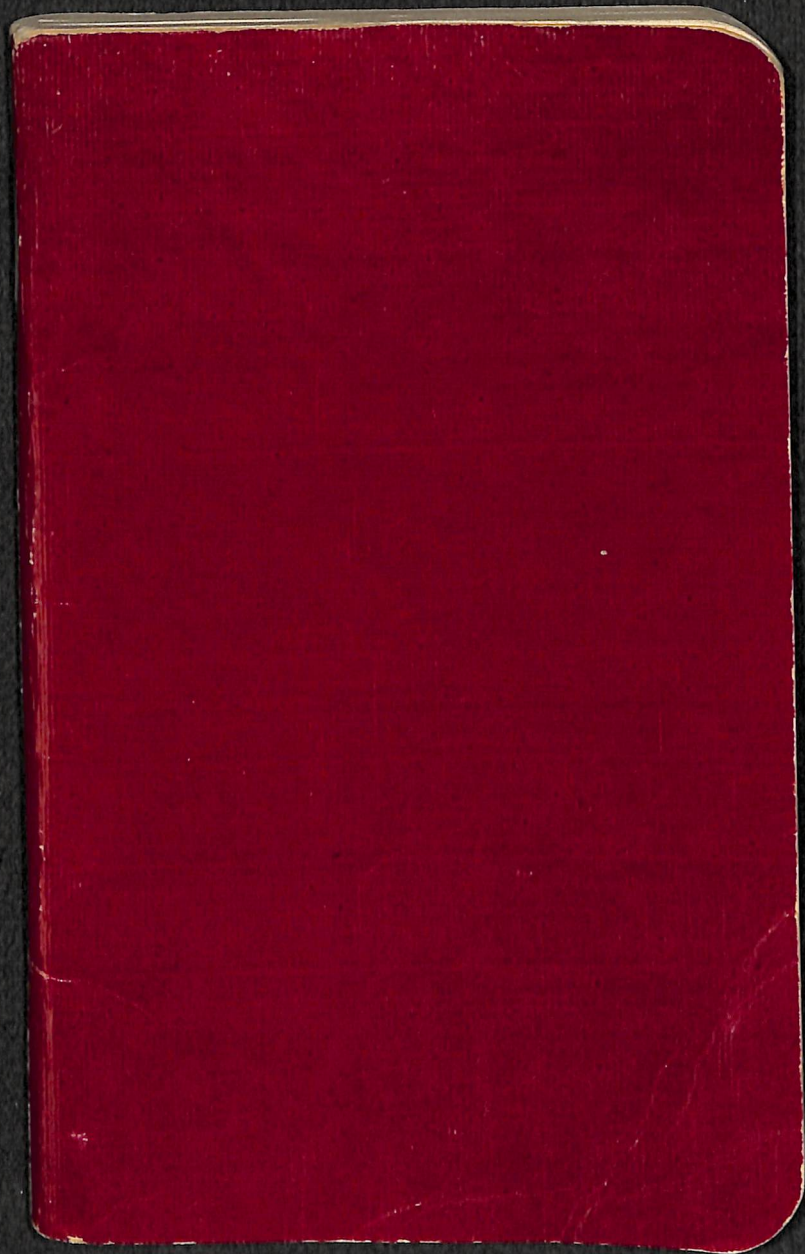

Oct 26, Fine, cold.

Oct 26. Fine, cold. Off before 10 with S to do a few errands. Left T at Emily's. Did Admet, Over, Boots etc, back before 11. Papers with tea. Wrote in Morris - tied up book to send. Wrote St. Nice Trio, Keltic, ^{103.} Beth, Goosens, songs by F Hatfield. Bridge Mrs Rudge's, also Jo, Mrs Wardrop, Moore, L Harris, nice time, down 7d. Early supper, heard Menschel read his poem. Mozart Serenade for wind later, J Stokman, Brahms etc. E to music club. Did ST puzzle began this one. Ace of Spades.

27. Fine cold. Election day, all household out early. Tr S to R later. S did taxi for electors with car. Did some pressing for T myself. Bridge at Jo's p.m. Also Mrs Rudge, Solmonson, Fawcett, Waugh, nice game, lost 1/1. Marc & Bernard in during tea. Back about 7. Returns off & on during eve. Stayed up hill 2, M up hill 4 where they closed down. Landslide for Quot.

28. Less cold, drizzle. Clear to fine p.m. cold but sunny. Everyone out before 10. Read

papers, these cleared out boxes of old letters etc. Took long time, finished them before fire in dining room. Wrote a few notes. Out for Mrs F, did 15 holes, very cold. I came for us 4.30. Margesson in big majority, a large crowd waiting for announcement. Cable L, re voyage. Back for welcome tea. M+S to cinema, 6 pm news had letter & lists of results, Cons. sweep, only 50 vs. Concert, Howard, Couidan, Dutchman & Beth II & Bauer, Sibul. I Sym (The last slow movement) Meph. waltz. All very sleepy in eve & went up at end concert.

29. Fine, cold. Parcel Seep. had key-guard broken, so wrote, repacked other things. Spent most of day in kitchen. to packing typing up shoes, parcels, hats etc. At 11 if on. Fixed squirrel pussy with hooks. Much to see in papers, large sweep, very small opps. about 50. There prep. after lunch, good start but takes endless time.

3
After tea finished The Portrait - began Marie Hamburg till 7.30. Leiser's concert - Figueo, New World, Ital. sisters in duets, Moz, Cimarosa etc, charming. All rather sleepy, reading Low Budget - did some ST.

30. Cloudy. Car still at Hilton's so did not go to R. but spent a.m. on more odds & ends & packed most of trunk. Got a lift from R. after lunch & had lesson with Beau. in place of T. Had to walk back to Bilton bus, home for tea. Had a good read in Hamburg afterwards. I went to rehearsal. BBC Rm 2' Up, Eurydice Ania H Janssen, Or. Heus (Heist), Pigeon Mogenlies (Strauss) Mhesent, Shep. Idy. Chamber Music, Eng. Ensemble Fauré Quartet C. Trini & Scheun & Flac, M Brunsell Trahler & Pfitzner songs.

