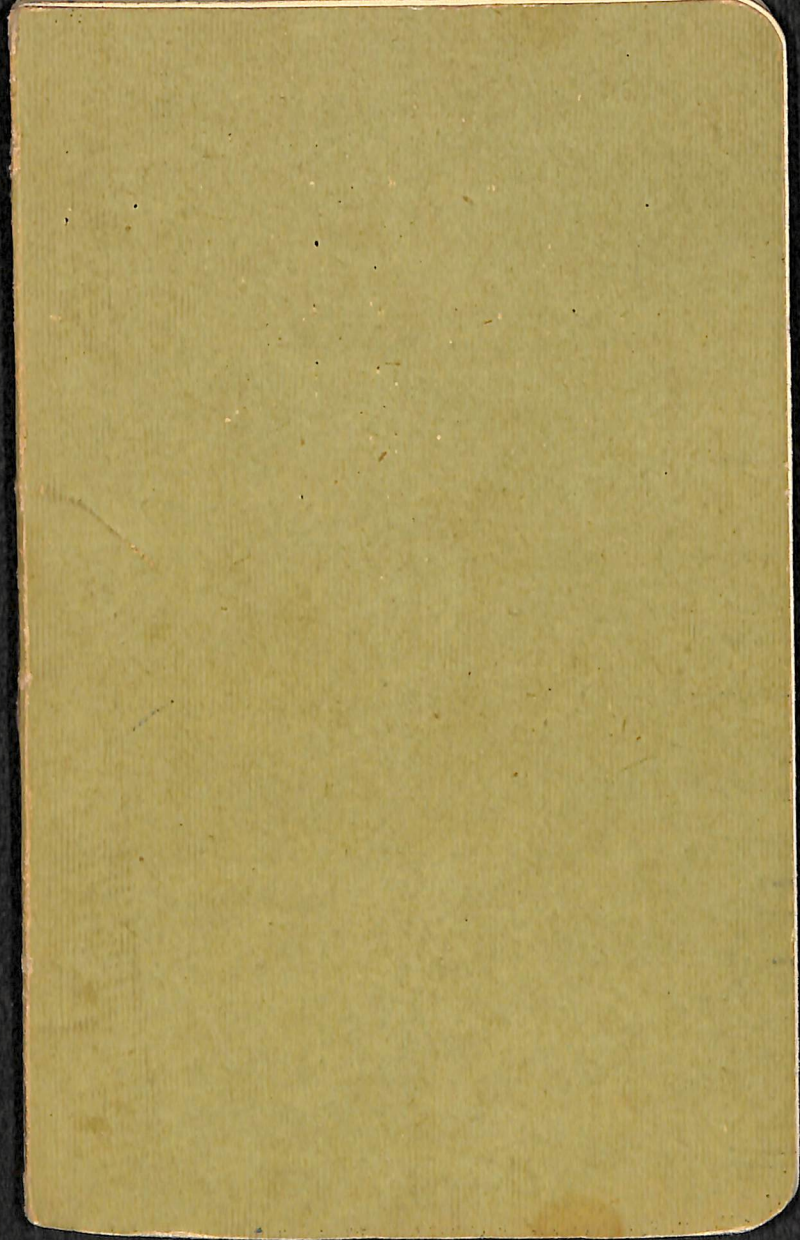

27. A-I off on bus to NY where we stopped for a coat & finally got one from Dangler. Met others TTC and lunched with Grace at H, M, L, - S. More errands pm. Got dress Edmon's - ^{29.50} Went to see Patsy off on "Deutschland," describes name. L. heard to TTC where had tea with others, then to Englemund. First sight of charming new house.
28. Most of a.m. settling. After lunch went to Montclair to Robert's for tea. Wrote M, papers.
29. Did many errands in Eng, incl. Canyon abt mill. Stopped at Esth. to see Anne. E out. Lots of odds & ends to do pm.
30. To NY. Studr supply warehouse, L to Huesar, J to Aber, L to T stockings & nts, met DImy Skens for lunch. To Sales, Hunter tea Jolaster, back to E for 6 o'clock bus to Nyack with May in new house.
31. M, Lucy & I had great gossip. 11.30 train to NY,

met Mark at St. for lunch. To warehouse for trunk-rack. Out to E by tea time - Glad to rest.

