

April 8, 1934 - September 18, 1934

April 8. Greek Easter. Gorgeous day. Wrote
M, later out in gardens for walk, ergone
lunch & dec. After lunch wrote H. For tea
had 3 Balts, McFadden, HV came in at
end. Eve finished "Nine Tailors," fine, & read
about Bells in Birt.

9. Fine. P off to Cor. at 9 with Payne. L had
lesson & I washed gloves etc. Off before 12
& collected Attis Geo Manni & went to
beyond Bayati to nice pine place for lunch.
Left about 3, side wiped by a drunken
idiot near B. village - Home before 4
changed before tea. Out about 6 to Millers
for good call - much talk. Found Phew.
Eve read papers & some music at night."

10. Fine, sticky. L & I spent most a.m. going
over summer clothes, trying on etc.,
sorting out. Large Corse. mail. Wrote Mrs S,
local notes etc. papers, being out. L P J at
5³⁰ to d'Artivane, excellent. P out for dinner.

Met Baltzer. WST returning Cor. as we got home. Eve Times, pug. etc. Bruckner II.

11. Fine. Wrote M. Out 10.45 to Rague, M. Marom, Antley & back for L. Then Pris, AMT (kimono Miss Burns, runner Effie) mail, Neggs. Garden after lunch - Mr. Mrs Tillyard here 4³⁰ to tea, Dr Rondeau & Miss Tufts here 5³⁰, much talk. Eve read Obs. ST, some mod. Polish from Prag.

12. Fine. Went at 10 to Orlia for an hour. L came & met C Wellington & Virginia Layton at Nat M & stay till nearly 1. Picked up L & back here to lunch. Sunium in pm, 3.30 - 8, perfectly heavenly. Had tea there. Eve Argus Tong. 16aps of mail. Lilies from Dr R. Tong. 16aps of mail.

13. Fine. Wrote notes etc. Out 9.50 to GBS - met CW & VL - went to Aerop. for rest of a.m. Huge mops, 3 caravans,

2000 in Mus. Dodged Mme H. - Rox. when I could. L met us at 1/2 when it closed. Left girls at Book shop. Back to change. Lunch Ralph, also Harry Pris, 2 Tirana (Albanian, Am-Russ) Phyllis, Con. Heated discussions over language etc. Up to see garden - puppies after. Back 3.30, did some Tong. 2 Lyman (Ely) for tea, many reminisc. & arch. questions. Drove them to end good road for sunset & left them maraudes. More Tong. in eve. Interf. bad, couldn't get Brahms from Munich. Emp. from Warsaw.

14. Fine. Spent much of a.m. on acts, letters to CGoold, DHC, AM etc. Much warmer but buggy. Read a good deal of Maurois "Mes Songs". Out for tea at Negg. Then took all 4 to see "Poplars" very good. Back late. Eve did more Tong. - papers.

15. Fine. Wrote M a long letter, then AM, then GMAT before after lunch, also

Call I. Read more Maurois - Lucy T. in before tea, then Gladys - later Lucy, Angie. Then drove to Glyphaea rather late for sunset, but fine glow. Eve had nice call from the Stevens - GPS brought photos of Carolyn statue like Nymph Perene. Before that had Bach & Beeth. violin sonatas from Billy. Later a bad trans. of Br. Double Concerto (Menges - Solo) from L. Reg. Fine playing but terrible interference.

16. Fine. Met May Mc D., Mrs. Johnson. Mr. Botti in about 10.45. Out c 11 to Orijas - later L came with Mrs. B + R + I took M' 13 to Museum + intro. him Phila. Back to the Ex re trip, B arrived back before 11. Met him in street + bought back, then 4th for L. After lunch much talk about sail along Corinthia - Epid. L doing News Items Cleared out papers. Mc Fadden were to

tea, then he - B out to Lorando. Later Daniels came to see B, and at 7 went to Daniels + had much chat + songs before the fire. Eve not much but w/ music. Saw part of tennis.

17. Slightly cloudy. Cleared, but frighteningly windy. Wrote Effie, birthday letter. Spent rest a.m.

typing out L's news items (7 part). She has to go to Stern-R. re Gladys B. Brought her back to lunch. B took her + Daniel along when he left c. 2 to put things on Mc F's boat. Read some w/ L, off before 4 in taxi to Agora - terrific wind + dust.

Lucy took us around, Tholos clear, Homer 3 per. walls, Metre etc, altar 12 gods, inc. ped enclosure angles (2 per.), S Burr (mice), Parsons (R Bastet) in to tea. Cherry time - Back to see Stillwells at 7 re addresses for guests at Co. Mus. Eve was more S Maryham Play, Mrs. Dot, had real lady f. very clever.

18. Fine, windy. Began M, then typed all the rest L had ready, till about 11.30. Out

- to return book on St Luke to Amelch,
went by garden - met Miller so sat
on a bench & talked. W. very gloomy
over polit. sit. Too late for a walk.
After lunch another page for M, note
to Mrs Baetz. Call Timo & his mother.
More typing - off 3.15 to Piraeus, round by
Castello, awful road, Star. Coll., still worse
to "Samothrace", fine Schooner, 70 ft, ¹⁴⁸
All done over, incl. saloon with oak
panelling, old furniture, fireplace etc. Had
tea with McF, a fine host, lots of books.
Back to house, got delphiniums & went
by cross country road to Priscilla's, garden
fine, just ourselves for late tea & gossip.
Back via Patis. Post. Got road JLN - new
Punch - Dow in for short call & wrote Ms.
Had T's Cone & Sym Dom. from Wien.
19. Fine. Went around to Orij at 9.15, back
soon. Typed for L & read some Ch. act.

wit her. Dressed & out 11.30 to Sheet for
^{6x35} bags for A.M. chemist, Amely, Mrs Lewisout),
Rauffmann Tauch & Albatross for trip, Kepiakid
GM to lunch with Dr Rondinella. Miss T
ill. McF there & we collected him & brought to
house & gave letter for Pendlebury, also Arch.
qnat. I had copied out early. Worked with
L on Orlando 3-4, to Loring H to Battye, L
came 4.45, left 5 & got Pries. & all to Man-
deus tea for Lyman, re pi lot, School
etc. Back to Vasili at 6³⁰. Eve very sleepy,
was "Jackstraw" - part of story in Tremat. of
a Leaf.

20. Fine. Typing early, finished M & did all
rest news items, many interruptions, Daniel,
Tel. etc. Out to Orij, L stayed, I paid bills
Pries, NWH, back - typed more - nearly dead by
lunch time - out to Coll to recital Laaloni,
Moonlight, Br. Rhaps, Inter, Jet's d'Eau, Pian.
Tea after, very funny at Doris. Back to

L + I to Mrs W Hill, down for crowds,
quick change, H, Mr R to dinner - to
hasty $\Sigma \kappa \gamma \mu \nu \gamma$, Eraphyle, less said the
better - Home at 12, left about middle.

21. Fine. Delightful morning packing - acht.
L off to Orly - Antex. Ticket mistake, so
dashed down a minute, packing done
by lunch. P back to say good bye. Off
2.30, no Antex (caravans) but good prov.
Mrs. "Hellenan," fine ship, excellent
cabin 31.32. Zoe Dragounis on board
(S. Co. Const.) Good tea, heavenly sail past
Attica, Sunion - islands. Eve had cinema
on screen behind deck, Carniola + Canaille.

22. Fine. On wrong side for Troy, so did
not try to see it - or Chanak as L had got
to sleep. Read Huxley "Trovor the
Graec," before + after breakfast. Fine
easy morning, not up till 11. Coffee +
talk with ZD after lunch, finished

packing - on deck for last part. Got in early
about 3. Former Antex man, now Cost + WL,
saw us through, tedious but no trouble. Yorgi
+ Hussein to meet us, but Y. not allowed
inside barrier - lovely drive, vistaria, lilac,
Judas all out. College about 4, Miss B
- Mrs P on steps to meet us. Fine welcome
but - gone without Alice. Unpacked a little,
tea, lamb, drive to Therapia, up by Bosle.
back through country. More unpacking
before upstairs ground supper, 2 Pretty-
mares, Burns, Wright. Lovely party. Turned
in fairly early -

23. Fine. Took it-easy about getting up. Walked
long after 10 M. Left 12³⁰ for Embassy -
had a grand time with Mr Skinner -
Mrs Stone there for lunch - Afterwards Mr
S showed us all over the house, then we
had a long gossip till after 5 + all 3
went to Robert C. to Mrs Munro's tea -

saw various pleasant people. Back for dinner, in blue parlor apart, mostly H Hart, T Wright, B, Mrs P. Vacation still on. Bridge till 12 B + I vs L + VP.

24. Fine, hot. Mrs P, T Wright, C Gurney, L + I off at 10, to bridge for boat to Princeps. Lovely sail, light clouds - winter glare calm - pretty, to Proti, Antigoni, Baliki + Prince. Got caravza + drove to Tongue pine wood for picnic. Lovely houses flowers etc, charming place. Great feast. Walk to Luna Park + met Carr. + took other road back, got postcards, capl etc. - boat back at 5; arr. 6 + cool 6³⁰ time for rest before dressing up for Miss B dinner. Mr S. III, but Mrs S, 2 Gillespie, Moore, Nicholson, 2 Prett, Nelson, L + J. Grand dinner all a great success.

