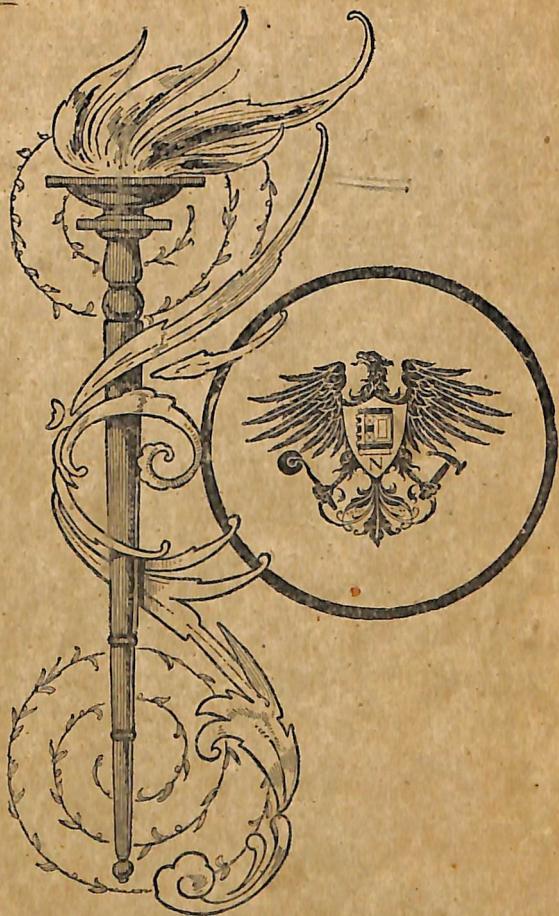

May 31. 1926

Evards in morning. Mrs. Finley & John for lunch. Packed for Crete, had early tea & left about 4.30 for Piraeus. Found the landing place quickly - went to "Kanaris", small but excellent. Clean ^{Room A} beds, good food, good service. Sailed soon after 6 & fell in with Gr. Am. family who kept us much entertained - Very beautiful until dark, lovely evening -

June 1. Up in good time & went on deck, Crete rather shadowy ahead but soon got clearer - Perfect morning. After coffee went to top deck for approach to harbor. Much fuss over passports, good boatman etc, & after some delay got Ford 301 to take us to Halaikta. Very circuitous route - We are in an inn across street, plain but very ^R clean. Nice Smyrna wif. Armenian who had been in Miss McC's school & did every thing for us. Got to hotel before 10, left things & went to Mrs.

Town looks much the same as 1923
but less picturesque - has had
fence around fountain. Museum as nice
as ever. New ed. of Guide which we
bought. Some acquisitions, Curo. fesc.
pleasant, negro etc., man from Malina
- a lot from Arcadias (great mixture)
etc. by Ital. Doro heri (see notebook).
Marinatos (off to Mesara) returned
before we left - we also saw Xantho
- had pleasant words - went with M
at noon to his house for Maria -
found Mrs Er. There - soon M came
in from school, great surprise -
had a liqueur with them, then
went for lunch at Caprice (all
meals there) - back for siesta. As
the Ford was new we arr. to go to
Cussos at 5^{pm} from Mrs; had already
booked for return by "Kanaris" Fri.
Went to Villa Ariadne - found after
entertaining Mrs de laey - Miss
Meikle - soon we all went to the

excavations, starting at N - New State
entr. - around to S. Propyl. where a big
col. - pier have been reconstructed, also
various basels - found. around, stair-
case to 1st floor (Nelson, see 1923).
along that level to the E or N stair (of
Agora) - to central court, then S. - to S
house where more has been cleared,
fine view of viaduct - caravanserai
across ravine. Saw place for pleas fringe
in chief room, next to it a foot bath.
Saw spring house - niche - pool,
also viad. with stepped spillways -
All very fine. Got Ford there, took after
to park - soon overtook Mrs de laey - Miss
M who had started to walk. Went to
tea with them, charming comfortable
house, ate and drank & smoked a
great deal - stayed a shocking time.
On sompart till dinner time, then
back early - read Beason's Rubicon
2. Made Bell etc. - left soon after 8
for Malina - Splendid drive by the

