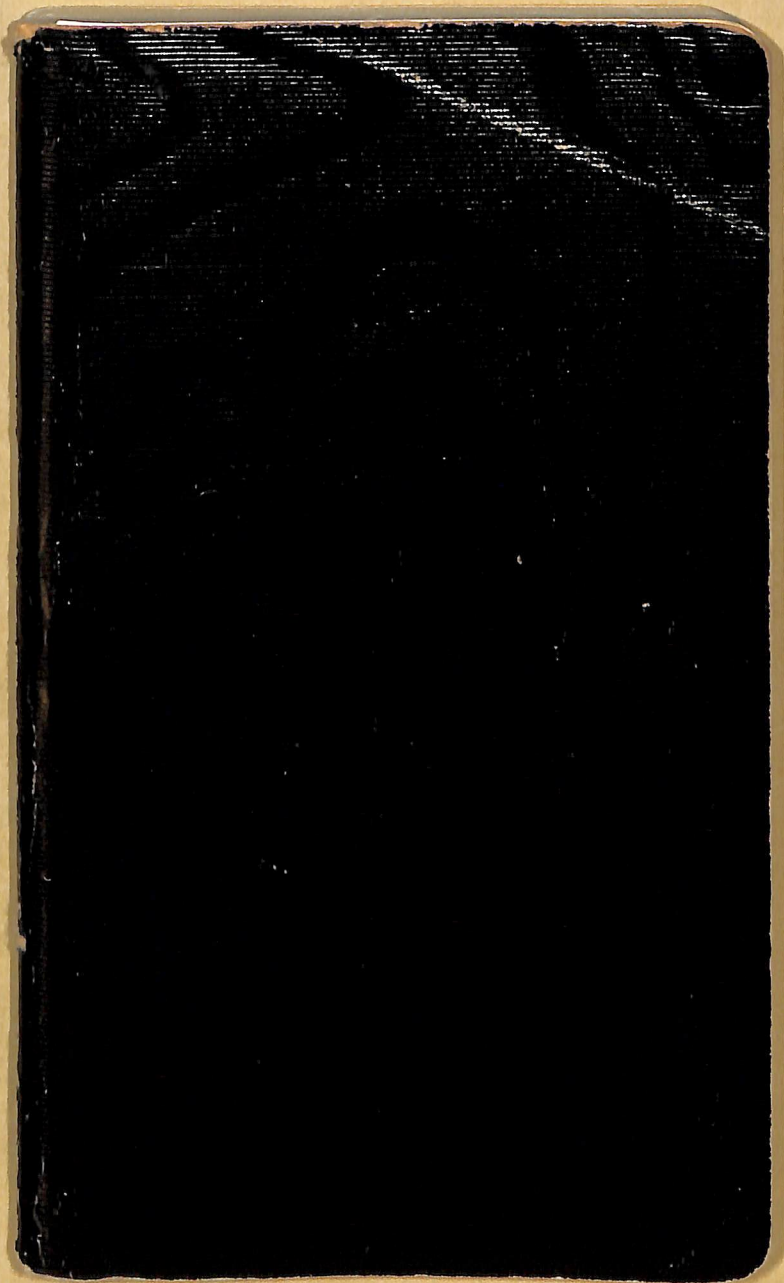

September 19, 1934 - April 15, 1935

Sept. 19. at Vinfray. Fine morning. Could not start Skellman, spring gone, so we all pushed her out & along road until Piet got her going. Left about 11 and went to Thetford, stopped for petrol, on road for Mustadford, branched off at some cottages & a splendid road on moors, woods etc. to corner at Barton Mills. Had gone through edge of Middenhall. Had a picnic while car was repaired. Very windy, I had been in red car with Effie's lecture open cap & fur jacket. Got sheltered place behind furze bushes opp. lovely beech wood. They went on with us past Newmarket, then to J back via Bedford. North. & got here by 5 for tea. Lovely drive, very successful trip.

