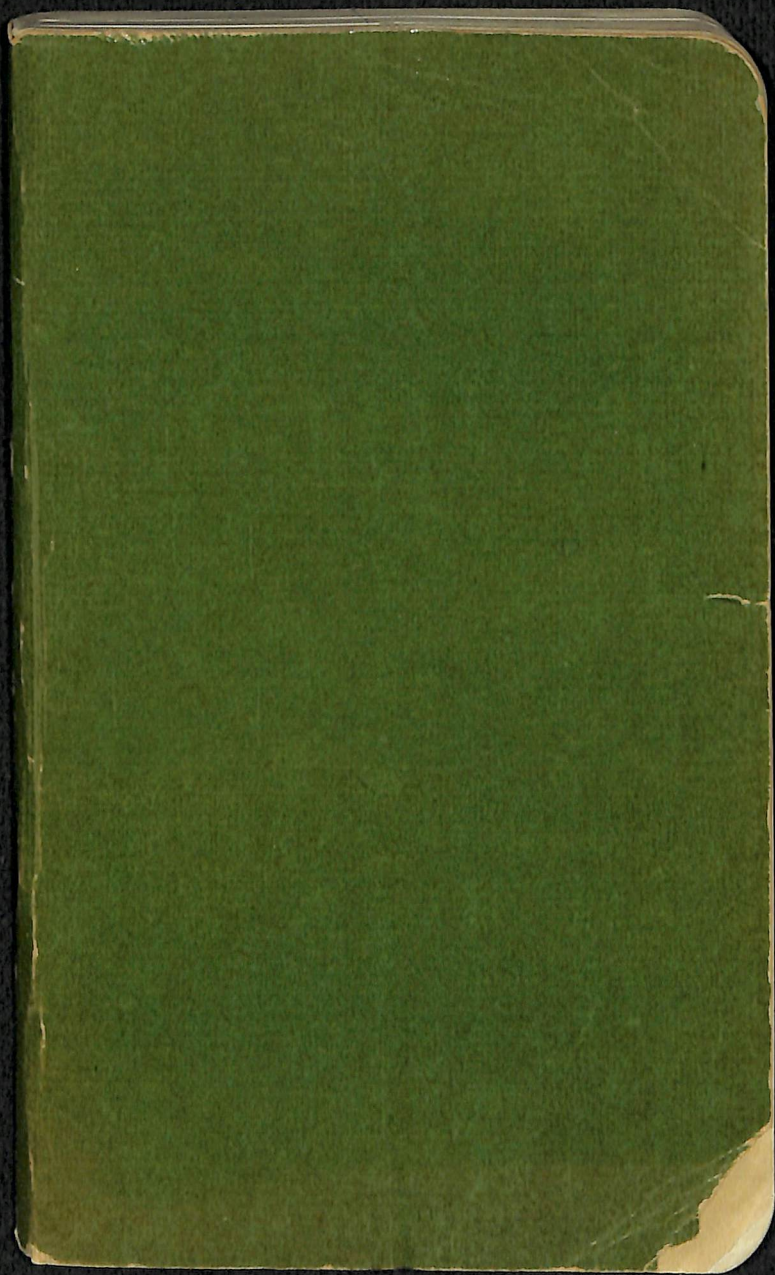


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September 4, 1933 - April 7, 1934.

Sept 4. Fine. Off 9.30 took M. to errands, Miss B. & did other errands in interval. Back 5 P.M. About 11 T. & J. H. to Leicester very quickly, fitting ok, good drive, back by 12.45. Wrote Eleanor G. before lunch. Papers etc. till about 3, Mrs E. on gram. Wrote Helen M. (Star map), H, L till about 4.45. To pillar box. T. busy tract. After tea 6.7 played 3 with M. Supper 7 P. to a meeting, Wagner Prog, Kaiser M, Loh II-III cho - duet, Walkalla, Trist Duet, (Austral - Widdup) Tann. Ov. Did Tel - poked with Theat Whist. V.