Nov 1. To NY via Holland Tunnel - Gk cos for visa (one free) then L to NGI - J to washer. I went to Becky's - L to Evelyn's. B & J much talk some Dad's cherry. Lunch at L'Bigton Bank for B's bonds, Bank TC met L. All at B's. Tea Cosmop. club with AT. Met M & G at TTE - out to dinner, also M & W, while L, & Gisela at TTE. Went to JMR on Olynthus at CU. Saw McCrea, Davis, Goldbergman et al. Back to E about 11.

2. Erands with de Scheer & will from Nuclein Early lunch, pack. Met N at end subway - all 4 drove to Pot. Wet but good drive. Left 230 am 5 at ^{7:5} 4th. L & J went to tea with M & N. All drink Wms. then to EMT for see, chiefly JC, F13, M & - Chatterbox.

3. Showery. L went to Gibbs. I to EMT. Hat tel. from Geo. that Alice died Fri. Went to

Gibbs then to Pot for errands: Raymond, trucker for stockings, W Sch. at Fallkill. Lunch Tshop with GS, H, N, M, L. Afterwards to see Dr K. Tied up M's Thanksgiving parcels in orange ribbon. Tea at M's. Dinner AT, with H, N, G, CS - BR.

4. Very wet. Went 10.15 to see Schickle then Smailly for rest 7 a.m. Backwards. Midday dinner AT: D, T, G, H, N, M & B. Much fun over coats. Drive to NY, cleared off, splendid sunset. Left E - out to E before dinner. Home M eve.

5. To NY. Gall - L for phot. paper, L-T (grey shoes) Becky where talked book. Lunch DC Mrs C in apt. Edm. for L's dress, G & L. Met very late, but G showed new ring - Later to home for L's needlepoint - Found M Back at E when arr. Heard last speeches H - Hoover etc.

6. Election day. Spent it packing large trunks, except for final at de S. Returns in eve, decision for Hoover pretty early. Bed 1230

7. Trunked off by 9. Rest of day to small bags

Last errands. Tel. to UWH. Some calls p.m.
Bill + Esth. in while we had dinner. Read
sheet summary. Off c. 8.30 for "Roma". Met W
on pier. Cabin changed to 154 - bath, fine.
Becky - John dropped in. Wrote many
notes for pilot. Then found many packages
8-16 voyage on R. Finest ship I ever was
on, everything de lusso, beautiful rooms,
perfect service wonderful cuisine. Wine
was McD, yellow RPL, ch.-a. 2 from C, Sherry
che - Plumbridge AT, Ph Morris E Green, nuts
G-GP, bag GGP, books Rawson, fruit basket UWH
-M-F-W, pen - ink for Xmas card & box. Flowers
lasted very long. Beautifully comfortable
+ cozy. Fine ^{table 17} waiter, lounge before meals.
Met Alberts, Bush, de Rob., Boyden. Great
nice quiet time. Rough a couple of
days, mostly calm + fine. Read lots of
stories, Slyph, Scarlet S Mary, Deack near Rine,
Invisible Portrait, Old Pybus, etc. 15-Gib^{am}

17. Landed Naples before 10. Grey am. No diffi-
culty at customs, G. Manini has us in tow -
letter M-Fs at St L. Sent wire M. To Sitmar
for ticket. Took 12.15 to Rome, fine trip. arr
3.40. Girardets very sad over death Alberto's
wife + departure made night of Geo + family.
Unpacked. Met Moon - Geisse on doorstep. To
Ros. for tea. Call VIX (out) walked Ven - Tritone
VIX came soon w. note. Miss Wilson at G, Mint
away - Sat by Signora, Miss Loomis (hells) on
other side. Move room M moved to during
packing. Fished out stories, "New day" for eve.
18. Lovely morning. To Terme + saw new
rooms on ground floor, observ. + Bra P
room. Sabrin cloister garden beautiful.
R looking fine, fountains etc. Wrote M
after lunch, also to Mrs S. Times. Met W's at
Ros. for tea. Rain. Good gossip. Signorini die
Back for quiet eve w. story.
19. Fine. To Kodak, order from DC, Roberts

sox for B. Genoni to look for fruit baskets
like Roma's (none) ordered cards to include,
Gallenga. Full for ^{5.30} pm - etc dresses, green,
lovely, perfect fit. After lunch read papers
- up to Palat. until tea time, at Fagnola's.
Schubert concert at Phil. 8:30, the trio,
D quart. - songs. Ede saw some of Swa.
E's linen things, got chiefly help.

