

May 15 Fine. Hung embr. plates etc. in w. room
got out old MSS while L has lesson. Real
some in Ponte's Delphi. Out & presents
met Davis in Pres. Back late for tea. Out
again to buy for a moment. Is back - got
bed up while we put cat in W Room.
Dinner here, MBS, Brown, Davies,
Ralph, Karo. Everything fine, shared
them around. Stayed till after 12.

16 Fine. Went out c 10 with C & to Mrs.
Kondylis, Ghialle Saturnia / Amly, Elou.
Back c 11.30, began Torg. w/ L. Call from
Mrs Sotiriad. All lunched with Fisher &
nephew in his garden, 3 charming chil-
dren. Saw Br. Silenus they wanted to
buy, nominally from grave in Eretz
Kondyl. here on return. Call a Greek.
Late tea, presents, left B - went around
Magg, barkats etc. Met dinner Schi-Melas
also Mr & Mrs Ghassis(?) Gen Mrs Kaliriski.

17. Fine a.m. L+J out fairly early to Orij, also took insur. papers to RMTM & back to Orij. Doing over many summer things - L+J played some with Torg, tried everything on d.r. shelves etc. Weather very threatening p.m. but had early tea - went to Aerop at 6 for Balanos Partition show. Good crowd, much pleasure or results. Back 7.15 - met Poulsen, also some more in eve - played all T with L.

18. Fine early - Deluges off and on after lunch - wrote M+L before lunch. Did some accounts with L, re furniture - Call early from Mr. Mr. Cook, has friends, grandson of Mrs. Chilly horrid afternoon - L+J did some red Torgs. More Poulsen in eve.

19. Fine. Grand time clearing apart.
- transferring things to former

haunt of Vict. & Co, everyone at it - got done soon after 10. L+J out c/l for many errands, NER, Pris, Michael ("Saturn"), Magg, Ambs, Mrs. where we looked at a few j-C's things. Left 12.30, quick change, lunch GJM w. Cooks - Gen - (Marconi), back by 2.45 to see Mrs. Kerr-Rox. for a few min. Cooks here for tea, then to Aer. with B. L+J out for doorhandles, new candlestick & then drove to Spata, road much improved - More Poulsen eve.

20. Fine. ^{P. to Co} L+J off in good time to Orij & back by 11.15 - hectic time with elect. Out again to Phil, tried on dark blue, left 6k. Mended piece in front. bowl after lunch, more Pouls. Early tea, to see GJM near at Kafe Kosmas, 8k settlemen on point - near cafe, tomb nearer was on wet shore. Lots of pottery etc & some L+J no MH, island figs, much abd. Bought

Geo back - wired Piet - if coming. Very sleepy but heard some Schol. notebook that borrowed from Andre. More Delphi.

21 Fine. Notes etc. Spent most am with Mr. Effie - L in Mrs. Odds' room after lunch, finished Poohs. After tea went to Negr. for his name day, only Jamie in - Alterations finished. Later to Meadow for message to John. Old Toys eve.

22 Fine. Bouquets Delphi at intervals all day. Out, left C at Mrs., to Stasini, etc., etc. Price w. embroideries back 11.30. L, C I to tea with ^{Flowers bought} Davieses. Took piles of periodicals which were duplicates. Their garden day fine. Brought back 2 Cretan jars.

23. Greyish, threatening p.m. L - J to Oryj c. 10. I continued to Ambx, Mrs. with C, Sleuth, hat stretched, back to Oryj till c 1230. I went to Mrs. & I came back

read a little more Bouyg. Finished p.m.

L - J went to tea with Mrs. Skinner, still in bandages. Vasili at 6. Tong (hard) later.

B back for dinner. NYT pictures after.

24 Fine but sticky. Off betimes to Spiro for flowers. L - J putting up icons in Gk room. Call from Miss Stone. L had lesson & dressed early, very warm, chiffon. Luncheon Mrs. Kerr, Mrs. Sotiri & Rox, Gladys SR, CBZ, Owen, Fisher, Hill.

House looked fine. Nice time. Took it easy after they left. Cleaned papers etc. After tea L - J to Millies (out), batteries, new lamp shade for 10/16, later took presents to John for Timo. Radio going in eve, working all night.

