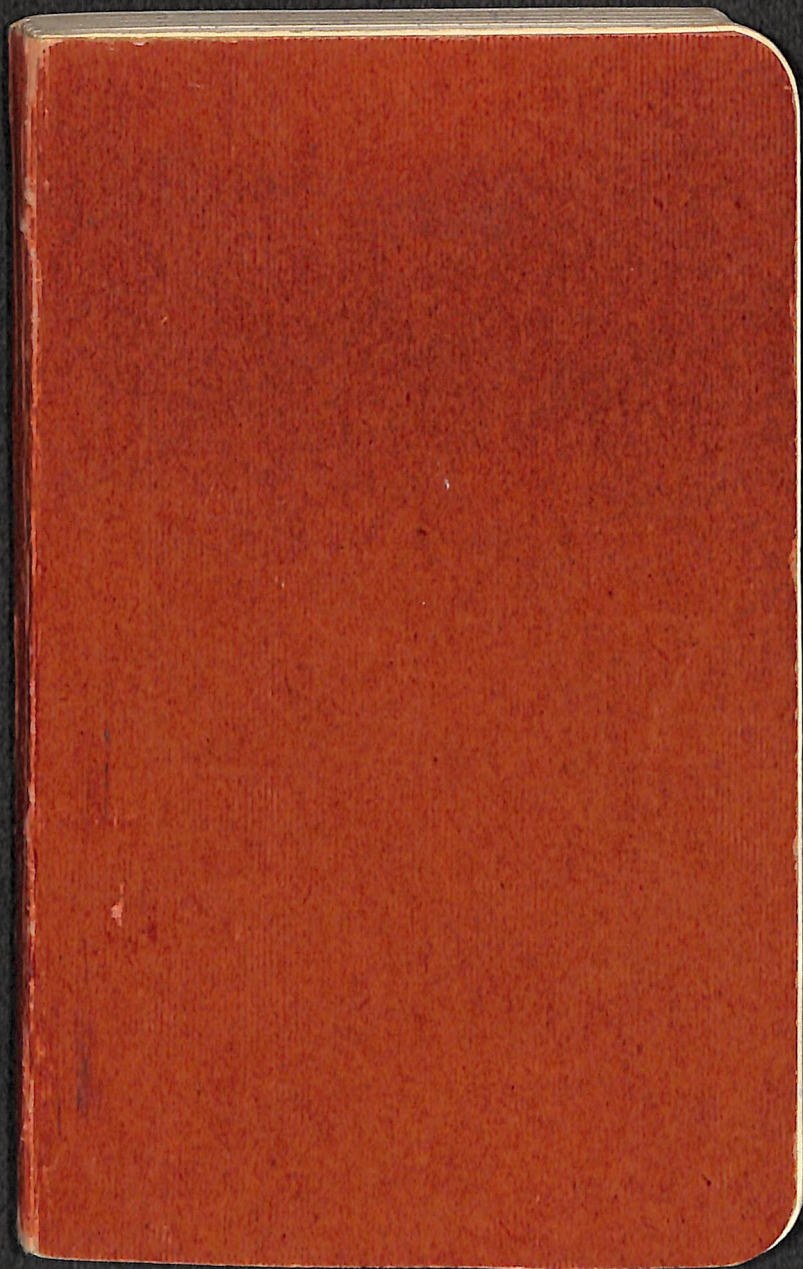

May 15 Fine. Hung embr. plates etc. in v. room
 got out all M's while L had lesson. Real
 some in Pontani's Delphi. Out & errands
 met Davis in Paris. Back late for tea. Out
 again to buy for a moment. B back - got
 bed up while we put cat in v. room.
 Dinner here, M's, Brown, Davises,
 Ralph, Caro. Everything fine, skinned
 them around. Stayed till after 12.