25. Fine, hot, sultry. Off at 10 for town. Yorgi went with us to Turkish ship

office re Chanak boats. Met Baker up a side street + to S.S. by old Bridge as the funeral of Gen. Amb. closed Galata B. Gave nice long drive. Met Tom W in Harbor + saw splendid effect of lunette, far finer even than photos. Met Mrs Hooper inside. Later to Mrs. + called on Aziz Bey. Had seen Halil with T.W. Up to Nata agency, sent B. off for lunch, went to HM + got 4 records Br II, + all Br IX. Lunch Tokat. good cold one. Walked to tunnel looking for Cd. records (before lunch) - Back to NATA, could not have Adria stopped. Visit Malt Bay for mule at Smly. Chemist for brilliantine, dental floss etc. Back to College. Very hot + enervating. Tea upstairs with Mrs P + Miss B. Read papers + had rest before dinner downstairs. 2 tables bridge eve, B + I vs. Nelson + Mrs P; L + Wright vs Davis + E Fos- dick.

26. Fine, still warm, but fresher, breezy - off 10, Mr P, L & I for errands, printer, Dori, Et Cos (Kapsale) for risas, nice call, Nata for Mr P, cigs, back to Dori for chocolates & viscina conserve, VP to Gill's office, home about 12. Lunch upstairs with 2 Pts. Wrote up diary. Wrote a long letter to H. until about tea time, Mrs P, Miss B, L & I. Finished "Respectable Lady" (Tynan) - read Obs. Eve to Embassy, Miss B, L, I, 2 Monroe, Moore Nickson, 3 Anderson, Buckler, Seymour, Lampert (Et Cos.) - Bay (act. to Embassy) 2 Sgoureas (eugenon + cleanc) Sat w/ Dr S & Mr S, politics to right, Cyprus to left. Much Ath gossip w/ Mrs Sq. afterwards & then we 3 stayed a little after the others. Long time.

27. Fine. Wrote M in bed from 6³⁰ on. Went on a picnic to the Genoese

Castle with Mrs P, Mrs Monroe, C Guiney, K Wright, leaving on 10 o'clock boat. Very windy, crowded with scuba etc, but grand sail & colors gorgeous. Climbed to castle & went to see it, lots of ancient blocks, late cols. etc built into walls which are brick courses & stone ones, zoned. One Heron to Zeus & 2 Gods. Many Byz things, crosses etc built-in. Door is old cornice of prob late Rom, marble, devils, leaf on under side corbels etc. Lunched in garden of little kafeneion with grand view. Boat back 2.11, change en route. Landing before 4, took Mrs M home, back for tea. Rest & papers after. 2 tables eve = Carr & L & E Fosdick; Burns - VP vs. Mrs Po K Wright - Later had annual look at Hinch.

28. Fine, cooler. Got most of packing done before 11 when Mrs P, L & I went to town. Left note Mrs S, posted M's, Nata, stationer,

Am Hesp. to lunch with Miss Doane in her rooms, also Miss Rutledge. Little Pita after - Home about 3 - finished packing. Early tea Mrs P, EF, B, EG, L + J - left 4³⁰ - got notebooks, met Yorgi who saw us on "Antakia", sloshy rowboat, small very crowded steamer, cabin 6 off saloon, good ones bagged by others - Sat on deck, N wind, fine sail. Rolls + oranges for supper, early to bed. Actually slept.

29. Fine, beautiful day. Woke early, read + Hux in bed. Gallipoli about 9, light breakfast. On deck, top one for last part. Chanak c. 12.30, Rodney met us - Meosta-fa on pier, loaded up. Lunched with Bacons + Maj. Lee. Much talk. Left c. 3 lonely deer out. All on hand for tea. 2 R, Jack, Terry, Goettlert, Seltz, Bay. Saw fine new pottery worn after wards. Cis. urns splendid, mostly large grey

esp. grey lugelkanne, unique. Many mender, unpacked, cool, much chat after dinner.

30. Fine, warm but breezy. Not around till 8³⁰ breakfast. Then did rounds with C. after some pots. To Jack's Delight on s. slope plateau, R. wall had cut into cem. but large no. urns found. Goet. doing Rom. grave nearby, cover tiles on it, then all around to see possible sites to dig. G. doing NW part near E wall, M's hill diminishing, part Mac's dig to Terry huge area at N. end at Jack's F 6, has been in his big cut before. Selected the place with ~~E~~ house in H + J. After lunch made enlarged copy of plan of house, very slow work, done red, blue, green. Took most of p.m. read text. After tea mated M, part of letter. Eve had Br II + Bach.

May 1. Fine, perfect weather. Out to 3⁰ - began to clear tops of walls, scraped on path, w. J. E wall, throwing out stones. 4 men, Achmet, Ali, Aziz,

- Continuation from last year. Devoted most of day to wall, then L + I worked in a corner between 2 presumably ^{NE} walls on S. plan, one // to side of house one at rt. ls. Many mediocre sherds. Eve finished his letter - had C.F. Quint. A beautiful day + eve, very mild, breeze.
2. Fine again, sunny but a breeze. If it were not for great need of rain for crops, it would be perfection. Out at 6³⁰ + spent most of a.m. in outer angle of walls, clearing wall face + seeing relations. Got very hot there. After lunch had another sli clearing to floor level at rt. ls to across wall. Did more in NE angle, enough for present. Eve all tired + turned in early.
3. Fine, hot + sticky. Had Aziz + Halim on respective levels. Did not dig ourselves. Walked around general tour.

Changed into cooler clothes at lunch. P.M. cleared to w. side of wall, Halim doing levels to w, Aziz to "promontory" he got a rather globular pot w. base, shoulder neck gone. L + I cleared it out after it had dried a little, stayed till 6³⁰. Eve finished "Dying Alderman" in bed.

4. Some clouds, "windy, sun in out. Supposed to be free day but we put our 2 men on their floors. Pot washed, not enough in our sherd bags to tackle yet. L + I worked in re-lays, wrote H after breakfast. Aziz + Halim at it all day clearing to floor levels in their respective corners. To outstanding finds. Cold + very windy. Big mail before lunch. Eve had Br IV + Bach Suite before dinner. Read "Slade of the Year".

5. Windy, clouds + sun. A so-called day off so not up till breakfast. L + Dat - doing card catalog. Read some about Brown.

Wrote Tintis re subscript, Part, began Mrs' - half to M when wire came that she was very ill, so planned about leaving with Jack on Sunday. After lunch a splendid trip to Banabashi, through Scamander to B. village, then cross field in car to near Acrop - 3 large (late) tombs. Gorgeous views of river, cliffs, winding course. Is this the place like Iroquois valley? Back via Calvert farm after going to 40 fountains of B., to main road & tried to telephone Chanak if another message. Wrote T, I was starting - Back 6.45, eve Pastoral.

6. Greyish - up early to pack. At end of breakfast had wire darling Mother died yesterday morning. What shall we ever do without her? Decided to stay here & carry on. Wrote ^{wire} TOT: Unpacked. Spent part of a.m. writing B to direct

my mind. L added bits to letters to Pierott. Did not go out on dig, lay on bed & read a detective story but did not get to sleep. Had some mending to do before dark. Early to bed. 7. Greyish, much thunder about. L & I out this to lower levels, Must. also down in his corner. Went before breakfast to visit Marion & after to see Jot. Rain began about 10.45, knocked off, mended umbrella. C had letter from Gov. But he got Comb. Prof. Low letters from P & Effie. Finished B. Wrote T & Mrs S before lunch. Cleared after, had a rest with book. L & I out c. 4 or 5 to work on sheds, 20 bags or so, sorting etc. till about 6³⁰. Cloudy evening. All sleepy but C had some amusing extracts from Schliemann - his trials with officials.

8. Fine, some clouds, rather threatening just before lunch. Cleared both L & C of

walls E' - F for C to photograph. Then did N face of E', terribly gusty, dust all over the place. C got picture of it after lunch when sun out again. Aziz + Mustafa were out after E', - did general clearing up. L + I dug deeper in N - where E' had crossed F, between the wall + under where E' had been. Few sherds. Aziz found big pieces below his floor level, hole broke through to it - 2nd floor? Read some Cofts "Death on the Way"; we had double cone.

9. Fine but a terrific gale all day. Work in same areas - a 2nd pith. with slab cover. Cold in a.m. but later nice + warm, sat in sheltered spot in sun p.m. In book, we read some Iliys + had Bo. vid. Cone. Tristis. L + I clearing out near S. end of E' part of time, fearful dust.

10. Fine, breezy but less than yesterday

Before breakfast took out extreme S. end of E'. After br. did some N face, frighteningly blowy - Johnny extracted smaller pot from inside 2nd pith. - L + I cleared it out. Mostly dust, charcoal etc. Nothing very important. Aziz still in that area, no 3rd pith. so far. Must. down much lower in his corner - clearing out döps - dump inside house. After lunch Az. found a grey pot inside 1st pith. which was much deeper + more difficult to empty, terrific job. Pot in frags but neck + shoulder ok. Mustafa got deep in döps dump, medley of stones, what conn? Began "Fed Up" (Birm.) in eve, tried new Brahms II piano C. (A Rubin) which Jack bought - he arr. before ka, got some track + cars.