20. Fine. E & J to Rugby. To Thacker, Police, Bank, Woodmote etc. Back after 11. Write L. Etiquettes moved some things back to d.r. Bridge at Miss Slade's, also Miss

Cusack via Mrs M. who was away - iron
2 rubbers, 3^d unfinished, up sd. Back
before 7. I went to Music Com. meeting
in eve. R moved wireless back to dining
room. Rainbow run - 1 or 2. Heard part
of Hight Forest. Later concert under C
Lambert.

21. Greyish, cool. Finished L before breakfast
- R. posted it: Spent long time hoeing
out papers etc while E practiced.
Then skulled Pearl - she - I washed
glass from dresser, very fine. Washed some
gloves after lunch, then read aloud
"Linsley" 3-4.30. Quiet tea, went for
R who was much delayed, but got
9 holes, misty - darkish before end.
Back. Evening 2 Romances, III Sym -

23. Greyish. I had to go early to Rugby
about dynamo brushes, brought back
little black cap from Miss T. Cut

red dahlias, packed up a lot of rings
for children. Left before 11 with flowers
then on via Coventry - hauch via Hamp-
ton to Warwick Rd. Rain about the
time we reached Harborne. Unloaded,
all fine, nice lunch and talk. Very
hard rain, let up. Left c 3.15. Exchanged
Double Conc. for 24 Preludes which P. has
not. Returned same way to Plaça
about 5 for Walls - Lygon in very funny
"Cup of Kindness." Not home till 8.30
for supper & end of Prom - Wren & Cme
Temianka, unfinished Sym, H Nash in Bohemia,
Rond Valse - Read aloud Linsley, Ch II.
23. Fine, sunny & breezy. T having morning
in bed. Began in good time with letters
to B, H, then garden 11-12.15 roses & dah-
lias, washing etc. before lunch. Papers
after. Wrote Conda & Mrs Costley before
lunch. T - I started on Tong. All done

but one word even after tea. Finished L.
After supper read Ch I Linley as no
good music. Earlier had II in Haydn -
Borodin. Misc. music off and on in p.m.
R back about 9.30 - up about 10 to col-
lect for packing.

24. Grey - drizzle & light. Rain in Lond.
off - on all day. To flat - left bag -
unpacked, then 19 - to Hamelin's Bank
St Jas (no luck), Am Ex re freight to
Pis., got two £. bills for T, bus to Scho
no vermouth here, got Martini in Buygt
left bottle at flat, then to shell. Soc
till about 3. Couldn't find desired
numbers Mist. so look at current
periodicals. Then to Selfs. to make
appt. - got chocolate straws, Times &c
where I got Michael Kelly for 3). Out
out, through Marshall's, Bond St bus -
to Esll for tea. Huge crowd in drawing

room, few papers available. Back at 6 -
It had arrived. Went to Queen's Hall for
tickets for Wed - to St Jas - changed for
Monday night. Supper at flat - pt to
"Shinning Hour" Gladys Cooper, Raymond
Massey, Marij. Fielding etc. Splendidly
acted, rough bad spots as play. Back
for a bill - puzzles till after 12.

25. Fine. Looked over some maps - Re
Hb. article on Roman London. Set out
c 10.30, bus to Monument, tube to Mark
Lane off. All hallows Barking - Very
interesting church, some Norman, 10th.
Below are remains of Rom. pavement,
small brick squares, other misc. things
bricks, tiles, pottery etc. Got little
book R. Lond. Went around side of
Tower, small house site of wall -
same thickness (9ft.) via Minories,
Aldgate (tablet to mark site of gate),