16 Fine. Went out c 10 with C - to Mrs.
 Kondylis, Ghisla re Saturnia / Amph, Elus.
 Back c 11.30, began Tony. w L. Call from
 Mrs Sotiriad. All lunched with Fisher -
 nephew in his garden, 3 charming chil-
 dren. Saw Br. Silenus they want £
 to buy, nominally from grave in Eretr.
 Kondyl. here on return. Call a Guelick.
 Late tea, errands, left B - went around
 Magg, baskets etc. All dined Schl. Melas
 also Mr Mrs Ghassis(?), Gen Mrs Kalinski.

17. Fine a.m. L & I out fairly early to Orig, also took Insur. papers to RWHill & back to Orig. Doing over many summer things - L & I played some with Tony, tried everything on d.r. shelves etc. Weather very threat. evening p.m. but had early tea - went to Aerop at 6 for Balanos Parthenon show. Good crowd, much pleased w. results. Back 7.5 read Poulson, also some more in eve - played old T with L.

18. Fine early - Deluges of wind on after lunch. wrote M - it before lunch. Did some accounts with L, re furniture - Call early from Mr Mrs Cook, traces friends, grandson of Tho. Chilly horrid after noon. L & I did some old Tony. More Poulson in eve.

19. Fine. Grand time clearing apoth. - transferring things to former

haunt of Vict. Co, everyone at it - got done soon after 10. L & I out c. 11 for many errands, VER, Pris, Michael (III "Saturn"), Magg, Ann & Mrs. Here we looked at a few of C's things. Left 12.30, quick change, lunch GB w. Cooks - Gen - (Maurice), back by 2.45 to see Mrs Terr - Rox. for a few min. Cooks here for tea, then to Aer. with B. L & I out for doorhandles, new candlestick - then drove to Spata, road much improved - More Poulson eve -

20. Fine. ^{B to Coo} L & I off in good time to Orig - back by 11.15 - hectic time with elect. Out again to Phil, tried on dark blue, left - blk. Mended piece in front, bowl after lunch, more Poul. Early tea, to see GSM near. at Cape Kosmas, EH settle men on point - near cafe, tombs nearer was on wet shore. Lots of pottery EH & some LH - no MH, island figs, much obsid. - Bright

Geo back. Wired Piet - if coming. Very cloudy
but heard some Sch. notebook chat
borrowed from Andr. More Delphi.

21 Fine. Notes etc. Spent most am with
M. & Effie. L in Mus. Odds & ends after
lunch, finished Ponds. After tea went
to Regr. for N's name day, only Janie
in. Alterations finished. Later to tea 5m
for message to John. Old Toys etc.

22 Fine. Bouquets Delphi at intervals
all day. Out, left C at Mus, to Stasin,
Elie, etc. Pris w. embroideries back 11.30.
L, C I to tea with ^{Flowers Dept.} Davies. Took pile
of periodicals which were duplicates.
Then quidam day fine. Bought back
2 Cutan jars.

23. Greyish, threatening p.m. L & J to Orig
c. 10. J continues to Andy, Mus with C,
Elueth, hat stretched, back to Orig fill
c. 12.30. L went to Mus - J came back

read a little more Brong. Finished p.m.
L & J went to tea with Mrs Skinner, still in
bandages. Vasili at 6. Tony (hard) later.

B back for 9 dinner. NYT pictures after.

24 Fine but sticky. Off bitimes to Spiro for
flowers. L & J putting up icons in GK
room. Call from Miss Stone. L had lesson
& J dressed early, very warm, chaffon.
Luncheon Mrs Kerr, Mrs Sotir & Rox,
Gladys SR, C B & Owen, Fisher, Hill.
House looked fine. Nice time. Took it
easy after they left. Cleared papers etc.
After tea L & J to Millers (out), batteries,
new bamp shade for 10/6, later took
presents to John for Timo. Radio
going in eve, working all night.