sea, but shortly beyond Strion th. the road got very bad - much of it was fit only for goats - & banged up the new Ford pretty much. Took about 1 1/2 - 2 hrs. & at M. picked up one of the men who has dug there & went on by dreadful field roads but got nearly to ruins. Made our way through ploughed land, stone walls etc. to little house of phylax, & found his wife. Spent a long time going over ruins carefully (see notebook.) In some ways more like AX than Cn or Ph. Though this was a big palace & the colonnades & some of the magazines especially interesting. Lunched under a big tree above the ruins, then went to the "sanct." on Kab - Charypolakkos where the very strange column is, at much lower level than the sq. structure which was evidently built in late times out of Min. blocks. Back

to Mallia for cafe & then to Neokleion where we arrived about 3.30. Had a rest & went to tea at Mrs de laeyp's, then in Park until dinner time.

3. Went out about 8.30 to Cnossos & spent the morning poking around - much repairing & rest. going on, Royal Villa has now had cols. & floors put in to show diff. levels. Did all or part of pal. first, then to street. to v. with underground pillars & strange arr. of "blocks"; like a maze almost. See R.v. then along E side & up into NE & all down side, then to newly rest-sanct. at SE part, along S face room S house, through throne room & all the complex there etc, ending at NW. AJE had gone in to Her. but we met him & Call. on the way out & had a few pleasant words. Early lunch & a siesta before going to Mrs. where we stayed until closing & then went for tea to Marionatos. In the

spare time read Benson's The Rubicon -
Lord Belmont. Dined at the de laeys'
- had a nice quiet evening.

4. Went to SS office for tickets, then to
Mrs. for rest of the morning where
we did the more recent discoveries
very carefully. Tanny had the day be-
fore brought us a photo of the Malicia
plan which he was saying he had not
known about to lend us for look,
but fortunately it was not hard.
Did he to rooms - then board to the
big main one where we stayed till 12.
Were told the "Kanacs" would come in
at 4 - leave at 5, so we got down
early - as there was no sign of
the ship we drove to the cem-
tery to see RBS's grave, then out
to N. of town as far as de laeys' quar-
ries. Still no ship - Sat at little
cofi overlooking harbor - Came in
about 6, went aboard, left about 8
after a fine time on top deck.

Had good cabin opp. The one we had
occupied before - were well looked
after.

5. Fine sail in, but did not get to the
morning till about 11.45. Spiro was in
row boat to meet us, - Marica in car.
Here before 12.30, much mail, news
good - After lunch got cleaned up -
began letter to EDTB, PC came in
- at 4 we went to Modistra - Quick
tea - then to Vasili, back by dinner
time - Bellingers - J Day here - letter
- newspapers in eve.

6. Cable family sailed 5th. Cleared up desk -
wrote letters, cards etc. After tea went to
de Ji's - then to golf club for clubs. Dinner
late. Read Xanthi - Evans, a lot.

7. Errands a.m., Co., photos for police, tickets,
Amby, Pais-vias, Oruidja, Cable here for C
on ret. to lunch. B. arr. by early train after
we had gone out. Long gossip p.m. wrote H.
Starting to dress to go to Paris. When Shears
came, good call though could not come

to dinner. Off by OE early next a.m.
B cable at din. Eng papers many.
8. Started about 8 for Corinthe, took things
for Bellingeres. Hot but fine in am. Then
violent wind & much dust. Saw new
Sarc. at Eleusis, pretty poor, but there.
Arr. about noon, Dick, Brown & C for
lunch by Miko. Then went to theatre with C
& saw what a lot had been done, pla-
cos, arch, etc drain etc. Dig on Titill,
behind Mus, back R - Perib. Apollo-
General cleaning up. Saw new am-
f Mus, qt. success, also new panas-
kema (3 rooms) lots of frags. from Pc.
früger etc. Miko doing C's parts from N.
Geo has plastic tes now on table, a
fearsome lot. Early tea, gorgeous
dinner back. Waved farewell at canal
to Jf on "Sardigna" - Here about 8:30,
dined in Sal, then saw Bell. in hill.
9. wrote Schidde, errands - long delay
over Fr. visa, police permits etc. To
Museum, setting up bronze. Boy in

