February 18, 1931 - October 26, 1931.

Feb. 18, Fine, perfect day. Wrote M - Mrs Renner. L's lesson early so later drove to Koopi taking Attila little George in front. Mrs Keays here for lunch. Left her at their office after 3 & went to Golf Club. Airplane nearly hit the place as we arrived & caused st. excitement. Played 4-9 twice, heavenly out. Tea there. Back c.6. Big tea, really masticha at Eliascos. Huge crowd has very good time, nearly 9 when back. Not much luck getting anything on wine less. Rent a little Barnes. Early to bed.

19 Fine. Wrote Effie. Later out buying while L did errands & came later. Off at 2.30 for golf, very slow starting, big crowd, all holes open. Heavenly out but took long time. Back 4.50 and quick change before tea Mrs Barbour, also Forbes, another Sartorius, N White, bright, Hensley, - , Attila boy. Left c.7 & bought Mrs H, making a few calls on

way at 75 Sk, 35A, could not find Bratton Torg. eve, based on Raveling. Fine concert tier, led Boutrit off, Eulenspiegel, Faun, Cog d'Or, Scriab III. Meals in Gk room during floor-polishing.

20. Fine. Went over Deep. revisions & later began Delos. Typist here to see L re chm ngs of neighbors. after her lesson she & I measured, cut, turned hem in curtains for library. Out 2 to gofr & had fine time 2.30-4 with a complete round and a couple of extra holes. Gorgeous out, some decent shorts. Dressed for Caldwells eve to tea - cake great hit with bags. At 7 out to Dar with message to M. Stayed only 5-10 min. as M was dressing to go out. did as much Torg. as our Raveling allows. Some of Tosca fr. Buch, a concert Rome mid. CT - Grieg sonatas.

21. Greyish. L & I did a lot of recent Delos reports (Roncalli, YMCB, AIA) to catch up with latest things, also 2 copies R's pamphlet. Out 11.45 to Orij, short stay. Vasili's for appointment. Began to rain about lunch time - Times 5.11 2.30 Ben Delos. B came about 4. Carlines due Thurs. Call from Miss Mary Breed (SF). Out 6.30 to W Birth. tea at Legation - Chest - ground dancing - Back 8.30 or so. late dinner. But reply from Rome. Read some Father Brown.

22. GW Birthday. Cloudy. Wrote M. off before 12 taking lunch and driving to Megara to put B on train. Went out to Minya and beyond to harbor for boat, very bumpy. Found good place on slope high above sea. Train 14.14. Fine drive back in a little over one hour. Found note from Mrs Haskell (Vas). Chango & wrote it before tea. Mr & Mrs ST came 6.30 for nice call. Read Ob & ST which no time for earlier. Stuck on end of Torg, no more tips.

23. Fine. Kathara Devora. Spent most a.m. on Delos. Call from M. Dusek about 10:30-11. Read & wrote a little - after lunch ironed all remaining envelopes, then addressed some for next year. Out & to Negri. for tea with laguna etc. Stayed a long time for much talk. Violin recital Rome, Szigeti and Bach, May, Austria. Spain. came high finely - not so successful eve, got some Buell (at home) from Stockh., & Moz & Dror. quantities from Shultz.

24. Fine, perfect morning. Rain p.m. Went to BSA and read Delos till 12. L & J to see Mrs Skinner, sitting up in salonaki. After lunch addressed envelopes - wrote some cards for teas - Out & for Major & then to the Mrs Neidle, also Mrs - late. nice time, took M home, dropped Mr L, stopped here, to Vasili. Both. distrib. a few invitations. Back before 8. Eve a

gray misc. Vienna program - addressed envelopes ate till after 11.
Sunny at times
25 Grey. Wrote M. Out c. 10 to BSA for an hour and a half, reading Delos. Back to house, lots of mail, to Orij & when L came here I went to Ambro & PO. Lunch late - afterwards more invitations - L out by 4 on round of calls, also left many inv. now out - Back 6, first late tea. Making list when Effie came in, adventurous trip, went to Tosadino's for dinner & night. Finished list eve. Petrovich, Hindemith gone jazzed from Vienna. Bed fairly early.