25. Fine, warm & sultry. Finished 6AM tiller
up rather late. Wrote M & H before
lunch. Papers after raids & some old
Toys. Piet in while at tea, came

backs later to dinner. Got all news of
Tinos from him.

26. Warm & sticky. Spent a.m. in selmaki
going over Delphi material. Did
not write much. Piece of saloni
ceiling fell before lunch & afterwards
nearly the whole E. half. So light
that nothing was broken. Went for
Bondj. & spent most p.m. clearing
up. Servants & workmen fire. Rather
exhausted by tea time. Out c. 7 to get
Coul to get brief case B had left at
meeting - talk at Davises' (out). For
dinner Mme Schl, M. Mulas, C. B. S.,
Piel - used W. room afterwards.

27. Fine, warm. B. off on 6 for Cor.
Up in good time - Fat painter taking
charge, covering etc. walls, floor,
piano, Cabinet & etc. to coat room.
Stuffed cracks bet saloni & dr. Plas.

kerer getting up scaff etc. First coat before
night. Did not accomp. much all day
finished firidous story, odds & ends. All
& Mess. here for tea & shown around.
L & J did some old toys.

28. Fine, hot. Began M. Kandy. I came re
sitter & antiq. case. All of c. 10. Left L at Orig
& C. at Mus, went to bank & other errands
& back to Orig. Home before 12, finished M
wrote Girardet, St L, & paper (Nyx & bill).
Late lunch. Times, lazy pm rather hot.
L & J out after tea to PO, Physk etc - then
to Margie's for an hour. Tried one to
get Nyxym & Tox. via Vienna but got
Goy instead in Stabat M. Fine.

29. Flat, much wind. L, C, I, to Mus 10-1115
back for L lesson. Did Delphi till
lunch & tried to write some after
it, chiefly outline. Plastering done by
one. After tea L & J out to Phil, exhibit

at Strat, with "fat painter", drive to end
road, drop in at DK. "Aida" via Gatz en.
30. Attic a few minutes before breakfast
wrote B. All 3 off to Mus before 10,
Diox appears e.g. she r Ransom here
for day then Rhodes. Mus till 12.30, all
lunch PP while back hall de-plan.
Here. They all left soon after 2, hot.
Tried Tony with small success. Be-
gan Tsounta Cabot. After tea call
from Copes, then to Varili. Very
sticky eve, began hammering with.

31. Mus open earlier so L, C I off soon
after 9. Stopped for flowers. Did 38
till after 11. John's book while L
had lesson, a letter Delphi. Dances
to lunch. Hot in p.m. Papers,
finished story, did some Tony -
Mrs Ohini - Aristeia here for tea.
More progress eve, Ob. Bed early.

June 1. Hot = wrote Mr H a.m. Spent most
of day lazily reading The Bolt and
trying to keep cool. After tea, C & I went
past Spata to the coast, not back till
dark.

2. Hot. A letter Delphi. L. I went at 9.45
to Cathedral to Mr Thurber's funeral -
huge crowd. Afterwards to Mus. 11-1
day 38. After lunch C read Perseus's
article on LH misc. from Boine. Very
interesting - most of it good till near
end when too far off field. L & I hung 6
of Pitt's pictures in salonaki. Last
coat while on stairs, working on salonaki.
Times before tea. Short call Teoro, re
exc. in Mus - to say all revoir.
L. I out 6.30 to Proodos, Petr, Zan - got a
set of china in lower Hermes st, much
like Davises'. Drove on Elvessis road
as far as sea, back for short call DK

Late dinner, scraps on wireless. Began
Master Day Judgment lent by DK.

3. Hot. Started staining stairs - L & J
to Ouis, first - to Amby. Back 11.30
a little J, out to Cecil for lunch w.
Mrs Keays - a long talk afterwards.
Stopped with Coel to see Ralph &
DKast. Brought him to town. After
tea drove to Menidi & enant HST.
Some CF Quins - before dinner. Wire
less n.g. ^{Read} Began Master Day Jndy.