25. Fine, warm & sultry. Finished GOMS thinnings rather late. Wrote M - H before lunch. Papers afterwards - some old Toys. Piet in while at tea, came

back later to dinner. Got all news of
Knoz from him.

26. Warm & sticky. Spent a.m. in Salnaki going over Delphi material. Did not write much. Piece of saloni ceiling fell before lunch & afterwards nearly the whole E. half. So light that nothing was broken. But for Bondj. & spent most p.m. clearing up. Servants & workmen fine. Rather exhausted by tea time. Out c. 7 to sit cool to get brief case B had left at meeting - took at Davies' (out). For dinner Mrs Schl, M. Klar, C. B.,
Piel - had to wait afterwards.

27. Fine, warm. B off on 6 for Cos-
up in good time. Fat painter taking charge, covering etc. walls, floor,
piano. Cabinet etc. to coat room.
Stuffed cracks bet saloni & dr. Plan-

ter getting up scaff etc. First coat before night. Did not accomp. much all day finished friolans story, odds & ends. All 4 new. here for tea & strolled around. L & I did some old things.

28. Fine, hot. Began M. Kondy. came re-
sitter & antiqu. case. All off c. 10. Left Laabij & C. at 11. Went Antaly & other errands & back to Orij. Home before 12, finished M wrote Girardet, St L, Heffer (Hyperborea). Late lunch. Times, lazy pm rather hot. L & I out after tea to P.O., Phyle etc - then to Marjorie's for an hour. Tried eve to get my sym - Toc. via Vienna but got boys instead in Stabat M. Fine.

29. Flat, much wind. L.C.I., to Mus 10-11-15 back for L lesson. Did Delphi till lunch & tried to write some after it, chiefly outline. Plastering done by eve. After tea L & I out to Phil, Exhib

- at Strat, met "fat painter", drive round
was, drop in at DK. "Aida" via Gratz en.
30. Attic a few minutes before breakfast
wrote B. All 3 off to Mrs before 10,
Slox appeared c.g she, Rawson here
for day then Rhodes. Mrs till 12.30, all
lunch PP while back hall de-plan-
tered. They all left soon after 2, hot.
Tried Torq with small success. Be-
gan to sand Gk Art. After tea call
from Capes, then to Vareli. Very
sticky eve, began hammermith.
31. Mrs open earlier so L, C I off soon
after 9. Stopped for flowers. Did 38
till after 11. John's book while L
had lesson, a little Delphi. Dances
to lunch. Sat in p.m. Papers,
finished story, did some Torq -
Mrs Ohini - Aristea here for tea.
More progress eve, obs. Bed early.

June 1. Nat - wrote M - H a.m. Spent most
of day lazily reading The Bolt and
trying to keep cool. After tea, C and went
past Spata to re coast, not back till
dark.

2. Hot. A little Delphi. L. I went at 9⁴⁵ -
to Cathedral to Mr Thunberg's funeral -
huge crowd. Afterwards to Mrs. 11 - ,
doing 38. After lunch C read Petersen's
article on L/H misc. from Asia. Very
interesting & most of it good till near
end when too far off field. L & I hung 6
of Pitt's pictures in salonniki. Last
coat while on stairs, working on saloni.
Times before tea. Short call Kao, re
esc. in Mrs - to say au revoir.
L. I out 6.30 to Proodos, Petr, Zan - got a
set of china in lower Hermes st, much
like Davies'. Drove on Eleusis road
as far as sea, back for short call DK

Late dinner, scraps on violin. Began Master Day Judgment lent by Dr.

3. Hot. Started staining stairs - had to Orij, first - to Amiens. Back 11.30 a little I, out to Cecil for lunch w. Mrs Keays & a long talk afterward. Stopped at Coel to see Ralph ^{at} DKart. Bright sun to burn. After tea drove to Menidi & enroute HSt. Some CF Quint before dinner. Wine less n.g. ^{Read} Began Master Day Judg.