5. Fine. Wrote Mrs Keays in bed. Garden till 9.30 went with T. to R. for many errands - got back about 11. Wrote G.M.H., C.B. before lunch. Bridge at Wauffs also Mrs Powell, Greg, Rawlinson, very good time, lost 6 in all. Back for supper at 7, Dickens meeting at Geo at 8. Very pleasant. Back for news, Tel, upstairs early. 6. Fine. Woke early, up 6. T. & J. H. for Newford. Left 7.50 - made fine time, Worcester in about 1 1/2 hrs. Took road via Ledbury, over Mal-

horns, upper road through town & pass. Rather
lazy. After that had winding slow but
pretty roads to Hampford. Foolishly went 100
far over bridge but later parked in College
St. all well on. Plenty of time, entered Mrs
S door of delightful little ^{2.9.10} garden. Transcript seats 27 could not see
anything but heard beautifully. Silk, Des-
mond, Flegg, Cranmer, splendid. In inter-
val Mrs amusing little skit, gay play.
remount at Milton, lunch in car. All
comfortable. Rest of Mass, Cantata Tunder
(Silk) Brahms III. Gorgeous time - Arry before
4, but went slowly, back Mrs' home road
to Malvern & hence same route. 10 min 7.

7. Fine, some clouds up early to pack.
Cooler. T took me to station. Son at em-

for tickets, back early, Mary cleaning. wrote
L.M. Early tea, pleasant week papers & do

S Thordyke, M Hunt, V Keats. Pay etc. on return.
8. Fine. Late starting, real part "Fulton Key" (B
Capes). Both out c 10. En route, shoes blue
18 1/2, dressing gown ^{20/} Sutcliffe for Florence,
Beane, walk to club. Groom - GAT to lunch
later read a few ill. papers, walk along
Tunbridge etc, to 74 to tracks for tea. Also 2
Nuff (rather deadly) Miss ^{Wynne Thomas} ~~Thompson~~ (?)
B&B Rome. Left at 6, back to change. Children
met us D Fr. for dinner. All to "Dinner at
Eight" Palace, all star film, excellent.
Did Times on return.
9. Fine. Finished St in bed. Out to Seep. -
Bank, Rem K + J to Sad. Wells for properties.

Back to pack & play till lunch at Berta-
elli's. Then left bag, Euston & went early
to tea at Arthur (Kirsti's), 9, Finchley. Lovely
big studio, 2 pianos, nice pictures, furni-
ture etc. Tea with orange cake. A played
Vogel als P, Br Romance & several Barts.
Taxi behind R Park for 5²². T met me.
Eve mic. cone. incl Bolero, papers etc.

10. Fine, very windy. Good early start, all
very bad, could not collect to add, but we
had good time. Back 12:30, lunch, prompt
lunch. Post-Reg Paul, Bant etc. recital.
Cleared out old papers, read ^{Spanish music} etc. Settled
about 3 to Tony. - got it by tea. 6-745 Cth
with M. Eve Quartets Brahms, F. Bridge.
Read ST & mic papers.

11. Fine. M, T, J to town for lunch with
Jan. Stopper Eust. to post 2 boxes exp
to L for birthday, got train seats. To
Hell Soc. Met-Allen W-T/Wachs, Koma)

saw 2 new fascicles Beasley, Payne. To Seaf.
errand for M, walk to J. May & Alice here
& spent day gossiping & having fine old
time of reminiscences. J wonderful. Early
tea, back on 5²⁴. Left car by station. Home 7.
Hague concert, heard part of it. Meist (H. Skerun)
Wotan + Brun (F. Easton) Wackine, fine,
also Ride. Wrote 2 during music, in bed
in Tony, Tel etc.

12. Showery. To R. with T early. Got hide's
picture & post to Eleanor, also to Mrs Ken-
ner, M's book to Lena, other PO errands - off
soon after 10 to Leam. with M to Bobby
for fitting. Briefed S for Trist. Home 12.45.
Wrote Renner, K, 11 trace before lunch. Wet
afternoon & Kate insisted on a fire. Had a
regular copy of letters, sent Tony & Tel, mail
Gtm, L, H, Effie in time for Mrs B to take. 3H
with M till early dinner at 7. Trist went to
Dickens com. Haydn Surprise, 2 Flute Trio

Hedale Wash, Moz. viol conc. 5 in 4 (Alma Woodie)
Amors Pfeil, Hayden, Kati Winter, Jap. Sym. - After
news had Brahms Serenade in D for Orch.
Papers, Tel etc.

