Feb. 18, Fine, perfect day. Wrote Mr. Mrs. Renner. L's
 lesson early so later drove to Kospi taking
 At's little George in front. Mrs. Keady here
 for lunch. Left her at Wren office after 3
 - went to Golf Club. Airplane nearly
 hit the place as we arrived & caused gr.
 excitement. Played 4-9 twice, heavenly
 out. Tea there. Back c. 6. Big tea, really
 marticha at Eliascor. Huge crowd
 had very good time, nearly 9 when back.
 Not much luck getting anything on wire-
 less. Read a little Barri's. Early to bed.

19 Fine. Wrote Effie. Later out driving while L did
 errands & came later. Off c. 2:30 for golf,
 very slow starting, big crowd, all holes
 open. Heavenly out but took long time.
 Back 4:50 and quick change before tea
 Mrs. Barber, also Forbes, another Barber,
 White, Knight, Hurstley, -, Atchley. Left
 c. 7 & bought Mrs. H., making a few calls on

way at 7.5 Sk, 35A, could not find Krallen
Torg, evl, based on Kipling. Fine concert
Kien, led Boutrikoff, Eulenspiegel, Faun,
Cory d'Or, Sierak III. Meals in Gk room
during floor polishing.

20. Fine. Went over Deep. revisions & later
began Delos. Typist here to see L re chim
neys of neighbors. after her lesson she
& I measured, cut, wired hems in
curtains for library. Out 2 for gref & had
fine time 2.30-4 with a complete
round and a couple of extra holes.
Congealous out, some decent shorts.

Dressed for Caldwell's here to tea. Cake
great hit with bags. At 7 out to Dow
with message to M. Stayed only 5-10
min. as M was dressing to go out. Did
as much Torg. as our Kipling allows.
Some of Torca & Buch, & concert some
incl. CF & Gueiz sonatas.

21. Greyish. L. I did a lot of recent Delos
reports (Russell, YNCB, ASA) to catch up with
latest things, also 2 copies R's pamphlet. Out
11.45 to Ouz, short stay. Vasilis for appointment.
Began to rain about lunch time. Times till
2.30 then Delos. B came about 4. Calibrated
due Thurs. Call from Miss Mary Bread (SF). Out
6.30 to W Birch. tea at Legation. Great-grand
dancing. Back 8.30 or so. Late dinner. Put
reply from Rome. Read some Father Brown.

22. GW Birthday. Cleared. Wrote M. off before 12
taking lunch and driving to Megara to put
B on train. Went out to Minora and beyond
to harbor for boats, very breezy. Found good
place on slope Min. above sea. Train 1.14.
Fine drive back in a little over an hour.
Found note from Mrs Itaskell (Vas). Changed &
wrote it before tea. Mrs Mrs It came 6.30
for nice call. Read Oth & ST such no time
for earlier. Stuck on end of Torg, no more Kipl.

23. Fine. Kathara Devera. Spent most
a.m. on Delos. Call from Mitzi about
10:30-11. Read & wrote a little - after lunch
opened all remaining envelopes, then
addressed some for next teas. Out 4 to
Neqr. for tea with laqara etc. Stayed
a long time for much talk. Violin
recital Rome, Szigeti incl Bach, Moz, Aurb.
Span. came through finely - Not so suc-
cessful eve, got some Bults (etc) from
Stockh, & Moz - Dror. quartets from Stutt.

24. Fine, perfect morning. Rain p.m. Went to
BSA and read Delos till 12. L & J to see
Mrs Skinner, sitting up in salomaki.
After lunch addressed envelopes - wrote
some cards for teas. Out 4 for Maj & then
to see Mrs Meikle, also Mrs - late.
Tea time, took M home, dropped Mrs L,
stopped here, to Vasili. Ask. distribute a
few invitations. Back before 8. Eve a

gay misc. Viennese program & addressed
envelopes etc till after 11.

^{Sunny at times}
25 Grey. Wrote M. Out 10 to BSA for an hour
and a half, reading Delos. Back to house,
lots of mail, to Oriq & when L came
here I went to Amby & PO. Lunch late.
Afterwards more invitations - L & J out by
4 on round of calls, also left many inv.
Back 6, ^{new out-} front late tea. Making list when
Effie came in, adventurous trip, went
to Ladaris for dinner - night. Finished
list eve. ^{ILN} Petrovich, Hindemith Cone Zarate
from Vien. Bed fairly early.