31. Fine. S. & I went with M about 10 with yellow chrys. Afterwards with T & Ethel

to R. for boards, Bank, Over, etc. Then to
Learn. - to Bobbi's for muleskin coat &
got belt. ^{29/11} hat - T a beige one, cigars,
bats for lunch. P.M. more packing till
after 4, 1/2 bank. To cinema near Regd,
M, S, Alex & I to Arlin in Millionaire
fine, followed by roller randoille.
Dinner about 8.45, Wallace, Brel &
cho, R-Jul (Groum) Massenet Ced,
Hesperus (Hamich), Tann. Read a couple
of stories in Rachel Guid.

Nov 1. Fine - Golf R, Bernard & I. That
not allowed, Mrs F. off to see Arnold.
Good game, playing mostly not too
bad. Home 1.15. A off after lunch.
Back, T & I start Tony. but had no
luck, all blind clues. So came about
4 - we played bridge till 7, stopping
for tea. Mrs F. in with box of
sweets to say goodbye. Another
by Tony. but no success. Letters

cheques etc. during concert = Leon I,
Moz D Conc. (F Goodson) Delius, Unfin.
Up about 10.45 for more packing till
about 2.

2. Fine, gorgeous day. Up early for last
things. S, M, T to station to see me off
most comfortably, no seas. To Kingsly
R.S. left luggage - to Seepidge & glass
ray guard (trial), hair, telephoned Jess
who has flu. To sell by 1.15, met K -
H Fraser for nice lunch. HF & I wal-
ked as far as Bond Road - I went
Liberty for slippers, New Bumber for
Gals & Huxley, bus to Kensington to C
Cooper for an hour, tea traces also tra-
ces (Dum + Russian). Tube to Trip, met
K at 7, to Denis France, to Watzges
from Vienna, back 11.30, with M -
vised packing, met Effie. Bed c. 1.
3. Unpleasant but soon cleared to
beautiful - sunny - up 6.30, off at 8.

K came to see me off, very early, no crowd, sat and talked a long time. She wired T to send Blue Guides. Crossing rough but pleasant & sunny. Nice little steward saw to luggage etc. Arrived in Bond, nothing opened. Car + Comp, a big one, more space because of different plan. At lunch met Mr Polter so we had all meals together - he left at Genoa for Piacenza. Real paper, Punch alm, puzzles etc. Dark before we left Paris. Talked a lot. Slept well, good bed.

4. Fine, misty in valley then brilliant day, never saw finer. Customs at Turin no trouble, contr. took receipt + keys. Breakfast with P, left about 10. Had lovely day, read W. and Brown most of the time, but lots to see - lunch with old Eng. lady who lives in Rome in winter. Gorgeous sunset. Arr.

7.50, good porter, no delay. Fine welcome, have room over M's. Right in to dinner. No one here I know well except Miss Hams but several I have met. Came up early and unpacked. Early to bed.

5. Beautiful brilliant day. Wrote M in bed. Out c 9.30, carrossa to PO - wired M, also Cantagalli. To Serm. for ³²⁰ curtains, to Gallenga & got model bed satin evening dress. Bus to P. Columna - Ven. - to Pal Colon na to see gallery + family portraits, good view courts from windows. Had not been in it for years. Out at 12.30, taxi back. Out c 2.30 on CD but got carried to Colo. so had to walk back to see more excav. near Aug For, clouds of dust from pulling down house but Trig For + Ven Mon. Walked past Cap. along new Turp. street to Marcello - along river to P. Garibaldi for 31 to Acad. Got up early - strolled about, met Mrs Skerres.

Tea at 4 with WSi in his office. Tram
down hill, to Min Educ. to session of
Inter. Inst Med Studies, Count Constanti-
dini, Min Educ, Bartholin on Ardea
(brief, in Ital), Joetham J on Min-
litano with good pictures. Saw him
& Elsa afterwards, also Mrs Shing-
oother speaks Maiuri, Giglioli. With
WSi to Ponte, home by CS about 7.15.
Came up early - not Ashenden.

6. Cloudy & in & out. Up in good time
EF to Babuino & got cig cases for T
at Gambinini's, also ordered paper
radi. he will post. Got Venet. purse
for afternoon. Back via P di S, steps,
Pincio, & Borghese, Veneto to Courlet
for tickets²⁰³ - Naples. Pakas, to Gallenga
for fitting. Am Ex again, paper, Con-
datti, Corso, Jesu, Pal Grutani, P. Basil
& CS back for lunch. Out soon after
2 by CD to Colo., Palatine, Arch

Coast, up hill past S Geor. & P. to Arch
De & P Navone, Villa Alimontana at
last, lovely place & views - Back via
Claudia & CS arr. soon after 4. A
brief house incl. ¹³⁴⁴ note of thanks to
Mrs Gray for tea cloth & napkins sent
from Florence via Miss Martin. Tea
WSi with various arch, incl Stevens,
Russian, Germ. from Court Coll,
Ogles, Berlangue, Luglis, et al.
Bo, Mrs B drove me to Miss Ceissis
leaving Luglis en route. Nice call, tel
all about traces. Scrambled back
for dinner. Que not Times, wrote
up diary. Blue G, Sp. arr. at lunch,
posted by T. in response to wire.
7. Wet. Showery. Letter from T re cig
cases so went to Gambini, shower.
Decides to return for umbrella but
it let up, so went via P di S, Frattina
Corso, P Ven, more hard showers. Back 11

- got umbrella, lucid interval to Vray
- got necklaces for maids, to Eschra -
remount - Times, deluge, short visit
to Terme but very dark. Lots of small
things after lunch, wrote mat, trav,
at 4 Giuseppe Mrs Woodruff's chauffeur
came - we stopped on way at Carrier
re box from Cantagalli, then to tea at
Asperula, lovely house, gorgeous things
Both seem pretty well. On return
stopped Flora but Eng. out, then to
Mrs Strong 6. after 7. Eve call from
Miss Martin - upstairs before 10 or read
D. Fine, a.m. Showers later. Washing
before breakfast. Later borrowed
tools - opened wooden case with
Cantag. things, cleared it up, began
letter to M. Out about 11.30 to
P Ven, Campid, back alley, SM
Crosmedin, roadside to P Garib,
3, tram, up early, work in garden.