4. Hot. Began M but went to Mus 9-12²⁰ not so bad there. Doing 42 when we left. After lunch finished M went through papers. Began ^{at} Maurois' Byron borrowed from Ralph. Very hot. Stairs being waxed. Dinner at Jacobs', other guest Polish sculptor Witting. Nice quiet time, walk back & wash by

window to cool off. Did some old Tops at intervals.

5. Hot. Out c 9 to Orij, then to Amiens for new passport, took long time. Back c 11.15, later to BSA, near Ponville de Sepeh (Marn.) till lunch time. Very hot after lunch, L & I did old Tops, read some Byron. Great gale after tea, had to shut many windows. L & I cleaned out-in bookcase cupboards, put small pictures on shelf, clean up hall bookcases. Out very hot & dirty - late dinner, B back from Corinck c 9.30. Very little rain.

6. Much cooler. In Mus from about 9-12²⁰ doing gold things from 41. Torrential on way back. After lunch went to BSA 2.30-4.45 dis Ponville de J. Back to change before tea. Cakes here, much arch. questionning after. L out c 7.30, left notes at Mus to rank for picture. Back 8.15, started new

Tony - did more of it after dinner.

Read more Byron.

7. Cool. Off before 9 to Mrs - stayed till after 12. Latter part seeing Huntley's things, Then + Dan + H. did rest of good things, then beads. After lunch L + I did some Tony, then BSA 3-5. Showery. After tea call from Dick Shillwell. L out at 7 to Mrs - Played cf Quint. Read Byron - Tony, eve.

8. Cool. Wrote M + H and a few shorter letters. Investigated saloni floor at. Some Byron after lunch - more letters. Early tea - L + co back but - did not see them. Took B to Gloucis, then continued with him to Megara - went out to look for sheeps on hill. Back to station for a masticha + saw train of fine drive - Back after 8, moon. Not

much luck with radio. L + I dug out an old Tony + did a little - Early to bed.

9 Cool. Went in good time to Ong, then museum rest p. am. Beads from 2. Mrs Keay + Mrs Balfour here to lunch. Read Myres who was noble till time to dress for tea at 4. Also Leslie, Mrs Ohini + Christ. On return stopped P.P. for cocktail with the girls - L + MR here a few minutes in eve to get detective stories.

10. Cool. Museum 9-12.30. Marion working part time, Dot in too. Back via Phil + Army Garden door going in - warmer after lunch, read most p. Byron + finished it eve. Out 4.30 to Piss, Sheld, Magg., Chania etc - Back for tea + out later to see Julia D. Found her + Dimitri + 2 friends on terrace at 5 P.M. Good symph + granite Vienna - A little on an old T.

11. Colish. Wrote M - Then to Orij - to mark Hill closing time - Stopper Brit-Passport (closed). After lunch went ~~home~~ a little out at 4 to Arley for Romeo ticket. tickets, dillie etc & back to prepare picnic - off 4.45 in 2 cars. Fine drive to Sam & Ren's all account, supper on hillside & back by moonlight. Room kept. Boy, terrible, making a new one. Girls in for a drink before going home. Got to bed early with hurt.

12. Colish. Put in a good long morning in Mrs. MIP there part of the time. Got as far as part of 49. Back c 12.30 to find furniture back in saloni, floor polished etc. Before & after lunch hung pictures - curtains, lamp etc at it - almost incessantly. Mrs Skinner at 5 for tea and to look around. Mr S came soon after 6 - off

c 7.15 to Hotel Paspati for nice call, 3 Negrep, Carap. et al. Back - quiet round dressing. Mary S here for dinner. Decided not to go to Log. night. Tired, but early.

13. Colish. About 9 to Orij & bought jug on the way. To Brit-Passport Office, then Mrs Hill 11.45, back to BPO, Vasili. After lunch L & I did some new ^{Rome tickets} till she went out at 4 for errands - More until arrival 2 Kalop - later Leslie. Showed them around till after 7.30 dinner here 2 Raisons, SCox, 10 Hill, CBE, RK stayed till after 12, all talking them fully - B back just in time.