13. Grey, cleared off sunny before noon. Tr &
off 9.30 to R. Did errands while she had
hair done. Left c 10.30 for Leicester about
her golf shoes. Home about 12.15, nice drive.
Odd & ends till lunch, clearing up, gloves etc,
began letter B, finished p.m. - After lunch
in garden till about 3, cleaned up & wrote.
Finished B, sent M Avery article about pigments.
After tea, played with M. Bach concert, I went to
meet Annie, wrong train so not in till 9.30.
O'Aranyi in concerto, Fackire & Ar. in Double Conc.
Prometh. Ballet music after news.

14. Fine, fresh & clear. R went with Beethoven
to play golf match. Did errands in Rugby.
a letter garden. Wrote L, finished after
lunch. Papers. Played with M 4- tea & some

later after we had danced for dinner party.
Bob Croft, Bob Mason, nice boys, very successful
party, broke up late.

15. Fine. Did some necessary mending, top of golf
skirt. Errands after 10. Car very cold to start.
Left about 11 to take A to Shippenade - via
Watling St. to Dunstable - then up on top of
downs. Lovely place. Good parking, table place
beautifully laid out. Sat on hillside with
fine view & ate lunch. Then to tigers, lions, & all
around emus, rheas, llamas, deer, etc, rode on
elephant saw tigers & lions fed. Back via
bears. Left before 5 by circuitous route. Down
steep hill & took road via L. Bourz. & thence to
Buckingham. Late & good tea White Hart,
then Brackley, cut across & finally Warrington
to Bayfield war. Like a bird all day
till c. 2 m from Dunchurch began to thump.
Walked back to Willoughby inn, tel. Raymond
quickly here. Later he tel. Hilton from Dun-

church. My toward Hillman in. Gt or big
end? lucky to be so near home. Arr. in
time for news & dry dinner, & paper after-
16. Fine. Large mail. T went to R. with R to
do errands. Read letters & saw M's to her.
Spent a long time mending petticoat. Took M
to churchyard on foot. Car at Hilton's, to get
overhauling. Back c. 12 for more mending etc.
Paper before & after lunch. Stocking man came.
Played with M before tea, R took M-A to
Scala. Misc Prom, incl. Light Sp Fant, Movss.

17. Cloudy, cleared later. Finished AWA in
bed. T stayed home (blister) - A went to

Slow round but good. R excellent. I 52+47

Cantatas resumed. Lots of misc. music with

18. Fine, grey & clear/bright. Day mostly in odds
& ends, long letters to L & WTT took good
part a.m. Then garden. Wrote F Stone & M Da-
vis after lunch. Gram. Vallin (Italian Paris on,
Air) PGranger Debussy - Sh. Hay; Sontata
B Min Bach, A Moz (P Radmall & P Guemmit)
Finished Torg. & sent it - r Tel. Played with M bet.
tea & supper. Wagner Prom. ^{St. Catharine} Braugame, Sreg Idyll,

19. Fine, some clouds. Spent most of time looking

21. Fine, then cloudy, damp. T off to London. Order
of stockings came. ^{3 x 5/11} Tel. from Genio, will come
Sunday. Read Times, wrote enormous letter
to L. Played Bach a little. Tel after lunch,
then more Winters. Abbey Service, misc. cons.
Played Honey-moon B. with M 6-7.20.
Began H Nicolson, "People & Things." Took
concert. Catterall in Vire Cone, VI Sym.
Took back at 9. Pleasant fire. Punch & Vogue

22. Greyish, cloud. Garden, an. flowers. Went to
R 11.30 with T for errands before meeting Jess, May
& Alice at 7.19. Splendid day together, much
gossip. In M's room till lunch. Mrs Bott here to
help. Son's grouse. Jc after lunch, music, T
sang & M played. Early tea. Saw them of 5th
Quick note to Genio re Sun. train. Took Mrs B
& H to Bury. Bath = Leon III, II Concerto H Samuel,
Stiles Allen "Bright Seraph," VII Sym. Reading
H Nicolson.

23. Greyish. Cut red dahlias, also marig. etc. for T

Sound an Alarm, Strauss Don J. Read Ch. II aloud.