26 Slightly cloudy. Up 6:30, off 7:45 to meet
Carl arr. promptly & on Gray, back to
house by 9. B here from early Co train
Shut most a.m. putting around. Effie left
note returning Co. noon. Papers after lunch,
a little writing. To BSA open meeting 6:15, Paper
on Perichona dig. Big arch. crowd there.

Dinner Cecil & Keay, also WST, nice
time back before 11.30.

27. Fine. BSA from 10.30-12.30 reading Dels,
Kyp. Hall, Antiq. vol etc. Quite change
before lunch. Golf 2-5, twice around
(exc. 700) none too brilliant. Gorgeous
day, very strange light, brilliant on
Pant & Philop. Tea here. Out 6.30 to GTS to
call Haskells. Landown also came
along in GTS. Back before 8 or did a little
Tory. Finished it in eve.

28. Fine. Sold J. book. Cleared out many
letters etc. Did a little Diephi. To Brinj
then to Phil. Ordered blk satin hat. Bro
to lunch BSA, Payne, Huntley, Puddle-
bury, Theophanides & some lady (Fr. Oct?).
Back 6.3 and all to Eleusis for tour with
Geo. Stayed till nearly 7, brought him
back. Very late cup of tea. Eve L & D did
invitations for tea for 11 £ (Eng. sp.)

Mar 1. Fine. Wrote M. All pp 10.30 for Hilleniko
to blessing of the ground for Girls' Cael.
Big crowd, platform etc. Zacmis, Papadatos,
Merkouris, many other officials. Began late
as Metroph. was delayed. Started by disreputable
old priest. Speeches by Mr Skinner, Pap, Harlow,
WST, head of teacher. Ended w. Natanson.
Fine site, all well started. Gorgeous morning.
Papers after lunch, then wrote H. Cloudy so
did not go out, had the. deleted a few
mint. instead. Cleared up old Times GTS etc
Out before 6 to big tea Mangarinos. Men
went later to Arch Soc. meeting, L & J stayed.
Good talk Tsibi. about antiq. & med Byz
things. Back soon after 7. Read last
week's 5 Times, eve began 2 Couriers.
2. Had shower early. Cleared. BSA 10.45-12.45
finished Dels I. After lunch Times, curtains
in yard, needed altering in one pair, 20
presses turned etc. ready to send out. Put in

elastics & a few other dull jobs. Tea here
out to 30 to Phil, but only L's hat ready
to try. Later all to huge party at Sp.
Kovendori, gorgeous new house, wonderful
library, stunning place. Hordes there -
Back of, waiting away. Rest a little 3 Con
early to bed.

5. ^{Cold, N wind strong} Fine. L & J out in good time for errands,
got more small tumbler, ordered 8 large,
large glass pitcher, to Orij. Then to Mrs
Spinner, better, Mrs K Alexandri came in -
Back for L. All to lunch at Petros, also
Arch Cep, 3 Sotiriads, Barnett. Very good time.
Back after 3, then L & J to Petros, Orij, & Roy -
left notes & short call - Davis. Early cup
tea. L & J to Miss Gault, also Curran, Burt,
G. Louardo, Mosher, McCullough, Stealy, Keap.
Back for B & C and all to Tricoupi, nice
not too large party. Back by 9. Wrote office
in - read JLN

4 Fine, still. Wrote M. Out BSA 1030-1245. Got
colder. L finished putting up graph. curtains -
Mrs. dining room after lunch, like buffet. Big
tea 5-8, 8 3 here, everything went finely. Late
dinner. Began Sea Myst. etc.

5. Greyish, small occas. showers. Finished story
in bed. B off to Con early. Went to BSA 1030-1230
Delos vol x1. Called golf off. Could not resist
Tony after lunch, so L & J got it rather soon.
(out after tea to glass shop & Melai's office
cont) Then Orij. re Const. boats, GFS to see Miss
Breed (out) to Kelop - saw Dr & Dr M. Has begun
Burchor's report on Samos & read it etc. Has
Europ. Conc. Vain = Figaro, Beeth. IX, Schubert VII.
6. Greyish. Clear. BSA from 10-11.45, mostly
del x1 and Dugas. Back for L & went to Phil.
& Orij. Back to change before lunch. Off 2:15
for golf, did 1 round + 3 more when it got
chilly. Not brilliant. Tea here. Later L & J to
Norman Whites, small nice party. Eve read

more Buschor on Samos but got sleepy early.

