

September 19, 1934 - April 15, 1935

Sept. 19. at Kinseys. Fine morning. Could not start Skillman, spring gone, so we all pushed her out & along road until Dietz got her going. Left about 11 and went to Thetford, stopped for petrol, on road for Mildford, branched off at some cottages on a splendid road on moors, woods etc. to corner at Barton Mills. Had gone through edge of Mildenhall - Had a picnic while car was repaired. Very windy, I had been in red car with Effie's leather open cap - fur jacket. Got sheltered place behind fence bushes off. lovely beech wood. They went on with us past Newmarket, Ben T. & back via Bedford - North. - & got here by 5 for tea. Lovely drive, very successful trip.

Even Bath concert, Suites 1 & 4, avan, flute Bar.

20. Fine. E + J to Rugby. To Thacker, Police, Bank, Woolworth etc. Back after 11. Wrote L. Ethelnes moved some things back to d.r. Bridge at Miss Slade's, also Miss

Cusack via Mrs M. who was away - won
2 rubbers, 3rd unfinished, up 8d. Back
before 7. Went to Music Com. meeting
in eve. R moved violins back to dining
room. Rainbow now = 1 or 2. Heard part
of first fairest. Later concert under C.
Lambert.

21. Greyish, cool. Finished L before breakfast
- R. posted it: Spent long time racing
out papers etc while I practised.
Then shelled beans - she - I washed
glass from dresser, very fine. Washed some
gloves after lunch. Then read aloud
"Linley" 3-4.30. Quick tea, went for
R who was much delayed, but got
9 holes, misty - darkish before end.
Bush. Etteray & Romances, III. Sym-

22. Greyish. Had to go early to Ruffing
about dynamos brushes, brought back
with black cap from Miss T. Cut

red dahlias, packed up a lot of things
for children. Left before 11 with flowers
then on via Coventry - back via Tambs-
ton to Warwick Rd. Rain about the
time we reached Harborne. Unloaded,
all fine, nice lunch and back. Very
hard rain, let up. Left C 3.15. Exchange
Double Concert for 24 Preludes which P. has
not. Returned same way to Plaza
about 5 for Walls & Lyon in very funny
"Cups of Kindness." Not home till 4.30
for supper & end of Prom - Wren & one
Temiantska, unfinished Sym, Hatch in Bohemia,
Rare Valse. Read aloud Linley Ch IV.

23. Fine, sunny & breezy. Thawing morning
in bed. Began in good time with letters
to B, H, then garden 11-12.15 roses & dah-
lias, washing etc. before lunch. Papers
after. Wrote Conda - Mrs Costley before
lunch. To - I started on Tony. All done

but one word soon after tea. Finished L.
After supper read Ch I Linleys as no
good music. Earlier had it in Tchaik -
Borodin - Miss. music off and on in p.m.
R back about 9.30 - up about 10 to col-
lect for packing.

24. Grey - drizzle a little. Rain in Lond.
ff - on all day. To flat - left bag -
unpacked, ren 19 - to Hambs' Bank
St Jas (no luck), Am ex re freight to
Pir., got two \$, bills for T, bus to Soho
no vermouth here, got Martini in Byst
left bottle at flat, ren to Stell. So
till about 3. Couldn't find desired
numbers hist. so looked at current
periodicals. Then to Selfs. to make
apt. - got chocolate straw, Times BC
where I got Michael Kelly for 3). Coct
out, through Marshall's, Bondst bus -
to Esse for tea. Huge crowd in drawing

room, few papers available. Back at 6 -
it had arrived. Went to Queen Hall for
tickets for Wed - to St Jas - changed for
Monday night. Supper at flat - pf &
"Shining Hour" Gladys Cooper, Raymond
Massey, May. Fielding etc. Splendidly
acted, rough bad spots as play. Back
for a while - puzzles till after 12.