26 Slightly cloudy. Up 6:30, off 7:45 - to meet Carl arr. promptly & on Grey, back to house by 9. B here from early train. Showed a.m. putting around. Effie left note returning C. mon. Papers after lunch, a little wrong. To BSA open meeting 6:15, Paper on Perichora dig. Big arch crowd there -

Dinner Cecil or Keay, also WST, nice time back before 11:30.

27. Fine. PBA from 1030-1230 ready Delos, 1st p. Hall, Antig rot etc. Quick change before lunch. Gaef 2-5, twice around (exc. 700) none too brilliant. Gorgeous day, very strange light, brilliant on part of Philop. Tea here. Out 6:30 w/B3 to call Starkells. Lansdown also came along in B3. Back home & did a little Tong. Finished it in eve.

28 Fine. Did J's book. Cleared out many letters etc. did a little Deephi. To Duy Hen to Phil. Ordered all satin ones. Bro to lunch BSA, Payres, Kurskay, Pendlebury, Theophanides & some lady (Dr. Oct?). Back c 3 and all to Elmasis for tour until Geo. Stayed till nearly 7, brought him back. Very late cup of tea. Eve L & I did invitations for tea for 11th E (Eng sp.)

Mar 1. Fine. Wrote M. All off 1030 for Hellenito to blessing of the ground for Girls' Cael. Big crowd, platform etc. Zaimis, Papadatos, Merkouris, many other officials. Began late as Metrop. was delayed. Started by disreputable old priest. Speeches by Mr Skinner, Pap, Harlow, WST, head GRC teacher. Ended w. Nattanstein. Fine site, all well started. Gorgeous morning. Paper after lunch, then rain H. Cloudy so did not go out, had little. Drove a few min. instead. Cleared up w/ Times, B3 etc out before 6 to big tea Mangainos. Men went later to Arch Soc. meeting L & I stayed. Cost each Tisi. about antiqu. - need bags things. Back soon after 7. Read last week's Times, eve began ~~scouring~~ - 2 Hand shaved early. Cleared. PBA 1040-1245 finished Delos V. After lunch Times, curtains in yard, needed altering in one pair, so present turned etc. ready to send out. Put in

elastics & a few other dull jobs. Tea here, out 6.30 to Phil, but only L's hat ready to try. Later all to huge party at Sp. Lovendos' gorgeous new house, wonderful library, stunning place. Hordes there - Back q. hating away. Rained a little & I went early to bed.

3. Fine. L-J out in good time for errands, got more small tumblers, ordered 8 large, large glass pitcher, to buy. Then to Mrs Skinner, better, Mrs & Alexandre came in. Back for L. All to lunch at Petros, also Atchley, 3 Sotiriads, Barnett. Very good time. Back after 3, then L & I to Petrop, buy a Ray-left notes & what call Davis. Early cup here. L-J to Miss Gault, also Curran, Baer, & Losando, Mosher, McCullagh, Shirley, Keays. Back for B-C and all to Tricoupi, nice not too large party. Back by q. wrote effie in - sent to N

4 Fine, still. Wrote M. Out BSA 1030-1245. Got colder. I finished putting up graph. curtains - Arr. dining room after lunch like buffet. Big tea 5-8, & there, everything went finely. Late dinner. Began Sea Myrt. eve.

5. Greyish, small occas. showers. Finished story in bed. B off to car early. Went to BSA 1030-1230. Delos rot x1. Called golf off. Could not resist trying after lunch, so L & I got it rather soon. Out after tea to jeans shop & Melai's office (cont) then Orial. re Const. boats, GB to see Miss Broadbent to Ralph & saw Dr r-d M. Has begun Bushon's report on Samos & read it eve. Has Euro. conc. Klein = Figaro, Beeth. II, Schubert VII. 6. Greyish. Cleaned. BSA from 10-11.45, mostly del x1 and Degas. Back for L & went to Phil. - Driy - Back to change before lunch. Off c 210 - for golf, did 1 round + 3 more when it got chilly. Not brilliant. Tea here. Later L & I to Norman White's, small nice party. Eve read

more Buschor on Sams but got sleepy
early.