Duke, Camomile to Bishopsgate.
Digression to Hambro's Bank re B's
Gk. Bonds. Took long time, got no.
Here despite every assistance. Lunch
at nearby Slater's, then via L. Wall
Aldersgate, Little Britain to St. Paul
Ch. Here we spent a fine long
time, magnif. ambulatory, went up
to triforium, cloisters (recently open).
Through Smithfield to St. Paul's (chor-
oid church) Bart's quad, then along
past PO to Newgate (tallest) Old Bai-
ley, to Ludgate. Then down to
river. Back via Strand & Kings-
way to Cannon Row. Home soon
after 5, changed, settled down
to papers, puzzles - quiet evening.
26. Greyish. Sent J. T. with many
misgivings, wrote L., part of letter.
Off before 12 to Achille with blue

velvet to be dyed. Lunch with Caskey
at two tables. To Beane at 3, cut orange
straws to Trent. Back for tea. Fighting off
a cold. Did some puzzles after I had
read Times & she had written letters. Sup-
per in good time & on to B. Hall where
we sat in orchestra behind double bas-
ses (not too bad). Brahms concert:
2 Min from Serenade in D, M. Mass in II
conc, simply splendid but each very
stodgy. J. Sym. of Ireland conducted
Mai Dan, Holst Somerset Rhapsody, De-
bussey F. etc. More puzzles on return
but to bed fairly early.

27. Fine. Dad's birthday. Finished L.,
began packing. It's out before 11, met T
and went to "Hell Congn", splendid. Had
a quick late lunch at home & on to St-
Martin's to Mem. Service for Fanny Davis.
Later to Nat Mus. for an hour, then flat

for tea. K's Cousin Christy Stokes there,
nice tho' had selected a pi. Left 6.20
back by 7 o'clock. Papers etc.

28. Windy, unsettled. R went off for the
day to Bath with Gregory & his wife. Tr J
cut up green tomatoes for chutney 10-12.
But c 2 for a little golf, had cleared
sunny and hot. Bath did poorly
but I was worse. Home at 4 to change
& wash gloves etc before tea. To Carlo
in "A Christina", well done but a lot
of bludge. Finally put on. Back c 8.30
Prom - M Hers, heard last 2 movements
of III Concerto, Pastoral later. R not
back till after 10, much warmer.

29. Greyish, then rainy. Got clock & 2
watches to send to Paris. T & J off
after 10, red dabbles, paid Vey & Th
icer, got shoes at E's man, after try
elsewhere. Very comfortable. Doing

pictures in drawing room & put up a few
more things. Looks very nice. Began
letter to B. Late lunch, wet & horrid out.
Read some Linley's 4/1 E & R had to go out
to tea at the Bennetts' - Read Lettaby's
Londinium & some Lucas. Began Agric.
son's Swinburne. More Linley after E's
return. We heard Bach's ^{Roughly} ^{high} Inaugural, Ireland
Concerto (Pekkin) B theme Aria (Hilop)
V Symphony.

30. Fine, breezy. Off to golf. Wet under
foot, also muddy, so none too fine for
any of us, though some decent holes.
Slow going, late start. Back c 1.
After lunch read M's. Then T & J
started on Trig. None too easy, clues
mixed up with each other, got it by
supple time. We wrote it during
Bournemouth farewell to Godfrey.
- Knightbridge, Cocaigne, Gondolins, & VIII,

1812, Mayor, Sir H Allen, Godfrey.
Oct 1, Greyish. Wrote K, Tom G, long one
to L. Then T & I cut up little red crab
apples for jelly, till after 12. Off early
after lunch, picked up Miss Slade, to
Chulchin Chow, very good respectable, Geo
Rohy. Back to ladies tea, read a
little Linley, then D McCarthy on Thea-
tre, "Shining Hour" "Moon on Yellow River".
Early supper, R to B Legion. Szigeti
recital with Haydn, Moz, Fuxler etc,
then Wagner concert parts from Ring
with Hagen. Read some H Nicholson
also tried write T to do Grayman.
2, Greyish. T off in good time to Rugby,
read Tom's & wrote letters. Cookery,
M. Davis, Balty, Cullis, K. At 11 most
of morning, then read papers & some
Linley before & after lunch. Went to tea
with Jo & Mrs Yarborough. (new M.D.)