11. Fine, some clouds, windy. Not around till breakfast, odd in bed, cleaned 3 pr. shals. L + I spent most of a.m. in pottery room, good new tables, sorting sherds. Mustafa brought

large mail incl. from both Skinner's. Can't come, Mrs S, gripple, also from B about Cor. Mrs H, & a wonderful one from M written 3rd in great spirits. Early lunch, good start c. 1^o in car, J, M, T, J, C, J - L & Goet. stayed home. Then Hisarlik & to plain, across to Scam. Very funny M, D, J in Mehmet's araba with bally horse that had to be led, then walk thro' low flat fields to next branch & 3 p.m. again in car but there is a bridge over which the men went. Turn Tali' to r. (mudлат) hill (small) n. Turkish com. to l., no one sheeps. Whole country a mass of trenches, war rubble, abandoned emplacements, etc. It would be a grand country if not for the people. Went to tepes called Patr. & Ach, latter up on headland, sandy bay - marsh - pool bet. it & Kurnik. Followed coast path high above sea to Yenisher, deserted, view of Sigeon & Demetrius Tuf.

Back to Ach., either 1^o or 11^o good site for 6th camp, up KK with harbor (wo) either side. Down to sea where we had a terribly hard walk in the sand to KK. Up to lighthouse & deserted fort, village, about 6 people, tried to see mounted sc. Over Sc. bridge, high modern, met Mehmet who drove to fort & across it, back again. Met Mustafa there, back c. 6.15. Good talk, read more "Fed Up." Eve Bath quartet, Unfin, Bach Et. 12. Fine, some clouds, rather blowy. Not around till breakfast. L & I worked in pottery room until Mustafa brought the mail, c. 10.30. Splendid long letter from Trot, a great comfort to read. Told me every thing. Sent a lot of snaps of 25th party. Wrote Mrs S & Trot, then back till lunch. L & I changed afterwards & left c. 2.30 to see Mr Bacons. Grand drive. Did errands first, then Mrs Jones, but she was out. Capt T. in jail Mrs' brutal slice.

To Bacons - went with Uncle B to look for great task - saw a lot of his things, incl. Tomb of Selim. Back by the longest way round to tea, Mrs B, Miss Calvert, Maj Lee, then Mrs Jones came in. Left about 6, picked up Bag - had fine drink back, just before dinner. Eve had Br I & read newspapers.

13. Fine, some clouds, windy after the early morning. Back on job again.

Johnny has mended jug from pithos as Ajiz found a few more frags. Then both M + A busy cleaning inside house cross wall, part of N wall, NW angle. Got another big pithos, left them - had out rubbish till lunch. Moved some huge blocks, over 3 + 2 Jack's. After lunch had each cleaning out one of the pithoi by N wall, badly squashed in upper part by falling wall. Huge

quantity pith. frags, not much else inside. One apparently cleaned by dogs. Third one near N. side cross wall, did more cleaning up in NE corner. Wrote up diary. Eve had Br Piano Concerto segment. "Read House Party Murder."

14. Greyish, windy, cold early. Cleaning out cont. Ajiz finished his pithos, clearing faces of walls - general fallen stones etc. In $\frac{5}{2}$ between cross wall & N wall house found 2 pith. One on S plan. Took out lots of fallen stones there & below where red spon (S) was, before house. Cont. deeper afterwards. C + M took some pictures of them. 5 pith. in house so far. Eve had Br IV.

15. Fine, a perfect day for weather. After Mustafa finished new pithos he worked in NE area, took a lot of fallen stones from S' trench to N wall about another pithos. Ajiz also got one in trench

against N wall in W area, has made 3 small
hatches there. Total 7. Came in before 12 to
meet 2 Mrs Bacons - Miss Calvert who
came for lunch. Veranda afterwards &
then C did the rounds beginning w. pot-
tery house; then up to ours. I went with
them to Marion, view of Jerry, Rams, Mend,
M.E., Cox Cut, S gate, then got in car &
drove to Dot's & around back, not for a
few moments before tea. Fine day with
them, very amusing. They left just before
6 & we went for a last look around in
our hole before closing time. I busy with
pottery in a.m. also making lists. We
measured a lot of distances in a.m. &
she added walls etc. notion & plan.

Eve had Br I & newspapers.

16. Fine, warm. Cont. clearing mostly
NE part to floor. Marion drew profile
of pith. rims. Stuck at it - all day - C

set them to clearing down dump to look
for strat. on S. side. Collected a few things
to pack after lunch but did most of it, but
no dinner. Had time for veranda after
bath. Grand finale was Br. piano conc.
17. Fine. Up 4.30, early tea. L, C J & J^{2d} for
Chauak, lovely drive. Rodney met us & we
went to Whittall's for breakfast. Boat
came earlier than expected so could not
stop to see Uncle B, but C. would do so
later. On board "Quirinal" about 7^{2d}
Cabin 5/6. Not very good visibility, but
followed coast w. map - thought we saw
Troy. On deck till lunch. Late it was
grey, strong S. headwind, scurroo. Sat
in smoke room & read R.I.P. (Macdonald)
till tea. Got very rough, sat on bench be-
hind smoke room, drizzle. Only 5 at
dinner, L & J only survivors except Capt.
who congrat. us & gave cigs. To bed soon.

Read a little, beds o.r. but had rather a sketchy night.

18. Grey, raining & misty as first but got in about 7. All easy - off soon, 8th met us at house soon after 8. Piet here, thin, has had grippe. Large mail letter later from Trat. Unpacked, had tub, read letters etc. L went to Orij & Phil with a lot of clothes, then in garden - in in time to clean up before lunch. Read papers etc. Took it as easy as we could in p.m. both tired. Garden after tea, lovely roses, all look nice. Vasili from 6³⁰, long session oil massage 12. Late dinner. Read books & all early to bed.

19. Greyish. Up in good time - P went off to Peacocka at 9. Wrote Miss Burns. Did book with L. Wrote Mrs S. L went out for errands. Out 11 to Orij,

back 12 or so. After lunch taking it-easy when c.2 Girila & Irma turned up, by Lloyd. Had not got letter - Got them stacked setting in C's little room. Both fine. Wrote H long letter before tea, at 4³⁰. G-I to Acrop, then L-d went to see Janie & Angie. Read J.L.A., Punch etc. on return. Give much talk about anch. things.

20. Fine. Warm. Wrote early - up in good time. Wrote Trat, L went to Flower Market. G, J, L, J pp c 10 to Mus. for most of am. Had interesting time trying to fit cast of foot to Elens. Relief, but could not save Semni. L-d left to get tickets for Stad. show, went to Lyce, Synag, Stad. Began clearing old papers before lunch & some more later. 21. Fine. Another holiday. Coast & Helen. Sent HN a basket of sweets with XIT, card & my greetings. G. Irma to Mrs. for morning. Wrote Joss, Effie, did odds & ends, more clearing up. Papers after lunch. L & I out to Chid., Agora etc. Mrs MacLeagh in for tea - news about Troy till about 6. Went out to Daisies for long stay. Eve talked mostly Agora & places for Crete for Richter.

22. Fine, cooler. L & I out c. 9.30 to trial man, chasing G. I, then Orij and some errands. Back at 11. Wrote K, B, finished after lunch.

G & I, lunching with Huntleys. Still doing old numbers Times etc. Richter back to part. Tea 4³⁰, Miss Mather in for nice call. G & I, H for Crete. After 6 L & I out to Karphi, country lovely but very summery. Stopped at Vergili. J. in. Eve started a Tong, but sleepy so left it, more papers.

23. Fine. Warm but airy. L & I went in good time to Orij, then Delta for shopping, Phil(L) back 11. Wrote several notes & ~~to~~ EDTB. Spent most of day going quietly through old newspapers reading Tong, part of p.m. & eve. Got it all. Garden after tea cutting snapdragons. HN in latter part of a.m.

24. Fine. L & I to Orij soon after 9, then Phil. Blue rough straw: bet. To Pris. Got bet. - white bag. Met Dr Ag. Back c 11. Wrote Trot. L & I lunched w. Huntleys at Cosmopolis. Karso also there. Back by 3. Cleared up last Times Up etc. Angie & Lucy to tea 4³⁰ & all to 7⁰⁰ to see

"Persae" & "Cyclops," both extremely good.

Took them home. Started a Torg. in eve.

25. Slightly greyish. For a wonder did not go out a.m. but wrote some letters & went thru' clothes cupboard & chesty drawers & put away colored things. L + I off soon after 3 to Ath Coll. when she was a judge in speaking contest, 3 Eng, then 4 Gk. Tea later in H's office, Mr Delta, Mrs Mauro, Mr MacV, Lanesdale etc. Back after 6 did Torg. before dinner & got it - A few papers Eng + Am + turned in early. Threatened thunderstorm in middle of day but cleared fine p.m.

statues, one with remains of small boy on l. shoulder, Ben to see Epig. prof. one again - compare with it. in Museo Russo. Joined R's on Aerop. 615-till closing & had great time measuring in Pareti. re Dinsmoor's article. Took C & Orij. We went over G's material on Epid. Pict. out.