Lunch Villa Amelia, also VBs, Wrights
(-libarian), Rechart (archi) Mrs Has-
brouck (formerly in R. US Naval Att).
Delightful time - Back c 3.30, finished
letter - did a little packing - Rain,
let up. Tea VBs also Wrights (Smith)
Mrs Woodruff, Mrs Kichlaas - Back
about 7. After dinner told Miss
Jackson, Miss Eaton about trees,
then busy of packing till 11.30, then
wrote to Mrs Hallam - Bed time -
^{met.}
9. W up early after short night. Tremendous
thunderstorm about 4 a.m. Let up. Break. at 8,
off at 9, fine send off by family. Train 10
to Formia, rain there. Gotham met me, all
small things in car. Picked up lunch basket
at V. Monti Scavini - drove several miles to
Minturno dig. Rain over. Good lunch in
dig house, Ital. asset. then bus-hat hatkin.
Afterwards to pottery shed, lots of red, blk,
white w. blk lining, under, good shapes -

fabric, Rom. sculpt, inscriptions (esp. 2 of unusual imp.) out to dig. Theatre (not cleared in int. yet, fewer parts & temples, Cap. way, other roads. Many old foundat. big blocks under temples, puzzle to disentangle. Circ. wall, well w. Dor col. at bottom. Back to room w. arches (late mostly) // chiefly in V. Giulia, some fine big corners & white tiles & connect. seen. (No flat + covers in one). Back for train at 3. Bright sun, lovely ride to Naples. At Merq. Gov. met me soon after 5. Fine welcome hotel Multoni, porter, red port. Had 50 on front. Fine bath & rest. Wm. the garden under alterations, so up early after good dinner. Head miles away. Fell asleep over book, 20 to bed. Red Maid in waiting.

10. Rain in night but cleared fine. Coffee at 8 & walk M at same time. Off about 9 to "Salernina". (No need to

go to office). L on upper deck, quickly on board. Room 144 fine double w. bath - verandah, lots of room. Went ashore - to St a moment for address to tris shell place. Got ^{50c} comb, brush, clothes brush, mirror for Orij wedding present, - L got new cig case. Back soon after 11, sailed 11.30. Pris + Scamp & Miss Edwards on board. Removets & grasp on deck. Lunch Purser (Empaldi's) table, L, P. J. Every thing most excellent & comfortable. Lovely views Sorrento pen. Unpacked a letter, but chiefly L & tied up bundles of her books till tea time. Cinema afterwards, rubbishy King of Corsairs: (band on L Wallace. Cocktails in lounge, nice dinner, turned in early to read. Fine comfortable bed.

11. Fine. No hurry about getting up, L got things packed. Up on deck about 11. Lunch 12, Paltas about 1.30. Capt. Cos. not on this (on "Rule"). Usual melie

about landing, too much Murphy - Stevens.
On tender with II, first - ashore last to
finish customs, but had seats. Child
sent - old Stavro who helped but we got
Sames - did well, no duty on things -
few opened. Barrel & case go to Pir.
as customs closed at 5, we just got
through. Majestic no 5, out for coffee & a
few macarons etc. Went with about
train. Dinner about 7.30. Bed early.
12. Congenial day, perfect, after shower in
night. Up before 6, early tea, left 6²⁰ good
comp. on train, luggage all O.K. Off
7.05 most beautiful trip imaginable
Mantle's light, fields full of vines,
everything entrancing. Rest in W.
Restaur. on at Xyl. so all 4 together
- after meals L, P - I played 3 had
bridge till past Eleusis - I won
most of their cash i.e. 68 dr! Arr 4. Met
by Ash - John, quickly home. Mantle

Er, Anna, Soph. All looked beautiful &
spotless. New green in hall very fine.
Garden full of chrys. Began unpacking
before tea, after which went into garden,
night getting dark. Sent Ash with tele-
grams M - Ma, - for Obs. Unpacking till 7
Then did mail & after words re papers
etc. That was all. Ash, JHS etc.

13. Fine. Good sleep, up about 7.15. Long talk
w. John during breakfast. Unpacked trunk
10.30 to Vasili Hill about 12, Ambyx to see
state of finances & ask abt. hotel, back 12.30.
More putting in order Hill 3, to Keph. to
Mrs K to thank for lovely chrys. To Da-
vid to leave seeds etc. In recording form
cold but would have kept as receipt for
other imminent - visitors. Left Mr Hon-
land's package at Adresides. Back to
tea. Went to concert - Belgian Quartet
w. Piano, Max G. Min, Fauri C. Min, Brahms
no 1. Op 25, splendid artists, lovely concert.

Back about 9 for dinner - tried a little
Torg. after, but got sleepy.

14. Fine - up in good time. Busy clearing
out desk & papers. Unpacked parcels of
books, stationery etc. Out at 11 to Amby
for money for bills, then Phil. write
old hats. Will remake blue & make
a blk. w. aquites, also several for L.
To bring with present, looks fine.
After lunch cleared several shelves
in C's bookcase & shifted some
from hall ∴ put new ones there. Most
but not arranged. Out 4 to Regrep.
& found all at home + 7 cats includ-
ing new white one. Tea there & much
talk. Back about 5, wireless man
came & Ath got new battery after
wards. Out 6 to see DK, also Mrs
Ghini, Maria, Kalop cousin, & L w X -
Mr Mrs Babbitt, known Uncle Jim.
Back soon after 7. Did a little

Torg. in eve but rather sleepy. Not
much luck w. wireless, much in progress.