7. Grey. Write ~~ED~~ NB. Out c 10.45 to Phil. - left with Mme Sch, Sterling, Rose. Back via flower market, lovely red tulips. Nice call Mrs Skinner, still improving. Main Bird here to lunch, lots of Pitt. back after - lent her 3 detective stories. B back by 4. All out to Circo's to tea, then Eliz Schumann delightful recital: (Bach, Schum, Brahms, Strauss Splendid artist. Eve a little Samos, very heavy going.

8. Fine. Write M. Fine symphony, Berlin Rom. J (too long), & Schumann Re Pastor, Alleluia, Str: Wiegenslied, Morgen, Ständl. Pastoral Sym. Back late. All out c 3 to Porto Raptiti, last part road very bad. Got out on way back to turn pot. sheds. Late here for tea. Letter into Prof Long (Mrs Droppers). Write H. Eve read

Obs, ST, T&S etc.

9. Fine. ^{warm} Went to BSA 10.15-12.45 mostly reading Dugas, though sat out in sun on bench w. MH for a little. Off 2.20 for golf, went twice around. Lovely day, windy at first - but quieted down. Back for 5.20 tea, though - Fanna & his wife up to town. Tub after tea - then settled down to Buschor, more in eve - Concert Buda, Beeth 2, Deming, Man, Tordaly Ps. Heng
10. Fine, ^{warm} slight clouds. Shifted furniture in S. room etc. Out before 11 to Vasili, Hermes St, Legation (out) Orij, Phil. Tried made over blue felt. Out before 2.30 for golf. Big crowd. Went around only once. Small shower, rain bon. Stopped w. message Graves. Tub, tea 5.20 Vasili 6.20. Eve chiefly Lhengien, Buda finished Buschor. Begun Atlantic.
11. Fine. Write M. Then BSA all a.m, Delos xi, esp Thealium. General look around after lunch, papers etc. Huge tea Amer & a few Brits

116 here, nearly all at once. Late dinner.

Ern had Sch. conc. from Rome, read N.Y.T.

12. Fine. L, C, I to Mrs. before 10, to workroom.

Pendlebury came about beads, later
Geo M. an epimetele when C had gone

to see Gill. Left soon after 11 to Phil (out)

Germsch for photos Delphi & Delos,

back to dress. All off for lunch Minie

Schliemann, And, Keyes - Razil(?) very

amusing & interesting time. Back by 3.

Finished Payne JHS 1926, which I had begun
before, in conn. Dugas - Cycl poetry. ErP

arrived before 4, both fine - L out to

orig 4:30. B, C, L, I to Marg. for tea

left after 5:30. B went to Acad meet.

& came out later. Meikle, S. Lute, Ha-

zeltine, Cahills, Mrs N White, outstayed the

others - ErP out for dinner, but came

back by 11. Good Mozart (6 flat sym) from

Buch, later some M violin conc. Shanby.

Played a little w. Tony. in eve, slow
but not as hard as some.

13 Fine, a little grayish, muggy. BSA till 11:45

nearly finished vol XI. Quick change, of 12:15 to

Phil, re old blue & gray straws. Back to finish

dressing. Lunch Paynes, Pendlebury, ErP. Fine

talks. Papers etc. All four of c 5 to WT Blacklers

for tea, also Dr. M. K. M., Mrs Kinnes, Mrs Ramsay,

Mrs Paulide, Forbes, Mrs Payne, Flakes. Lovely

garden & house, much personal thought in it.

Back 7:15, L & I had go at Tony. ErP ^{all had} ~~out~~

good talk in eve. Early to bed.

14 Fine, still mild. Elect. came about outlets.

BST from 10:30-12:45, finished SI and looked

up some BETH. L came after me. Got things

ready to send Tracy's baby after lunch. Out c 4

to Meikle (out) Woodley where stayed to tea &

a long gossip, Hillier, both W's, ErP. Back 6:30,

late tea with Carl. Prof Long on steps as we

came in. Dined Legation, also Phantzie,

Petroc, Brown, vaults, Monte, Mink, Mrs
Emery, Mrs Campbell. Mrs S still upstairs.
Back c. 11.