25. Fine. Looked over some maps - the
Hs. article on Roman London. Set out
c 10.30, bus to Monument, tube to Mark
Lane opp. All Hallows Barking - Very
interesting church, some Norman, too. etc.
Below are remains of Rom. pavement,
small brick squares, other misc. things
bricks, tiles, pottery etc. Got little
book R. Lond. Went around side of
Tower, small house size of wall -
same thickness (qft.) via Minories,
Aldgate (tablet to mark site of gate),

Duke, Camomile to Bishopsgate.
Digression to Hambr's Bank re B's
Gk. Bonds. Took long time, got no.
Then despite every assistance. Lunch
at nearby Slaters, then via L. Hall
Aldwgate, Little Britain to St. Paul
St. where we spent a fine long
time, magnif ambulatory, went up
to triforium, cloisters (recently open).
Through Smithfield to St. Barth's (hor-
rid church) Bart's quad, then along
past PO to Newgate (tattered) Old Bar-
tley, to Ludgate. Then down to
river. Back via Strand - Kings-
way to Carwardine. Home soon
after 5; changed, settled down
to papers, puzzles - quiet evening.

26. Greyish. Sent off Torg. with many
misgivings, wrote L., part of letter -
off before 1/2 to Achille with blue

velvet to be dyed. Lunch with Caskeys
at two radiis. To Beane at 3, sent orange
straws to Trot. Back for tea. It fighting off
a cold. Did some puzzles after I had
read Times & she had written letters. Sup-
per in good time & on to L. Hall where
we sat in orchestra behind double bas-
ses (not too bad). Brahms concert -
2 Min from Serenade in D, M. Hens in II
Cone, strikingly splendid but orch. very
stodgy. ISym. J Ireland conducted
Mai Dan, Holst Somerset Rhapsody, De-
bussy Fête. More puzzles on return
but to bed fairly early.

27. Fine. Dad's birthday. Finished L,
began packing. It's out before 11, met T
and went to "WellComyn", splendid. Had
a quick late lunch at Lyons & on to St-
Martin's to Mass. Service for Fanny Davis.
Later to Mrs. for an hour, then flat

for tea. To cousin Chissey Stevens there, nice tho' had rejected a pi. Left 6.20 back by 7 o'clock. Papers etc.

28. Windy, unsettled. R went off for the day to Bath with Gregson & his wife. Tr J cut up green tomatoes for chutney 10-12. Out c 2 for a little golf, had clear and sunny and hot. Bath did poorly but I was worse. Home at 4 to change & wash gloves etc before tea. To Carbo in "A Christina", well done but a lot of blige. Finely put on. Back c 8.30 Prom - M Hens, heard last 2 movements of II Concerto, Pastoral etc. R not back till after 10, much warmer.

29. Greyish, then rainy. Got clns - 2 watches to send to Paris. To J off after 10, red doublets, paid keep & Thicker, got shoes at Es man, after trying elsewhere. Very comfortable. Hung

pictures in drawing room & put up a few more things. Looks very nice. Began letter to B. Late lunch, wet & hurried out. Read some Lings 5/11 E & R had to go out to tea at the Bennetts'. Read Lethaby's Londonium & some Lucas. Began & Nicol. son's Swinburne. More Lings after E's return. Eve heard Bach's ^{Postlight} Fugue, Ireland Concerto (Perkin) B theme aria (Dobson)

IV Symphony.

30. Fine, breezy. Off wifey. Wet under foot, also muddy, so none too fine for any of us, though some decent holes. Slow going, late start. Back c 1. After lunch read Ob. Then Tr J started on Trq. None too easy, clues mixed up with each other, got it by supper time. Eve wrote & during Bournemouth found out Godfrey - Knightbridge, Cocagne, Gondoliers, & VIII,

1812, Mayor, Sir H Allen, Godfrey.

Oct 1. Greyish. Wrote 15, 2 more G, long one to L. Then T & I cut up little red crab apples for jelly, till after 12. Off early after lunch, picked up Mrs Slade, to Cheltenham Chow, very good spectacle, Geo Robey. Back to latish tea, read a little Linley, then D' McCarthy on Threepence, "Shining Hour" "Moon on Yellow River". Early supper, R to B Legion. Szegedi recital with Haydn, Moz, Trister etc, then Wagner concert parts from Ring with Hagen. Read some & Nicolson also tried with T to do Everyman.