Back about 6 & read more L. till about 7,
early supper. Dickens meeting at Mr Geo.
Good lecture by Mr Whittick (pres. Journalist
Large attendance, saw many old acquaint-
ances. Back before 10. Short BSC with
Amacron, Tom Cooperin, Dines Song by Sumner
Pantom & Fair Dance (de P). Finished "Swainburne".
3, Grey, showery. T practicing all am. & I
wrote to CS, H H, Helen N, papers etc.
After lunch we washed glass things from
drawing-room during Bourn. concert.
R Austin's first ^{Mrs Austin's duet.} Tsch R. Juliet; G Min, Russell
-wife, Rhap Espag. Had let up somewhat & we
got ready to start for golf at 5.30 when
rain began again, so called it off. Finished
Linley, delightful book. Began Forster's
Life of Dickens. Back Prom: Brand II & II,
Fachini - Aranyi, Bartlett - Robinson, arias.
4, Fine Brilliant early, but very windy & soon
a bad day, hard rain. Cloud fine late pm.

T practicing - I spent most a.m. writing notes to E, Janet, Ann G., Ethel (sub.) & Marc.

This is funny - T got Ethel - I wrote some then to Rugby with Rem. Packed book to H. Wae, took many apples to Mrs Sutton. Got hand made silver brooch (Mistle) for hat - at art shop opp. School. Back in fairly good time - we went through "Bridge Avenue" - distributed packs of cards, scores, pencils etc. to various friends. Wrote L before - after lunch. Kate posted letters in R. T & I spent most of pm. reading aloud from "M Kelly", delightful - we had to ides in Craig, Rev "Keddenleben" which must be Strauss at his worst. Read Punch, Vogue & Forster.

5. Fine. Velvet backs from Ach. looks fine - did odds & ends, papers - some letters. D Cox, May Parsons, Mar-ae, Corley,

Paulides. Turned to a horrid damp raw day with rain off & on, some sun. Read aloud M Kelly till tea. Showers & fine rain now. Got R. and all had of hles. Got underfoot but no rain. Last Bath. Prom, heard Choral Fant., queer thing with piano, soloists, cho. etc; part of TB men on for "Beaucaire" with Mr Raph. Read Forster. G. unsettled. Several notes early, T & I off soon after 10. Left peas at Mrs Powell's, Mrs Maule's, rd dabbias, by road still terrible. Took velvet to Thacker, a few errands. Glean papers etc before lunch. Horrid afternoon. Kelly 3-5. Bill Lunday in at end of tea as it had let up he & R went to walk & we read till after 7. Last Prom incl Tann. Or. Scheher, Handel water music, Sea Songs. Did some old Times pg. in eve.

7. Unsettled. Wrote B & H in bed. Extra hour with changed clock. Rather a

horrid morning but we went out
and played 10-15 before the rain
came on. Had umbrella in bag - De-
cided to come home, but about by the
Bowling Club it cleared and we
went back and did 1-9, not too
wet or hot, 45. Late lunch, odd en-
ds. R out again. T-J on Torg
until supper but badly stuck -
S Times after supper, then wrote L
during traina boys - Ben Phil.
8. Fine, for a wonder. Off to London
by 9.30. K-Mrs G busy in flat on
arrival. Unpacked - had 2 remonades,
then to Saddler's Wells for tickets -
walk via L Conduit - Brunns. Sq. to Dr
Cullis for lunch. Doing hygiene
films - 2 picture men, Parker -
Dyer, at lunch also Miss Bond -
another whom I'd met before - Very