20. To Virginia for an hour or so - saw new wing
v. bronzes - vases, new garden - To Gall.
for L's fitting, Rosati en route - up Sistina
- to Pd S, - Gambini - Got eyeglasses case
match case, purses for servants. After
lunch read Ob - S.T. At 4 went in Mrs's
car to Aurelia, taking Shields - Wrens.
At tea, Sanders, Shipley, Richardson, Compton,
several students. Had to leave early for VB.
Sand. too. There saw A.H. Smith, Bo, Boccioni
Miss Mather, Lords, Mrs Curtis etc. In
we went to Miss W's room to see gems.

Stayed for long talk, R etc.

21. Rag market. Got pendant for Effie. Walk to Ven
for vermouet in sun, up Casso - Cond - to
glass place in Bab. there got masticha set
- small vase. ^{Wrote M} PM for card (ing) gallery to tea
Geiss - Moore - long talk. Dined VB's, also
Stemms, nice talky time. Back early.

22!! Most a.m. packing, incl. doing over the
glass st. came absurdly. To Kodak (400 ox)
Aragno, cards (washout) Trevi, final pack.
Lunch, 2.40 train - Arr 6. Stb, met Miss Vict
Adams in lounge. Wrote H eve.

23. On 9.40 electric to Nere - Miss A too. Very
interesting. Theatre, old etc, - new etc. done
like P-O leaving - restoring - Lonely day -
Back 1.15 got sick at Massa's for N - G.
Late lunch - rest. Am Ex, tea Mid, first
sent sick to N - G. Postage very dear -
Wrote M. Early din. at 7, off c. & for "Milano".
Cabin 12^a looked very small but got

things in. Late leaving, asleep when sailed.
24 Calm-grey. Good view Stromboli. Short
stay Messina, did not go ashore. Spent
most day reading papers, magazines, etc. Sit
opp. Mrs. & Miss Argyrop. Left M about 5.30.
25 Fine sunny am. Spend most time in
encl. veranda. Good boat-food. Read
Dr Ricardo. Rough p.m. 2 miles to before
dark, calmer & very wet. Did not see Patr.
lights at all. Gossip with Miss A in cabin
26. Off Canal very early, went thro' at 4.5.
Rain stopped but grey, rain & very windy.
In about 7 time, alongside quay. B
met us. Customs easy. Ath had car
car. Home by 10.30, everything fine order
files etc. Luggage came soon - heaps
of mail here. Began unpacking. Phot
left flowers. Made appt. Vasilis, then did
E rheum. fever, still almost helpless.

28 ^{Fine} wrote M, stopping in middle to take E
for drive as far as good road past Gkyd
Call M Davis in Kalamaki. Finished little
rest papers Eng - Amer
29. Thanksgiving. Did desk & bank acct
a.m. To Den, flowers, de J. E better. After
lunch L & I worked on envelopes & lists. At 5
B, L & I to tea Legation. Mrs S had rheuma-
tism in arm. Big crowd Amer. Goolds &
Mrs R not there. Dinner here (Berensons,
Mariano, SK, Pallas - Good time.

30. More addressing & revising lists. Tried to make up items for diary. To Amaly - a J. Harid & wet. L's cold keeps very bad. Began Geo M's book on travel in late pm & eve.

Dec 1. Began letter ECT. Out at 12 to chemist & then a deluge & hail came up. Afterwards did for brochures for L. Tim letter pm, then L - I did stamps. Got cards from Dem at 7 & in ev put them & DC's into about 250 envelopes. Read GEM from 6-7. Have done c. 40 pp.

2. Began as beautiful am. Wrote M - 13 & I went at 11 to Zap. NER meeting. Pat, Ken et al there. Golden Rule Sunday. Saw Mrs Sotir & Petro there. Had them home. Began to rain abt. lunch time. Made up diary - Awful job. Wrote H. Pouring pm. so did not go to Hirono remittance. Call from P. L on lounge.

Got all envelopes gummed in ev till abt 12.

3. Spent a.m. around desk etc. Errands before lunch. Left L & went pm. to post n. letters, then cards Sch, Pap, tea with M Davis & R K who came back to A. with me. Pict & herous off for Creta pm ^{Cards at hand.} ^{Com. Mrs Miller 630} Picked up Effie & brought her here. Read some GEM, most ev lacking. BATH to Trent.