2. Greyish. T off in good time to Rugby, ran tennis & wrote letters. Carte, N Davis, Bailey, Cullis, K. At it most of morning, then read papers & some Linley before & after lunch. Went to tea with Jo & Mrs Yarborough - (new M.D.)

Back about 6 & read more L. till about 7, early supper - Dickens meeting at the Geo. Good lecture by Mr Whittick (pres. journalist). Large attendance, saw many old acquaintances. Back before 10. Short BBC with Anacron, Tomb Cooperin, Delius Songs by Sumner Panton & his Danquelle F). Finished "Swinburne".

3. Grey, showery. T practising all am. & I wrote to CS, H/H, Helen V, papers etc. After lunch we washed glass things from drawing-room during Bourn. concert -
Mr Burton gave
R Austin's first, Tech P. Juliet, G Min, Russell - wife, Rhapsody. Had let up somewhat - we got ready to start for golf at 5.30 when rain began again, so called it off. Finished Linley, delightful book. Began Fontaine's Life of Dickens. Back Prom = Bourn II & II, Fachini - Anagni, Bartlet-Robinson, arias.

4. Fine. Brilliant early, but very windy & soon a bad day, hard rains. Closed fine late from

T practising & I spent most a.m. writing
Notes to E., J.A.C.T., Uncle, E.S.C. (sub.) & Mac.
This is wrong - T got Ethel & I wrote some
then to Rugby with them. Printed book
& Mac, took many apples to Mrs. Butter.
Got hand made silver brooch (^{7/6} M.L.)
for hat at art shop opp. School. Back
in fairly good time & we went through
"Bridge Drawn" - distributed packs
of cards, scores, pencils etc. to give va-
rious friends. Wrote & before - after
lunch. T ate postcard letters in R. T & I
spent most of pm. reading about
from "M. Kelly", delightful - we had
M. Kelly in Crieg, then "Heddenleben" which
must be Strauss at his worst. Read
Punch, Vague & Forster.

5. Fine. Velvet back from Ach. Lunde
fine - did odd - ends, papers & some
letters. D. Cox, May Parsons, Mac - ae, Cosley,

Pavilids. Turned to a horrid damp raw
day with rain off & on, some sun. Read
about M. Kelly till tea - Showers & fine
rainbow. Got R. and all had q holes. Wet
underfoot but no rain. Last Bath. Prom,
heard Choral Fant., queen being with
piano, soloists, cho. etc; part of IX men on
"Beaucaire" with M. Ralph. Read Forster.
6. Unsettled. Several notes early, T & I off
soon after 10. Left pear at Mrs. Pavelli's, Mrs
Maulis', red dahlias, by now still terrible.
Took velvet to Thacker, a few errands. Cleaned
papers etc before lunch. Horrid afternoon -
Kelly 3-5. Bill Lowday in at end of tea
as it had let up he & R went to walk & we
had till after 7. Last Prom incl. Tann.
Or, Schubert, Handel Water Music, sea songs -
Did some old Times pg. in eve.
7. Unsettled - wrote Br & H in bed. Extra
hour with changed clock. Carter a

horrid morning but we went out and played 10-15 before the rain came on. Had umbrella in bag - Decided to come home, but about by the Bowling Club it cleared and we went back and did 1-9, not too wet or bad, 45. Late lunch, odds-ends. R out again - To Jon Teng until supper but badly struck - 5 times after supper, then more during Tuina boys & Brim Phil. 8. Fine, for a wonder. Off to London by 9.30. To Mrs G busy in flat on arrival. Unpacked & had 2 sandwiches, then to Saddler's Wells for tickets & walk via L Conduit, Bruns. Sq. to Dr Cullis for lunch. Doing hygiene films - 2 picture men, Parker & Dyer, at lunch also Miss Bond & another whom I'd met before - Very