14. Comfortable, clear during day, wind & rain late at night. Mrs. 9-1 all done but 8 people in for visit. After lunch met Times - Oh & some Dancing Beggars. Early cup of tea then to Nick for Salurnia, then to tea with Orij & sister. Flowers, to Negrep

back c. 8. Dinner Miller & Pietro. nice time. Liked everything.

15. Fine a.m. Cloudy & shadowy latter. wrote M, H, - spent much time going over things preparatory to packij. - L packed all a.m. Got hats in, did shelves & drawers off - on all day. Also wrote Effie - did an old toy after tea. wrote Aunt C in evening. Call from Rawsons.

16. Fine. Off at 9 to Ouij & then Mrs. till 12.30, doing Tomb & lots of beads. Deox & MR in for a call. Times after lunch, call from Timo & his mother. Started packing. Perfect deluge c. 3 rows in start. Clean off. All + Negri, DR, MR, Deox, Mrs Stone to tea - Diner PI with girls, also Cyna & Scops. Piet arr. while out.

17. Cool, cloudy at times. Piet came about

9, all off to Mrs till 12.30, then to Goef for our clubs - back by 11.5. Packed after lunch & then to Mrs 4-6 & finished things. Late tea & more packing. Rawsons here. Same in evening, getting on.

18. Fine & cool. Up before 6 to pack. At 11 off on until time to leave at noon. Dot & Marion came about 10 & helped with silver. All off on 12.35, good breeze, very comfortable, rain began before Co with whom Deox, B & C got out. Deluges off & on all p.m. Muddy but not raining at Patas. Christmas man misses & we got room at Majestic, went to Co's office, he did passport. Dinner with Copes whom we met hotel. At bedtime found L's Rev. soaked. Horrible time.

19. Woke about 3, rained with few intervals till boat sailed at 11. Everything drenched, no sheds or protection. Finally in pilot house of tug. Spent about 2 hours working

over luggage, opening, closing etc. Lovely ship, have III with bath & verandah. At lunch met Baltzes, nice talk over our coffee. More things to put in order. Tea on palm verandah, at intervals read Bleis & Mansfield. Saw Bi again after dinner, turned in early, very tired. So woke early, up in good time, lovely sunny day, got repacking done before 10. Breakfast on verandah. Short glimpse of Celands. Letter. All in order before lunch. Sat with Baltzes afterwards, splendid view Capri & Sorrento but had shower when reaching Naples. Covered gangway & luggage well protected. Off and through customs soon after 3. Giovanni met us & we had no delay at all. Decided to take 5 for Rome so stopped St L, saw Matoni, went to Mergellina. Nice run up, occasional

showers. Very comfortable. Rose 7.40 - 8.00 by about 8. Had wired Signora. Fine welcome. Miss Kars in hospital, only one I knew here Miss Fletcher. Turned in early, unpacked a little. Got books from Louis. Ready to start for gymnasium like wind.

21. Fine. Read before breakfast while I got good sleep. Out about 10 to Gallenga, Amby, Condotti, Tivoli, TC Ital, Biffi, - another carriage to P&S, newspapers & drove back via Borgo. Took a very long siesta. Tea Baltzes. Then to For Ang, Traj, Taip, Marcelli, Auguste & to Palatine till 7. Back in good time. Called up Gray (ancy) & Stevens. Another quiet eve, hot done Trig. after lunch, a Cibitilian one.

22. Fine. Began M in good time - out to Capit. by new road at back & spent an hour in Conserv. & garden. Later to Terme until lunch. Family all here.

finished M. Real VF during siesta.
Out 5 to Card Rose, mothers Stevens,
+ Mrs Dekaralla for tea. Stayed after
they left till 7. Stopped flora, message
for Genio from M. MHS turned up
before dinner. She, L + I went to Essedra
for copper + lignites. Back soon
after 10. Finished book.