7. Grey. Wrote ~~to~~ 11.30. Out c 10.45 to Phil. - left
note Kne Sch, Sterling, Rose. Back via flower
market, lovely red tulips. Nice call Mrs
Skinner, still improving. Miss Bredt here
to lunch, lots of Pitt. talk after - Lent her
3 detective stories. Back by 4. All out to
Civ's to tea, then Eliz Schumann delight-
ful recital: Bach, Schum, Brahms, Strauss.
Splendid artist. Eve a little Sams, very
heavy going.

8. Fine. Wrote M. Fine symphony, Berlin
Rom. J (too long), E Schumann Re Pasto,
Alleluia, St: Wiegendied, Morgen, Stäuf.
Pastoral sym. Back late. All out c 3
to Porto Raphi, last part road very
bad. Got out on way back to turn pot-
sherds. Late here for tea - letter into Prof
Lang (Mrs Drophus). Wrote H. Eve read

Obs, ST, T.S etc.

^{warm} 9. Fine. Went to BSA 10.15-12.45 mostly reading

Degas, though sat out in sun on bench w.
MH for a little. Off 2.20 for golf, went twice
around. Lovely day, windy at first - but -
quieted down. Back for 5.30 tea, brought -
Farrar & his wife up to town. Talk after tea -
then settled down to Buschor, more in eve -

^{warm} 10. Fine, slight clouds. Shifted furniture in s.
room etc. Out before 11 to Vasili, Hermes St, Lega-

around only once. Small shower, rainbow.
Stopped w. message Erans. Talk, tea 5.30
Vasili 6.30. Eve chiefly Lohengrin, Buds
finished Buschor. began Atlantic.

11. Fine. Wrote M. Then BSA all a.m., dels ~~to~~ esp
Heracum. General look around after lunch,
papers etc. Huge tea Amer & a few Birds

116 here, nearly all at once. Late dinner.

Eric has Sch. conc. from Rome, read NYT.

12. Fine - L, C, I to Mrs. before 10, to workroom.

Pendlebury came about beads, later

Geo M - an epimellet when C has gone
to see Gill. Left soon after 11 to Phil(out)
Germisch for photos Delphi & Delos,

back to dress. All off for lunch Mme
Schliemann, And., Keyros - Razil very
amusing & interesting time. Back by 3.
Finished Payne JtS1926, which I had begun
before, in conn. Degas & Lysit poetry. ErP
arrived before 4, both fine - L out to

orig 4:30. R C, L to Mary. for tea
left after 5:30. B went to Acad met.
& came out later. Meissle, S. Leete, Ha.
Zeltine, Cahills, Mrs. N White, outstayed the
others - ErP out for dinner, but came
back by 11. Good Mozart (& flat sym) from
Bach, later some M violin conc. Stanbury.

Played a little w. Tong. in end, slow
but not as hard as some.

13 Fine, a little grayish, muggy. BSA till 11:45
nearly finished vol XI. Quick change, off 12:15 to
Phil, re old blue & grey straws. Back to finish
dressing. Lunch Paynes, Pendleburys, ErP. Fine
talks. Papers etc. All four off c 5 to W Blacklers
for tea, also Dr. McCal, MacKinnon, Mrs. Ramsay,
Mrs Pauline, Forbes, Mrs Payne, Blakes. Lovely
garden & house, much personal brightness in it.
Back 7:15, L & I had go at Tong. ErP ~~all her~~
good talk in eve. Early to bed.

14 Fine, still mild. Elect. came about outlets.

BSA from 10:30 - 12:45, finished XI and looked
up some Betti. L came after me. Got things
ready to send traces' baby after lunch. Out c 4
to Meissle(out) Woodley where stayed to tea -
a long gossip, Hillier, both Ws, ErP. Back 6:30,
late tea with Carl. Prof Long on steps as we
came in - Dined Legation, also Phranzies,

Petroc, Brown, Van Slyck, Monroe, Mrs. Kinst, Mrs. Emery, Mrs. Campbell - Mrs. S still upstairs.
Back c. 11.

15. Fine. Up in good time - wrote M. off 1045 to Pisacis with Effie. Thompson & Harry came just as we were leaving, re Sabanaki mantel. Took E to "Città di Bari" and stayed on deck till after 12, but as boat was not to go till 2, left P for lunch then came back, stopping Silic.