jolly time, also in charming new Com-
mon Room for coffee. Met K at Car road.
2.30 for another coffee. Flat for an hour
with Times puzzles. Then Ebb - at
tea had 2 Casky, 2 trace, ~~FAET~~, K-J.
Supper here. Tackled Torg. again before
- after - got it by 9.55 & sent pc to Trot.
Times puzzle later until quite late -
9. Fine. Finished No 2 The Pines, begun
night before, before I got up - Also tried
Torg. from memory. Wrote L after break-
fast - Looked through Times. K'd out c 10.45
to Notting Hill for tickets at Mercury for
Thurs. Then bus 27 to ^{27a} Trichinham via Rich-
mond. Bridge House gone, now park. At Tdd.
changed to 201 through Bushy Park & to H. Cont.
Lunch in Tilt-Yard restaurant, then via

gates. Went all through Palace rooms, incl.
pictures, holers, Chapel, Hall etc. A little

Call for Lamb. Coleridge. Took subway
to Addison Rd for tea with Kath. -
Helen, much talk, delightful display
flat. To see ALWK in hospital but
I couldn't get there in time, back here
about 6³⁰. Supper here, then to Mercury
for Vauxhall Gardens, delicious show
Arne "The Sally", Hook "Musical

Courtship" "Peopleri" "maid a. mister
3 choice songs by Woodhouse, lots of
ballet, ballon etc. Very good show.

12. Fine. To off for day with aunt in
country. Finished L. Packed. Hair
down, back to BM unsuccessfully
hunting Huguenots hill 2. To Am Univ.
union to ask re Sam's youth, n.g.
To call for papers - early tea. Back to
get bag. Returned 5.20, I met me. Un-
packed before supper. Kate on holiday.
Caught up a lot of papers in arc. Con-
cut B'ham incl. 1st Cohen in Gardens of
Spain, Antae.

13. Grey, slight drizzle. Went over large
mail again rec'd last night, incl.
money from Bank. To J to Rugby.
Left car at entrance to lane, rest
of way on foot. Then to R, Bank, Thack.
wards, back c. 11.30. rashed a lot

of gloves. Papers etc. dull afternoon,
Tilly 3-5 and some after. Off 7.15 to
Grillhouse for recital Mod. Evng 14
songs & lectures Fine, some unknown
to me before. Back before 9 for news.
Read Cumberland's Friendship, etc.

14. Grey, windy. Began letter B in bed,
wrote to off to golf. Good game though
it blew hard. 10-18 pretty poor, picked up
at 17 when T & I both in hand. 1-9 better, 4-8.
Back later. Read *U2* after lunch,
Tory about 3.30 ^{Piano - A. Ivellman} got it in an hour or
so. After tea finished B, wrote H & in
Leon ut, Oh Pulpido (Era Turner) VII Sym.
we wrote L part of a letter.

15. Grey, cold, unsettled. Off 9.15 for Bimbs.
Good going over & sun came out. Arr.
c. 11, Baby's birthday, took him ball,
toy etc. Also lots of plants for garden.
All flourishing here. Hard rain, left
c. 12 in deluge, hard pelting, sleet &

Large snow flakes, very cold, misty on windows. Stopped before we reached TC for lunch. After lunch, changed, tied up things for Mrs Haigh, then for bridge + Miss Alderson. Played 3 1/2 rubbers, down 8 1/2. Back about 6.45.

15. Fine half moon, cold. In read G. Currie. (Quartet-Kruecker) Moz. Bb, Bath G, S. Wgns.

16. Fine early, then grey + chilly. Wrote F Stone, tied up her parcel, finished L. T + J off to Rugby, via, Bank, Thacker, Poffelton, then to Betty where I got a winter ^{5/2} coat + a cardigan. Back about 12.20, looked over papers. Bridge Mrs Powell's, also Mauds, Sam, Rogers, Winter, Haigh. Long session, hard contest, up 1/0. Real some turkey before + after supper, then 8 songs "Parsin", Sea Songs (Haymer), Ballet, Kruecker R back late from bee meeting.