4. L very miserable. Spent most day packing around & read in Geo to about 70 pp. Rather unpleasant & dull.

5. ~~6~~ Wrote M, stopping for call from Dr Robbins - Atk son born 4 am. E & I went pm. to Manoli, PC, E's box, shipping office, back late for tea - GEM ev.

6. ^{Fin} M did calling list, wrote cards etc. Pm papers. After tea made many calls. Got B at RSC & to receipt. for B's of GEM at Brit Hotel. GEM to 88.

7. Lonely day. L & I out errands am. PC, Petrop. for maids dresses, tablecloth, dish towels, seek for old dressing gown. Wrote more cards pm. Off c. 4 to Amaly, Manoli, calls Phalern. Tea Mrs R Taylor,

also Mrs Urquandt, Gould & Morris whom I brought to Ath. Many calls. Back c 7.15. Found Mrs Seng & Thompsons had been. Entered more Geo.

8. Did more cards am, various odds & ends. Sunny pm. L, E & I went to Psychiko, then to Neqep & back for tea. Later I did the Paris. district, wash horrible. GEM finished first part in ev. Read Nov 2, Nov W.

9. Grey a.m. clear & fine. Plet here before breakfast. Wrote M-H a.m. Drove pm P, E, L, I, to Koropi. Lonly out. B in house w. cold. Read GEM 133. Pr E went ^{Brahms from Wien.} home after dinner.

10. Grey. Wrote Ma (concord), Mrs Ot, Hills, out c 12 to Ouis, then PO de Jo. After lunch put up Sav. curtains in Salon, w GEM. To tea at JK, 2 Ohinis, Blackler, Salmon & family. Left L at de J & got B for tea Philad. Very wet, back to de J. Good music Ven. in ev. GEM to 152 (all but appendices.)

11. Terrible morning, deluge & gale, clear pm.

Read last parts of GEM, wrote a few letters. Tea here pm. About 30, everyone seemed to like it. Ev read Am papers.

12. Wrote M. Call from Amethimona in middle. Ouis for L's satin, Marouli, Anaxa, de J. In pm got E & went to Neqhis. write cards, then around town. E here for tea, took her back & left a few more. Read back no. Lit-Supp. in ev.

13. Ordered Vassie's china, Amby, Mend, de J (out) & home. wrote cards & looked over ATA. Chased E, & did more cards pm & later I went de J. for tea, Neq, Neut, St Rich. there. Dinner here Lucas, Thompsons, Davises, Kent.

14. Went a.m. to register, then to Mrs. Saw Kost, hem, Heramp & Bertis who showed us fine new bronzes from Artemisium area. "Pos", horse-boy. Then to Vasilad. about cars, de J. for a little custenance. B very late in, chat pm. Paper, then pay, w. L. Tea at Ambar. w. Mrs Papa-dava, Ghinis, Neqh, Venis (son), Maccas & Ev, - ?
Loprestis.

Deluge going on. Then to de J. Bin very late
began to the lighthouse, & work.

15. Worked on cards for Europe & wrote many
notes on them & some letters. Orig. w. blk. evs,
moire, L's satin. Ordered 24 ³⁶⁰ lemonade glasses,
office on sofa. Began as fine day but got dull.
More cards & letters pm. Aer had tea here.
Schub. concert Rentrikon at 7. ¹⁶³ Quinter, song
by Dishorn & Triant. Very long, left before
end. Sch. quartets from Naples eve. Lighth.

16. Rather greyish. a.m. wrote M or part of it,
finished it afterwards. Read papers. Early
tea, then B to office - L & I to de J. Illies
also there. Trio letter. Aida from Wien eve,
followed it from score.

17. ^{Grey rain} letter early, then Phil, shoe maker, & G.
Wrote ~~2000~~ after lunch then got to want
to sit on with r/Deerest. Tea with de J,
L to Orig. Douglass in Peter. Trentgen on
Hrv when L. returned. Static very bad eve

Read NYT, TNS, cut new Camb & H, a little light.

18. Beautiful day, warm & sunny. Went c. 10.30
taking McDavis & Mrs. Luce to Acth Coll to see
Ben. hall & D's house. lovely out. Saw
fine site. Got flowers, the de J. odds & ends,
paper etc pm, dressed early. Huge crowd,
85 besides ourselves. B off to office after
dinner. Finished Lighthouse.