29. Fine, breezy. Don't remember very well except Orij, errands, long letter to Aunt C, papers, another Tang. Hatch. Bonnell in for tea, I went to W Hill for masticha. Did a little packing.

30. Fine - up early 6³⁰, finished packing L, Dr. G, I off about 8, splendid drive. Bad part road (70 km.) rebruiet, Old Corinth about 11. To Mus (Geo area) met Dick there. New Rom copy good II type, woman, heavy simple drap. Mike, also R. but from II type. To see

Bronze's mosaics, good, mostly scenes w. Eros & marine monsters etc. Tiryns - so on. Back to Mus. Left before 1 or had lunch in far. pine grove near Chelion. Forgot to mention shops (Darrison) after. Road from Ch. much improved. Long stop at Tiryns till after 6. New Hotel over Arine after tea. usual Room q. Kondas away but others there. Good dinner, early to bed.

Thankful to get back about 1/2. Did J's book. Not very energetic in pm. G + I packed - went to Aerop. L + I to Vasili after tea. P. out. Richters moved up to BSA after dinner.

3. Fine. No hurry about getting up. Talk with P. at breakfast. Wrote To H before lunch. Irma lunched with us but left early. Typed out + copied Targ. +

L + I played with it before tea. Went c. 6 to Millers for call, hung out of window to see ec procession. Back after 7, found Man-
gel here, call till after 8. Richters here to dinner, talked about their island trip - did more Targ, most of it.

4. Fine. L in garden - then out. Spent most of a.m. writing letters AHWK, Nace, Paspati, FG, M Morris, May McD, Little Annie. Then L + I had general clearing up after lunch from At a Fr. papers, Times etc. After tea went to Daries but out, so had call on H + T, then I came in. Quiet eve reading JLH - some 1933 Plays, in Am. bk. which I had not managed, so only starts now. "Book Your Houses," design for L.

5. Fine. Made a good start for Oriz but took a long time there, then to Amex, Petro, Phil, Am Co. for new passport. Back c. 12 - Ripped hem in movie sick + baked it - new. After lunch THS + wrote PB.

Hot day. L + I to Stevens at 6, upon delightful terrace. Also Richter, Maer, Mott, Mrs Penyglou, Mrs Konstantar, Eta, Kiva. Great view. Later took R's to Fr Sch. with note, L wired Whitall re Maer, left R's at BSA. Quiet eve, papers + play "Biog."

6. Fine, still warm. L + I off 9.15 to take 3 Millers up Parmer. Fearfully hot, fan belt broke, stopped various times then gave it up when not far from top. Fearfully hot return to 4th + stopping to get new belt. Left them home 12.45. Cooled off somewhat in p.m. Read NYT some ATA, Karo "Pers at Myc," Busch "Kent," Pernier splendid on "Primas T." Grace "Teil f Despina," Orlando "Mount Sion." Tea at 6 PM + Hallie D to tea and till about 7.45. Cooler in saloni so sat there before + after dinner. Read "We the People" - looked over

The rest of the book of 1932/3 plays.

7. Fine, still hot. Yesterday hottest so far.

L went to Prio + I wrote GO'C, Gmtt, Regina + Woodley, T, Giraudet. Long pleasant call from Mrs Lauderdale c 11-12, L came in. Tried to keep cool after lunch. Read Mrs Toberman with Giraudet. Warren papers etc. + some of the letters.

L + I out to Davis' after 7, all in pool, then on back veranda till after 8. Eve hot. Backhaus in Emp. on Germ. Stations. Still hot.

8. Fine, hot. L + I working at e.g., long session, then Ambx, Petrop, Blackbut with subscript. Miss W, mother Miller, all ok. Got chocolates to send to Troy + a few purchases for Sam's trip next week. After lunch copied out the new Tong. + we had a grand go at it, got a lot. Tea in saloni; L + I went at 7 to BSA Garden Party - D in for a fine long call on return. Went out with Paynes.

Read S. Times in eve, cleaned out back papers after tea.

9. Fine. L + I out with basket for legation, paint shop, German Sch. to read Buschor on Samos but Shufeld lent us a copy to take. Short call on Neuerk, back to Metoch. + saw Mrs La-Liki, also Mrs Z + her father. Back c 12. Charged, did J's books + other acc'ts. Gisela + Irma to lunch, left early. Very drowsy but read some Buschor after tea h + I am all detection stories in hall + fiction in little room, fairly hot job. Later to see Negri. At first Tr A, then H. Left A down town. Eve read papers + some short stories in Greek book from.

10. Fine. Still hot, but less so. L + I spent most of the morning messing about with Samos. Typed a missing

part of early report, read a lot of Bush. hunting cross ref. etc. Call from Miss Stone before lunch. Put back at 1. Fairly hot but wrote Tr typed for H, took it easy 4.30-6 when H + I came. Out in garden when trade bergs came after 7, good call, re Troy etc. All here eve, read papers + omnib. cooler.

11. Fine, some breeze more life in air. Out c. 9 to Duij, Ben to get pat. boat - flat, home about 11, charged, mended, L + I got most of packing done before lunch. Finished after early tea + early dinner, 7, off c. 7 to Piraeus to "Samos" - nice boat good cabin, 2, top deck, plenty of chairs. Very sleepy eve, nice + breezy.

12. Fine. Work about 4 for Syra. Two very talkative Eng women outside window till Myk. Got to Tenos about 6 or 7, view of town + church. Myk c. 7. Richies in boat

This trip great success. Fine sail all day sailed Skaria, very bare in most parts, but some little fertile parts beside river mouth. Spent day reading & discussing Buschor & others on S. Stopped Carlovac, all S. fine, fertile indeed. Reached Tathy c 4, great scramble for boats, esp. horrid woman who also begged one of our engaged rooms at Hotel Sava. Got all right but our double impossible so we went next door to Tapovac, noisy but clean. Had 1, 4, 5 - Went presently to museum escorted by hotel man. Phrasak ill - away but Archivist sent boy & got upper room opened when he found who we all were. Great cult Nicol most kind. Saw several Apollo's, fine horses etc, many in Busch (see notebook). Back to hotel for bath, good dinner in restaurant of Md. on sea front. Who

should turn up but Anthonopoulos, now Tigris. Here - General promenade on sea front, very noisy music in cafe till 1²⁰.

13. Fine. Called at 7, breakfast out in front. Left c 8:30 for Tigris, splendid drive w. magnif. views inland - to SW coast. Tobacco, vines, carrots, olives &c, beautiful. Through T to Heracum, field road perfectly satisfactory. Big plain rather like Pontine Marshes. Column of H. Temple (Rom, 3rd from E on side) visible all the way - very deserted & overgrown. Expected it to be hard to decipher - so it was. First decided to make for earliest T. Then G wanted to investigate so-called base for statue. Soon found SW angle, like fig 13, and from there worked around. The appropr. spot was full of boulders, plants, weeds, hay etc. but we cleared it out - found it as described, also

black earth appropriate for altar which some think it is. Got line of interior cols, then to E. Altar stone, perh style of both Early T. Then tried to investigate Rhak. T. of which little is left. Great difficulty is that not any plans with all remains of all periods very hot but a breeze. Saw a wall or two built in but it is all much overgrown, swampy & presumably snakey. Couldn't identify basin for water, can't see why not. Gisela & I searched old street & offerings, diag. across w. end of R. Temple, knew where it lay but none to be seen. Had a very superficial but interesting visit. In small mrs. only a mushroom & frags history etc. Told that Buschor has key to apothecia in which were Kouros. No bathing beach or shade, so decided

to go on. Nothing before Tigani went thro' it & back some distance, got a good place w. pine & olive for shade & magn. view of sea. Picnic & siesta. Back c 5⁵⁰ to T. for museum. Outer room has Seikos statue, very little Branch. style, latott, Gen. group reclining, standing, seated figs. very fine. Inner room colossal arch. head bearded & horiz. hair, two or 3 Ap. torsos, Roman portrait-heads, misc. Found after all no vases were at Heraeum, so decided to return. Went to apoth. and found legs, feet & other large frags. which G studied carefully. Back via Chora, Mytilene up- per road with grand views, MM, Patmos, Leros, Kos etc. Got cleaned up & then to Plat. for mastichas. Joined by Nik. & Ant. the latter of whom blew us to a festive dinner, then coffee in Plat. till about 11. Heavenly cool evening.

14. Fine sleep despite music, till 6. Took it comfortably. Breakfast - losatos c 8.45. Left L.G. & to Mrs. leaving Lema to paint on balcony. Did it thoroughly, the guard opened many cases, mostly ts - bronzes. (See notebook). Stayed till after 12. Back to hotel, then to bathing place. L, I, G went in & I sat in a nice little shady cap. All over later, late lunch in rest. Siesta off at 3rd for Tigani again to see tunnel. Drove part town & stopped at rocky path up on walls, fields etc. to small house on hillside where entrance was. Sun hot but fine breeze. Put on coats, took torch & candles. Down steps (ruinous pathway) to built passage & for some distance to man-hole, then rock tunnel about 60 ft. high & broad. On left is path, varying width, slippery, on r. deep water chan-

nel. Some places rather ticklish but had a grand helper in Mansli. Small chambers at intervals on side, some stalact. Did not go as far as chapel, had got good idea of structure - very great piece of engineering. Back thro' fields & almonds to car, to Castro palace of Logothetis now ruined. Church picturesquely enlarged to commem. victory of Lycurgos vs. Turks Aug 6/24. Germans have found Rom. peristyle houses etc. in the court; now bordered by picturesquely little houses with fireplaces. Great ruins. Heard there were pret. sherds at castle, room was locked, sent for key, schoolmaster away - no luck at all in our visit - about the out. P. the way things. Lovely drive back, very dry, all had refreshments at café. Back to change, dinner out in front of rest. Then to Nataca for café, wander to have Ant. but he had stolen away. Much

grieved to lose him - Went in fairly early. had good sleep.