room with high bronze, exact place not yet
decided. Dined with de Jongh at "low" place,
up on top, Metz, opp. Zapp. Great view.
10. Meet 7 a.m. on desk etc. Some calls in p.m.
for P.P.C. at de J's, (many there), von Schlie-
mann (out), Gards. Mostly getting in order.
11. Packing in a.m. Bridge with Mrs Miller
& Pis. in p.m. Bot returned in evening -
12. Finished last packing, call from Dinomomo
P.C. ill with sand fly fever. Early lunch, big
crowd at Passes for passport. On board
"Patris II" before 2. Fine ship, beautiful cabin.
Verhoozen & Mme Dubois as our pour, best
on boat, also Damalas, Mrs della Porta et al.
Beautiful afternoon sail - teleph at Patra.
13. Fine calm voyage, everything good etc.
lack of deck chairs, but we found something
land by middle p.m., fine view of Calab.
coast, then Sicily, used map for the
straits - Seylla etc. about dark. Then
Stromboli just before midnight. Very red.
14. High seas, very rough, heat wind,
many unhappy - Slow progress. Corica

- ↳ Sardinia before dark, passed between them.
- 15. Still not easy going so did not get to Mars. till about 9, too late for customs - stayed in boat.
- 16. Off early, met by Ghidman's man, easy customs. Took cab to P.M. - finally got a compartment of 4 couchettes for 7.05. Then more breakfast - off to see the town. Museum - picture gallery - best known Puvion delh. two fountains of Marseilles. Mus. is handsome building, waterfall in front, garden at rear. Drove to Quay to Basso's for luncheon - had bouillabaisse - sat over harbor. Tram around to residential part - back by Corniche. Am Ex, each got scarf, back to hotel for tea. Got on train early, very comfortably seated, huge crowd.
- 17. Reached Paris 8.20 after usual rather sketchy night. All luggage on omnibus across to Gaudin Road. Sent most of it through to Victoria, got places on 10 o'cl.

- ↳ bade farewell to the Belgians. Comfortable trip, cold in boat but had sheltered place. Glad to get Pullman at Dover. Rather long at vict. over luggage, raining, got to King's. Leg. - found word Dad very ill, nursing home 30 Parkeside Sq, E.L. I at 219 St. Ten. with the R.G's. Great shock, last news good. Hurried to home, saw parents at once, F very weak. ^{Letter 10/11/16} afterwards E.L. I got some dinner at Renda.
- 18. Arouse to 11 after breakfast. Then L. I to Brit where we spent an hour in search of Gisela - not last caught her - Bank. lunch Renda. ^{1/2} Visit to Mrs. Fritter about same all day - over 10/12.
- 19. Letter 10/11. Bad day for Dad. Met Gisela at Plane Tree for lunch. Much talk. Cover 13. Rest of day with M. Patient very weak & dangerously ill.
- 20. Much letter, bright & interested, best day he had. Dinner at 219 - papers until tea time wrote S.L.B, H, B etc. hard work. Tea very dry at 30.
- 21. Comfortable day, many errands all the time. Lunch at Fullers, back for tea, later to tea at Richters' was, Min hamb there.
- 22. Quiet day mostly at No 30, except for lunch

and errands.

23. L. & I lunched with the waces. Got M. to play a game of bridge in eve.

24. Hair done at Selfridges, missed T at lunch - hurried back.

25. Short call in a.m. from Jack & Betty who was off to Suff. W. Went to tea with the waces, Luce & Harlands. Talk with L.