23. Fine but warmer. Ambix w. pass.
post to send French, PO with letter
for air mail, 12 pearls, papers, met
Mary, vermouth at Gargiulo, got
dahlias at Pdi S + took them to
Miss Hayes in garden ^{Ang. Am. Mun-}
³¹ning Home, via Nom. She is convalescent.
Short siesta with Times + out before 3
with MHS - Miss Fletcher, fine dive
to Remi with Bianchi (good new
clad Fiat) to see boats. Got down
close to Remi on shore. One now under

canvas, second being pumped, 3^d on off.
side. Much more impression than the
pictures. No permission but got in + went
all around + then to small museum.
Later up to Belv. for tea + back via App.
Ant + tried Scip. but they close at 5.
Splendid drive, fine asphalt road much
of way. Back about 7.15 L + I dinner
Villa Surdia on terrace, also 3^d flights
at Fairchild. Beautiful up there.
24. Fine, warmest. To Cristighi met his
electing book, Sermoneta for curtains
(3 pris + 4 transoms), Kodak, Gay, Ambix,
Mrs + to Spanish exhib. in Villa. Fine
lot, esp. Gucc + Gayn. Not when out but
finally got back. After siesta M, L + I
went to Tomb of Scip. + then decided to go
to Ostia by new road. Scars first - had
good poke around, then Mare for tea.
Spent most of eve packing.

25. Up in good time - got small packing done. Out c. 10. M, L, I to Traj for where we had a most thorough look around with foreman. (Permit.) Hat in sun. Got report of excursion. Then to Trevi - for bladder back before 12. Trunkies had gone with Am ex. to station. Farewell remount in Bar Eog. - Bo came along. Early lunch. Things very comfortable, early to train car 4, 10/12-13. Not as hot as the Bind. trip last year. Read Obs., Times, began House portique.

26. Raining when we got up. Dull trip but kept comfortable. Clear before Paris. Got 4 o'clock to Bond, easy without change. Quiet crossing, good dinner on Pullman to ticket. Arr 11 o'clock. Knisley, 42. L's Birthday.

27. Up in good time, a little grayish, more suits. Left 2 coats, 4 dresses at

Achilles. Selfridge for emerald & hair, 10²⁰ To see Mr. Fothergill & I got ticket from Pinxter, money Andy, slow. To E.S.U. soon traces came to lunch. Fine wine; coffee in garden. Left 3 - to R. Clarendon, got 2 breakfast cloths & napkins, blue, yellow & small napkins. L hunted jersey dress, - got 2 at D.T. Knisley 4⁵⁰ for tea & 77¹⁰ 4.50 Euston. All luggage O.K. M had re-served place. Quick trip. Train met us - all fine. Talked briefly in eve.

28. Mostly unpacking a.m. Also at 6¹⁵ practice with Ethel. Set with red roses & chrysanthemums about 12:30. Mr. had her gift before lunch with us all there - lots of kissing, p.m. Clothes a sight. More unpacking. Car back a.m., then after lunch. Birthday dinner, wine, lots of jokes - nice things. More, Jo, Gordon, 10 in all - lasted 5/11/12.

29. His real birthday - Out for golf but L & I did only 11 holes. Many lost balls. Tubs after lunch. Later L, T & I did *Tony, the Everyman*. Tidied up small bag etc. Eve started Scarab Murder.

30. Unsettled but many "bright intervals," now to R when E took M to Buckley & did a few errands, P.O., Pariss, Boots etc. Fine out so all went later for drive in country via Cuckington, Henst, Leam, Warwick etc. PM all to bridge party at Jo's, got lovely prize charming stat. dish with flowers on lid - Mrs Ridge, Brown, Waugh, Maule, Gregory, Boothroyd, Miss Sizer. Back about 7 - E out to Music Club so R, L & I had supper. Hard showers. Haydn Quartet flat - Took D on wireless, read more S Mus.

July 1. Fine, warmish. Mrs Button pressed many dresses for us both. Cleared up,

washed gloves, settled accounts etc. Reading SM ff - on, finished eve. Listened to a lot of Wimbledon in p.m. To in for a few minutes a.m. Took down making.

2. Fine, with clouds. Wrote a few notes etc, then T, L & I to R for errands, Bank, PO, Ouse etc. out on Hillmorton Rd for strawberries. Began Edwardianus. Heard hills. Match but by Ticken Box match we were due for tea at Longwood. Nice time, Mrs Reed, her companion, 2 , Billy - Tutor - Out in garden here after tea. Took it very ready, before & after dinner.