17. Grey, less cold. T + J off early to Leam.

to replace a find parcel left behind yesterday. Got it. Back via Rugby, left coat at Veeji's for button hole, errands - back before 12. Rather chilly, papers, cleaning up etc. After lunch hoed a few things out of Son's room. Brown. concert Bach Suite D, Glaz. Viol Concerto (H Fairhurst) Julius Sumner, Tristan, Schubert I.

18. Slightly greyish but fine. All 3 off to London 6.25 in R's car. Great luck about weather, no rain, less cold. Went via Watling St + left car at 11 at garage opp. Swiss Cottage station. Tube to Pic. Circus + to Ital lines - Cos. asking about Callit, Taranto train etc. Long walk across St Paul park to 160 Buck Pal. Rd. to Russian church for memorial service to King Alex. Beautiful music, big crowd, Sam Pp W, 4 Chant, Marget + huge number dips. + dignitaries. To pict.

for enquiries, 30 to Berkeley St for cigs,
up to Rensz. to meet T for lunch, then
to "As You Desire Me" at Regal. Saw

hibits. paintings. 2 good Turners, some
fascinating cassoni. Coats, small Titian
etc. Up to Broom Hill for lunch.
Masks in great form, looks years

early. Turn around garden, leaving

took same route home. Idle for tea
then a long bout of cut-throat

26. Fine. Wrote a few notes & finished L
while T & E practised. Went to R with
them. Left shoes for heels, 200's & got

bye to Mrs Powell. Bridge at Mrs Hope -
wells, called for Mrs Haigh. One table,
Mr H. for tea. Down 4d. - E not much

27. Greyish. T off early to take R, book

28. Fine, cool & breezy. Early breakfast

Papers till lunch, then letters, L, etc.

30. Fine. Up in good time to pack - off
as usual 9.30, cold, comfortable journey -
It away but Mrs G received me, unpacked

for Mrs. H went on to Cook's. Huge
caravans. C has the Tray case in my
room as well as where Cill's things were.
Up in workroom selecting tomb groups
from pottery & boxes. Begun obs. near
some dip, to notes etc. Early tea Mangel's,
also Mrs. Miller, Hodgson, girl who has
studio with Mangel, 2 others, Piet - Sent
Mrs. M home, found H & V here, 6.15-7.
To masticha Karkirimp. new flat in
Loud. Also 2 Stenous. Etta, stayed
till after 8. Eve near obs, times began
Trag. I Sym (weir) Prag.

23 Fine - L, C, J out 10³⁰, L to Ouzi, took
C to bank, errands, GBS (out) garden,
DK, garden, Jack & Lewis, H before lunch.
Lunch 1³⁰ at Karoi, Mrs. H, Evans, LCI
Back after 3, left 345, to GBS for Sam-
ples, to Pir to see C - Jerry Jf on
"Helwan." Home for later tea

after which I wrote most of an enormous letter to T. Then tub-dress for Payne's dinner at GB. Evans, 3 Katerlows, Fime Spathato, H Euclid, Dick, Karko, Benacci, Yoy, Kao, Megaw, Marwadi, F, M, L, I 19 in all, with a few extras brought in later. Fine time, back about 12. Piet - at Agora dinner, also GB.

24. Fine. Finished T before breakfast. Cleared out some papers. At 11 took H & L - I off for H Merk. via Pat. Lovely day, picnic lunch down the slope at HM amid pines & oaks. Lots of snow on depth & others. Back - got wood anem - dug up hemrod. & pale cream iris. Home c 4. St. back for ka, also Lands, Jack in bed with sore throat, sent Loraudo to him. Call from Mrs - Miss Adams (L & Mrs)

about 6. Went at 7 to GB for F-M, but F was worn out, so took M to Euclides. Dinner GB with Semples - Hazel. Aerop. illuminated.