26. Doctor thought v.o. for Trot to go to Rugby, also to see his own family - Slow but steady improvement. Lib's birthday - lunched at Fuller's - got birthday cake, then on bus to Richmond - wait for tea. In eve saw "This Woman Business" Compton & Quakermain Foolish play but good dialogue - acting.

27. Sunday papers. Telephone Trot to stay until next day - L. & I had walk after dinner, interesting to discover new neighborhood - Maud & Charlie sent for tea with M. Found the Rector here on our return - had nice little call - Read Cartwright Gardens mystery in eve. better.

28. Trot returned while L. & I were with M.

Call to Skewatts for lunch, then got tickets for "Mozart" - Josef. "Mozart" delightful in eve.

29. M's birthday. She went out in a.m. for a walk & errands. Dr. returned - felt satisfied. L. & I went to Hellenic Meeting at 5, sat with GMA & afterwards dined with her. Made dates with M. van Buren - Back about 8.30 - played with M. & Trot.

30. little walk with M. in a.m. P. Sq. etc - Took Mavis R. & G. out to Richmond - had lunch at Bridge House. Then L. & I got a boat to St. Court & walked across bridge to Gennadius' for tea. Lovely time, delights to see each other again - Back on tram - bus. Dinner kept for us. M in eve

July 1. Took 8.30 from Liverpool St. to Cambridge. Lovely day there. Poked around & took it easy, called Heffer, saw Lewis Cole, & new Cuban goddess in Fitzwilliam - Even better than Agatha's fine watercolors. Tea with Annette - then upstairs to see Mrs R. who was temporarily laid up. Went over the new little house. Saw a

lot in John's & Trinity gardens. Train
(7.07) late nearly an hour - dinner on
train - Lrv. St. at 10 - quickly up here.

2. Left about 11.30 & went to Bank, Kiel. Soc.
Knigsley & Cable office - Met T. at Stewart's.
Went to Tate to see new wing, much
modern French (less good than British).
Tea with Gton & T at in nice little
place. Their apartments delightful.
All went to Josef Hofmann recital etc.

3. Early call, then got away soon after 10
for H Court. Bus to Teddington - then
all around the block on trams via H
wick etc. Ahead of crowd, state ap'ts etc.
hill about 2. Lunch in nice cafe on
Till-Ground. Then gardens etc. Got 4.30
boat to Richmond, tea, back late to M.
Dined with Jess & Leo.

4. Spent a.m. at 30. Some shovels in
p.m. Tea first with M, then at Miss
Lamb's, lovely garden. Then to Club
to dine with the Van Burens. Found
all doing puzzles in dining room.

5. L got the chair & table from Roberts.
Went for short time to Brit & Wallace, Selfridge,
met T at Stewart's. To Amby - the Nat Gallery
& back for tea. All played bridge in eve.

6. Carl arr. 7 am. Spent a.m. with M. All 4 met
at Thistle for lunch, then to Beaux Arts to
exhibition by Miss Richlee, lady Callaux &
Mrs Marschall, very good - Liked portrait of
Mrs R. very much. Back to dress then to
tea with V B's, several there including
Miss Nelson & the Waacs. L & C went to Gton
& Ben dinner with Waacs. M came to
219 to dine - we went to Marie Tempest
in "Cats Cradle" & had an amusing time.

7. Trot off to R. at 10. L packed & I was at
30. Errands & lunch at Stewart's then to
"Mrs Cheyne", Mother too. L & C got off
soon after 6, telephoned from Waterloo.

Spent eve helping M. get ready.

8. Up at 7 & got most packing done before
going to do last things for M. They
got off about 11, lovely ambulance. M,
Lloyd & Ske were in the car. Finished

odds & ends, left soon after 12, put things
in Euston. Left - dress at Sere, Bumpers for
M's book to Tregoules, Scotch House for
rugs, Marble Arch Stew. for lunch, Seefridge
for shoes. Then to People's Theatre for "The
Salutation". Nice glimpses of R, E, M
afterwards. Back to PO, tea at Kingsley,
7 o'clock for Rugby - McGookin there -
Arr. about 9 - found others settled. Both
flats very comfy - I took journey well.