15. Fine. Called at 5³⁰ on "Zakynthos" at 6³⁰. Much better than it looked, very clean, excellent food & service. Each had room at foot stairs, good air, clean. Had breakfast, long sail to Caior. A great many clouds, had rain on mt. Oreas. Showed so we moved. At Icaria had excellent lunch, early. Later ran into fearfully rough sea & had a most unhappy afternoon, mostly on deck trying to sleep or read. Very glad to get to Mykonos, sun about 4³⁰ or 5⁰⁰ an hour, then tons with fine view of town & church. Syra soon before 8 but decided to stay on board. 2 hills in town, busy place, restaurants all along quay. Had light meal w. giacanti from Syra.

"Samis" already in port here, had been 8 hours. Left soon after 9 - found it comfortable when we went to bed.

16. Fine. Piave 4³⁰, up at 5. Ash came before 6 - all piled in & were home quickly. Unpacked, etc etc. glad to have good coffee. L went to garden - cut a few flowers. Lots of mail. To Dijon soon after 9 for very long session, then Phil, Ambo & back by 4:30. Charged, washed gloves before lunch. Very glad for a nice lazy time after, with letters, puzzles, clearing out old ones, clearing desk, puzzles etc. To Varilie 6-7:45. Quiet - we reading Obs & NYT, early to bed. P out after dinner on small boat back by 10 or so.

17. Fine. Took it a little easier for a Sunday treat. Wrote T, began H when

HR came, then Lucy so we told them all about trip - Lunched with Lourdes, Dr Mackay just arr. for a visit. Had not seen her for years. Boys back from bathing - nice - cool, made good long stay - Continued H's letter before & after tea till we went to Miller's from 6³⁰ - 7³⁰. At dinner 2 Richters, Phil, Hallie, Austin Harrison. Very good time.

18. Fine, breezy - Went early to Orij - back by 10, did books. Wrote letters A.L.W.K., Curney, Gray, G.Parsons, Girardet, H.Hill (no Amis charges). Orij sent new bell & white to wear lunch Ital School. Good party: 2 Aristoph, Philad, Russell, 2 Della S, G, L J. Irma had to miss it. R had some fine photos of col. tes from Thassos. Left 3.15, back for quiet change, G, L, I picked up 11ou at B.P. & all went to Eleusis. Be-

gan to rain as soon as we got out, but we saw most recent in Tellist, geom, Myc walls etc, then to Mrs. where Goli played with foot, then to apoth. hunting scraps. Coffee, back to Mrs. Guards family luncheon umbrella, took to Stupsiades back to Ath. Hard rain, wet in Ath. All last morning then G to BSA. Eve L & I went through stationery supply, bathroom supplies etc. In p.m. had closed cupboard in C's room & put in all J.L.N. Tid up many copies Punch to Ath. Coll. Ready "Sea Level" in bed.

19. Fine, cooler. Spent first - part a.m. prep. for packing, selecting what to take, tying up shoes to leave, mending etc. Out C 10³⁰ to Orij. Left L, went to cleaner, Nestia w. note for ^{1100 cash} Reprocce Nico, H.Hill, Brit Passport, now moved to Metochi, Orij home by 12 or so. Wrote long letter to B in pm. till 3.30. Dressed, to Amby, Times, blanket ribbon,

Piraeus to new Richter at Trinton, to Mus
for careful exam. of reliefs with shield
copies. G. has Schide art in Bust. Sitz. Took
them to boat, got Mrs. Miller, all to Megr
also Mrs. Petro. & Norara. Took P-M home
- changed, out to Danis for dinner,
also Darbs, nice time, back 11.30.

20. Fine. Wrote a great many notes -
letters. Tommy N, Arist, Johnson, Bantz,
Pudlebury. Long session with Ouij
late in am - till 1.20. Some short rest
after lunch, read back copies Times.
Off & to get 3 Lansdales - Dr Mack -
went to H. Andreas for bathing and
picnic tea, then to Marathon. Long &
very successful party, home at 8. Had
a quiet evening. Read "Aliko" by K. Mar.
Hans, latter "Sea Level".

21. Fine. Spent much of a.m. getting
ready & packing. Went to Ambyx 11.30 for

tickets etc. Met DM Robinson there. Slow
job, Paper. ill. To Ouij & L came here -
Last fittings. Home soon after 1. Not
too hot to pack. Miss Stone c. 4, Mack's
c.5 - for short call. L - I out 6 to get
books for voyage, then Vasilis for her, & I
got cigar triumphs. & back to Vas. L went to
Stal Sch. party & I put in more things.
Came mostly desk clearing out etc, finished
"Sea Level."

22. Fine, not too hot. Up at 6 to pack.

Mostly done before breakfast, so could
have fairly decent morning finishing up.
Ambyx for call & work box & chocolates. Great
scramble at end about Ouij late bills -
had to send off to Ambyx. John for luggage
c.11.30. Dilys in as we finished early
lunch. Left before 1. Many ships, so "Vienna"
was at pier near customs. Ambyx had got
passports, permits, luggage in cabin 43-44.

Hughes-Stantons next to us, cabin - deck. S Stocklist on way to Eng. for plane off c. 2. Unpacked - settled, on deck again about Megeora. Strong N wind, much delay entering canal, rough for pilots to get up. Sail fine - At table w Eng girl Const (Thompson, cousin Whittall). Excellent table & service. Cimma "Spie in Dark" wild German mix up. Began "Antic Hay."

23. Fine. Took it easy & did not get up till c. 11. Read in bed. Early lunch, 1 hr Brindisi 1-2, did not go ashore. It looked unusually clean, rather empty. Got 3 Times from man who came on board. All read papers, long chat before tea w. Hart (Const) - a nice Swiss man from Smyrna Coll. who told a lot about how to see sites in A.M. After tea began "End of an Ave."

"Mariners" (Coles) read it in bed also. A footlong film "Cohen Kelly in Africa." Fine moonlight night.

24. Fine, out about 10. Passing little islands on way to Venice. Quiet - calm air. Promptly at 7, everything quickly done. Met by Regina - Ambix (Verdeci) all in gondola, hotel before 5 - have 32 two floors below terrace rooms, bath, hall etc. Cot unpacked, L had tub. Out c. 6 to Piazza for tea on shady side. Then till after 7. Met H. S. - Hart. Went into S Marco for end of service. Big Sunday crowds out, all very lively. Beautiful day - fine moonlight night, many boats out. Sat on terrace for coffee, papers later.

25. Fine. Breakfast in good time, off c. 9.15 in gondola for Murano to see Boys Ch. S. Donato, fine taking our way along. Couldn't get inside church last time.

Splendid interior, restored w. discretion.
Large single fig. Panagia in apse on
gold ground. 4 Evangelists below. A few un-
known later addit but has fine caps -
a wonderful mosaic floor, circles - bird
motif which is original. Fine low rel.

St. John, in baptistery old Rom.
statue base made into font. General
effect of ch. very admirable, double
arches on ext. apse. (superimposed),
lower ones = niches) Went to fine
Museo of Glass from Roman - Mod.
Started on way back to see Colleone.
In about 1 hr. for lunch. Brief siesta,
read Ulysses. Out about 3 - walked to Acad.
to see Giorgione's Tempest; also lots of
other Bellini, St. Ursula, little
rooms with small pict. or old bro-
cade walls etc. Closed at 4. On boat
to St. Chiara & back to Schiavone.

Terribly hot & crowded going, fine on
return. To Amex w/ money & trunks, to
Riassa for tea - sat long time - Then to
Parly for green lemon mastic glasses
15 to be sent to Rome. Vermouth on way
back - Terrace in eve, upstairs early.
Finished Sunday papers etc.

26. Fine. Woke early. Fin. silly boat by
Tajon "Mystery of Creek"; bag packed,
mostly before breakfast. Went on boat to
Exhibition in Park, most delightful -
First - V Gk exhibit in charming Byz
building, but didn't understand much of
most pictures inc. Pan Area. - a few of
the scruffs. Then to big room exhibit of
portraits for our home. A vermouth in
rest. over water, back to S Marco - hotel
by about 1/2. Called Co. for inquiries
on way. Early lunch, off in good time,
managed save us of ff. Had to be at -

station very early to register trunks, a lonely gondola ride, then after trunks did like last time & wrote postcard in buffet - Had 2 Amles - , Regina man buzzing around. Left at 2.42, good comfort, 0-11 in centre of carriage - got 10 pieces of luggage in. Not too hot, arrived well to Milan. Out on platform & saw Miss Lorimer in another W.L. All dined together - Read "Antie Hay" in bed. L's birthday.