3. Fine warm. E, L & I to London on gas. Did puzzles most of way. Went to Kingsley, Rev, A Transport, Amly, Dr J, Liberty, where got slippers & thin dress material, Fuller, then met E at Bernards for ravioli - sataron asks IC but did not turn up. Tel H. Wace re Monday - Splendid afternoon at Rose

Show, gorgeous exhibits, Sets guards, Pipers. Back on 5-20, tea en route. Eve heard at Le Amour 3 Rei, read some Two Tickets.

3. Fine warm. In about 9:45, returned straw berry crates, Ovens, travel worths for many household articles. To Golf Club, T. had lesson - L, Jo - I played 9 holes very badly with many lost balls - late lunch, cleaned up. M - T out to garden party, read Edw. Later M - L to cinema. Wrote Effie. But Eve finished Edwardians.

5. Fine. Doing roses, papers. Out 12:15 to church mended grey coat after cleaning. PM saw Wimbledon finals, Tilden Allison, Moody & Ryan, Ryan + Crawford. Finished 2 Tickets worked out routes for Norfolk.

6. Fine, warm. Set out to golf club, L - I did 11 holes. Fewer lost balls but no brilliant play. After lunch, ticks - general

cleaning up, talk with M re BTCo. nice concerton. L, T - I did Tong, amusing, not very hard. Finished it soon after tea. Read S Times, Mo etc - My lecture papers.

7. Off to London by 9:29. Left bag Kingsley spent much time off + on trying for GDMB. Went to Dr J for T errant, got green hair dried matinée Biel, Fullers. Effie for lunch, with her to Victoria 3:15, Sheepidge to see glass knots - got Dennis set. Taxi to races, also Gisela, Woodward, 3 Semple, much talk. Left 7:30 - to Frankoe for gossip with P + E. Off 8:30 to see "On the Spot" + Wallace Chicago young writer, splendidly done. Sandwiches - tea on return.

8. Tel Cosmo at 9 relander Has am. the night before - gone straight. P + E came while we breakfasted. Went to Cosmo. Left note. Wrote T. To BM to see Woolley's new things. Less spectacular but very important,

many places, statif/c. etc. Astonishing
 'Wair pottery very like Matt. Eric & Drake
 in Elgin room - GMAR in RF. Callow on
 Forsdyke, Ont. Renowned ticket. To E.S.U.
 where had talks by GMAR, J.A.K., GMAR
 for lunch & talk in garden after. Also
 a most amusing man Gisela knew, buys
 for museums etc. Tea Kinsley got 5²⁰,
 plenty of room. Trout met us, his chard
 to all around Stratford. A lot in the
 hotel got letters. Go here for supper.
 9. Wrote B in a.m. & part of one to
 H, while I stayed in bed. Did a
 few odds & ends - some garden.
 Early lunch & then M, T, L, Dr & I
 went to Stratford (via Chichester &
 Newbold) to see "As You Like It."
 Fine company very well done,
 Clifford Waller, Jaques, Hale, Orlando,
 Fabia Drake Rosalind. Very cinema

for temporary theatre. nice tea at Shakespeare
 Hotel. Back about 7 Woolly 7.25 on grave
 near. Ratsey, Went 9 to rehearsal -
 10. Breakfast 8.15 off c. q for Dr & after petrol,
 Poole, left 9.30 via North, Bedford, Sandy,
 Potton to Wimpole Hall to see garden.
 First over house, 17-18, lots of fine
 rooms & wings mixed with all sorts &
 rather shabby. Lawns & trees fine but
 garden not much for big place. Park,
 trees, roses & splendid. Lunched by
 road under trees a couple of miles
 beyond & then to The Gables, Melchett, a
 fascinating place. Mr Lambert house
 most artistic gardens, summer house
 orchard, kitchen garden etc. Left soon
 after 2 & via Newmarket, Thetford to
 Wimpey. Arr. before 4 but Dr had gone
 to meet us. Fascinating old place -
 had tea after a wait, then Dr left

but met others on way - Late tea,
much talk, all around, everything
lovely - Had a lot of Schubert after
tea, late dinner & more music.