15. Fine - up in good time. Wrote M Hill
time for concert. First Sym = Bart. Bide,
Double Concerto (Lykoudes & Netzel), Tam.
Paris Version, Saloni Flor. Schmitt (new)
In intermission to Eucl. box, all there
but T. Much talk, also saw Razous.
Sat there for rest of concert. After
lunch wrote B. Call from John & Timo
in garden. Read Times, to tea at Legation,
just ourselves. The Skinners crew had a
splendid long talk. Just back when
the Thompsons called. Mr Porter here for
dinner.

16. Fine, gorgeous weather all the time.
Wrote H, JLN Jr. Ath to Picasso for
barnet & box, so walked to Oujas about
11.30 - tried on new dresses L brought.
Washed gloves after lunch, read papers -
Out to Amby (re Hooker) PO, then cards

A while - tea with Mans/Homer - a very long talk about college affairs. Gilroy here for short time. Stopped to find Ralph but he was out. Resumed Trq. but progressed very little. Back Mass from Vienna, not as good as at Gloucester.

17. Fine. Devoted a good part of a.m. to putting up curtains, 10 pairs in all. Transferred library ones to bed room. Started to change ^{impacted glass.} while eat but found one screw bent in trussis. Off early after lunch - took seat to Simpson at Helleniko, then golf. Did two rounds, fair to middling. Hiders marring above bunkers. Lonly out. Back about 5.30 after second run to Helleniko. Wrote some notes re dinner Thurs. Late tea. Papers after. Had long try at Trq. but very slow at it.

18 Fine. Wrote M-L bought material for maids' dresses while I finished. Put up trussoms in library - behind piano. To buy to buy 2 dresses. L did other trussoms. Returned via Amby - PO. Golf p.m. Started about 2, but lots of people so began at 4. Went around twice but - did pretty badly on the whole. Back late for tea, fortunately H Hooker did not come. Dressed after. Some good music from Buda before dinner. Vien call in eve. Read Themes controversy in ATA, also some reviews in JWS.

19. Slightly cloudy, cleared fine. Letters, later to Philippe until lunch time. After lunch read Of & some journals. H Negep. came while we were at tea. Later all to Miller's (Kraupor also here). Mrs M still very crippled with neuritis after shingles. Had look at new women Book Club on lower floor. Dinner here, 2 Davis, Ralph,

2 Darbishires, 2 Thompson, Priscilla,
14 Hill, Mr Potter.

20. Fine, colder, very windy. Went a.m. to
golf, balls blown all around so woods
were none too fine, 57+51. Gorgeous day
except for violent wind. Back in time
for lunch. Started papers when Miss
Stone called. Good talk till she went
w. L who was off for errands. Quick
change, L back 4.15 - out to tea with
Mary. Childrens party, Mrs Teary, Jane,
Mrs Balfour, 2 Dicks, Mrs Novell, Lavinia,
Trilce, Tina, 3 Dick. children - juvenes.
Great success. Later Homer & Corrie
came in. Escorted Lavinia home in
state. Back about 7 - worked on
Tory - finally got - it, very amusing.
Finished Keftin article in JHS.

21. Fine but much colder. Did books etc.
- L went out for errands. Arranged a
lot of envelopes for calls, until 6 cards

gave out. Cleared out old papers, went over
JHS, JHS etc before tea. Afterwards did a
wonderful round of calls till 7.45. To
GTS for dinner with Mr Potter, new party
very nice, stayed long time.

22. Fine - ^{very} up in good time to write M.
Lovely Pop concert, Beeth Vienna Dances,
Handel Viola Concerto (Foidart), Sym Var (Maer)
Stal Sym. A few papers after lunch -
at 2.30 Mr Potter came & we went to Sam
& later to Taber - back to tea. Greyish
& chilly out. Got end of Augusteum con-
cert incl Bach. Adagio - All, 2 Sym. Eve very
fine - read Pontifex Lon & Thorndyke -
Bad inference but got Brahms Quint.
from Rome.

23. Greyish, windy. Finished J's letter. Got
out MS & poked around a little, many
interruptions - ^{Call Geo Kachor} not much progress.
L out for errands. After lunch did acct.
Out 3.30 or so to Psych, M out but saw

Homer & Marion. Thanksgiving. To
Phil. To Am Cos ^{4.30} book club committee,
Bostum, Gould & Hill. Chase new com.
Late tea, sorted cards, - left them till
about 7.45. Streets in terrible state.
Guda concert Bartok suite, Gemin, Br.
B flat concerto (Rubinstein) fine.
Real Times - did some puzzles.

24. Fine, still, sunny, cool, cloudy later & chilly
puts on caloufer in afternoon. Wrote
B. Hooper. Did some addit: & revisions
to MS with Evans all of and on during
day. Call from Mrs Kulligas before tea.
To tea Poffy Taylor, Amer. party incl,
2 Keay, Curren, Blattenburg, Fisher, Gausman,
Pis, Wright & al. Plays contrast with
L, Mrs Leonardo & Mr Keay, till 7.30. Got
mess' cards from Denaxa & in eve got
rest of envelopes ready to lean. Begun
Am Beauty (4th ed).

25. Light rain. Wrote M. Got some work

in on Tues. L out about 12 for errands.
More in in pm till 3.30, quick change
early tea & to Pir. to meet "Excelsior" at 5.
Great climb up & down ladder. All glad
to see us, 3 nice cabins, Miss M, Mrs Scan-
drett, Mrs Jencks. Brought them all along
after quick packing. Here about 6, got
them settled, made cocktails, much talk.
7.30 Auto car for them & they dined
Dances & went to Aer. as it cleared
somewhat. L & I dined Melas-Schlie-
mann & had lovely time. Alex & his Amer
wife, Mans, Tyrone. Back 11.30, writes c 12
& more grips.