24. Wet. Breakfasted in bed. Read some Rodd,
then Obs. Off 12.15, tied up with string, to meet
Signorinis at 12.40. Put in order at Hilltop.
Train very late - then came 2d section c. 1.30.
Talked to Mrs & Walker while waiting, also 2
Ridge. Pouring when we got home. Had a
fine day with them, all fit - best spirits.
Cleaned off, took E around garden. Tea at 5,
took them to 6.50 train. T & V played with

26. Misty, clearing. Went 9.30 with T & Hugh &
did errands. Wrote B before lunch, also to re

more Beeson.
27. Misty, some rain - Daddy's birthday. Left c. 10
for Leam. Bobby's Dress Parade very amusing.
Back 1.15. Wrote office after lunch. E lunch in 3
Debussy - Brown. = Irons Carnival, Bach Suite
E Kersey in Moz. Conc in A, Stanford Irish Sym.
Then 14 till after 7. Bach = Suite for Flute et
2 Concertos (H Samuel) 2 in E, 4 in A, Jo Vincent
S Robinson arias from Cantatas, Brand. 10 1.
Finished Beeson. Read Elc A - Punch in pm.
28. Grey, very windy. Cleared up some letters
etc. Cut out papers, got royal fam, Tral. etc. Tr
off 10.45 for Oxford, Law Meeting. Wrote L,

Selfridge, Cullis, Winnie C, BTCL cheque etc) 11
 Quick lunch, 1/2 after it. Can call to Hynes
 to put in R. Misc. music, Hynes at 3.
 Scottish Orch 4.05. Poked around in T's

 till about 7. E-R back about 7.30. Prom
 Moz. "Little G-Min", Suddaly Creation, Over
 Pennel, P. Shore. Moz Conc, Adin 2. M. flute
 arias, Clark Sym.

29. Misty. Clear. T went off c 10 for a
 few errands, then golf. She had beard
 did 11 holes = 47 + 9, ^{Got hot.} wet grass. Back by
 c 12. Put patches in dressing gown, off
 on. Bridge Ridges' p.m., also Mrs Handroft
 Snell, Meiklyohn. Gregory. Mr R there for
 tea, girls came in later. Had 3 rubbers,
 won 4d. ^{Lamond} Berth = Piano Fant ^{of 50} - Orch rcho,
 X Sym. Much better than last year.

30. Misty, unsettled. More mending. T & I to

 6.30. Played B.H. with M till after 7. Part of

Oct 1. Grey but rather nice. Wrote Remer & W
 Bowman before breakfast. Off at 9.15; did 9
 holes (10-18) 49, some good 5,5,4,5,4,5,6,7,5 - E-R
 to Duntwich so had to be home early. They
 got off about 12. Read Os before lunch & ST
 after. Lots of nice music. D'Indy on gram.
 Bach Cantata fine. Started Torg. by myself

Out before 1 to Saddle's Wells for tickets,
lunch D'Frame. back to flat. Elected -

Back before 1. Madge Wallace to lunch in
flat. Left to leave bag - met Dickens party
at Euston 2.26. About 5. Tube to Hampstead -
To I marked over Heath to Ken hood, bus to
Jack Shan's for high tea. Merry throng - Bus
to Palace Hotel, arr. early. To I remount in
Lounge. Screaming party. Alfred Noyes, new
pres. Good short speech. Rare show, table,

dancing, general cabaret, little Dickson
except Carlton & Peggy by Mrs Eliot. Rest
of show was like. Finished about 11. Set
walker to Euston, got bus, bag, train 11.55.

table. Won 7/2 + 6/2. Nice party. All left soon
after 6. Foundat: Sch. Sonata c Min. (path.) John
Hunt. Sir W. later. Caught up on papers. Keith:
Conc. of House, Rondine EP for wind, Adelaide
(Pam Jones) in Cone (H Parkin) v. Sym. Used
music. Read Punch, did 2 Tel.

7. Wet. Let up by about 10. Cut red dabbias,
ff with T & Ethel at 10.45. Did errands on
foot while car at T's house having oil & battery
changed & T at Bennett, Churchyard on

return, back 12.30, washed gloves. Papers
till lunch, late. Sitwell to T until 4, then
3H till tea & then till 6, finished 'Winkles'
7.10, dress, dinner Marc, also Gordon.
Bagatelle in eve - many years. M at
cinema with Mrs. Maule. Back 11.40,
E Paris changed clocks.

8. Grey. True brilliant sun, then cloudy -
Wrote part of L in bed. Early start by 9.15.
Got around 16 holes before caught in a
steady rain. All very rotten - 51 for 10-18"
worse on other part. Got 29 for 6 holes but 8, 6, 7.
Rain let up. Some showers. R had to be at
Legion show for freshening standard for
Maule via Jo. Foot went to service - tea.
Finished L after doing some pressing.
J^{re} has "Othello" Cordelia, T, G. in Danes
very well done. Eve BBC concert Leon II,
Lamond list II, Sibelius I. Did Tony
in eve, got it quickly, copied & send.