jolly time, also in charming new Common Room for coffee. Met K at Carnard. 2.30 for another coffee. Flat for an hour with Times puzzles. Then ELL & at tea had 2 Corky, 2 Mac, FAET, K & J. Supper here. Tackled Teng again before & after - got it by 9.55 & sent pc to Trot. Times pg. later until quite late - 9. Fine. Finished No 2 The Pines, begun night before, before I got up - Also twice Teng, from memory - wrote & after breakfast - Looked through Times. To downtown 10.45 to Notting Hill for tickets at Mercury for ^{2.20} ^{r Teddington} Thurs. Then bus 27 to Twickenham via Richmond. Bridge House gone, now park. At Tad. changed to 201 through Bushy Park to H Con. Lunch in Tiet-Yard restaurant, then via fine Oakleigh to Palace, scaffolding on gates. Went all though Palace rooms, incl. pictures, library, Chapel, Hall etc. A little

in garden. Then to tea at Mme Gennadius, nice time with her. Back by train. Supper here. Sadler's Wells, ballet - Rendezvous, The Jailer (new, very amusing) Carnival, all very good. Home recuperation on return.

10. Fine. At breakfast met K. long acct. of King Alex.'s assassination. Out in good time for errands, first an unsuccessful coat hunt, then to R.C. for pillow cases, comb'd about Lits' boat, Nat Gallery to see Hogarth's Graham Children, back by 12:30. To lunch had Miss Macklin & Miss Wells, much talk. Trot arrived before 3 & we went to Colnaghi's to see N.H.-S's exhibition of pictures of Greece. Bought the min. from hysat. Nat L - I liked so much. Saw both Sir H - Lady H. There - To Tivoli

to see Visit in Jew Süss, very finely done. Back before 7, supper here - at 9 went to Euston to see Trot pp. Caught in rain but no harm done. Seated in about 10 for an hour puzzle.

11. Fine. Read Mass "Enchanted" in bed - took Mrs Macau - big washing up. Begun L. Out about 11 to Covent Garden, St Paul's to see Linley monuments, Elly Terry here also, then to Royalty for tickets lunch dinner fr. capp., to Nat Gallery till about 2:45. Coffin at a Lyons, to Port. Call for Lamb. Coleridge. Took 3 subs, to Addison Rd for tea with Kath. - Helen, much talk, delightful duplex flat. To see ALWT in hospital but I couldn't get there in time, back here about 6:30. Supper here, then to Mercury for Vauxhall Gardens, delicious show Anne "This Sally," Hoot "musical

Courtship "Progress" Maid as mistress
3 choice songs by Woodhouse, lots of
ballet, balloon etc. Very good show.

12. Fine. To off for day with aunt in
country. Finished L. Packed. Hair
done 11, back to BM unsuccessfully
hunting Nuremberg till 2. To Am Univ.
Union to ask re Samo youth, n.g.
Wrote for papers - early tea. Back to
get bag. Returned 5:20, I met me. Un-
packed before supper. Rain on holiday.
Caught up a lot of papers in am. Con-
cert B'ham incl. 10 Cohen in Concerts of
Spain, Austria.

13. Grey, slight drizzle. Went over large
mail again rec'd last night, incl.
money from Bank. To J to Rugby.
Left car at entrance to lane, not
far on foot. Then to R, Bank. Thence
wards, back c. 11:30. Washed a lot

of glasses. Papers etc. Dull afternoon,
Tilly 3-5 and some after. Off 7:15 to
Bridge House for recital Mod. Every 14
songs & lectures Fine, some unknown
to me before. Back before 9 for news.

Rest Cumbrian Friendship, etc.

14. Grey, windy. Began letter B in bed,
wrote to off to golf. Good game though
it blew hard. 10-18 pretty poor, picked up
at 17 when Tr. J both in bunk. 1-9 better, 48.
Back latish. Read Op. after lunch,
^{Piano. A Newman}
Trig about 3:30 - got it in one hour or
so. After tea finished B, wrote H & in
^{Con II, 4th Partido (era Turner) VII Sym.}
we wrote L part of a letter.

15. Grey, cold, unsettled. Off 9:25 for B'ham.
Good going over & sun came out. Am.
c. 11, Baby's birthday, took him walk,
etc. Also lots of plants for garden.
All flourishing here. Hard rain, etc
c. 12 in deluge, hard pelting, etc -

large snow flakes, very cold, misty or windless. Stopped before we reached TC for lunch. After lunch, changed, tied up things for Mrs Haigh, here for bridge & Miss Addison. Played 3½ rubbers, down 8½. Back about 6.45 - Fair half moon, cold. We read G. Cumb. Quartet (Kuschen) Moz. Bb, Bush G, S. Wynn.