9. Got unpacked - in order in Son's room
before luncheon, also to PO - around town
with T. Showers - Out again with T to
get chair - Dick Haggard here for tea.

10. Letters ^{Chm, Wt H} & errands in am. Went out
in p.m. to Old Bilton to see the "es-
tate" and house, stayed for tea.
More showers, back about 7.30.

11. Sticky day - G, R, & I went to golf
club & had a fine morning though
hot. I came out & back to lunch.
Read papers & wrote in p.m. M & I
had tea together. Late supper,

did some puzzles, read papers etc.

12. Odds & ends in am., letters etc. errands,
hot sticky day without much to record.
Everything going on quietly.

13. Father had another attack about
10 o'clock, cerebral haemorrhage which
made him unconscious. Doctor said
he had no pain, but it ^{R to history} was a long day.

14. Quiet morning again, gradually
warmer. Darling Daddy died at 2 o'clock,
very quietly and peacefully. Many er-
rands to see to, notices cables & 15 letters
before 7 o'clock. Mave was kindness itself
about everything. R back in evening.

15. Cables & wires began coming. He did
anything but turned up here, much to
write & errands to do. Out for flowers.
Nurses have arr. everything beautifully.

16. Heaps of letters & messages & 4 big
wreaths from London. Service at 2 in
Bilton church, lovely spot chosen in
the churchyard, just what he would
love. Nurses off after tea. ^{More}
EDVBS book. ^{letters}

17. Trot & I helped M unpacking trunks & getting straight - a.m., also errands & out to B. to see how all was - Took M out in p.m. & she thought it all lovely. Walked over to T. Close and spent p.m. there. Had the wireless in use.

18. E & R were not able to leave on Sat. as car had cracked pistons. Got taxi to Q club & had a good game. Went to B in afternoon but I stayed in & got some things moved, matts, and papers etc.

19. Chief occupation was shifting my things upstairs & some of S's furniture down. Got all settled in to room, lovely outlook to the garden.

20. M & I went to London on 9.40 & had a busy day: Selfridge, Roub, Reare, Stewart, Liberty & J. & J. at Bond. House for Hill Soc. Miss Skelton & Agnes - S came out with me. Met M in Euston for 7 o'clock train, back by 9 for supper. E & R got away.

21. Errands in a.m. No golf in p.m. because of rain though I was to have E's lesson.

22. Spent most of a.m. writing to p.m. to H. also to Trot for birthday.

23. M & I drove to Oxford (Tallis Clynes) to lunch with the Vantours. A beautiful drive via Banbury. Brief visit to Ash, Hogarth, lunch, rest then to the Halls, met M's for tea at Fuller's, ^{left} back about 5.15, fine drive - Altogether an excellent day.

24. Did errands with M in am. Walked with Dick to Bilton, much rain, bus to Dunchurch & back.

25. Besides the papers most of the day went to sending out cards & writing letters, except when we went to tea with Mrs Cox - Finished Meganie (Gimson)

26. Quiet day, was to play golf but it rained in p.m. so I did odds & ends.

27. Tried to make a start on Cor. with help of

Edw's. Dr Wheeler called a.m. Went to golf with RH in p.m. - did 11 holes - walked back as we lost the bus. Took M to "Bohemian Girl", very good.

28. Large post from USA, much to be answered. Took E's time at golf club - Beaumont went around with me.

Saw masseuse to make appt. for M - did errands. Shirts full for Aggr. Show. Wrote Rougie, having address from Lib.

29. Long letter to H. Some Cor. Golf p.m. with D as guest- putter. Market and went to tea with him, then I took her to masseuse. Wrote L. Puzlos very eve.

30. Went to Dr Wheeler for eye exam, to have glasses changed. Had a look at park. Some Cor. in p.m.

31. Busy time on cupboards, small things with M. Letter to WNT, Cor. not much progress as have left some notes in sth. Went to meet M after masseuse. Have read "Reginald" (Saki) - Barymore.