15. Fine. Up in good time. Wrote M. Off 1045
to Piraeus with Effie. Thompson & Harry
came just as we were leaving, re Salo-
naki mantle. Took 2 to "Citta di Bari"
and stayed on deck till after 12, but
as boat was not to go till 2, left P for
lunch then came back, stopping Sicily.
B went to Cor. at 2 with some American
students. Wrote H, read Times & Sun.
Mr Long here for tea, Mr & Mrs Johnsons
came later. Planned out their Angled
trip. All left c. 7. L - I did Tony, slow
but got most of it by bedtime. Built
Concord Egmont, I, III Sym. Prague via
various relays.

16 Fine. Son's birthday. In P&S all morning
mostly Delos houses. Back by 12, to Obij

then Phil (not ready), back to Obij for L.
After lunch tried on & mended out a lot of
old clothes. Tidied up papers. Early tea, took
Pier to Piraeus for "aphotos", left typing for
Gross. Found Uncle Bacon here on return,
looks fine. Changed to Phil, then G.B. to call
Mrs W.S. Stevens & ran into J.M. Robinsons.
Talk with them, then up to Mrs S. Back 8.30
Ever terrible interference by Govt with Moz.
Camin Mass. Very sleepy.

17. Fine, warm, windy by noon. Read L's Aephi

11.5. Houses. Out by 3 to Obij for L, then to

for house. Saw about table etc after
lunch. B back about 4. Huge tea began
promptly at 5 and lasted till after 8.
General polyglot crowd. Late dinner
read a little Dumfries, early to bed.
Ricardo from Rome.

19. ^{Cold} Windy. Notes. Heffer. L + Jont C II to GBS,
Guent, Pris for tea cloth C Droppers' md-
ding present, Legation (out), Euclides (14 letters)
back for books, Red + Nosp (fine) to see
Miss Dutton who has ^{broken} sprained her
ankle on "Rotterdam" cruise. Good old
chat with her. Then via Alex to Mrs. for
C, picked up B in Acad St. After lunch
read 2 reprints de Waale Amingen -

Cornish (Gnomon), also old JHS on Homer Min.
Asked Mrs Haverstick to tea but did not come.
Out 6.30 to GBS to say goodbye to Miss Bred
but - missed her. 7-8 started Torq. with L.
Dinner 9 (blue velvet) for 2 Jacobs, 2 Ames, Long,
WST, Mrs Skeris, Mrs Robinson, DMR in after
wards for coffee (wild delo strip). Much talk.
Gan WST present to take to CD, also Pullinger
Saroukia. Lasted till after 12.

20 Perfect. Out c. 10.30 to BSA, finished VIII and
read Beth 1905, 1916. Back at 12, went with L
to Orij. Tried blue georgette. Rushed
back for lunch. Uncle Bacon + Geoffrey
Platt (Harr.) fine talk about GK things +
Dad. Left c. 3. Later L + I went to see
Davies. Back before 5, out before 6 to DK
for tea, also Leslie, Othinis, Davis, Brown
- more but spent most time talking
to Othinis + Miss Mills. To Germ Sch 7.30
Makridog on "Panachrantos church, sep.

of the Paleologues. Very int. double
church, very long talk - poor slides. Got
out till 9 or later. Evl. Gyeck concert
from Prag. incl Dvorak & sym. L. & I did
Torg in eve, got all but one word.

21 Beautiful, warmer. Did ^{with Gyeck} accounts -
then L. & I went to BSA, but she soon

Miss J (better) till 5 - Back quick change
before Ful Wenck & Schader, nice time
Times - Ols before dinner. began Byz
Acher. in eve. Wien Sch Lenfin, Moz. Quar-
tet wood wind - orch, Beeth II.