16. Fine early, then grey & chilly. Wrote to Stone, tied up her parcel, finished L. To J ff to Rugby, Ave, Bank, Thacker, Po, Hilton, then to Bobby where I got a winter coat & a car-diggin. Back about 12.30, looked over papers. Bridge Mrs Powell's, also Manly, Sam, Rogers, Winter, Haigh. Long session, hard contest, up 1/6. Read some Poetry before & after supper, then "Song & Brain", Seabrook (Haynes), Ballet, Wreckers R back late from bee meeting.

17. Grey, less cold. To J off early to Leam.

to replace or find parcel left behind yesterday. Got it. Back via Rugby, left coat at Vesey for button hole, errands - back before 12. Rather chilly, papers, cleaning up etc. After lunch had a few things out of Son's room. Bourn. concert Bach Suite D, Glaz. Violin Concerto (H Fairhurst) Delius Simeon, Tristan, Schubert L.

18. Slightly greyish but fine. All 3 off to London 8.25 in R's car. Great luck about weather, no rain, less cold. Went via Watling St & left car at " at garage opp. Swiss Cottage station. Tube to Pic. Circus & to Stal Lines - Cos. asking about Callit, Toronto train etc. Long walk across St. Paul park to 168 Buck Pal. Rd. to Russian church for memorial service to King Alex. Beautiful music, big crowd, some Pg W, A Chamb, Mayor & large number dops. & dignitaries. To West.

for enquires, 38 to Berkeley St for cigs, up to Rendez. to meet T for lunch, then to "As You Desire Me" at Royalty. Saw J F R + PG at lunch + afterwards in dressing room. Most charming. Went to Westminster Hospital to see A Z W K. Too late for any thing else, so to Edder + had a rummage + newspaper. Then via Tibb + W 2 to Swiss C. Where met the others + we left C. 5.30 + came along well, halting for supper on the way. Back c 11³⁰ + had cups of tea before bed -

19. Greyish. Wrote Thirkield, K, Macan, fin L + to R. with T + Ethel. Got coat back from Vandy, a few errands. 11-12 did quinces, 12-12.45 red papers clearing out from Son's room. Took it easy after lunch with papers for 2 days, then finished M/Tilly before + after tea. Sorry it is over. R went to see manif. back c 5 for

supper. Eve did Tel, Glantz "Friendship" Lopatkova back on R Ballet - with illust. music.

20. Greyish, milder. Did some necessary mending, tied up package with Baloni clock for Sparrows. T + I out 10.45 + I walked back, more mending, began L, till about lunch time. Washing it off. Then T + I settled down + began "Music at Midnight" until tea + a little after. Eve recital Elsnerhardt Schubert Cottin Fr., Francklin, Brahms, Jensen -

Lady ITS and "Apollo" with our painting ill. in it. Charming magaz. read it in eve -

21. Greyish - Not a bad day, rare sun, got colder during golf. Out in good time, windy + mud on balls. + R below par, I above as usual, better on 1-9. Papers after lunch then Tony. from 3²⁰ - got it soon after tea. E + R out to supper at Mrs Fullers,

I had supper by fire & wrote H + L & did more puzzles. Concert at Teign, O Pernell in p.m. £1.50, Emily, Bt Harrison in Elgar Conc., Mend. Stat. Gym.

22. Fine. Perfect day. To Stokeyard c. 9.45 for errands, back to TC - ff for Oxford via Bayfield, Cynho, country very beautiful. Went to see Miss Hall, old lady still going strong at 95. Back to car park & to Ashmolean for loan ex-hibit. Paintings. 2 good Turners, some fascinating cassoni. Coats, small Titian etc. Up to Brown Hill for lunch. Master in great form, looks years younger. Dorothea + John Street left early. Turn around garden, heavily out. Collected it at Tom Tower - took same route home. Home for tea then a long bout of cat-napping until late supper. Rat new man's

for treatment. Mostly talk in eve & I did some puzzles.

