣΤΑ with the students, and drinking healths. L & I did O.S. in the a.m. ^{in p.m.} & drove on Bonliag mene road and across to the sea and back past Bonli and Thaleron. The men made some calls - then we all went to the Peroglou's.

2. Odd ends in a.m. & went to Kondouriot's workshop & ordered curtains for saloni. After lunch L & I returned to O.S. until tea time. There, then Dr. I called & after words I read the Kaiser's book on Cofu (for the pictures) partly before, partly after dinner -

3. A.m. got to work again on Cor. t.c's and it was a long job sorting notes - checking up the illustrations etc. but have got the preliminary part pretty well over. Struck with most of the day except for brief turn in garden. Lights all out from about 6-10. L & I finished our work on O.S. - then I read "The White Monkey".

4. B. off for C. on 6.40. Hoped to get a great many letters done, but didn't succeed. Went to Ber.

after lunch, very crowded, but did some Mus.
- then around to SE end where there are heaps
of arch. frag. behind small museum. ^{GS} Write

dull but necessary work. L & I out in gar-

many as usual to do at home, 14. Had
3 rubbers for NSF before dinner. Eve read
French report on Nemea & early to bed -

7. Have started earlier rising this week, so
as to get morning's work. Did te's all day
except for walk to P.P. and Dilicent before
tea. Eve chiefly WB and Tisch, Camp. TC

8. At last a large mail arrived. Epig in matrus,
Brea diene, Leontini, Skle Hellepont. Had a look at
papers until went up to library to have B. explain
roof construction of Prop. Tea at legation, and a
musical at von Schuens' (R. Schmitt)

9. Went to C. in Mus. Eyclades, Syra, Naxos etc.
TC after lunch until time for tea at Good's. Eve
got WB started on O.S. (Intro. ^{vid} 37-47)

10. Lib on "Tanten" - TC in p.m. L & I had our tea but
the others came in late, so we talked a bit. Eve
did OS with B. again (pp. 4-14).

11. Chiefly letters, trying (unsuccessfully) to clear up

20. C on EH, saw in apothecary another Meg type seria like ours. Dressmaker here, did some good mending, very quiet. Not large crowd at tea on acct. of Sym. Concert. Bod went in eve to musicale (Violin recital) at legation, very silent, had a good time.

21. Heavy mail, much pleased to get delayed letters. Tidied up OS so B could take it to Cor. L & went to Ergastirion & ordered some interim curtains for salonaki. B had his class in library & we went to it, Ezech. inscription (Chandler) [that was Tues. before the tea]. I

22. Decided to devote rest of the week to getting correspondence in order, but pain in arm grew much worse, so had Dr. Louandos - he

filled me up with same stuff as Geo T. had given me. Then stayed part, at least of the day in bed for about a week. Neuritis in l. shoulder & arm. C off to Cor. at noon.

23. Very lazy day, read The little French Girl.

24. Isabel Thompson died a.m. of pat. diptk. para-lysis. - everyone very sad about it. B did all errands & preparations, I could not move, but managed to write a few notes for Mrs. T. Harriet & Moore Galt's came by "Adriatic" - were here for tea, on way to Const. Read some DMR's Sappho he sent for Christmas.

25. Services in Eng. Ch. at 9. All back before lunch time, I shut quiet day - B made calls.

26. Nothing special

27. CWRB's birthday & we all gave him some Cycl. idols & daggers. First letter but could not comfortably dress for tea, so others went.

28. B off to Cor. early. Days much alike, enlivened by frequent calls from F, light literature, & have read Neurtley's Maced. report

11. Hairdresser at 10.30, then L + J drove to Phaleron + early the sea, hot coffee + pistache nuts. In spite of having decided to wait for H's letter, I got started on revising diary - Tea at Sotirades. Saw Julia Dragomirova again. Long in eve.
12. Spent nearly all day + eve on long, checked up with Mac I., edited sentences etc. Call in am. from Mrs Bonython, Miss Murphy, Miss Morris from Baltimore, showed them around. Dressed here. Out in garden that time in p.m.