23. Greyish, got damp & chilly, clear -
Spent a.m. with interruptions, writing
on Dels. Revised beginning - did
most of tenenos. Papers after lunch -
more Byz A. Carl back at 4. Tea
then then dinner. To Arch Soc 6.30

- to hear Bentley, in Cox, on Maca.
 All went well till lights failed ∴ un-
 able to show pictures for last part.
 Later to Phal, sea Macca's, many navy.
 Nice chat with people, dancing began.
 Back 9 - Good Bath, ^{to Eym Buda}
 More Byz Ach in ^{re. wire from M} ^{Emie dies Friday}
- 24 Fine. Wrote Josephine - L & C off to
 Mrs. I spent 10-12 writing more Delis
 Then to Orij, blue Cretan, navy slip.
 Papers & Byz Ach after lunch. About
 4 to Mrs Skinner, much better, kept us
 to tea. Mrs Alex. came in - Back c 6 &
 settled down to more BA. Out 10.30
 to Mme Paspatis, small pleasant
 party incl Jacobs, Alex, Damala, Lous-
 dale, various family etc. Back c 1.
- 25 Fine. Got Nat Holiday, guns by cab.
 Johny out flag. Wrote M, finished it

airplane demonstrations etc, so read

 the day. Out c 3.30 for a fine run around
 Trophi Δ, gorgeous out. Back to find Kath
 Reilly whom we had asked for tea &
 with whom we had a great gossip. Read

 for bible. Europ. concert from London - Semis-
 out, Greek concerto Suggia, Attilis Mouj
Heris, new w. cho. & narrator.
 26 Greyish, mild. ^{works} L & I spent a long time
 hunting out & translating an acct. of
 thing part for Mrs Skinner - did odds
 & ends, then out to see Miss Dutton
 & around via Mrs. for C - an errand
 as two on way back. Man came p.m.
 re making front door. L & I out c 3
 to Paris, began to pour, fittings, then
 Marinop, Ghid, Amly, Elmh. back:
 for tea - BA 615 for Evans latest

on Crete, esp worship of snakes - new excavations to tv court & visitor at V entrance. Too late for King Fued's party. Took Mrs Miller home. Read Oth - tried to start on Torg. evl, not much luck. Beuth III conc. Prag.

27. Grey, colder. Spent most of am writing Idos, esp houses etc. Sir Arthur here for lunch & much talk about his lecture, his year's plans etc. Windy & disagreeable p.m. L & I did Torg before tea & after dinner. Went to tea Kulop, also 4 Regs, young Blackles, ALWIC, Maria G Arist, Mrs Payne, Mrs Reed - a few others. C came for us - all at Basilis hill nearly dinner time - Eric Wien Mrs. Staloo, Mours. Josua, Athalia, then to Rome & heard part of much Dm. concerto - 1st movement Brahms viol conc.

28. Gale & lots of snow. Terrible for

garden, quite deep by 6 or still at it. Split haunch of one lemon tree. Snowed hard all a.m., but sun came out by 4. Spent a.m. writing hard on Idos & got first writing done by early p.m. Everything dripping in p.m. but no further damage to us. Had to cut Forbes's party in Keph, but went soon after 6 to Giras & then to Am Consulate where there was a huge jam. Back about 8.15. Read STories in evl, had Prag Hindveger Skating Rink, Satch Jack, Debussy Fantasia (piano) New World, Bolero.

29. Fine, sunny, everything melting. Wrote M. L & I to Sym. Couperin - Strauss Suite of Dances, Beuth viol Conc. Erica Morini, brilliant, Mids. N. whole suite. Wrote H after lunch. L & I out around M-K S, little sign of storm out, here etc. a few olive boughs broken. Back for tea & Caldwell who stayed till after 7.15. Uncle Bacon came for tea but left soon. Hayden quartets from Wien. Eric had parts of Parsifal

tried for Brown Hairs but had interference
later misc. from Prag. wrote Mike earlier.

30. Fine, mild. Spent most of the day
typing Duffin which I finished after
dinner. Went to P&SA for 1/2 hour
10.15-45, to look up one or two things.
MH back from Pelop. L-C went p.m. to
Teram while I wrote. Out after 5 to
Catch keys, also Mrs Miller, Barbours, Ghini
Beran, Cumberbatch. Took Mrs M home
& dropped Mrs Gh; then to GFB to Mrs
Hazeltine (out) met K Reilly & Co just
back. Battery being charged. Finished
typing 9.45 & read 2 Times - TL Sup