Aug 1. Spent most of day on papers - chiefly writing many letters.

2. Ditto. Got a great number done - Bankhol. but everything very quiet.

3. Out before breakfast to PO to write GS (int.) letters again, errands etc. EOR - Son arrived in time for supper.

4. Trot, Son & I went to golf club, lost bus & walked back.

5. Much the same, played around with Dick & Son, while I had to go out to tea.

6. Letter a.m. Just reached g.c. when big downpour came, so we returned like meeting of France. There in eve, bought "25."

Not much outstanding to chronicle when making up diary, a week later.

7. Did some k. Trot & I went out to club in p.m.

8. R, E, D & I spent a.m. playing 4ball. Turned out hot & sunny. Late lunch. Took M for drive in p.m. Some lugh etc, nice country. Tea at Bilton. Papers eve.

9. Letters most of the day. Went with EOR

- on errands, Men planted heliotrope at B.
10. Horrid rainy day so devoted most of it to letters.
11. Mice birthday with books, golf balls, money for gifts. Went for shampoo, put new ribbon in typie. Golf p.m. with Son & D. Th Marshall & R Cowie for dinner, bridge afterwards upstairs.
12. E & I spent the day in London, errands, GS at Rend. for lunch, City Co exhibition at R.A., tea races. + Deane. Back by 9.
13. Rougie came at 11.30 & was delighted with everything. Took her to Golf Club & later to Bilton. List.
14. G & I did some errands in am. & we all had a good talk about plans for enlarging the house, over which we are all delighted. GS is to see about all M's things in Post. Saw her off at 4.17, quiet tea & papers & letters as letters had gone out to B. Painted hat.
15. Showery day, but we managed to

- get a good round, D & J, & R & Cowie, all here for lunch. T is bed. Men went to B in pm & the rest of us did papers & letters.
16. M, T & I went to the Am Cos. at Bim to sign papers about will for B Trust. Spent an hour poking around shops & got back for lunch. Quick easy journey. Still writing most of p.m. The Holiday came to do plans with E & R.
17. Writing seems endless, at it all a.m. while M & T went to dentist. Golf p.m. around with T, actually did 8 holes in 39 including lost ball. After tea went out in car to Mabbett & then to B. for a moment.
18. Chiefly letters am. Golf p.m. with Son while Thad Beaumont. 4 to 3 Found letter to Mott & wired her to come tomorrow.
19. Police station for registration re passport. Gotm an 11.30, did some errands & short walk. Also had a

good walk p.m. Got very black but we managed to visit B before dinner.

20. G.M. & I off on 9.40 for London. Went to furrier, Fr. Co, Meyer, Regent St, Stewart lunch with G.S., met K.O. also at Liberty's, stopped in rain for coat. Am Ex about Paris & Rome, various enclaves, tea with Jen. Back on 7 o'clock.

21. Spent most of day doing odds & ends, mending etc. Traveled out to B in afternoon, stayed about an hour.

R-D busy turning over for herb. border.

22. Golf a.m. Fine day fresh & breezy. Played with D, I up. R-D to lunch & out to B. M.D. did not go. Papers & letters chiefly. Finished The Dancing Floor.

23. E & I went to golf in am. as we could not count on weather later.

Good game, rather hot. Pressing letter. Wife's machine, terrible job. Wireless began series Brahms & Corbett Smith all week.

24. Chiefly letters & odds & ends. No golf,

decided skirt must be baked first. M did a lot of it - finished.

25. At skirt: Shampoo & enclaves a.m. Golf p.m. Treat with Beaumont, & I knuckled around.

26. T & I went on the 10/11 trip to London, left 9.10 took 9.30 back. Got visas from Fr. & Gk. Co, then to Am. Co. to see about M Income Tax - Referred to Som. House - Enclaves at Steep's Selfridges, lunch Stewart. Then T to Som. & I chasing all over for Ital. Co. & visa. Met at ^{25.5} Liberty's, got purple motor rug for M. Got

^{+ silk blouse} tried coat - D. J. (S), fell in with Jen there - Tea at Fuller's, bus ride to Barnes - So. Pers. again to see City plate. Dined Rensley. Had asked traces but they could not come.