Gossens, V Williams, G Parson

10. Rainy - finished L before breakfast.

To D off soon after 10 for Cambridge
via Hunt. Took it comfortably - a
spurt near end - Arr. Peile ahead of
McCharles, put car in drive. Sat in
Alice's very pleasant room, quiet on
garden, many windows, piano. Had
a fine time with them. Much talk.
Gmt came in about 3 & later we
went to garden, walk - seats, & I had
an account of Rome. Tea, Minnie T
too, then in reception room, told a bit
about Troy - left soon after 5, shown
when we started, cleaned until we
got to Creek - ran through another.
Back at 7.45.

11. Unsettled, rain at first. Built
day - half K - Agnes, was ash tray hot

lonely tapestry pocketed by Trot, cable L.
Cut red sweet peas between drops, fit
rather catchily after so many hills &
letters. Good letter from Bto. Took
flowers, left Duck. See. at Mrs. Marcelli,
& R. & Bank, Wilson, over (map) etc.
Back after 12, papers etc. After lunch
some more, pressed L's woolly scarf -
cleaned up, read some "Anne". Began L
after tea. Proms began eve, heard
part of C.F. Van Syen (Stokler) Largo at
F. (Shostak) Cap Cap, List Mignon (McTeigue
very poor) March Joyce -

12. Showery, no golf. Did odds & ends
all a.m. Wrote B - knitted stockings, etc.
After lunch read Oh, wrote this Fish,
then Troy with T. got it all by tea
time, a good one - wrote Miss Blackie
Miss Blaman & H. Read Stines.
A home in Carnival, earlier hot a

good wind quintet in new things
some lighter music. Hanck
Ship & Friend in one concert. Another
had a lot of Schubert songs (Rafford).
Ropartz, Dietl, Holbrook, Schulhoff, Nielsen.
Eve finished L. Concert of John Ireland
works, 2 Trios, Shrop. Ladd (6 Pianos).

13. Greyish but not bad. Ran into shores
clear by middle p.m. Off C & Stopped
Hilton, then via Leic., Nottingham, Dr.
Keele's - Sherwood Forest, Worksop, Donc.
Thro' Bolsoverbridge when we pulled up
for picnic lunch opposite a small
plantation on Leeming Lane. On thence
Calverton to Newarkbridge (see Jessie for
route Agr. Rd) W. Attkland & up & down
to Corbridge. All hilly, some mines,
some high moor, grand scenery. From
C. to Wall by Cawton (longer) then on to
the George which we reached by 6:

I greatly astonished to find us at tea
time. Mr & Mrs Whaley, gave us rooms next to,
house enlarged & modernised with big
lounge - Sumptuous tea. Afterwards to other
side river to bridge head. Fine & more im-
pressive than I remembered, even if you now
say 6th. Talk with amusing guard about
salmon going up the weir. Course for dinner,
then saw "A Vic". sister before drawing -
won first. Then in lounge, cut throat
until bed time.

14. Fine, a grand day. Read Bruc, Jessie &
maps before getting up. Huge breakfast,
finished packing. Off on foot to Chesters &
spent splendid a.m. There, out of doors
& in sun. at end. Back to 12.30 lunch &
ff before 2. Road repairing, or widening. A
great change from when Tell & I first
saw it. Picked out wall, & allum, etc. as we
passed. First stop. Levingshields. Polit-

ness of opening gate to tenant let us drive in too. Went first to & around down to bottom of crags, fine view of them, too stiff a climb to get up, so back again & then by lane behind houses - over the hill into plantation, fine wall there, out again & along top for some distance, then back to car. Grand views all directions. On to Borovicus, now a great place for trippers, large bus & lots of cars at entrance. Walk up & down grassy broad path to site, must take at least 10 minutes. Tickets in farm house. Very tidy and well marked camp. Did gates, bannisters, principles etc. Splendid on n. side for junctions with wall which continues to n. in a wood. Sat on grass for a rest. New rec. of Mithraeum doesn't show much except long room marked "Murder House". Back to car & on

to Twice Brewed. Going by road to Peel looked pretty steep, splendid views of wall all along. Excellent tea at T. Br. such a nice girl. Changed hands a good while ago, still a genuine old place. On up & down to Greenhead & across railway to Thirlwall Castle, looked fine, terrible time getting to get out. Advice usual footpath next time. On to Gilsland. Mrs Eads had recommended asking Mrs Watson, whom I found in garden. Full up, sent us to Dacre House, nice old couple Wilsons & a little maid. K + E rooms on front, mine looks out to Spa. Took car to garage a little way down the hill. Changed, discovered a fine fire in sitting room. Started Cut Throat & played till supper, a good one, then again till bed time.

15. Fine. Sat up in bed & wrote up diary. Wrote L until time to get up. Broke

front for breakfast, delicious and a special privilege. Got away about 10 for Amb. Gord road to the farmhouse gate. All as attractive there as ever. Parked well around but it is chiefly gates + circuit, not much interior dug up. fine terrace + lawn. Grand view, road companion. Try (Brown.) Very grey + threatening after. To Lanercost Priory, saw much more than on former visit. Had choice red bird as guide + missed naught. Now being repaired as Ave. Mon. Many tombs + then to Hall + smaller room to it, site refect, cloisters, crypt w. many Rom. insc. In Vicarage Tower Room was where Edw I made long stay. As we were about to leave, Vicar wife Mrs Taylor sent maid up to us + took us all over house. Scot from Edin - asked about son of Pilopontos. Began to rain, too Brampton (hotel) + Carlisle via

hawick. At C got a garage in $\frac{1}{16}$ left car, next door Ridley's excellent Tunch, battery wouldn't go. Had to get mechanic + leave car while we went to Cathedral. Fine mixture w. Norman (partly) nave, + very fine choir clerestory w. unusually high open arches. Also to Fratry, splendid room, desks, bookcases. Got car ready + off before 4 for end of wall. Out via Castle + around Cais, but missed some parts + went to M across to Brough, a charming little place. Not much wall to be seen but followed straight road to a few gates + bridges over railway to Port C + Bowness beside Solway a long distance. Surprised road was so good. Splendid horizon + view on clear day must be great. Rain off + on. Took approx 1½ hrs. Back + back, got direct road on return, skirted town + past Castle to Brampton via Stanwick, lovely near river. Very wet part-time - Ten Br. at

Sand Bank Hotel, such a nice woman, did much crocheting & needlework for room we had tea in. Well after 6 when we left by direct road to Greenhead & on to past Three B. turned Broad. for Bardon Mill, very wet, in search of Lindolmara & some how missed it (up too high). To B. Mill seeking Mrs Eades only to find we had passed Birkshaw on horrible road down, but up it again. No one home, a brief interval in rain while I had gone to house, magnif. view. Old man on road said all had gone away last p.m. to place to turn until nearly to wall road so went to it & on to Geo. Gutter's estate & tried to stay there, full up, so on via wall & Mexham ^{Mrs Cooper} Arbury, where they had kept 3 little rooms together & gave us some supper after 9. Cut Throat again in eve.

16. Fine early. Sat up in bed for diary & L.

After breakfast T & I went to see the Abbey. Verger took us into crypt, now lighted, for Rom. inc. worked stones, also grotesques on tomb, night stairs etc. Back to hotel to collect for luggage, pp c10.30 (?) for Corbridge via pretty road on N. side river. Sign by Cow Burn path as private, so on to Exe. also marshy that way, but work going on. Foreman (mason) showing 3 others in Mus. so we saw all three mds. Chief work is protecting what has been dug, cement tops etc. off by Stayshaw Bank road to Wall, Postgate, then E looking for all we could see with aid of J & B, but much less rare when T & I did out to Bewlwe way. Hunnum rocks seen in fields but too soon got suburban. Went through Newcastle on Shields Road terrible industrial, to Wallsend & to

see tablet on Simpson's Hotel, a most
memorable place where we dined.
Nothing to be seen now. Back thro' N
over bridge at Scotswood - along Der-
went valley very pretty to Elchester.
Shut runs through middle of camp -
all built over with houses. At an open
place with fine view across river -
beyond, could see parts of the rampart
slight traces in church yard & S edge,
very little except to get an idea of
the situation. Then to Lancaster by
Shut part of the time, up -
down - over high moors, then L below
fine view of village - church. Across
bridge & up "bank" to site of camp
on Nunc - Wolsingham road. Longori-
cum, fine remains of w & s walls, S-W
angle, big enclosure, trees on rampart
often. Grand site. Almost nothing of

interior buildings to be seen, all grass
covered for pasture, cows. Then down to
village to see church w. some Roman col.
in N. side nave - a couple of inc. altars
in porch. Good church. Back over burn
& to left(s) for B. Auckland, again an
up, down walk - at Town we got on
road we had taken northward. On to B.
Auckland, not an attractive place - terrible
hills down to the wear up to town. Big
viaduct on L. For Brinkburn we had to
go out on Durham road c. 3 m., turn L.
at garage & on some distance, ^{bear} L. at
Wes. chapter & then on cross road sharp L.
poor surface, steep, finally to deserted
works on a burn, then up to B. Farm or
Vimovium. All right where you know
how to go. Can't take direct road from
B. A. because of the Chare, steep lane
hard or impossible for car. Fine big site

enclosed in farm walls & hedges, but at farm yard got key to enclosure-trap door for hypocaurst. Large green area, lots of trees, Road runs through camp & can be traced by tree-line, steps fall to woods & river, can make out N side & adjacent parts E & W sides, rest may have disapp. Hypocaurst fire ally found in yard with chicken house. Had no lights but matches, but went down steps & could make out 3 arches & a lot of brick pillars (see J). A place one would need more time to explore well but time was going on. Back to Durham road & finally to W. stuck having been needlessly around block by getting wrong turning. Large open green & wide area at W. A. - we found a funny little pub where we had an excellent tea, nice friendly people.