11. Stormy in night. Did rods - poles
around, drove via Ettrick to Duns
& back via Eddle. Saw church & H.
Late lunch, Sch Trio (Aranui, Salmon
Hens). Went for walk down lane to
see other field - river, lovely country -
After tea went to Ottery to see the Cairns
Jack Effis young man was away but

B'nef supper late, sleepy & soon to bed.

12 Grey, some drizzle, windy - Had a nice
fire in a.m., read papers & had
some music. P did Rachmaninoff
Hours. They drove us to Thetford
for 2.45 - we came via Cambridge
& Bletchley, here 7.45, met by the boys.

E, R - Left off about 10. Unpacked before
supper. Reading The Pearl Thief.
13. Unusual Sunday without golf. Did a
few rods after breakfast. Tidying up,
odds & ends, cleaned Rev, gloves etc.
Began Org. after lunch, made Effie,

31 Greyish. Fine off-on. Not so cold. Did do

Books, papers, odds & ends, read some W.M.
To Gr3 for lunch with McClare, Carr, Fordick,
Rowell, Krokodilov?/ Henk Hill 3. Another re-
less by Troy. L & I to tea J Dragomir,
I Dem, Etta & Mrs Menbourn?/ fat tamer, has 2
at her bands. Stopped Davies', M in bed w.
headache, saw Horner a minute. E-P out
all day, back for dinner. Fine Mozart (I
Sym(?) D), Divertimento, DCone. Johnnyani
from Buda. All in the room & heard it
well.

Feb 1. Greyish. Began M in good time, also
started H. L, Gran & John went to flower
market but only got 2 tulips. All off 11.30
for picnic, past learning to Telia & had
lunch in pine grove in ravine. Showered
as we finished but drove through to a
nice large village, great houses - trees - but
no leaves of anemones on return, near

ruined tower - Part of war bad, all night from near Mandia. Back before 5; no rain atk. till about 6.30 then hard. ErP to the BSA, L + I here. Out after 6 to Benaki's tea, lots here, house beautiful. 4 Fine. Cloudy off + on. Wrote M. Posted letter - went to GerSch for Wagner (in L's Elensis) 10, elec. with battery. GB with laundry (should be our old enemy). Back after 12. Off before 2 for Geo M whom we took 5 Elensis. Started out side walls - followed new line of road +

many late shops etc, baths, marble wall facings, circular affair with 15 places for footbaths. Roman wall brief - in front excellent Per. one. Why? To G's houses on slope near "Tolos." Excellent. Not apsidal, also odd across angle like bays from apse. Etch, Mysr some LH, landslip. Only poor houses but good idea plan & struct. Red by Strauss from Vienna. Staats Tym. eve after reading S. Times.

6 Wet. Spent ^{most} a.m. in house, mostly reading on Elols, Russell, C. H., Guide etc. This letter came with 2d Tym. so we had a go after lunch, not very successful. Out to tea with Blacklers in their new house, fine big garden view. At 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ to Vareli, back c. 8. Eve near WM. Has cleared after breakfast. Saw Rat Mysr Dragounis hor dir, so sent a curr with violets to house. Out a short time in a.m. Two or three other errands.

7. Grey. Job sort & some acet. L out for errands & I got out old notes & went over some Delphi. Out 11.45 (delay) to Duy to try many liberty - put on old chiffons - grey to see about alterations. Back 12³⁰. Van Wilkinson there, husband & son here for lunch & had fine time with them. At P only till Sunday - left soon after, showed them all around. Sent Ash to ask Negr. to go to Ath C. play / none could M. first - called and we kept her to tea. Off by 5²⁰ "Fanny's First Play," very good esp Mrs. Novell as Dora, Mrs. de Salle as McColley. Ralph has fun so comes not do his part. Coon very good. Back before 7³⁰ and 10.

9. Looked over rest of W.M. in eve.

8. Grey - No concert on account of dance wreath M and H, looked over a lot of new pictures in my T with L. Then afternoon so did not go out. Did

more Torg. & got nearly all, some still left. Read P. on in Eng Ed Maurice Byron. Schub. Quintet 6.³⁰ from Vienna so followed it. Eve began looking up a lot of Eleusis material & L & I read some in Kou's guide.