4. Hot. Began M but went to Mus 9-12³⁰
not so bad there. Doing 42 when
we left. After lunch finished M
went through papers. Began with
Maurois' Byron borrowed from
Rueph. Very hot. Stairs being waxed.
Dinner at Jacob's, other guest
Polish sculptor Wittig. Nice
quiet time, walk back & wash by

window to cool off. Did some old Torqs
at interval.

5. Hot. Out c 9 to Ouis, then to Amby for
new passport, took long time. Back
c 11.15, later to BSA, near Fovilles de
Deeche (Marm.) till lunch time. Very hot
after lunch, L & J did old Torqs, read
some Byron. Great gale after tea, had to
shut many windows. L & J cleared out in
bookcase cupboards, put small pic-
tures on shelf, cleared up hall bookcases.
Got very hot & dirty - late dinner, B back
from Corin c. 9.30. Very little rain.

6. Much cooler. In Mus from about 9-12³⁰
doing gold things from 41. Toldenly on
way back. After lunch went to BSA 2.30-4.45
dis Fovilles de D. Back to change before tea.
Coke here, much arch. questioning after.
L & J out c 7.30, left notes at numb 6 to
rans for picture. Back 8.15, started new

Tory. - did more of it. after dinner.

Read more Byron.

7. Cool. off before 9 to Mrs - stayed till after 12. Latter part seeing Stuart Key's things, Then + Sam + SA. Did rest of good things, then heads. After lunch L - I did some Tory, then BSA 3-5. Showery. After tea call from Dick Skillwell. L out at 7 to vas. Played cf Quint. - Read Byron. Tory. eve.

8. Cool. Write M + H and a few shorter letters. Investigated saloni floor etc. Some Byron after lunch - more letters. Early tea. L + Co back but did not see them. Took B to Eleusis, then continued with him to Megara - went out to look for sheds on hill. Back to station for a maskicha + saw train of. Fine drive. Back after 8, moon. Not

much luck with radio. L - I dug out an old Tory + did a little - Early to bed.

9. Cool. Out in good time to Brig, then Museum ^{to} rest of am. Beats from Mr. Mrs Keays + Mrs Balfour here to lunch. Read Myres who were subtle till time to dress for tea at D's. Also Leslie, Mrs Ohini + Christ. On return stopped PP for cocktail with the girls. L + MR here a few minutes in eve to get detective stories.

10. Cool. Museum 9-12.30. Marion working part time, got in 4.00. Back via Phil + Andy Garden door going in. Warmer after lunch, read most of Byron - finished it eve. Out 4.30 to Piro, Shelia, Maggi, Cheria etc. Back for tea + out later to see Julia D. Found her + Dimitri + 2 friends on terrace at 5 P.m. Good symph + quartet Vienna. A little on an old T.

11. Coolish. Wrote M. Then to Oriq - to Mrs Hill cleaning time - Stopped Brit-Passport (closed) - After lunch neat house a little out at 4 to Amby for Rome - Vict. tickets, Dilec etc - back to prepare picnic - Off 4.45 in 2 cars. Fine drive to Sam - then all around, supper on hillside & back by moonlight. Road Keph. Boy, terrible, making a new one. Girls in for a drink before going home. Got to bed early with boot.

12. Coolish. Put in a good long morning in Mrs. MIP these part of the time. Got as far as part of 49. Back c 12.30 to find furniture back in saloni, floor polished etc. Before & after lunch hung pictures - curtains, lamp etc at it - almost incessantly. Mrs Skinner at 5 for tea and to look around. Mr S came soon after 6. Off

c 7.15 to Mmet Paspati for nice call, 3 Negrep, Casap. et al. Back - quiet rush during. Many S here for dinner. Decided not to go to Log. wpt. Tired, but early.