On to Pierbridge - put up at the Wheat-staff Inn (Mr. Mrs. Berry). Has 3 fine big rooms, hot water, bathroom etc. Such nice people. Were very late but had dinner - a good supper, then our usual game. 17. Fine, a lovely morning - Little burn behind hotel. Grand sleep. Out before breakfast, charming village, went to bridge & across to where Road crossed the Tyne - there food was. Game mushroom & bacon breakfast. Then along C. Barnard road to see NW grassy corner over the wall, then to "Rom. Rem" now being dug at NE corner where several yards of wall N & E are cleared, also fine large culvert just inside, grand room, a longer building, barracks?, then three storey and beside church - to green - hated to leave, but got away c. 10 for Darlington where we deposited it at railway station. Then S by main North Road, Sc. Corner, Doncaster,

to Bawtry for excellent lunch at Crown. Had recognized many things on our return journey. Saw site Coltrick Bo - after passing Brough. could see Hld. ff on rise to left of road as one looked backwards. Bawtry via Blyth to Worksop & around on w. side by Wadbeck & turned at Cockney - back by Forest to Retford. Avoided Nottingham by taking fork for Lincs. & on Foss Way.

Back shortly before 6, most successful. Got unpacked & cleaned up, smart shower 6.45, dark evening. Caught up the week's newspapers. Upstairs soon after 10 & settled in bed & read Jessie Clegg till nearly 1.

18. Fine, misty early. Read more ^{Hab. W.} in bed. After breakfast did accounts, trip seems to have been about £ 3-17.0 each off c 10.30, red dahlias, then errands,

Hilton for new typewriter, PO word GMH is Mon. a/c. to be away), Bank, Baker's etc. Back about 12. Cleared up letters & papers, short letter to GMTR, Customs note to staffed, washed brush & comb, began writing up in diary for two full days. After late lunch read more papers - got diary up to date. Wrote Monk-W, Madeira, GMH, Eades. Took them to box before tea. After tea in garden for more than an hour doing roses & carnations. Quick change. Eve got part of Prom Lisa Minghetti in Bruck, then part Act II Siegfried from Bayre, back for Boles & now, 2nd end of Sieg, with score. Return to "The American" at odd times.

19. Grey. Segan L in bed, 7-8. All three off for golf & it soon cleared to a grand morning. We were none too bad though not brilliant, no scores. Had a fine time and never knew the diff.

ference between ankles though did 18 holes. Back good time to get clean before lunch - wash bandage. Read *Ob* after & then Tr. I went down to Toy. Had to start but finally got it some time before supper. Bill Lovelady came in eve, perhaps to say he had done it, but couldn't gloat. Heard A Desmond in songs by Finn Yrjo Kilpinen & Kraef, also Trio flute violin, piano by Fr. Bach played by Slater, Ponchet, Morrison (New Aeolian) Sonata Delius (P + M) Serenade Gossens, Raad Box, Tityus Rousse (S + M) Trio Gossens. Got some written on H.

20. Brilliant sunshine early, then wet, fine in a.s. Wrote more H before breakfast, finished after. Wrote GMH, K, Toy. Continued L. Then Tr. I began to clear out Mis things in bathroom, washed

window. At it again after lunch until tea, terrific job. Finished L's letter in intervals - posted at 7. Eve some Wagner, Rienzi (M. Jarrell) Trist ov. & Lieb, Tann. War. (P. Jones) Sieg. Rhine, J. Meist. parts etc etc. Began "Rodrick Hudson," did everyone with T, also some Times.

21. Fine, hazy, some clouds. Rain now & then. E & I devoted most of the day to more work on Mis things. Went through nearly all things in bathroom & clothes from sitting room wardrobe. Divided & took what we needed, got others ready to ship Kate & Eliz. At it all day until 4²² when we heard a quartet in Bach & Robin Milford, & good singer
Good shot - 2 pianos 6¹⁰
Eve most of Tschaik. Prom, & Moodie in 1st. Concerto, II Sym. Read a lot of Lucas's London.

22. In-out, coolish, fine later, shower 6.
Wrote B before & after breakfast. To & to
Rugby c 10.30 to Miss Thacker, new type,
order, etc. Began L on return till lunch.
Gregory's at 3 for bridge as we thought, but
they expected us 4 for tea. Much fun
over it. Played 1½ rubbers then Mrs
Morrison - daughter came. Took them home
after tea, in a shower. Read more Lucas
& Rodenick. Back concert, Bonn smile,
Brauds etc.

23. Fine. Wrote to M., Patrick. T took me to
10.40 bus for Cambridge, very comfortable
Arr 2.30 Summer St, after ½ hr STA.
where I had a vermouth in New Inn. Had
been showers everywhere, but we escaped.
Waited to 18 Broadside. Regret it. a
mess, all up. G & I out to Litz. to see
some new small bronzes of animals,
esp. two with ploughman & oxen one of

which goes forward & other turns back. Saw
Nicholson's new portrait of G & thought it hide-
ous, especially color combination. Tea at 4 to
which came Reids & Mrs Allen. Went in later.
From 6-7 G & I went across fields & through
new Class buildings to look at Library, much
more than expected. Class building beautiful
pale grey brick with iron trim. Back over
Class bridge to Trinity & to see repairs on
gate of Johns, a fearsome sight at the
moment. Bus back. After supper we
talked hard on Rome - Wall trip - did
most of Ted. puzzle.

24. Fine. Wrote L in bed & posted letter on way
to Arch. Mus. where we looked at casts, as
G was in doubt about Tournier horses.
Things not all marked - Back to 18 & we
set out together, she for station to go to
Saffron W. & I to PO, New Kings Chapel,
Market Place, Ch. Price & bus at 12.40.

Going - coming same nice drive we went with to Thetford. St. Ar. quite as the tomb in contrast to Market-Day on the out trip. I met me, unpacked before tea. Colles, had a fire. R-T went on an errand to Brundaston & I read papers & looked at new book on Shs. London. In we looked over Eng. County Houses, & Roderick. Birth. concert, heart-felt conc. Anna Wood's, VIII Sym.

25. Fine, lonely day. Sorted out a lot of records to take to Son. To off c. 9.30 with red dahlias, Bant, lower road to Coventry, loaded up with downstair wireless set, hi. loud speaker, tool box, field glasses, materials for t., basket of apples & vegetables. Turned off to get onto Warwick Road & avoided traffic & centre town via Cedars Green, Nolesey, College Rd, Priory R, Church, 5-

ways etc. Children glad to see us. Van men brought - machine, chest of drawers, chair, piano stool & a lot of pictures while we were here. Mrs. Beauchat left after 1/2 hr back before 2, cutting across to Cov. Rd. by a new way. After late lunch read Times, Tel, tidied up books for MFW, wrote CRM, GMH, diary, began L, did odds & ends before going away. Eve had Rock III Conc. (Moisrith) the one Aunt C & I heard R play in NY for first time, Sorcerers' Apprent. Sound ambream (Titterton) 3 cornered hat.

26. Fine, all off to goop. A perfect day, but not perfect playing, except that R. was very good. After lunch read Obs, then did washing, pressing, hen etc. Got started on Trop. about 4-5 in the midst of tea so - Desire came for a good call, hadn't seen him for a long time, finished in garden which they

admired very much. Got all Tag. before supper - R off to bath - Eve has Droitwich (1/16th-14) in hand & Mt. - Flood, Elmsley in Bach. shorter rings, 3+4 movements Ital-Sym, Elgar Ave Song, Yeomen - Read St. Pieter & ff & on - made it - Packed.

27. Misty, cleared fine. Up early to finish packing etc. 9.30 to London, very quickly to flat, unpacked etc, then settled down to gossip. But 12.30 left shoes for heels, 19 to DF where we met Jean Smith for lunch, back to coffee house, got shoes. Back to no 4, JS very attractive & interesting. She left before tea. K & I did puzzles, had tea, began to read about Jessie Aginc. While K put new cushion cover on. Dinner here, pasta latish, puzzles in eve - Both sleepy & turned in early - On sofa.

28. Fine. All hands up early, both of us tubbed & dressed by 7, then Barbara Bell arrived, early breakfast & to see her off at Charing &. Finished L. It and I out for walk & went around, LD Fields, Clifford's Inn a forlorn sight, Temple & back again. Lunch here early, coffee & to Stoll to see "Cath in CT," good as first time, but saw also a terrible show called "Boles" so went back till about 5 for tea. Began to rain when I started to CHTH so took tube to Gl. Road - taxi - 3 races also here for dinner, & much talk both before & after. I stayed latest. Rain again as I came back, really very wet, but was all right. In at 10.15 & read papers etc. 4/11 K's return, seen a puzzle or two.