23. Fine. Spent most of a.m. in TC room talking, mending etc. Finished L in time for R to take it. Hurried over Mrs' papers before lunch. Went off 2.15 to bridge lesson; won B, ended in 2 Traps, won Antex (n chyph). Thence for tea. Long go of shandead until supper. Eve Hilda Diderich in Palmgren vocal, news etc abt Mid. Melb. air race, Sir T Years, E Heinitz viola da gamba + Elwes harpsichord in Bach, Scarlatti, Poglietti, Handel.

24. Slightly greyish, cooler. 15 ff on 9.30 + T in R. for morning. Papers + letters. 2A, Thornton, Chapman, Antex (n ticket) ESH, M Hirst. Cat it until after 1/2, some nice gram. records Mrs. Dixie (now). Bridge at Miss Alderson's. Rain began at lunch but stopped before we collected Mrs Haigh. Nice cozy game for 4,

house full of old china, furniture, pictures (by brother). Lost 1/2 hr but had good time. Back soon after & read some "Music at M" till early supper at 7. E off to village for Blegion Whist. Heard Delius's "Man of Life", very fine. Stiles Allen, Desmond, Henderson, Russell.

25. Greyish, windy. Began L early. Then Walter & Agnes got trunk etc. from attic. Just began when T was summoned to go to Cor. to meet R. - bring him back leaving Lancaster. Found my little fat trunk had much less of mine than I feared. Sorted out a lot in S's room then after T's return we did more - continued after lunch. Tidied up Mrs. Powell's parcel. Read M at M aloud & finished after tea. No especially good music p.m. except Mozart II Div. Latin.

26. Fine. Wrote a few notes & finished L while T & E practised. Went to B with them. Left shoes for heels, stockings & got book (Morton, Steps of Masters) for M's birthday. Stopped on return to say good bye to Mrs. Powell. Bridge at Mrs. Hope-Wells, called for Mrs. Haigh. Our table, Mr. H. for tea. Down 4d. Eve not much music, amusing speech after news via Bannerman. Late supper again. BBC orch, Sauced B., Delius Parade. Gardner, Glazeburn, Seasons, Valley -

27. Greyish. Toff early to take R, walk for dahlias etc. Home before 11, wrote a few notes, odds & ends etc. After lunch E & I took Cor. in Skillman & got R's car, back via Rugby, round or two. Papers, puzzles etc. Read Alington "Abbott's Cup" late pm & etc. Heard in town tonight, part of Szymanowski

before 9.30 news, then Manhattan Sw. made, a misc. Souvenir "Carnival" card in it.

28. Fine, cool & breezy. Early breakfast E + R off 9 to Weston for M's birthday. Out soon after for walk around Black Sun - Canaston, caught in last shower. Back before 11, changed wash gloves etc. Then settled with the papers. Much more misc. music. Papers till lunch, then letters, L, H etc. A nice quiet day. E + R back in time for supper after fine trip. M very fit. Eve T + I tackled Torg and got a good deal of it. Concert with Szymb. playing own concerto.

29. Fine, cold. More Torg with F, then a practice for her, odds & ends. Out c 11 to errands - golf, 11 holes, not so bad, some very good ones. PM took Miss Seale to "Unfin. Sym." A few changes,

unnecessary, but most seemed same - both T + S delighted. Went to tea with S. after - Backly 6.20 went B, finished L before supper - also got Torg ready to send - collected a few things for packing.