19. Grey. Wrote M; to Tomby, ²⁰⁴⁷⁰ blankets as Geo-
iades in bed, ordered Ath cap, Heemes st. took
Mrs Pabo home, de J. Late upstairs after lunch.
Went to Prio ship, got PMH & to tea Richardson's
Psych. to meet Curran (now inst). Also Skinner,
Monton, Luce, Stevens, Davis, Aldrich, Lamsdale, Good,
Broner, Pease, Douglas, Keyes. Back 7.15 to de J.
Wien eve, good concert incl Tsch. violin concerto.
Read Zyg. chop on archit.

20. Static fine, but clouded over. Page proof to. arr.
To Phil, Orig, Zyg. ch. on tombs, tea de J. Piet
went w B, L I to Presentral. Back 11, Sch. Et Syn

Chopin 2 etudes, ch. Pol (Liszt) Album, Music Box,
Wien Carnival (Ro). Still fine, but hangs. Eve
read Zyg Pottery to p. 122 eve.

21. Looked at proof, wrote Hnt r H Pass. Went to
Stoa Bp'h. to consult Roxane about car. To
Comm. Exhibit of Gk industries p.m. Got beads,
table cover, boxes etc. & got silk pockets for micas.
Back for tea, then de J - had some music incl
faun. Eve Zyg. rest of Pottery Misc p. 208

22. Began reading proof. To Phil (grey) shoe-
maker (600 satin), license bureau, Menidi, then
Red. hunting stamnos, de J. Left c. 3 - took E
- went past Boyaki to Ulen tract for greens.
Back late to Skayft. for tea Mrs Markas.
Then de J. Eve read proof, text as far as Inv.
till about 12.

23. Began M letter, then to Attention for Sym.
Buechner 4, Rosenth. List came, Valkalla.
Finished M. Call M round our sister. Kirby
H. Called at Dragoumis, de J (out) Miller.

24. Read inv. of A.R. Out to Phil (endless wait) 14 MV
de J. After lunch did through Ssq, spent 1/4 at 14 MV
- left in disgust. Back for tea. Out again to Skavell
for top, got a gram. Then - Col. heard 13 of Sville
at Stas - returned to St. Good machine. To de J. where
found Effeses, took parcels to Scogy for E - to Dark.
children. Eve popped & string corn, did Xmas tree
in dining room. Heard chimes, organ, chorals from
Wien then Natale from Rome.

25. Merry Christmas. Ate up too late for church
so did presents after breakfast. Lots of nice
things incl cheques, Vincent, Balkans, Pers letters,
Penelope. Man Sliz Essex, Cm on JSt. out before
noon, left at Kalop, de J where wood roads came
in. Brought Pk for lunch & T's pudding.
P had copied 2 lovely water colors, Rutor
Pauch. for home & had Eveshops. Had some of P's
borrowed records after wards. Began review for
Davies, call from W. Regrep. Tea at Peroglu's also

Mrs Black, Soter, Kondotar. Saw baby, nearly 2
fine - big. Walk both ways, windy but not
cold. Davies - Kent here for dinner & nice
variable evening.

26. Spent a.m. on proof, getting through it once. Out
c. 12.45 to de Jongh. Wrote M but lunch & tea
which we all had here. Very tired afterwards
so L - I did puzzles - took it easy

27. Feeling rather ratty so spent day lazily
reading The Children. Effie here for tea.
Late lunch - Dabishkin called. Eve nice
trios Beeth. & Schum. from Budapest. Began
Lily Christine eve.

28. To Vasile, Ten Nimono exhibit - def. Out
early pm to Elvassis on road which is
now a miracle. Tea at de J, also Mrs
Hewdly, Mrs Sakel, - Davis. Back c 7.
Good trio Breuer before dinner. Eve went
through second copy proof, & made notes.

29. Proof ^{thru notes} out off fairly early for errands,
Green paint on door (good)

Ann Ex where met WST, Gil, & Robbins. Mrs
March; to Stronilli to look at toys for Louisa
but finally got at Pan Bag. Plant for ^{nmv} Prija,
bracelet Timo, Coulet Ath baby, 22 lemonade
glasses, P.O. de J. Pm to NNV got some Gt
records - Cortot Chop, Publ., Figaro. Back for tea, Pen L
- I read 3^d copy till time to sleep. B & I did Ann
legat: Veng, Ce Sim, Argypop, Elianco, ^{Matia} St A Pelli,
Gen Mavr, Phrautzes. L at E's, called for her.