25. Fine. Nat holiday, guns on left, bands etc. Left c 10 with H for GB. Got into a terrible squawk - hardly managed to get inside hotel - but on this balcony in shade - saw procession to cathedral, crowds Synt. etc. Then to top terrace, very full, so eventually on balcony over ^{arches} sign on Synt. Many there but could see well all ceremonies near unknown soldier, review of troops, not many soldiers but organs. etc. Terrible squawk, wild teleph. home, finally H & I joined up with 3 Semples - Evans, got out through kitchen, to Busk. house. Got home till 8, thanks to
Peter & John we were got 15

26. Slightly overcast, cleared off.
L, D, M, J started off together I went
to Craig & left a couple of things,

Yannaki's for vermouth. Then to

flower market, met F & waited GPs till

Much talk & a joyous time till about 7.
M Crosby here for dinner. Lights off
just after she left, but on again
soon after 11. Bed fairly early. Had
hot Brand. When in salon.

27. Threatening. Slight rain off & on. Took
M & D to Amby where they met J & L and went
off re passports. Got money, tried to find
Gre air service office, went to Bond Bros. re
IT Club cruises with friends Cousin F
had written about. To Lionhop, to GPs -
lift out of order, walked to GPs after leaving
umbrella & parcels in basement. Shod call
on F, he that L was below, dashed down
to meet her, did errands. Went first to Mrs.

- saw Vlastos' things from Vari, stunning Cor-ports-A, room full of frags being pieced into stunning big vases. To Myc room - measured case for lining, Gill. advised saw sick like in Sparta cases. Went to Tim 'aropiv for it, also got thumb tacks, left L at Vasilis'. Home 12³⁰ for brief breather before lunch, but mostly clearing desk drawers. After lunch L took D + M to dip. Cleared up fine. I stayed home - wrote a long letter to Mrs Stewart till nearly tea time. Late tea eating remains. Looked at some of Obs before dressing for dinner at Legation. All to Agona, L + J to Piet, Jr, Museum with Currie, Lucy showed us 72 te disc, beautiful white-ground one (cf Emak's 4000) found the day before, also saw pots from geom. grave we saw last week. H took L + me to tea Yannaki's. Saw Mrs Bell, Dily, Mangel, Marn, Fairbanks, Mrs Campbell (Belgrad). Drove out on Mar. road as far as forts to Raphina, nice - green + quiet. Back c 7.15; found Missy C here with D + R. Quiet - we, finally got through for Brothers I Cone, II Syni. Read ShT + Greece (FObook given me by MacV).

29. Fair, some clouds. Write notes before breakfast. Collected - began to pack things for D & M to take. J, M, H, L, I off c/2 picnic to Eleusis, going first to St. N. for Ath's permit. Lunched in grove beyond Daph. Then spent a lovely p.m. at Eleusis. Terrible mess of things even with Tom's new book. Mrs. later. Back for latish tea, held up by Boule crowd. Quick change, L to BSA Open Meeting, Megan on Mani Church, Payne on Aph. p. Maesa. Excellent but out very late. FV sat with us. Dashed home, quick change dinner = 8 Samples, Kara, Jack, Henry, I, & family.

30. Fine, some clouds. Went at 10 to buy re grey skirt. Out again before 11 to bank with Dad, then got money for L, to Ghealman's re Delos boats,

via Mike, Kyd, Tat to Jk to ask about quartet concert. back to GB, caravans galore. Patrick - L cancelled reservat. Good talk - re mouth with F till after 1 when car came. L & M had been museum. After lunch did last odds & ends packing (mostly before Orjais). Began letter to T soon after 3. F came about 4³⁰ for books & stayed for tea. D & M had gone camp but back at 5. Saw Dem & boys off on Pilona (qui Adria) at 7. Changed & read paper 8-8³⁰. Eve wrote long letter to B. Very sleepy.

31. Rather unsettled, showers p.m. Second facing, finished T. Took Mrs Petro to concert via L. Oikonomos: Rameau 3 ballets, Handel Conc Grosso 19, arias Pensieroso, Esther - Loula Mantua, Unfin Syn Oberon. Ralph - Hazel here to lunch.