Under H.

9. Cloudy, occas. sun. T went early to R for hair
& J packed. Off 10.30 for W/S/M via Cheltenham
where we got - cig. Lunch after Glouce. as we
bowed along, max. 30 miles. Nice detour by
Clifton. Many changes & much building in &
around Weston. Reached Gables 3.30. T on to
Hutton & Scullis. Tea, talk before fire. To Music
club - T's recital fine, also violinist, Boley. All
went beautifully. Back 10.30 for soup & bed.

10. Gale, pouring rain. Had hoped for golf, but

11. Wet but clearing. Off 9.45, Beaumont 10-11, got much help. Errands, back before 12. No hot water. Wrote L till lunch. After wards notes to Villa, K, Sepr, Peaston, Gunn, Atherist, Jess, Gables. Bournemouth: Irish Rl. Hardy, C.F. Syp, Br Vidal Concerto(). Played with M after tea. She + I w Ronald Colman in "Cyrano". Back 8.40, Mairi partridge, delic. Real Punch, Ted etc.

12. Fine. Cool. M, T, I off c 10.30 for lunch with Mrs Booth. Watling St, Woburn Park (very fine, magnif deer) Smithill, Siloe, Lower Gr. Had lovely day, just for us. Some music. Left 3.30, cross roads Thro W Park again: back via Newport P. North. Here about 6.15, late cup of tea. Eve Phil Bach Beethoven = Meit, Haydn (Cak) Moz. D Conc / Sgigiti / very fine - Most perfect day with marvellous sunset effects on return. Ready "Fl. Wildermer".

13. Grey, cleared fine. Reading Willson "M+H"

in bed mornings. To J out 10.45, she with Beau + I by myself, errands after. Back about 12. Changed, pressed white satin blouse + washed wool collar before lunch. Mended gloves etc, papers, light music. Played M + - 5. All + went to J. Hulbert + Clout "Falling for You" very funny. Back for news at 9 + conc.

14. Fine early, then wet, showers. Read some hills. Tied up package for Ach, cut red dahlia's in non-rainy interval, off 10.45 with T + E, did several errands, chunch on way back, more rain. Did a lot of letters + clearing out, pressed white satin blouse + washed wool collar. Late lunch, very black p.m. Wrote L until 4 when we played with M till tea. She + I to Arlis in "King's Vacation": Eve used "Fl. Wildermer".

15. Fine, sunny part of time. Off early to golf, very wet underfoot, but had golf shoes. None of us any too fine but enjoyed it. Back in

good time, cute & manic. $\frac{1}{2}$ after lunch & walk to H Fraser. M Pathrick, then to I did very amusing Torg. Noah's Ark story.

Back Cantata, Quaker Deeds - M, Dublin, Mahler songs (Hornsey) played with M till supper. Got rest of Torg. wrote H. Telephone from Son, boy not here. Stalled for packing. Nearly rid of vile cold.

16. Fine - up to pack. M & I off for train & she to Miss B. Notice in Times about villa. Read Times & Sun on train, got seat for Fri, early at flat. To then & we sat & talked & made plans & unpacked some till 12.30 & went to Times (7th Regent) with notice about baby, then thro' by way to Renny for lunch. To back to Miss N & I by tube to Marble Arch & Hampton Ct. Caught a train so had time to go over new bridge to HC & see gardens, esp dahlias & chrys. To Mme G for tea 4-5

mic talk with her - Bright MS for Germ. 5.24 train back, slow, crowded in tube - Found Son here, brief call, all going fine. Miss O here for supper & all to bed. to "Cherry O" with Houghton, Seyler, Quartermain very good. Mrs Bell & friend here. Puzzles & refresh. on return. Had had some showers early on.

17. Fine - Sat up in bed to write diary & finish letter. Out about 10. To to Nev. To talk for paper, bus to P. Rd but no gloves like I wanted, Reg St to R.C. (no face.) got wool scarf, to ⁴⁰⁰ ~~to~~ ^{2/6} ~~to~~ ^{4.60} better than last time. Ordered tickets for Nov 7. To Midland to deposit cash, Corner St to Gt. Cr. for visa, same Cr. as last year.