31 Fine, mild. Clouds off and on. Went
out when C went to Mrs. & got bread
& packed things for picnic, Am Ex re
boats from Dad (?). Back 10.30 and had
an hour for corrections & revisions before
A & H Negv. came. All packed in, & on

ouapirane, picked up C, went to Bogati. Had
lunch on terrace of cafe then cross country
to ravine. Had uncasted old elk boots, most
useful, snow, mud, water, torrents. Both A
& H fell in during one crossing; all waded wade
had some barefoot some in boots. Splen-
did day, brought back iris & adonis plants.
Car met us near Helen power station. To
tea Negv. great fun. Mrs Atchley came
later. Back about 6 but did not go to
Fr Sch. Got dry & clean, was J-N, T, Punch
Eve began Lawrence class Se, after doing
Brahms on gram. Rain before dinner.

April 1. Gay, muddy. Uncastled, sun & showers.
Wrote M & took long abt with many
interruptions. Went to see Miss Sutton, going
on fine, massage then. Called for C, left
Miss D's glasses at Ragno's. Papers after
lunch & tremendous clearing out. Off 4.30 for
glasses, then to A & H K only D's & ourselves.

There from 5-7:30, L full of talk. To Mac-
cas 7:30-8, back for DR. Home 8:30 quick
change. Dinner of GBS with 5 Hassl.
times, Hill, Lamsdale. Back after 12.

2. Unsettled. Cloud. Just starting for
BSA c 10 when MH came in. Ready second
time, inv. KReilly to lunch, had to ar-
r. At. re car inspection. Too late to go, so
read a lot in new JTA, esp. Konink teram
by A Newhall. To GBS with KR - 2 friends,
long talk. Read Laurence Cl Sc to p/27.
Tea here. Later to Dangleis - Kypiakichis
near to Hill about 8. Started Tog, very
catchy. Some of Gottard from Buda, very bad
interference, tried to get Verdi Reg, no use.
Splendid clear night for eclipse of moon

3. Good Friday. Fine. BSA 10-12 mostly BOH.
Took care of young archis. to see Numbly.
Back 12, change, short call Rel +, then
for C, stopped at his bookshop. After

lunch Wichedy did some Tog, also ev. A
don one. Tea BSA with Mthist, Hartley,
Barnet, open fire. En Bach? / Cho. Buda, Rome
misc. choral, good.

4. Drizzle, mild. Did books then spent
rest of a.m. writing on Elcus. L typing
news items. Mthist - KReilly here for
lunch. Latter left c 3.30, L - I went to Min
Mills for meeting - Out to Helleniko but
found it was at school. Group to start
committees on funds etc. Back c 7. Typed
for L till dinner time. Ev read Laurence
to/b5. Buda concert w. Parcifal, Or - Good F, Bach
Concert, some from St Mat. Later Carmen from Rome

Very successful time at Olyth. Call from Miss Sut just after tea till about 7. More packing till dinner. Tony. eve, my papers, early to bed.

11. Fine. Up early to pack. Thm. Hussian Bey arr. about 9 - C took her to Museum. Out at 10 for Ambr, Ghid, etc. then to Mus. & took MATHS to Art Coll, Mrs Davies showed us all around. Drove to Poych. Mr, M & R here for lunch. M - J to Pir. to see guest of. Back about 3. To Dr L at 7 max in ear, Book Club till L came for me. Packed after tea till nearly 7 when 14 Nov. came - we called Sogginis,

Miller (out), etc, row as far as Golf Club, lovely sunset, took to home - saw J. Packing all in till late.

12 Fine. Up early to finish, which we did in time to leave about 10. Wire from B boat not in until 1. Got on comfortably, C nearly carried off. Good cabin 91-92. On board 3 *Aiginitis*, Romans, handlans, Venet. Lovely day beautiful sail, but in Canal, otherwise fine. Good deck chairs, read *Green Alps*, not much good though well written - Sit next Ms. Pleasant lazy trip, dull cinema on deck.

13 Fine, nice easy day. Brindisi before 10. Tommaso got us some Eng papers. Read all back Times, *Obs*, *ST*, *Punch*, *Sketch* etc. Began letter to M after tea. Started *Curtain Eggs*. Another dull cinema + Mickey.