30. Painter scenting house, inner door. L, B, I to
Pop concert; Anac, Nagay 2^d, Brand 5th (Met.
Vol. Flute), Flying D. Saw good proof Denaxa.
but 3 - got E-P for Menidi, Alex Bond &
Paych to Benachi. New for tea. Call Mr
Shrook, wrote M. Eve had 24 Chopin Preludes
by Cortot on Gram. Read L Chr. ^{wrote} H

31. Gorgeous day, finished H letter. off. 11
w. Pr E to St Demetrius bet. Marathon
& Souli, lovely spot, fine picnic. Terrible
damage by fire after Pileomi. Stop at

Sows on return, also Raphina, got queens
All here for tea. washed gloves, tidied up -
Mrs LC - records till dinner. Finished
Zyg. ev. did new year's envelopes w. L.

Jan 1, 1929 Cut the nitra at midnight - had
Gk. Natlymen on gram. Had a steady procession
of people for gifts in a.m. Began drifting
out Contents. About noon L & I went around
to Palace - saw part of procession, then thro'
gardens to de J, who had gone out to lunch.
Afterwards L & I addressed env. for next day.
Tea at Dewings, various Ark Coll, Morris, Skir-
ner, Thompson etc. Later to de J where had
Van Symp. Eve did cont, hist of I'd etc. in
first form to copy. Finished L.C. in bed.

2. Began ^{morning} typing I'll. To Denax for cards, took E
to Glyphada where good road. Called Mrs
Goold on return. Got cards ready p.m. Took
books to Neqep. Tea Satis. w. Mabel & Starko,
Petro, Mrs Payne, etc. Took them to G.B. Back for L

- took P's records back. Eve finished typing
I'll, cont.

3. Finished letter NWF - tied up proof packages
while L at Quij's. To Min. for Kou (out), to G.B.
for Mabel & to Cem. to grave of Johnny. Later to
see J's monument, & to de J. Began Index p.m.
Took Mr S to tea at Legation, big crowd there
many of their friends. To de J (out) Sotiriad &
Millers to invite to dinner. Index eve.

4. Sent proof to post. Index. Out c. 11 to Pris. w. bill,
Kou (not back), Museum where saw bronzes
again. Karo in Nye Room. Stopped to meet Mr S
but they did not come. de J a few min. Papers
after lunch, index, to Phal. left cards, tea at
Sakell. w. Phal. pic. E with us. Long delay w.
puncture & no jack. My papers, more index till 12.

5. Perfect day. That a.m. on index, then walk
thro' gardens & get unemoines & greens for
party, then to de J. Ind. again in pm & to
tea to Ath. to see baby. Dinner eve for

M-S, Sotiriades, Miller, Kalyp, Goid. Very successful.

6. Began M early, then Pop w. The drum of Symbati, Beeth II, Lalo Skrangouali, Riemzi. lunch GPs with Gromitches, then Kephessia, N Melas, Xidi, S Dragoumis. Left M-S at 5 Drag & went to de J. Wrote M eve.

7. Wrote H, then to Koro, Aedus for kitchen china, GPs to say bon voyage to M-S. Met former Steph & Chalkokou. There, then to de J. Did index all pm. when weather was bad. Call from Koro after tea. Cont. index of inventory in eve.

8. Horrid day, with snow & windy. Messed along on index while L went to brig. Out c. 12.30 across Zap. to de J. - Ind. again after lunch. Cleared somewhat. Tea here, about 25, played with radio. Late played Beeth 1-2 sonatas - lit dined legation. Dinner late, nassau uncut. Rev. Alsaubi. after meals.

9. Cold & wet. Began cutting Ind. a.m. L went to Koro & I wrote M. Out later to de J. At it again pm. Went to tea at Davises, with afternoon ^{gales} but cheerful time. Brought Mrs Makras, Minons back. Home c. 7.15 read my papers. Dinner GPs with Thompsons, Heulides & Ararand. Much talk later about Sikel.

10. Cold & very windy. Index till 12.15, but slow work. To de J. B. out to Ath Call lunch GPs. May 5 Beeth 3 after lunch then wrote visit. to tea Skyr H. on 15th Got E & all went to tea with Mardens. Ind. since. See daylight.

11. Woke late. Windy & cold. Index till 12.15 when went to Museum & met Koro. Showed him Carl's things, then brought him back to lunch & good talk on many things - his birthday. Went to see wonderful Acrop. photos by Hegez in their little flat. Tea at de J. Stayed ages & had Schubert, Kar-Sym, Beeth Romance. Still going but Index eve.