9. Grey. Windy. ^{a few notes} Spent most a.m. working on Delphi, old notes & writing rest of description. After lunch L & I read two. as far as p. 33. Short call from H. Negr. & then to tea at St. House, Mrs Rose hostess. Met BMC, MWP and sat with them & heard about their P. trip. Back about 7. Rome Phil. Quartets, door? Eve fine concert "Europ" via Wien, a Rubinstein Brahms B conc, also Chopin A^b Pd, a couple of short, 3 oranges, Amor Br. Read new JHS.

10. Greyish, windy. L & I read more Kou. Eleusis & then to see Mrs Skinner, still in bed with

rheumatism, horrid long siege. Left L at Oujas & did some shopping. Finished it after lunch & worked on notes. Dr J Dragounis' Extra here for tea, Negrop. came just as we started. B in for tea after A Coll. com. meeting much talk, shamed them around. Slix called for Di about 7.15. looked over IEN - Carl's Gonio, Buda. May B Son & Co - Son (hairy ba) - Edwardian later.

11. Fine. Wrote M, after shopping, out before 11.30 to see Chiolman re "Homeric," then to Oujas for things & summer chiffons, grey c.d.c., & Liberty printed. Lib came after 12. Worked on revising Del. in p.m. Gray "snow white" - Tea with Perilla in new studio, then Golf C at Jockey C. Everlasting futile talk, left before 1/2 past 11 home & 5.35 Vienna, Quint. May 20 maj - Beeth same. Read c. 60 pp. of Barres, Voyage au Sparte, lent by Perilla.

12. Fine, all day. Some Del. revision, out before 11 with G School in view, but first to Chiolman re F. GFB found lunch early, back to horse with anen. Found Mr Forthegill here, card also from WST. Went via Gsch. to warn Bert early, saw John & caught in Kotonatce, took F for drive to Tepel. Arrested for speeding, new law, about 20 km. in town. (Atte to Court p.m., fined 225). Back for lunch by 12.30. Nice time. Took F to GFB at 1.15. Large US post in so late of letters to read aloud, GTH, HTH, GDM, SBL, 10NF, CWB, F-Gut-al. L-d to G School before 4 & selected some Elmeris photos from big collection. Saw young Rast, & went back by 5. WST came to tea, long chat, had blue prints - Cor. Mus to look over. Left him also to dinner. A little Barres 10-11.

high dashing waves. Went to new tourist
house, most attractive large room w.
fireplace, peasant style dec, well built
good note. Had masticas - ate picnic
lunch inside. Too frightfully blowy to
look at T near by. Good run both ways
about 1.45; could go faster. Home 4.30.
E-P to tea at P.S.A., L - I had - were

typing & writing letters when W Caldwell
and small son came, looking for rooms.
Left by 6.30 so got D typed before dinner.
Eve had Schum, & CF Quint; did more Tong.

15. Grey, terrific wind. Wrote M + H and
typed part of L's Illusions which we had
gone over. Frightful gale, so P postponed
going. Rain thro' typed Delphi, cleared out
many old newspapers. L + J out c 6.30 to big
tea at Michalopoulos, lights all out -
dim candles, no lift, but nice party, lots
there. Terrific rain as we left, tangle of
cars. Back 7.30, near 5 Stones - in eve Baris
(med. part much preferable to ancient) -
met Mos, CF Son, Sal, Huber, Brahms.

16 Grey. Cloud fine about noon. More del
chiefly verifying & pictures. Went at 2 to sta-
tion with E-P, then others, for Illusions
relief picture for L. Others came from
Wagner & finished by lunch time.

17. Fine, perfect day. I went over my del. before we went to Orij. Before Nat dance to Parsons - Uncle Bacon. Times - 11A after lunch. Out c 3 to Psy. with note Meickle - took MD but hurried back for Kyriakid who did not come. Short walk around neighborhood - To big tea at Gümüşhane huge old house, lots men, chiefly royal. later, then to Loperte, big crowd. Out c 10.15 to Epeiros dance with P.

Dimitriades. Comfortable box to see all Nat. dance, syros, costumes wonderful. Kallas long visit. Back about 1.30