14 Fine but hot + sticky. Finished M + made up diary on deck. The M. M's took M's letter to post in London. Lunch 11, landed about 12 at Lloyd Office in Giudecca. All customs well arranged, fine waiting room. Slow but peaceful, no trouble. *Bank* had us in tow + things easily + in gondola w. all luggage. Hotel man also there. Though some nice smaller canals to Grand Hotel fine point: opp. Salute, next to Grand. Nice big room, bath, terrace on front. Very hot so unpacked, but long siesta + out about 5. Just missed Venet. Tea in arcade, then STM, service soon on so sat + heard it + poked around. Odd to mix good + bad memories that way. Repairing N aisle + w. entrance. All very fine. Walk to P. very short + easy. Back to rest before dressing, good dinner, coffee on general terrace + up + to bed early without lights.

15. Fine but hot - sticky again. Breakfast on terrace w. help of awnings. Very pretty up there w. shrubs - flowers. But soon after 9 via Piazz. to Am Ex next to Danieli, to see about London reservations, Bob + Flor. Kidato, Torcello. Boat to Accad. - stayed till after 11.30. Fine time poking around, all very well written big hall, Presentation, + St U. as sort of climax, also Byz. reliq. - Benetton. Boat to St M. C granite at Florian during clocks at noon. Changed before lunch, off for SP2. boat to Torcello. At Murano made wild hot dash a long way to Byz. ch. but it was closed, scurry back. At Bemano had tea on pavement in the shade. Too short time at T. High around completely in gondola along canal - Fine Piazza + sts. in a row, were rest. when we

were there before, also Mrs. in S aisle after - whole w end nave, fine screens, old piscina in room beyond bapt. Should stay longer. Back by diff. route after Murano, around to other side. Took taxi to SITA garage, then a drive to try to cool off to S. Michele in Bosco for view over city, Giard. Mag. Certosa - out to cafe for lemonade. Back to hotel, court coolest place - tried not to melt in lounge. Finished it - looked at Illust. etc. Nearly dead with heat, tub, change.

More comfy for dinner, coffee in court, up early to room - did packing - Pandemonium at cafe opposite but a little less hot than daytime, so went to sleep, but I did not. Called 5.30 (but had waked earlier, coffee 6, taxi 6.30.

June 17. Last items really this day. Fine but still roasting - To garage, luggage on top, excellent place, fine new bus excellent service. Splendid drink 7/2 only short stay Monhid. Florence room - 1 delicia, could have 4 after lunch - ⁴³ another to wash in - 4 am made nice new lounge to l. of entrance. Seem to be all new staff. Good lunch - up soon after. Bed room looked excellently comfortable. Unpacked, did wash etc, then nice long siesta, read leave it to Susan very amusing - up 4.30 for tubs, out to Amly, letters

T. 4DVB, from H. B. at hotel. Tea at Doney's, then to Cappini - got 2 pers. earrings - green ring for T, left necklace for cleaning, also crystals for restringing, & got lots of things. To Pia - ordered nice nightgown for T - blue for me - no one has anything but silk ready. Also ordered at R. Bellini, no dresses of kind we wanted anywhere. Back via Ponte V, the market (little crocheted ones) by 7.30. Cooled off some after dinner but came up early - finished Susan.

19. Fine. Woke at 5 - soon up to write letters, Eugenia, Seafidge, diary, H. Wace, M. Breakfast - 8.45 on terrace, then to Amly, - to Pal Vecch. to Garden Exhib. where we spent most of a.m. Lovely and cool in there, wonderful - fascinating show. Walked back to

Piazza VM for remount, to Roberts, for books 3 Touchnitz, Times, Hotel. Cool on ground floor so took things - wrote B. long letter, up for belated siesta. Out by 5.20 tram to Fiesole, theatre, view, up later for view. Tea first at Aurora, then back again for dinner at 8. Lovely - cool, fine time. Radio Roma with excellent Trio Mandels. Got 1 bag, 1 pochette, 1 crocheted cap. Back on tram reaching hotel c 10.30. Nice and cooler. Wrote to & from Trot ⁱⁿ nite.

19. Fine - Still fairly warm but does not seem so after Bol. Went a.m. to Arch Mus, all ground floor, garden etc. closed for alterations. Sent cards to Levi who was most kind, had call in his office then did the 2 upper floors, till c 11.30. Canoga to Bargello, remount in a funny little place opposite. Cool in B. among, lots of sun elsewhere. Up to