Then to OE to meet AT & get her to hotel but
did not get back till 2.30.

19. Tried ^{Del.} to straighten out at PP, saw Archie, Schmitt
etc. Philippe. Tried to find AT in pm but lost her.
Stopped writing long enough to go to Arch Soc to
Walston at 5. Dined with AT, nice time -

20. Each day is more, ^{B took trustees to Cr.} ~~calls~~ all the time. In
a. m. Jack Marshall & family, then Walston with
about 20 Brits, showed them all around. Phil.
Theid am. went to dressmaker. Last grand
spunt, tea for about 85. Finished tickets, met
Guth at OE & back about 2.

21. Constant stream of people & more details -
One reception at Petrocchini's another at
Mrs Schlemmer's, dinner for 36 in library.

22. Went at 10 to 'Ariasmos', done by Abbot, then

refreshments. Hard on details. Tea first at BSA, then by club for dances. Men's dinner - we actually got to bed fairly early.

23. The Great Day, hard at it all the time, of arranging procession - seating, running last errands etc. Sea. a great success, all went off splendidly, fine procession speeches etc., food in library. Actually panned a bit.

24. Caterers came early, went to tennis court etc. L. I went to Mrs. & rescued AT & saw new things. Big reception in p.m. all fine, huge crowds. In Gen. - our garden. In eve Dr G's big dinner at PP.

25. Took a day off - went to Vouliagmeni, L.C, AT, Jo, Thumps, Pils, & Neopontis, fine time, picnic & bathing. Tea here. Dinner with Pritchett at PP.

26. Took AT & GMA to Acrop. Mrs in a.m. Best. I lunched at Dionedes, Genn, APallis, N Pappas, Lady Henley - a cousin. Laundry garden. Pritchett Mrs Curtis for tea on balcony. Dinner for 4.

27. Went at 10.30 to see Mr Louvidos's Byz. things. Errands. Large tea here. Went to see EC early in pm. & get back just in time. Took in Eve. B went to Cor. by moonlight in Ford, & took Harringtons a.m.

28. Mrs Oakley here 10-10.30, errands, PP etc. Went to Kephissia to see Louvidos' Skyros house, dances, large tea. Bed early.

29. Took Grot to Mat Mrs to see Leonidas, then tried to get into Byz M. (no luck). Took AT & Harringtons to Genn for a.m. Saw EC 4-6.30. Mr Norland came after tea to say goodbye, then Mr Oakley. Dinsmore's dinner at PP.

30. Great Great Friday. Saw Trustees off, then AT, L. I went to Arnebery with flowers. Then packed up Harringtons & came to Genn. with them & AT. Romans came at 3 to see Genn. EC from 4-6.30, Mrs Cat. Jones. Dined with AT at PP.

May 1. Mat Mrs. with Grot, White Horse for Mrs Steel, Annex to say goodbye to Carpenter, last Grot early lunch & off at 12.30

for "Patris II," went to PP to see AT & Harry.
Boat cruise off. C saw El - EDP in am.
Pais - Edw. came & we took them to Daphne
- back for tea. B long int. El all p.m.
Saw Eastern lights from terrace at midnight.

2. Spent much time on lists of those who had
sent messages to Gen., ticked up answers etc.
Charles - @ here for tea on balcony, long talk
with @ afterwards. Were to dine with Harringtons
but he had cold so we stayed home.

3. B lunched at Goulds with Gen., but I had
refused to see AT ^{AT came} so had refused. Agreed to
go to Delphi as he could not. Tea at Mrs Mil-
ler's, then called on Mrs Stevens. Packed up, were
no rooms at D., so changed to Palaf.

4. Made later start, left PP 9.30, fine drive, had
lunch this side Chilianodi under pine trees.
Others went later to Corinth. We drove direct to
Nauplia, arr. at 4, got rooms ^{rented}, then out
to Acene - no digging, but phylax took us to
cem. where there are 60 tombs, not many we
got, very fine LH. Then saw ^{prognosis} in Mt

10. Went to Mrs. in errand to C. Saw Calydon sc. with Kastratis, my badly broken. burnt. C & VEE. Writing all the time - trying to finish.