B went to Cor. at 2 with some Amherst students. Wrote H, read Times & Sun. Mr. Long here for tea, Mr. & Mrs. J. Holmes came later. Planned out their Anglia trip. All left c. 7. L - I did Tony, slow but got most of it by bedtime. Built Concert Egnont, I, III Sym. Prag via various relays.

16 Fine. Son's birthday. In RSA all morning mostly Silos houses. Back by 12, to Orij.

Then Phil (not ready) back to Orij for L.

After lunch tried on - wedged out a lot of old clothes. Tidied up papers. Early tea, took Pier-to Pisacis for "photos," left typing for Evans. Found Uncle Bacon here on return, looks fine. Chased R to Phil, then GBS to call Mrs. W.S. Stevens & ran into Dr. Robinsons. Talk with them, then up to Mrs. S. Back 8:30. One terrible interference by Goat with Mrs. C in Mass. Very sleepy.

17. Fine, warm, windy by noon. Read L's Depthi & helped her type it out. Then to RSA 1130

115. Houses. Out by 3 to Orij for L, then to Piss where it took till tea time to get L's fitting done. Ordered raw silk dress, coat hat for travel & music. Dick S. came in at Piss's late tea, quick change. French School supposedly 6:15; began very late. Demargne on Nécropoles [?] de Mallia interesting but too long. Finished 8:10, then to masticka

at the Phantzes till 9. Nothing much to get in eve - we Faust from Buda. Read Debt in eve.

18. Windy, grey. Wrote M very long letter
B&A 11.15-1245. Red tulips - grass - heather
for house. Saw about table etc after
lunch. Back about 4. Large tea began
promptly at 5 and lasted till after 8.
General polyglot crowd. Late dinner
near a little Dumitru's, early to bed.

Went to tea 12:15, also 4 negro, young Blacklers, PW, Maria G Arnt, Mrs Payne, Mrs Reed - a few others. Came for us - all at Basili's till nearly dinner time - Eve Wien Noz. Italoo, Novus. Joshua, Athalia, Rom + Romeo + heard part French Divincento - 1st movement Brahms viol conc.
28. Gales + lots of snow. Terrible for

garden, quite deep by 6 + still at 12. Split branch of one lemon tree. Snowed hard all a.m., but up sun came out by 4. Spent a.m. writing hard on Dulos + got first writing done by early p.m. Everything dripping in p.m. but no further damage to us. Had to cut Forbes's party in Reph, but went soon after 6 to Giras + then to Am Consulate where there was a huge jam Back about 8:15. Real STories in eve, had Prag Hindsguler Skating Rink, Satin Jack, Debussy Fantasie (piano) New World, Boleros.

29 Fine, sunny, everything melting. Wrote H. LC + I to Sym. Couperin-Strauss Suite + dances, Bush Viol Conc. Erica Morini, brilliant, Mids. N. whole suite. Wrote H after lunch. L + I out around 11-12, little sign of storm out there exc. a few olive boughs broken. Back for tea 4 Caldwell who stayed till after 7:15. Uncle Bacon came for tea but left soon. Haydn quartets from Wien. Eric had parts of Parsifal

wrote for Brown Stars but had interference
later misc. from Prag. Wrote like earlier.

30. Fine, mild. Spent most of the day
typing *Daphnis* which I finished after
dinner. Went to BSA for 1/2 hour
10.15-45, to look up one or two things.
MH back from Pilop. -- C went p.m. to
Teran while I wrote. Out after 5 to
Catchley, also Mrs Miller, Barbour, Ghini
Baran, Cumberbatch. Took Mrs M home
dropped Mrs Gh; then to GFB to Mrs
Hazelton (cont) met K Reilly & co just
back. Battery being charged. Finished
typing 9.45 - was 2 times - TL Sup

31 Fine, mild. Clouds off and on. Went
out when C went to Mrs. & got bread
& baked things for picnic, am Ex re
bought from David (?) Back 10.30 and had
an hour for corrections & revisions before
A & H Negr. came. All packed in, then

ouapains, picked up C, went to Bogati. Had
lunch on terrace of café then cross country
to ravine. Had unearthened old Elk boats, most
useful, snow, mud, water, torrents. Boat A
rotted in during one crossing; all naked aside
from some waistcoat some in boats. Splen-
did day, bought back iris & adonis plants.
Car met us near Helen power station. To
La Negra - great fun. Mrs Catchley came
later. Back about 6 but did not go to
Fr Sch. Got dry & clean, was JL N, T. Punch