27. Got am. mail off, prep. for journey - M has made bell flowers for her georgette sh. She is lending me to take. Looks lovely - T & I to golf, ^{+D} but bus - had to walk back, boat, packing.

28. Off for 9.40 to London. Train late, Eur. 11.45, went to 219 & left things. Then to Am. Ex re Rome. Met G.M. - Jack - Norman

for lunch, then long talk with G.M. met
 Miss Avery & Miss Brown (Lullaby) at Thisle
 at 4.15 & had 2 hrs. Then took bus for a bit.
 Dined with traces, quiet talk. Back about
 10.15 & gossip with family at 219.

29. Computable breakfast, Jf about 10 escort-
 ed by Mr G. to Victoria. Good journey, calm
 crossing. ^{Silver Spoon in route.} French train very dirty. Arr P.
 7.15 (late) - It met me. Stan 22 at Bed.
 food, has been made into singles & baths.
 But very welcome, nice dinner, quiet-time.

30. GS here just as we were going out. met
 Amy, shampoo appt, then Bible. sat.
 Rather loth to give us tickets, but did.
 Great luck finding her engravings at
 once. To be photographer. nice attendant.
 Cooks for H, & back to lunch. Appt. at 3,
 265 rue Stt. (Henri, my man) expensive
 & slow but beautifully done. Tea at
 Rumpf., then lovely drive in Bois -
 weather very hot. Doc. in ev.

31. Started early & went to Charley (Jes)
 but the only belt. going. was an ensemble

so they would not sell it - walked to
 BN looking on the way. Very grudging
 of tickets. Finished soon, walked more. Too
 hot. Early cold lunch at Penyp, on pav-
 ment in shady place. Siesta, then to Loure
 to Ok gallery. Everything is open every
 day now! Stayed till it closed, then took
 taxi around Bois & had tea out under the
 trees at nice restaurant near entrance.
 Very sleepy & tired & early to bed.

Sept 1. Got ticket to L. at Am Ex, then to Liberty,
 with H who got two frocks. I ordered a belt
 1200
 going. at Charlotte Appert's in rue St. H (209)
 very attractive place, lovely models. GS &
 Marie here for lunch. Afterwards G.H. & J
 went to Loure sculps., then intended tea in
 Bois but it rained so we went to R's &
 then it cleared & we had a lovely drive &
 took G back to her hotel & said farewell.
 2. Went early to Aux Deux Burs & each got a
 hat, mine a small felt one. 295
 Then to Sophie
 Boissy d'Anglas (Vt) and got belt lace & me.
 700
 frock. This was after various failures
 elsewhere.

Then to Notre Dame & afterwards lunch at the place near river where L, T, Ma & I went.

Back to rest, then to Ambly for seats - then a very long drive in Bois until too late for tea. Have read most of Bellarion.

3. Really cooler. Went early (too early) to Louvre so went to Rivoli & got a mirror bag, very nice. Then returned & did Stal. ptg. for an hour, & to hairdresser for tonic for M, & for fitting at 11. 31. Saw E.H.H. off for Paris. Am. by Mr. King to order tickets Rome. Enroute - Very hot. Left things at 2.15 lunch Stewart's, ordered silver dishes M. or W. after looking at G. or Silver. To G.M.M. about 3 & had tea Back 5.20. Trist met me - Puz. in.

Sept 1. Learnington a.m. after photographs finished.

2. Ruffy early, Clements etc. Tr. I had lesson from Harkeris on wheels, jets, plugs etc. Golf p.m. Tr. I but sticky, back for tea - Read Lord Pope & Belle aloud until dinner time. Buthorn Prom in.

3. Started trying to catch up letters & spent most of day at it.