11. Spent most of day writing to Miss Carens. L & went to Strauss concert, all Mozart, M. Plate, A min & Jupiter. Then to New Phal. to dine with Gulicks. Foxles there too - light them home.

12. Cable had arr. the previous eve saying Minne. mailed June 5, so I had time to write M & spent all day & eve at it trying to give an account of 3 weeks. Gulicks called to say goodbye. B got off to C. on 4 o'clock. Had tea on balcony - Only day - Alfred for dinner.

13. Spent most of day except for a few errands in getting material ready for B's report to give it to take. Miss Galt & Miss Little came in before lunch. Went to see E de Jong about trip to Chalco. Caffer called to say good bye.

14. Had Mrs Stevens, Miss Galt, Miss L for lunch. C back from Cor on exp. G came after tea. Then to Mrs Miller's.

15. Encountered Mrs Hanks in C Room - heard abt. Cuban trip. Got with C. P. Grand exodus p. m. Capper, G, Galt, Little, Stevens - L & I went out to Marathon, lovely drive, but she fell & hurt arm - dined down stairs. B cable about Pulley.

16. Tried to get Sun. rest, then got to end of Genm. handles, documents etc. to give to Mr. S. Got bound L arm up to an abd. injury - Thatcher & Hodges here for tea, also E de J & Harrison later. ^{Wild goose chase to Keph.} Postponed Chal. trip. C ut. Cor at 7

17. L & I went to Zap. for X ray, no injury to bone, muscle only. Called E de J. Could not settle down so spent most of day reading Hounds of Spring by S. Thompson. Dr. Mrs G called & had tea on balcony, then L & I to garden -

18. Left about 9, taking V. Reboogen & J. Banta. Fine drive, arr. Thebes soon after 12. Mrs. No DE (too busy at Eur). Lunch & left

about 2, reached Ch. soon after 3. Fine drive - Rooms 37, 39 Palirshoia. Museum, then to Euboea over horrible road, fine place - Theatre - & temples, one of which I had not seen. Bridge in eve. 19. Left 8.30 for Skimatari, road much better across fields - Mrs. (some tiles) - Lunch at H. Mercurio, up in pines. Back c. 3.30 after glorious trip. Philippe, then tea at Oivras! 22. Got little ^{invalds} done. Went to Mrs M p.m. & heard of new sarcoph. & stile found at Eleusis by the road. Begun Burning Spear, etc. Went to hurry the villain Philippe, small results. Got cable Pulley died Friday.

23. Long letter to Trist whom I had neglected badly. ^{Ameliff - over} Miss Samuel, Mrs Brooks, Phrangles to tea.

13 to Cor. on 4. Made calls & went to Acrop-
after tea. Begun Jane our Stranger.

24. Dull day, heavy - just as well no Creta. wrote H.
Finished Jane, disagreeable but well done. Begun
Rough Justice.

25. Tried to get Mrs. D. on telephone. PC's shop,
Modistra - long session - call re Genrad. at CB.
Sent note by Bronner - Philippe, Dilie - bridge
in we with Pris & J. Day.

26. Must f.a.m. having out clothes with Marika.
Newspaper. NB for call after tea, then to Sergio.
Call from Mrs. Sotiriades. Pug. we & ready to bed.

27. Chief event was rain at lunch time - went to
Aurea, Sp. dancing, in Herod Alt. at 6. To
Taverna with LRT, then to Acropolis.

28. Mus. in a.m. Showed Mrs. Finley around.
Tea at Ital Legation for Duke of Spoleto, gar-
den party. Mrs. M's in we to see Miss Sch.
LRT to farewell lunch.

29. Modistra, long session, errands - Red Ckr
fr. on Kallia most p.m. in prep. for Creta.
Dennis' moor called - went to Kallion, kicked up
Edie J, de ned here, nice call.