13. Coolish. About 9 to Oriq - bought jazz on the way. To Brit Passport Office, then Mrs Hill 11.45, back to BPO, Vasili. After lunch - I did some new tong, till she went out at 4 for ^{Rome tickets} errands. More until arrival 2 Kalop - later Leslie. Showed them around till after 7.30 dinner here 2 Ransom, D Cox, 10 Hill, CBE, RK stayed till after 12, all talking their fully - B back just in time.

14. Comfortable, clear during day, wind & rain late at night. Mrs. 9-1 all done but 8 heolie in for visit. After lunch neat Times - Oh & come Dancing Beggans. Early cup of tea then to Mich. for Saluonia, then to tea with Oriq & sister. Flowers, to Negrep

back c. 8. Dinner Miller - Patro. nice
time. Liked everything.

15. Fine a.m. Grey & shabby later. Went
M, H, - spent much time going over
things preparatory to packing. L packed
all a.m. Got trunks in, did shelves &
drawers off - on all day. Also wrote
Effe - did an old Tony, after tea -
wrote Aunt C in evening - Call from
Rawsons.

16. Fine. Off at 9 to Quij & then Mus. till
12.30, doing trunks & lots of beads.

Dcox & MR in for a call. Time after
lunch, call from Tim & his mother.
Started packing. Perfect deluge c. 3
rivers in street. Clean off. All 4
Ney, DR, MR, DC. Miss Stone to
tea - Dinner PIP with girls, also
CBE & Scops. Put-arr. while out.

17. Cool, cloudy at times. Piet came about

9, all off to Mus till 12.30, then to goet for
our clubs - back by 1.15. Packed after lunch
& then to Mus 4-6 & finished things. Late
tea & more packing. Rawsons here. Same
in evening, getting on.

18. Fine & cool. Up before 6 to pack. Got in
off & on until time to leave at noon. Dot &
Marion came about 10 & helped with silver. All
off on 12.35, good breeze, very comfortable, rain
began before Corinth when Dcox, B & C got
out. Deluges off & on all p.m. Muddy but not
raining at Patras. Christman's man met us &
we got rooms at Majestic, went to Gov office,
he did passport. Dinner with Copes whom
we met hotel. At bedtime found L's Rev.
soaked. Horrible time.

19. Wind about 3, panned with few intervals
till boat sailed at 11. Everything drenched,
no sheds or protection. Finally in pilot-
house of tug. Spent about 2 hours working

over luggage, opening, drying etc. Lovely ship, have 111 work back & resandak. At lunch met Baltzes, nice talk over our coffee. More things to put in order. Tea on palm resandak, at intervals read Blin, K Mansfield. Saw Bi again after dinner, turned in early, very tired.

20 Woke early, up in good time, lovely sunny day, got unpacking done before tea. Breakfast on resandak. Short glimpse of Clelands. Letters. All in order before lunch. Sat with Baltzes afterwards, splendid view Capri & Sorrento but hard shower when reaching Naples. Covered gangway & luggage well protected. Off and through customs soon after 3. Giovanni met us & we had no delay at all. Decided to take 5 for Rome so stopped St L, saw Mattioni, went to Mergellina. Nice run up, occasional

showers. Very comfortable. Rome 7.40 - Ori. by about 8. Had wired Signora. Fine welcome. Minikows in hospital, only one I knew here. Miss Wicks. Turned in early, unpacked a little. Got books from house. Reading Kestel fire, remembering like Strind.

21. ^{Five} Read before breakfast while I got good sleep. Out about 10 to Gallenga, Amby, Condottordak, TC Ital, Biffi, - another canaglia to PdS, newspapers & drove back via V Bough. Took a very long siesta. Tea Bar Esq. Then to For Aug, Traj, Tarj, Marcell, Argent - to Palatine till 7. Back in good time. Called up Gray (amg) & Stevens. Another quiet eve, hot done Tony. after lunch, a Gilbertian one.