26. Unsettled, sun in & out, no rain. Socia-
ble breakfast, then sent them Am box,
photos etc - later took them Skyes
house & there I took Mrs Jarovns
Mrs. Warm welcome here, saw Bill &
Karo. Writes next Perilla's. Back for
lunch but left about 3 & took them

around via Stad, Zeus, Aer, Ther - to Daph-
ne - then to Piraeus. Luggage & screens
by Dion. car. Saw everyone - everything
on board. Left some cards in Phal. late
cup of tea, brief "pause" w. papers - work.
Nice Th. dinner with M, H - R - a
good old gossip afterwards.

27. Fine. Spent most a.m. on Knorr, doing
E basket, hall, etc. Using chiefly PM III &
typed some new parts. Out late a.m.
for a few errands. Times after lunch -
more PM while I wrote Uncle Bacon - the
Crew. Fine out so started 3.45 with cards
- back c 5.30. Nearly all rec. Poy - kept.
Quick tea. Concert hall with Lehmann, Finy,
& Scheibel, Fraienleiber, 2 Frag, 2 Mend, 3 Str
& several encores - Splendid artist, big
house. Saw lots of people. Eve had

28. Greyish. Typed a little on PM, while

After lunch rec'd H - Times, wrote H, pared

4. Grey again, drizzle. Cleared later. Spent am mostly on Tins, E side. Also general look over. Paper & some more in pm. Call from Mrs Curran. Out to Blackless ^{Snow on mts.} for tea, back about 6.30. Letters from T to EDWS. Got out all the

Stevenson's we could collect and played
with Tony in eve. Chopin from Bunker.

5. Fine, sunny quiet. More Kus. very slow
going, ^{10.30-12.30} a.m. L managed to salvage some
chrys. from garden. Lunch 1.30 Androm,
now daughter, vice Mumb who was ill,
Payne, Karo, Ralph, Gade. Most successful
party. Broke up by 3.30. Lovely day so
ran down to past Voula before tea.

Road badly broken up after Telyphada.
Simple tea here. Out c6 to Dixie's, good
long stay, much talk Skender, Cumb,
Ghini, Dangle's, Aristea, Maccas, Mitav.
et al. Back about 8. Eve read part

Enormous amount of material, would take heaven knows how long to do all.

Back for dinner & eve before fire.

10. Fine. Poked around for a while - then all off for a drive across country to Leonardavouno where there was part of a castle w. some ancient blocks & cisterns & fine view around the country. Clouds here & there. Returned to visit & over to village with little narrow road & many trees - up to Taphalovisi then on other side town to see where med. site was. Back late for lunch then over to Museum for an hour or more. Saw Dikairo's latest finds & then around in general, escorted by Gw'ne phylakos. Turned down lot of pottery of all periods, also sculptures. Saw interesting ones from St Irene. Over to house before 4 & worked some & played at

matching frags. before after tea. Eve sat by fire esp. talking to Jim Bank. Not as cold as previous night.

11. Heavy clouds, showers, "bright int." Late in reaching house on acct. rain, but worked till about 11.45. To PO, then Jim Bank with L's letter credit, then lots of errands & back about 12.45. Return to work soon after lunch, doing 403 especially. Cable from Eleanor Lidu did. - Blew up. Stayed at home till after 7. Got a lot done. Eve wrote it in front of fire.

12. Fine. Spent a.m. busily on pottery, intermission at 11 for coffee. Got the fire much improved by zinc sheet, hardly any smoke. After lunch got 2 tablecloths from woman at door, beauties. At it hard from 3-7.30 except for tea. Got 250 in inventory & tons of studs. Eve was to write M

but Miss Stees had her brother here
so did not get started till nearly
11, but then wrote.

13. Fine. Packed, out on verandah till time to
start for Kapikhus. Off before 11, nice drive
over. Plain itself dull, funny small mounds
like slag, then through fine mt. pass. Excellent
lent road, narrow but tarred. A side of
mts. very fine, blue sea, snow mts in Cilicia
opposite. Tyrenia, castle, nice little town.
Seaside Hotel, excellent, very comfortable &
clean, good food. Room on sea. Large salon
below w. open fire. Good lunch & off to Kap.
Sun goes early there, most picturesque at
Kackin village on side mt. Fertile, much
greener on r. side. Good house, well built -
picturesque. To peak. excav. where tombs
are cut through rock, which has many
green cuttings in it. Tombs = usual
dromos, or squarish vestibule w. tomb on
short side. Often several chambers off

dromos, cupboards. Door small, often like a
cave hole, tombs very low, not much over 1 m.
Sometimes run into each other. Extraordinary
they hold so much. Next to geom. (nearest, but
by sea). Entrances much like BA dromoi, but
often tomb looks like big fireplace, low &
broad niche or entrance. In BA occas. frame

to other house to call on mother & several daughters, charming people, hot glyko. Then up to other geom. cem. near bay's sch. on one of the rock terraces. Toilet & girls' sch. on a higher one, reminds you of Sorrento. Some good tombs there. Had gorgeous view from high up. Lamboussa off to n. of geom. cem. near sea. Down to Pub. again, off about 4.20 got things at hotel & drove back to N. Here by 6 or went for meter sticks, then hotel. Seemed very cold, but good fires. Sat by one in eve, talked to St. Geo, Mrs. Reed, read her sketch & finished french book.