29. Rather unsettled, sun in and out - Began 14 James's letters in bed - but soon after 10 to look for shoes, well w. rubber

soles, fair traps etc, though I tried L-S, Sup, Dr J, Mansfield etc. Went to Mr. Muller & had squirrel tail shown on. Had done at 11, then down Regent St & met K & May Patrick at the Florence for lunch & much talk. Later to Esse - Then to tea with Arthur. Very tiresome on his sides, ear - medium. Nearly perished but behaved well. Back 6^{3/4} supper here & tried to go to L Smith's but S.R.O., so came back and read aloud from Jessie.

30. Greyish but fine a.m. Out c. 10 via Green Park to St J. Palace to see changing of Guard - big crowd. Like on us that comedians & pickers only very other day. Walk through St J. park to Paul. Bus to TCR - BM. There to see a small bronze ploughing scene very like one in Fitz, Elgin Athena, then Rose Brit-

room particularly to see Sleeping Slave Redboro' & Pierbridge ploughing scene, both ill. in Jessie. Then to sculpt to see a few changes, e.g. archaic Eph. col. ret. now in arch room, Eph room changed, Dem. Crudos between 2 Eph cols, Dim from Thras. bet Eph col & wall. Very pale grey walls, work in progress. Lunch at Carnardine, went for vermouth, forgot it was early closing day - K & I back to flat for a puzzle or two. She out to tea. Was going Esse but it is pouring. Sat down to write L. Mrs G. brought me a pot of tea in midst of it. - wrote Mabel. Cleaned up but by the time it was dry & I had finished it was 5^{3/4} so settled with HJ's Letter till K came in. Supper in - went earlier to Umbas, no luck, so back and read all Jessie past wall.

31. Fine. Finished L, & wrote a letter out

r down near St. J. Pal. to hear pipers, but they did not play. Saw marching st. Ball through Green Park leisurely to Esse fra vermont, papers, lunch, coffee. Then r Pic. to ENIT, bus to Bondet, Srefidge for chocolates, Amb. at 3.10 to put down 2 stools, Ital place (no verm. yet) back to flat - puzzle. Out 4³⁰ via 19 + 74 to tea at braces. Lisa in bed, did jig sans with her. Cotton jacket for tea. Left C.G., back to supper, early to theater. "Family Affairs" excellently done, good enough but not remarkable play. L Braeck wrote, A Seyler, G Isham, A Library, Harris et al. Well worth seeing - bracket home, a bit & a few puzzles.

Sept 1. Fine. Got 10.05 train, papers on way, T met me, stopped with red dahlias. Unpacked, washed gloves etc. before lunch. MP puzzle after, then

closed out many old papers before tea. Weather got bad, had nice fire. Began Daisy M. Int Ep. Strauss concert, 70th Ann, heard Burlesque (Hammond) Dan L.

2. Fine, cloudy morning. All to golf, good time, poor scores. Back latish. Began Obs after lunch, Ben T & I started early on Tong, "Al Fresco" an amusing story, not too hard. Finished long before tea. Wrote T. Began "Wings for Dan". Rained - blew in eve. Had a fire. Aviatrix concert, Magic F, Bach G string, Mids. Sch, Chabrier Rhapsody - contralto in groups of songs. After noon had Str. Orch in Vivaldi, Handel, 1st Nachtm. Another concert where N Dossor sang.

3. Unsettled. Cloudy latter. Did a little mending, began L in his room, Ben T & I went to Rugby to Hilton, 10, Thacker for Es wrap. Wrote until lunch time. L & H - after lunch worked in puzzle f MP & Tel, &

Tony, back to Effie, out to pillow box.
 Tilts & Jean came c. 4, new car Austin 10,
 blue, all new gadgets. Garden most of
 time till tea. Dressed, off soon after 6
 for Shaford. Showed them all around
 theatre, garden, terrace etc. before R. & J.
 Very good, Hyde, Thompson & most of the
 same as last year. Back soon after 12,
 R. up, had tea & sandwiches.

4. Fine, some clouds. Finished L before
 breakfast. About 10.30, Tilts, Jean, Tr. I
 started for Kenilworth, New Guy's
 Cliffe, Warwick Castle (better than
 ever) and along Banbury road
 where we had picnic lunch. Went
 out for walk looking for Charncole
 man, which is on Wrekin. road in-

5. Fine. Wrote S. Cox before & after breakfast.

 by about 11, wrote L. Then Jo & Dan came
 in for sherry & gossip. Did a few beans
 with Tr. & J before lunch. Early to Plaza
 for Cebis in Rothschild, preceded by
 Reunion and Lucy Tunes, very funny with
 animals. Late to Iris for tea, also Dr.
 P. There. Back before 7. Wrote a little more

7. Greyish, cleared warm. Tibs. Jean off c. 10. To J later in garden, then with paper etc. Rather lazy last part of a.m. Read Purcell after lunch, wrote sum C. After tea E, R, I played 11 holes, fair but

not brilliant. Nice out but rather sticky. Back c 7.30. Bath Prom, was H Cohen in II Conc, I Sym. Sleepy - upstairs early. 8. Fine, mild. Began L, saw R. off for work and wife Pat, then began morning things from dining-room. To J to Rugby 10-11. Red dahlias, Lidd. has planted grass, nicely started. Met Mrs Maule & took her to dress makers. Tom Min T. got plaid skirt, fishnet, maroc, black & white cotton check, got shoes from Allen's. T Agnes & I did dining-room all out before 12.30. Portables mostly in Son's room, my rolled up, all in order for sweep at 2 o'clock. Finished L. Read A London Life before & after
supper. Took last part piano conc (Mozart.)
I sym. A little packing.

12. Fine - off to London 9.30. Very crowded,
started 10 m. late but made up time. To flat
unpacked & talked till early lunch Cern.
To Stoll for "Evergreen," very good "Scarlet
Empress" fearful & lurid. Left at 4 to dress

Back at 7. Mrs Bell here for supper -
was talking, knitting for & Mrs B. Then

13. Greyish. Sun came through later.

15. Fine. Did a lot of clearing up of letters,

Viol & piano in P Schmidt, Ravel, CF & Heddle in Schum-

17. Fine, very breezy. Finished up letters etc. To J off to Wisbech. Stopped in Rugby to buy her a pair of shoes. Went via M Harrow, then new route via Cundall - country roads to farm road to Huntingdon, Cambs. Stopped in bush border for lunch before Newmarket. From Thetford took road around by E Harling. Lovely drive all the way. Arrived about 3.30. All fine here. Had large tea & much talk. Put the man in one front buildings - off for a lovely drive including magnificent avenue, chestnuts, poplars, evergreens, several commons with innumerable rabbits, countless pheasants, very tame. Had been shower before we arrived, we missed it. Cleared beautiful & had a magnificent sunset. Back about 7.30. Very cheery dinner after vermouth's & P's morgaropani, hot monrookles etc. Just sat

- talked all the evening. I gave me Eric Gill's Clouds to take up to read, but I was soon sleepy.

18. Fine. No hurry about getting up, eatish breakfast. Went on splendid picnic, off about 11 to Bury St Edmunds, many remains of old monastic buildings in fine old town with Gray, towers. Went to St Mary's, splendid church, very broad & high nave & aisles, no screen, marvellous ceiling with angels (not only heads) magnificently painted over choir, monuments: chancel from aisles. Tomb Mary Stewart Queen of Scots in NE corner chancel, window & Vic in S aisle, splendid N porch with flint ceiling in 16 panels, like our windows, big stone pendent ornament two' wheel on ^{Big W window} coat & angels. Out later to see it go down through churchyard & out by big tower-gate with fine Norman parts.

Then on to Lavenham - up to Old Guild Hall, wonderful timbered & carved. Went inside, stunning rooms, huge brick fireplace with enormous timber beams. Has been admirably restored. Fine: rooms. Went to cellar, formerly prison, & to 1st floor. This is on a slight hill, down the slope from it are many old houses. Effie sent me a pic. of one. Are keeping it as an old village now. Church very fine, huge tower, flint panels etc, open work finish around eaves, Vere & Smart, fine S porch, interior esp notable for carved screen & panelling around monuments on either side, roof beams are in groups similar style to Hall. Babies over font. Town has gone across though country & found a nice little place off road for lunch. Almost finished when a shower came up - wandered around various pleasant places &

eventually got to Terrey, church high up,
village on slopes either side little stream.
Fine old houses, walked around to see - saw
a particularly beautiful one, now with gar-
dens, lawns etc. Dennis. timber houses in
this part wood, slatted or painted - up to
church for view of village & country. Back
by divers route. Search for shoes, got
a good lot in several places by united
efforts. Back to Bury, where we had tea
at Dunn's, then returned via Thet-
ford. Wonderful day. Occasional showers
but a lovely late pm - eve. Back after
7. Eve had what they called lightning
cut, rich Campanella, Built Rom F (Thib)
Caruso Pal - Martha, Schub Impudent (G?)
(Padre), Brandt Cone II, Br. hulking to
top pf with. Read paper & some Gile,
finished G in bed. Theper T and pf Tug.
Phad Donker long, but E's took road to Fla., o.k.