22. Fine. Began M in good time. Out to Capit: by new road at back & spent an hour in Conserv. & garden. Later to Terme until lunch. Family all here.

Finished M. Real V.F. during siesta.
Out to Casa Rose, met Mrs. Stevens
& Mrs. DeCarvallo for tea. Stayed after
they left till 7. Stopped Flora, message
for Genio from M. MTS turned up
before dinner. She, L & J out to Esadva
for coffee & liqueurs. Back soon
after 10. Finished books.

23. Fine but warmer. Analyze n. pass-
ports to send French, PO with letters
for air mail, 12 pearls, papers, met
Mary, vermouth at Gargiulo's, got
dahlia at P di S & took them to
Miss Harvey in garden Ang. Am. Nur-
sing Home, via ³¹ Rom. She is consoling.
Short siesta with Times & out before 3
with MTS - Miss Fletcher, fine drive
to Nemi with Biauchi (good new
classical¹⁶⁰) to see boats. Got down
close to them on shore. One now under

canvas, second being pumped, 3^d on opp.
side. Much more impression than the
pictures. No permesso but got in & went
all around - then to small museum.
Later up to P. del. for tea & back via App.
Mont & tried Scip. but they close at 5.

Splendid drive, fine asphalt road much
of way. Back about 7.15. L & J dinner
Villa Aurelia on terrace, also had ³gits
at Fairchild. Beautiful up there.

24. Fine, warmest. To Cristoforo met his
clothing book, Sermoneta for curtains
(3 prs + 4 trousers), Kodak, Gay, Foxley,
Mrs & to Spanish Exhib. in Villa. Fine
lot, esp. Greco & Gay. Hot when out but
finally got back. After siesta M, L & J
went to Tomb of Scip. & then decided to go
to Ostia by new road. Scari first & had
good poke around, then Mare for tea.
Spent most of eve packing.

25. Up in good time - got small packing done. Out c 10. M.L., I to Traj for where we had a most thorough look around with foreman (Permit). - Hot in sun. Got report of year. Then to Trevis - for blatter back before 12. Trunks had gone with Am ex. to station. Farewell remount in Bar Eq. - Bo came along. Early lunch. Things very comfortable, early to train. Car 4, No 12-13. Not as hot as the Brind. Trip last year. Read Obs, Times, began House of Antiqua.

26. Raining when we got up. Dull trip but kept comfortable. Cleared before Paris Got 4 o'clock to Boul. easy without change. Quiet - crossing, good dinner on Pullman to Hist. Arr 11 - to Kingsly, 42. L's Birthday.

27. Up in good time, a little greyish, wore suits. Left 2 coats, 4 dresses at

Achilles. Sefridge for errands & hair, 10²²
To see Mr Fothergill - L got ticket from
Pinner, money Amby, slow. To EBU & soon
traces came to lunch. Fine view; coffee
in garden. Left 3 - to R. Cleave, got 2
breakfast cloths & napkins, blue, yellow
& small napkins. L hunted jenny dresses
& got 2 at D.T. Kingsly 4³⁰ for tea & off
4.50 Euston. All luggage ¹⁸ o.k. M had re-
served places. Quick trip. Trot met us.
All fine. Talked busily in eve.

28. Mostly unpacking a.m. Also at E's
practice with Ethel. All with red roses &
chrysanthemums about 12:30. M. had her gifts
before lunch with us all there. Lots of
pressing, p.m. Clothes a sight. More un-
packing. Car back a.m. She after lunch.
Birthday dinner, picnic, lots of jokes &
misc things. More, Jo, Gordon, 10 in all.
Lacked till 12.

29. My real birthday - but for golf but E & I did only 11 holes. Many lost balls. Tubs after lunch. Later L, T & I did Tony, Ben Everyman. Tidied up small bag etc. Eve started Scarab Murder.