15. Fine, clouds at times, began badly but cleared. To house about 9. Geo litened up & we went to town to Hadjikyriakon & ordered grill for fire place, then to market - got dress material, bags, dish tombs. Home before 10, tried improvements in fire, good olive wood - Much war-

mer - better though still somewhat smoky, worked all day on pots - frag from 406. Did inventory nice etc. At it all day except intervals for lunch & tea. 13 & back for dinner. A good fire in eve.

16 Fine, milder, good sun. Worked hard all day, 406, 409, lots of things. At it steadily only stopping for lunch & tea. Call from Dikairo. Dance at hotel, so had fire in bedroom. Wrote M.

17. Fine. Off in good time for trip to Yoni. DC stayed home. Across through bare & dry country w. a few villages, past Perist. on part - Stou. hill. Stopped at for oranges. On by twisting road part Soli to nearest point for V. Pull up under tree. Took lunch & climbed to top. Very impressive, wonderful position & view across Morpho Bay & to Cil. more snow mts. Hills & hills piled together towards Troodos. 2 principal areas on top of palace w. great peristyle 4x3

court or sunken area & deep well, & large
fiddle-shaped idol & head at center & curv.

22. Poured and blew like mad in the night. Vile day, managed to get to & from 1 Diag. in carrossas. Put in hard day at pots. Rain stopped at intervals. Put up B's crustacians. Rain let up & we

walked back to hotel. Moon came out in eve. Wrote long letter to Marjorie. Huge pile of mail came pm, many Xmas cards all forwarded from Athens. Talked to Miss S & G after others had left.

23. Wet again though less violent. Let up & walked to Etelle & sent NLT to mother - wire to Ath. to tell them we should not be back. PO for stamps, began to rain so took carross. back to 1 Diag. & journal L & D on pots. All day at it. B came back from L. Bridge in eve L & D w. B & D.

24. Fine. Decided before it cleared that we'd work all day & got on with things. Any. way Geo hurt hand cranking car and was at Larnaca, sent wire. Plugged along at it steadily. Eve tried to read but too much conversation until late.

25. Unsettled, B & D could not tell about weather for L - anyway G did not come early & then car mistook and so they did

not get away until about 12, but mean-
while we had done more inventory. Had
back early and got all done by about 7.
Finished prehist = 438 total 905 pots in
inventory, innumerable no. not accen.
+ some thrown out. Celebrated mildly with
a remonete + a gift to Christo. Eve sat by
fire, finished Police at Funeral, excellent
26. Brilliant morning. Took a day off for a
trip. Did a little mending, L put on coat
button etc. while I read Jeffrey on Bella P.
Around to 1 Diaz. for coats, sent Christo for
car. Comfortable saloon. Fine dinner lots
of snow on Troodos. To K + then off + up
to BP which has a small village near
abbey. Splendid ruins esp. magnif,
banquet hall refectory + 2 rooms un-
dercroft, cloisters, common room + chop.
house both roofless, church, small +
much altered for orth. Hamb. Gothic,
fine doorway, wheel-campante, abbots

quarters on W side all gone. Views + site
magnificent. To K + left coats at sea side
+ went around sea to look at castro, fine
round tower to W + smaller to E along
sea wall, fine surf, splendid view towards
Karpas. Low clouds covered Cilicia, did
not see it at all. Clouded over during
lunch, which we enjoyed. Off even after
2 for Lap. + to house where B + D were just
finishing lunch. Saw paraf. skel. in
aperture. Did not stay long but collected
3C + took her off. O + Geo to stay another
day. Went to Lampoussa + saw 2 ches.
ches, one still has part of monastic
buildings left, other small one alone.
Very mixed site of ruins, Roman tomb of
cube of rock like Glauki. Left K about
4.45 + back for good tea before fine fire. Very
ready to take it easy, read who is next
till dinner time + more in eve, but in-
ter. by much gossip around.

27. Unsettled. Spent am. having Miss Tre-
fussis do portrait. DC as amuseur. Very
cold but cheered ourselves in middle
of morning. PM to 1 Diag. very dull &
threatening. DC dictated summaries
of separate tombs. At 7. L
checked up members. Eve by fire & wrote
M & H despite much chatter around.

28. Grey, windy, chill. Short sitting to Miss T
to finish, then L & I took portrait to be
photographed & back to 1 Diag. Made cof-
fee & then DC dictated more summaries.
Rest of day devoted to typing what we
had. Stopped with 4:30 at about 7.30.
Eve read Disapp. House, but wind blew
all around the floor & it was very cold.

29. Fine, cold. Good sun & we worked all
day on veranda finishing typing & DC
compressed more sections. Before lunch
had call from Fr Co & Ck & Co. for a look
around. Got all but 1 of typist before tea

so come back early and warmed up by
fire. Same in eve. Finished books, not
much good.

30 Fine, cold. DC in bed. L & I had walk in town
to St Sophia where we stood in the sun & read
Jeff. Splendid Gothic cathedral w. fine porch
& doors at W end, converted into a mosque.
Back around by Vic St Peter Bazar, Paph. Gate
& gardens where we sat. Then to Hospital to
call on Gunnis & then to Mrs. where Di. C.
showed us the gold earrings etc. from Lof.
Also talking about his dig for which he was
writing report. Sideris from Kypr. came in so
we left & came back to lunch. PM. went
to 1 Diag. on veranda, looked over rest
of mail, boxes cards etc. Long walk, outside
wall, thro' moat & on top to Paf. Famaq. Gate.
Splendid views from top, mts, gardens, old
houses etc. Reminded me of old times in
Candia. Back thro' old parts, got off line
& under at Paph. Gate. Back outside to

usual entrance, got cat & fetch photo, groceries etc. Left packages at Diag, got some books. Geo for tea & quiet ev. as usual went to dance.

21. Fine. B litened up before breakfast. Syndicate on strand all day - got 15-38 text passed. Gave some to Loisides to copy (no that was Sat p.m.). Worked all day good - hard - really accomp. a lot. Real not friendly drop in ev.