Planned out dates with H. All
took R. home & saw garden & house.
Shower began before we reached Miss
Carr's with baby, lettuce. Went in for
a call, brought 6 of her lett. home.
Terribly hard rain. Back for tea, P
in, later H. L. & I to Arch Soc.
annual reports in evening. Back by
8, collected a few things for trip. Eve
had Schubert Octet, then Brand. III.

April 1. Fine but cold & windy. Went up for H
& she, L. & I started c 8⁴⁵ for Corinth.
Beautiful drive down, coffee on both.
At Cor. went to B's house then S Stoa
where Howland showed mosaic floor &
further work. Then to Mus. Met Sem-
ple there, also Dick & Agnes. Did
sculps & all but rose room. Picnic
lunch in SW shops, sunny place
out of wind. Semple also. Back to

Mus. & later to see Hall, & old lady, &
hot orange glyco. Then fine drive to Myce
in time for tea. Very cold when we went
to Acrop. hard wind, black clouds to N. lots
of snow on all big Pel. mts. Gorgeous flowers
at Myce. Did Gate, circle, houses, palace
via W. side, meg. etc. - Later with nun
quaid Panagioti to Ath & Clys & Acg. sth.
It greatly impressed. New dining room
at hotel has stove. Pleasant Bird. at
another table. Terribly cold upstairs (No. 1)
but had hot bottles & much bedding.
2. Fine, gorgeous sun in room. Up 7³⁰
breakfast outside in the sun. Mrs. Lee + 3
girls + 2 boys at another table. Left c 9 for Acrop
road good, bridge finished, to Kephalaria, to
Nauplia Museum. Gave fine impression,
Tir. Myce room in perfect order, also Swedish
things on top floor. Misc. stuff probably
to go below where they are putting building

in order. Ouzos in plates, then on to Epid. to which road is mostly fine, except a few patches with stone. Lovely at Hier. but very windy, went to theatre, too cold to sit; so lunched in stadium which was all grassy & flowery. Through arch under road to precinct & poked around pretty well, to Prop leading towards town of Epid. L & H went to mus. & I provided some more before joining them. in Rouk. ravine, very charming, garden
library etc. Pottery - a small amt LH
(parts p big part) lots of geom. with some

Coe. to the Beach, Hayden, Dvorak -
Tea afterwards by R. at D. Miss. Letter
brought H here - saw her photos, then
to Vassili. Eve read back members of
NY Times. Good Bach etc in eve.

6. Fine. Scurried around - went 10⁰⁰ for
Young, who took me to rehearsal of St
John Passion, 10³⁰ - 2³⁰ fine - very int.
Solovik Schwarz, Adai, Ruzul, Ruzin
Wien & Ponda - Home 2⁴⁵, began T after
lunch. H, F, M here for tea, also 10¹⁵. Eve
collected for trip, papers, etc.

7. Fine. Off for Delphi. L, H, I, just be-
fore 9. Stopped a few minutes at Elus-
Therac. Theres 11 for an hour in Mrs.
Nice old guard. Cameron's guide very

useful. Addition at rear, new archaic
room & above it one with a lot of things
from Halaie etc. Some improvement in
general cases. Lovely in garden. Left 12
lunch at Lion. Large crowd children,
nice woman opened Mus. Splendid
drive on, lots of snow. Stopped Amph
for benz. & coffee. On steep zigzag
above Chrysa burnt out a wire, but
no harm & small delay. Good wel-
come at Apollo, have 17-16. Excellent
dinner, L. & I had a walk afterwards
as far as Mus. Lovely starry night.

 breeze. Swiss caravan, left before noon.
 After siesta went with Michale to houses
 in Th. quarter, all best ones including
 new with Mastes. Part Th. up to Fox. Gob
 terrace, walk down. Tea, To Gym - Stad.
 Good stay "4 Days Wonder" etc. Fine moon.
 14. Another perfect day, breezy - Good start