12. Beautiful day, cold and sunny. Index all a.m. till 12.30 when walked thro' garden to de J. Skovads there. Out at 3 to Psychiko for look at lots. Karastashians here for tea. Ind. later - we till c. 12. Schum. Quint. from Wein, then new Cf Sonata by T. Cantat & all our other needs.

13. Began M letter. B, Effie & I to concert. Bouts. Don Juan, Berlioz Sym Fant ("hifi") Farandules Beethoven C min, Glazounov Sinfonia R. Very cold in Attikon. Greyish so stayed here pm - wrote M & did some index. Mrs Wood Baker for tea. Call Mrs Huddell's niece. H. H. H. H. H.

14. Beautiful day - Began typing Ind. At 11 all am. - then to de J. (house). B, h. I went pm to Boyati's & son to the dam. Grandi party arr. just as we left. Back for late tea, then to de J. where took Cf for them to hear. Had also B. Parnassos & Sym V. - Krautger. Wire from M that Uncle Harry did Friday. Typed hard all we till 12.15. Finished Family Studies, in bed.

15. Index till 12.30 when went to E. Finished

typing p.m. & began reading Gt reports to L. Tea first at Mrs Meikle's, then Romy's in new house, very cozy. Tried Mozart Quartet, borrowed from P. Did reports with L. all evening. (Tou's bunch).

16. Spent most of day checking references, etc. finished about 8. Out a few moments to de J, back in time for luncheon to which came Karastashians, Domesticos, Krimbas, Petros, Saquedros & where we talked over best. Conguous drive over mts via Monyptaina where saw E.P.'s hotel, most picturesque villages. Roads in bad shape much of way but drive magnif. This green & fertile country & pine woods. Much variety. Set new to me - to Dim. There we got out & went to find Mrs. in school, but

they were rebuilding & I w. key was on his rounds. Wonderful view. Saw Magou. across on other side valley away up high. Lots of showers & many clouds. Saw almost none of gorge because of mist filling it but drive was stunning. Then Karytaina, magnif. view of it - lunch in car just before Megalop. Too wet to sit out. Saw Meate etc. as we passed. Benzine in village especially had terrible time w. bad petrol & clogging in vacuum tank, but finally found trouble & got rid of it while we were away up in mts. Then to me again from Meg. which is fine though less thrilling. Terrible roads in Messenia esp. the one we took with rivers, floods & mud & a stuck camion & a hello

boy quicker as outside. Kalmata
soon after 6 or did not like looks
of hotel so came to White House
opp. station. L & J in the salon or
office but were all right. Very
nice & clean & new. Others are
about 8.20 by train. Dined very
late in restaurant below - he
had made tea & found the boat
black. Much rain, also cold.
15th A great day hunting fresh sites.
Took cars, to Nisi (Museum) and
beyond to "Kakulala" where Beets
had told C. There were chamber
tombs. Two had been plundered &
sealed up, no sheds about. Hunt
to all hills & mounds nearby
but found nothing - Then on to
Mavromati - Great Gate. All
his very much as I had remem-

bered from when L Sk. Port went - Great
Gate - Had shower, a.m but it turned
very fine w. gorgeous views. Sat on
top of the tower of gate for lunch on
then climbed along walls - to see
best pres. tower. Stopped Marco.
for water - birds' eye view city
(Cayna up) but did not climb
down. In little Mus. saw Domo-
phon insc. Parts of 3 lines. Not much
else of importance, had not been before.
Then drove by junction in main road
went through vineyards to see 5 sites,
2 high mounds & 2 lower 1 small
might have been tholos. Nothing
splendid drive back though much
of road very poor. Country very fertile
but apparently there is no interest
in improvement, people glum &
shiftless, lots of children. Back in

time for tea in room. SR with us.

Dinner in rest. below. Fine outchokes.

Bed in good time - Moved to room 5.

16. Good sleep. Up about 6, coffee 7. All off for Patalidi via Visci. Road under repairs & terrific. Last part fine, splendid sea views. At P all out & stayed around for coffee etc. Hill outlets got horses to go to Korone. Got back & out other side Kalam. by new road towards Ladi, went 8 km. Will be fine. Clouds very black esp. on mts. & on pass but had no rain. Lunched on side mt. by olive grove w. magnif view of K, castle, harbor ships etc. Back to Villhardouin's castle, now prison on way up. Big outer gate & walls, sort of garden-wood & then to inner gate & walls. Capi on top. Explored along walls, great views

everywhere but too hazy for distance.