Feb 1. ev fine, sun in & out. Has to work in doors. Got little done though we were hours at it, typing etc. B in snail mood but finally finished 1-4. Ev began Sweepstakes Murders but floor cold, so early in.

2. Fine. Had off for the day, left 10.45 after a few preliminaries. Went via Chytra to coast & stopped at Salamis. Site mostly overgrown with small forest, all sand. Saw STBs to right in fields, fine view of bay & Kaspass. Went first to forum of

which a lot of colonnade remains - larger reddish cols. on front, smaller grey to other parts. Big supp. wall near it. I took photo. Have new quad house above it. To bazaar, very ruinous, masonry extremely poor, many small stones in cracks. To large forum, ^{Cikm ch. at end.} very big c. 26 cols long covers huge area. To Constantia nr. early church, bar, 3 narrow-^{er} ones, some pavement. Plat. Aqueducts. Then to Fam. of St. had a fine distant view nr. cath. & other churches showing above the walls. Past outside to new town. Lunch Savoy nice clean hotel, fine view from upper rooms. New part full of better gardens. Saw Bryan off to play hockey. To old town, fascinating place. Cath St. Mich. now a mosque all white-washed over inferior. Fine facade, remains of gables over doors etc, 2 truncated towers. (See photo) Good loggia at SW corner. Fine Gothic begun c. 1500. Went around it & to another ruined

church nearby w. Byz. earlier next it & some frescoes. To palace (now prison) which has part of Ionic gateway w. anc. cols. Fine courtyard & int. remains. Then to sea gate, harbor w. lots of boats & to both towers (Ven. lions all around) & up on top for splendid view - Magnif. fortification. Then town to castle at other side, up on top & down to lower regions also. Two golf courses! Tremendous piece of work most impressive. Many churches in this quarter, must return to do study. On to Larnaca to Lloyd re sailing, Geo went to get cake & met the Pierides who took us to see his collection, most varied & interesting. Back late c. 6.30 & had hotel tea. Finished Snaps take evn after much chatter.

3. Unsettled, sun in & out. A hectic day getting report done. Prodder & presher all day long. Little progress a. m., but

did intro after words - had a terrific time but finally got copy types by about 8.45 to give Lozides. Not back till 9 for dinner but such a day! Wrote M in eve, very sleepy. 4. Windy but sunny. Report, letter & photos printed by B. before 8 for mail. L & I did a little mending etc & out c. 10 to Armench. but could not see it all on acct. of mem. service, cloisters, house in back w. more cols & old wood carving. Did a few engravs, met DE, all went to Phan (Chouville mod.) small Byz near, & Tripitotis. Back to house, read some Nypes, proof read lists w. L. Dikaios here for lunch. Had gone over some geom before with DE. Took it easy in hotel (electricians & Geo!) till Mrs O'Hara & P Taylor came to ka. nice time. Col. away on trip w. guests. Did photos till after 6 then to call on machides. Back at 7, read Eulaw till dinner. Jiff. in eve.

5. Fine, breezy. Started on geom. pots and kept at it hard all day until 4 when we changed & went to tea at the Sideris. He is chief cit. of Kypr, she handsome & charming, dau. was at Miss Trill's. Dik came in during tea. Brought him back as far as hotel. Changed shoes - back to work 6 - nearly 8. Got a lot done. Eve around fire, then packed.

6. Fine, then cloudy - Sent 2 Revs by bus to Limassol. At home for a.m. work till after 11, then to Mrs. Dik's gave us 2 pbk. 1/2 op. bowls. Saw coin coll. Gunther now deposited in Museum. Said good bye to Miss du P.T. in courtyard. Early lunch, farewell to all, off c 1.30 by Kouni road & around coast to Paphos. Terrible rain even before we reached Kouni, frightfully skidding mud - deluge - cloud of very cold, blowing hard. Stopped for tea

road near coast good part of way, Fine bay with Pali, west of Rom. Paphos after dark, c 6.30, 102 miles. Hotel Olympus, very comfortable, fire in saloni. Good sized house nicely done over. After dinner read paper (Times 228) in saloni, some Jeff, talked to Gk (Donides) in Land off who offered to get us maps.

7. Very cold, some snow. Geo had great difficulty starting car. Went to N Paphos, stopping at church underground in part of Rom. tomb. Frescos in apse much encrusted, but - could chip it off, colors excellent below. Must be early, very interesting place - on to harbor, got guard & went to tower, high foul wind but - climbed to top, splendid view. Fine tower Frank & Ven. probably. To St Paul's pillar & some R. cols. near by behind church.

Spied a vaulted building w. several chambers. Escorted there by man to whose cafe we went later. Back thro' Paph. & by road to Tali & along side of mt. to St Neophytos. Monastery reminded of Ras. situation at head of glen, fine view of sea, garden & orchard. Christie & garden. To see Robert, Jacobus 89 yrs old & very handsome. Laurentios, second in comm, former student of Alerisatos in Univ. All most hospitable, hot cherry & coffee. To church, somewhat vst. but int. pictures in apse, w. cheq. costumes & leaning attitudes & turned heads. Hard to tell age - to chapel of St N, cut in rock. Some very old frescoes, blue ground. To cell of N. w. desk, tomb - niche, cupboard w. dricif. skulls etc. Most int. place to visit. Escorted

to car by Prok. Back to hotel for lunch & made early start afterwards. Fearfully cold, much zigzag up & down mts. To Koukli to Aph. Kemeris, great wind. Parts of huge orthos. of circuit-wall, can't identify temple, 2 buildings w. road between. Exc. by Brits in '80s (I think). To old castle of which not much is left but fine entrance, court & part of fine hall, well vaulted. On up again, pass Pissouri - on to Curia where we tried in vain to find Apollo precinct on hill top in scrub. Nearly frozen. But at hippodrome which can be well made out, some masonry still fine & impressive. Saw a deep - but did not try to go up, too cold & not much left. Fine site. To Collosal, fine old tower w. mach. on entrance. Very well built - & historical.