30. Unsettled but many "bright intervals" went to R when E took M to Buckley & did a few errands, PO, Parris, Boots etc. Fine out so all went later for drive in country via Cubington, Kenil, Leam, Warwick etc. P.M. all to bridge party at Jo's, got booty prize charming stat. dish with flowers on lid - Mrs Ridge, Brown, Haugh, Maule, Gregory, Boothroyd, Miss Size. Back about 7 - E out to Music Club so R, L - I had supper. Hard showers. Hayden quart & flat - Took D on wireless read more S Mur.

July 1. Fine, warmish. Mrs Button pressed many dresses for us both. Cleared up,

washed gloves, settled acct, etc. Reading SM pp - on, finished eve. Listened to a lot of Wimbledon in p.m. To in for a few minutes a.m. Not dressmaking.

2. Fine, with clouds. Wrote a few notes etc, then T, L & I to R for errands, Bank, PO, One etc. out on Hillmorton Rd for strawberries. Begun Edwardians. Heard hills. Match but by Tilden Bow match we were due for tea at Longwood - nice time, Mrs Reed, her companion, 2, Billy & Tutor. Out in garden there after tea. Took it easy reading, before & after dinner.

3. Fine warm. E, L & I to London on 9.29. Did puzzles most of way. Went to King'sley, Rev, A Transport, Anly, Dr J, Liberty where got slippers - thin dress material, Fuller. Then met E at Tennant's for ravioli & satsumi. Asked IC but did not turn up. Til H. trace re Monday - Splendid afternoon at Rose

Show, gorgeous exhibits, Bests guards,
Pipers. Back on 5:20, tea en route. One
head at L'Amour 3 Reil, and some Two
Tickets.

3. Fine warm. In about 9.45, returned straw.
Wing crates, Owen's broomsticks for many
household articles. To Golf Club, T. had
Lesson - L, To - I played 9 holes very badly
with many lost balls. Late lunch, cleared
up. M - T out to garden party, and Edw.
Later M - L to cinema. Wrote Effie. Part.
Eve finished Edwardians.

5. Fine. Doing roses, papers. Out 12:15 to church.
Mended grey coat after cleaning. P.M. heard
Wimbledon finals, Tilden Allison, Moody &
Ryan, Ryan & Crawford. Finished 2 Tickets
worked out routes for Norfolk.

6. Fine, warm. Set out to golf club,
L - I did 11 holes. Fewer lost balls but no
brilliant play. After lunch, tea & general

cleaning up, talk with M re B.T.Co. Nice con-
cert on. L, T - I did Tong, amusing, not very
hard. Finished it soon after tea. Read STimes,
Mo etc. My picture papers.

7. Off to London by 9.29. Left bag ^{no 2} King'sley, spent
much time off & on trying for Edw.. Went to
Do J for to errand, got green hair brush material
Bates, Fuller's. Effie for lunch, with her to
Vict Hill 3/5, Beehive to see glass knots &
got terms set. Taxi to Wace, also Cicula,
Woodward, 3 Samples, much talk. Left 7.30
- to Ivanhoe for gossip with P & E. Off 8:30 to
see "On the Spot" & Wallace Chicago Young
Miller, splendidly done. Sandwiches -
tea on return.

8. Tel Cosmo at 9 re A. Lander. Had an. The
night before - gone about 10. P & E came
while we breakfasted. Went to Cosmo. left
note. Wrote T. To BM to see Woodley's new
things. Less spectacular but very important.

Potton to Wimpole Hall to see garden.
First over house, 17-18, lots of fine
rooms & things mixed with all sorts &
rather shabby. Lawns & hedges fine but
garden not much for big place. Park,
hedges, vistas etc splendid. Lunched by
road under hedges a couple of miles
beyond & then to The Gables, Meldreth, a
fascinating place. Mod timbered house
most artistic garden, summer house,
orchard, kitchen garden etc. Left soon
after 2 & via Newmarket, The Ford to