3. Unsettled. Cloudy. Just starting for BSA c 10 when MH came in. Ready second time, inv. KReilly to lunch, has to arr. w. Ath. re car inspection. Too late to go, so read a lot in new ATA, esp. touring team by Averhall. To GB with KR + 2 friends, long talk. Read Lawrence Cl Sc to p 127. Tea here. Later to Janglis - Reparaticks nice to tell about S. Started Tug, very catchy. Some p. Collected from Buda, very bad influence, tried to get Verdi Reg, no use. Splendid clear night for eclipse of moon.
- 3 Good Friday. Fine. BSA 10-12 mostly BSA. Took care of young archit. to see Remondy. Back 12, change, short call Res +, then for C, stopped at his bookshop. After

lunch quickly did some Tug, also eve. A slow one. Tea BSA with MHiast, Hartley, Barnet, open fire. En Bach! / cho. Buda, Rome misc. choral, good.

4. Drizzling, mild. Did books then spent rest of a.m. writing on Eleus. L typing news items. MHiast + KReilly here for lunch. Later aft c 3:30, L + I went to Miss Mills for meeting - out to Helliniko but found it was at School. Group to start committee on funds etc. Back c 7. Typed for L till dinner time. Eve saw Lawrence to 165. Buda concert w. Pasifal, ov + God F, Bach Concert, some from St Mat. Later Carmen from Rome
5. Mild, clearing. Wrote M. L, C, J to concert Brahms II, Parts of Moz. GM in Mars, Pasifal by Cho w. Oskarowides, excellent. Harry got mantel up while we were out. Quick change after lunch, then helped L type, then KReilly came and I took her to see Miss D.

Motherin Gordon - others incl. Mrs. Marsden's sister at hosp. Back for tea to which came Miss Brewster, Miss Gillis, Mrs. Stevens, Mrs. Haverstick & K. Reilly. Left before 7, wrote H before dinner. B back on late train. Began ^{to} plaque.

6. Fine. Out 10 to BSA, wrote some ^{Elmises} & had talk with M.H. who left on Trumton in p.m. Back about 12. L & I to lunch with Mrs. Stevens - Mrs. Haverstick at GB. Hordes there. Woolley's first people we saw. Sat on bench for coffee - I went to C in before 3, later I called for her & then went to Pines. Back 4.45, quick change. To Pia - ordered rose nightgown pink & blue for me - no one has anything but sick ready. Also ordered at R. Bellini, no dresses of kind we wanted anywhere. Back via Ponte V, old market (little crocheters) by 7.30. Cooled off some after dinner but came up early & finished Susan.

19. Fine. Woke at 5 - soon up to write letters, Eugenia, Supridge, diary, H.Wac, M. Breakfast 8.45 on terrace, then to Antik, - to Pal Vecch. to Garden Exhib. where we spent most of a.m. Lovely and cool in there, wonderful fascinating show. Walked back to

Piazza VM for our money, to Roberts, for books 3 Tauchnitz, Times, Hotel. Cool on ground floor so took things & wrote Belong letter, up for belated siesta. Out by 5.20 tram to Fiesole, theatre, excav, up later for view. Tea first at Aurora, then back again for dinner at 8. Lovely & cool, fine time - Radio Roma with excellent Trio Mendels. Got 1 bag, 1 pockette, 1 crochet cap. Back on tram reaching hotel c 10.30. Nice and cooler. Wine & fruit tray ^{nice}.

19. Fine. Still fairly warm but does not seem so after Bol. Went a.m. to Cich Mus, all ground floor, garden etc. closed for alterations. Sent cards to Len who was most kind, had call in his office. Then did the 2 upper floors, till c 11.30. Carrozza to Bargello, rummaged in a funny little place opposite. Cool in B armory, lots of sun elsewhere. Up to

won w. Donatello, then thought to chapel to see fine Byz. mosaic Pantok. All on other side Loggia closed for repairs too. Caravaggio back, newspapers, cigs & hotel.