Agued., basin - another building
nearby. Two boys + small girl
(flowers) escorted us. Still very cold +
getting dark, so on to Linassal.
Hotel Continental, bags there. Late
tea in restaurant, very good. B went
to find about "Dalmatia" - found
it had left Sat 7 p.m. A great sell
as they assured us it could not
go before Monday. But it's a unique
truck, disgusted. Got a little
cleaned up in a manure tin Ger-
man basin of horrid design.
Good dinner + off pretty early
to bed. Too cold to read long.
E. wrote at 4 a earlier. Clean +
cold. Sat up in bed late + men-
did stockings. Breakfast c.g. +
B off for more enquiries about
Cot. boat + so on. Took a short
walk + got a few postcards.

Great time packing on all the lug-
gage + market + so on. Did not
get away till nearly 11. Still very cold +
got cloudy. Stopped at tomb near
Amathus, fine w. well kept. Seen
of this type, good ashlar facade +
inverted door, 2 chambers, roof like
some Etruscan, excellently built. Got
stuck out of the dump. Came right
through to it. Saw out latter part of
way, fine effects on mts. Lots of
snow on woods. It looked very pic-
turesque as we came in. Had word
Geo. so had same room + good wel-
come. Much amusement over it =
celebrated by putting in a very busy
afternoon on geom. pots again.
Are very sleepy at fire, then had a
try at an old time.
9. Fine, not so cold. Cloudy am. Then
cleared very fine. Geo said first

while we were away, actually ice.
Did not get very early start, but at
it all day - Innumerable sheds,
still in track of it at 5.20 when we
came to life & dashed back for
dinner. Well past 1300 pots - Very
quiny ones today, dried mud etc.
- hard to decipher - All very weary.
Went M about our prospects. Geo
made enquiries at Larnaka.
Took long time to write up diary
in eve - wrote it till midnight.

10. Fine - Spent all day working on
the verandah, after finishing sheds
& scraps left over - Had a long ses-

Very tired and stopped after late
tea, back in time to begin M before
dinner - Finished in eve.

dirty this time. Moved indoors in p.m. Got
somewhere about 1650 catal. Only about 5 T
left for D to finish. Photos in eve, then to bed,
left packing till a.m.

12. Fine. Up in good time, all ready before 10
for Geo. to tie on. Walked around to house &
had a few moments, then off for Larnaka via
Dali. C. 10 miles from N, by road, short climb
to top. Sweed. view of parish. town - walls
seem very poor comp. to Mye, Thyros etc. Stone
crumbles badly. Double faced circuit wall
& a tangle of house walls. Fine site w.
view very extensive. Along by a very poor
cross road to main one for L. There c 12.
To office about steamer, to Grand H. for lunch
all o. r. Then left luggage at Customs &
drove out to Kiti via tomb of Queen of Medjay
in very sacred place w. tomb of Prophet's
niece. Charming garden & sitting. Megal.
mon. over niece but could see only the

link stone being keratics. To Kiti there is fine early mosaic in apse, Panag. w Gab. r Mich. at either side. Early, remarkably fine both in composition r work. Much more freedom of pose than usual in all figs. ^{Gab.} Kept wings peaceful. Facial expression beautiful. Some old parts church also int. Back to L - went to George's house. Children at school, his wife very pretty r young. Had glyko, then on to customs r oom about permits - Dik gave us. But after many false starts on launch to "Taranto". B came with us but we bade farewell to D r Geo on pier. Small freight ship 1600 tons, cabin ff saloon. Terribly small but cabin clean. Capt. fat r jolly, was on "Mykali" - knows various passengers we do. Lay in Lam. harbor till early a.m. After dinner up in wireless room r heard part of Faust from Bukarest, also news bulletin from Eng. r Germ. time

13. Fine, in Lemassol harbor from 7.30 till after 11. Stayed fairly late in bed. did not go ashore. Sail around Cyprus, good view of Paphos r cliff. Got very rough, far too much so for a small tub. Less said about it - he better. Out on deck etc. for attempt at dinner. Turned in early, very uncomfortable. Fine weather bright stars r moon.

14. Cloudy, shower, but clearing. About 7.30 at Adalia, roidid looking town on fine cliff, lots of waterfalls. Remains of old walls r castle. Did not go ashore, loading zoa. Took on 700 goats, very stiff. Long camel trains with gay saddle bags down zigzag to flour mill. Left c. 12.30, fine r sunny for a time. Then rather rough but not quite as bad as day before. On deck till about 7.30. Cut dinner. In companionway till 9.45. Got quiet r to bed all right r did Puzzle Books -

15. Fine, calm am. Rhodes about 7 o'clock,

excellent view of harbor, 2 round towers,
hotel etc. Large real steamer there. Bound
for where? Had good sleep, on deck c 10.30.
Lonely among islands, exc. for goats. /
Passed Nisyros with many almonds
in bloom, Cor etc. Cold in p.m. so sat
in companion way. Finished Orphan Id.
& did some from Times Puz. Bk. Cut din-
ner & turned in early. Fairly calm.

16. Grey but not wet. Thankful to reach
Pir. about 8.30. Ath to meet us, where
soon after 9. Posted letter to B for
Loyd. Stopped at Vasilis'. Glad to get
home, everything fine. Unpacked &
sent nearly everything to cleaners &
wash. Grand tubs. Heaps of letters,
cards etc. Put in at lunch time
looks fine. General clearing out -
looking over & tidying up. Vasilis at 6.
L Talcott there & we talked Cypr.
Eve nice gram. records, Huberman,

Salome, Klein Nachtm, last movement
of Sonata - Real Punch etc. Turned in early.
17. Fine, unsettled later, rain after 4. Many
odd & ends - notes to write before able to
start M's letter. Finished about 12 when