Then to harbor & along shore, busy part.

Back to hotel & write M, & B (card).

Then to village to hello boy's grocery for supplies. Dinner, Miss H. at next table & had coffee with her - Bed fairly early after some packing.

17. Off on 9.10 for Pylos. Train via Meligala, Kyp. etc. Splendid scenery, very clear views. Thome & fine east part through mts. Junct. for K about 1, then only a few minutes - K. on hill side, fine castle - Got Dodge for ^{625 per car} drive to Pylos & lunched in olive grove not far out of K. Country all currants & olives, lots of wild flowers. A present of yellow roses from nice old gent in village on way - Changed cars at _n for excellent Buick. Magnificent views on way down. Sph. much bigger &

more imposing than I thought. Harbor
 very fine, almost landlocked, big & little
 passages. Arr. about 5:30. Hotel Novarino
 on sea, small but new & clean. Great
 mixup about rooms at first but in
 the end got it straight. Price 20 per bed
 choice old woman - husband. L.O.J. went
 on to Modon to search for the others.
 Not there, but had fine time in castle
 which is in splendid position. Went
 to top of wall opp. island Sapienza -
 fine entrance gate to castle, ^{maple} armor at
 sides, col. formerly with STM lion in
 front or piazza, lions all around.
 Most of circuit-wall preserved,
 blue with gels at ends & prob.
 2 on each side - wonderful place -
 Back to P. over mt. drive about
 200 ^{L.O.J. to all castle}
 12 km. Waited a long time for
 others - finally L. Miss H. & I must

to cafe & soon they turned up. That
 just missed us & misunderstood abt.
 car so waited ages. Good dinner in
 little restaurant, in ocaide at end pla-
 tea. Everyone had great trip across.
 18. Showery morning but cleared off very
 fine & brilliant. Went by motor boat to
 Phanari & up steps to monument to Fr.
 on top. Then along side island. Phan is
 on small rocky one w. passage thro'
 rock & a couple of smaller rocks broken
 off from Sph. Passes Santa Rosa mon.
 lands Panagia (Russian mon.) &
 up along saddle & part way on top. Very
 precip. to E, more grad. to sea at W.
 Boat took us to end where narrow
 passage is - Screaming time pulling
 up on sand & being carried ashore.
 Got fisherman from settlement to
 carry bags. Then up to the castle on

Pylos. Hat rough climb of about an hour up through bushes & shrubs mostly on goat track. Another fine castle, outer wall nearly all left. Round towers etc. Crowns ruins. Lunched on top under tree - Terrific scramble down, very steep, around to Cave of Nestor. Pit dug by lions to left of entrance, not much to see - Cave, stables, gothic roof shape, large & goes in deep. Sandy beach near by, Ox-Belly bay, & the others went in & I found a shady place on the rocks. All walked around a hard tramp in sand, then along under side of hills thro' fields & vineyards to village of then we had a drink & got an old man to show us lions' holes. One had only part domes visible after clearing brush; other had been w.c. though top fallen in. Small well laid

stones, good door. (See notebook.) Ford was waiting - we went to main road, then and it for others. L & I sat under tree while rest went to see another tomb 6 min. distant. we went with Dion in 1923. Stopped
Frankobrysi to scrape for shells, n.g.
Trip. about 7, same words¹²³ in New Palace.
Met Richardson's so all dined together
in rest. with back garden. "Pleasure of
vine" or something similar. Near hotel.

20. Woke. 4.45 hearing sheep going through
town. Decided to go to Tegea so left
about 7. Looked at some of C's boxes,
te - rest. patting from 11 Georgitika
also brief glance around T. Museum.
Took old quard along & went to a
hill (2 windmills) but far too rocky
to find more than a few shells, with^{5th}

Stopped again at T. - got provisions,

so stayed in, read papers, hit Supp. etc. Bridge
from tea to dinner. My papers eve - began
Eng Numan.

23. E + I played golf a.m. Rather chilly.
Took the mother to cinema. Getting horrid
cold so sat around reading papers etc. Bridge
after tea. Finished Est.

24. Horrid wet day, stayed in doing odds &
ends - trying to cure cold. More bridge after
tea. Kate + I went to T's recital at Licha-
ny, women composers. Good number seen
considering the weather.