30. Fine. Up in good time to pack - off as usual 9.30, cold, comfortable journey - to away but Mrs G received me, unpacked - to W & Co. & found they had moved to 2 Park Lane, went in 73. Nice new offices, good call with Romanos. Then to Amex, cheque cashed £600, ordered tickets for 2nd October to Stewart's Brae. for lunch, then to Midland & deposited £50, then Fr Co, visa quickly - Back to Regent St, then to M.S., Times Bk Club, Sup. for chocolates, then bank. Dessert - off to Londonerry House for hotel reception, tremendous squash in traffic & after we got in - solid phalanx 1300 there but Prince of Wales

short hands all around. Crowd so big didn't see who else was there, not any one to speak to though next day I did find a number I knew. Ent. house full of fine portraits. Ant. room, hall, staircase, ball room, back stairs, banquet room. Then up again & all over the place. Three salons in front, Lawrence "in gloire". Delightful rooms. Stayed a long time - then eventually to cinema near Ox Cen. to see "The Horse" "My Song for You" & "A Gracie Fields" "Sing as you go". Back about 11.

31. Wet day, grey at first, then rain, cold penetrating. Mrs G gave me breakfast, bath, etc. Off 9.30 for Supt. hair done, a few errands, concert, workups at track & Colnaghi for another look at picture, then Bruton to Eust. Proposed both races as members. Spent long time there, trying to get warm before

fire, sandwich lunch, many papers. Left 3rd tube circuitous route to Kings H. St & landed in Ponting's. Tea with - Hughe - S. Both daughters, very attractive. Took par-
cel for Bergl. Taxi to races - Helen & her

out, cold, many patches of snow. Got off
at Teng Harry, very cold walk n. wind

until path in woods, paragon gate, then across at bottom of dig to church - to Reuter - very well cleaned, nests in fine order, stage, green room, bell tower circuit, later under S, 3 passage down a few steps, part triumphal arch, tile mosaic floor - Then up to town - lunch in same nice place. Bad conn. with bus so walked thro' man's place to church, parish church, mon. to Edm. Strong who built St Paul's, back to bus 3.15 - home before tea began L, papers etc. Sutton Cornhilline, "Figaro", Wells, very good, lively, well done.

Left at 12, sunny drin back. Painter at dining room door after lunch, Tarbridge lesson. Wrote B, H.V. Hunted up L's letter with Sutton's order & began going through their catalogue. T back for tea, read till early supper. All 3 to Dickens meeting, large attendance, readings from "Martin Chuzzlewit." Back for news, jeans, BBC in JC Bach, Gluck

7. Fine, sun trying to come out. White frost. Went off with R to S Brown, 930-10.15, scraping only. Errands to Bank, over (stat. returned from Stens), odds & ends for T, back by 11.10 bus. Cleared to a fine day. Wrote Colnaghi & sent cheque for pictures, Smby n ticket; began Sutton's. T-J in pm to Mrs Rogers, also Alderson, Thompson, Woodhouse, Hopewell, . . . Good games, down 10 $\frac{1}{2}$. Back in time to eat a little S.W. before

supper. Salome at 6, Coates, St. John's, Russell etc., Robinson & Bourke after noon in Sennar, Chabrier, le Faust. Did Telburg - some Asturley along - Post - S. Greyish, still frosty. Packed all on taxi, left Rev. bag & collected it, then to Victoria & left things in deposit - getting late, taxi to Supr. for hair at 12. 15 - I later with stopping dollar for supplies. Good lunch, not too full anywhere. I left 15 there & went to Sun Times Bk Exhibit in Grosvenor House. Fine

On 2 wild basis, home via Zapp + Ormon + Acar! Never saw such crowds here, all good natured - 4th.

in a side street somewhere. Finally back for lunch c 1.45, very cheerful time, started till about 4. L + I left 4th to meet Dot + Mar. on Savia at 5 at Phal. but so many passengers not had to go to Pier. old custom house. Sat home till 8, thanks to Peter + John we were got there. 15 pieces in a taxi. Acap. flood lit so hopped back into car + did the round before dinner, to which came Jack + Lewis + stayed till about 12.

26. Slightly overcast, cleared ff.

L, J, M + I started ff together + went to Oxy + left a couple of things, then to GBS - found F + M had not gone, M has some throat + out for Lorando. Later for errands met L, M, J, Lewis. + all went to Yannaki's for vermouth. Then to

flower market, met F + waited GBS till others came. After lunch girls had siestas - I finished letter to K begun early a.m. Here for tea: Mrs Mack, S Simples, Hazel, Jack, Lewis, F + W, girls, L + N. Much talk + a joyous time till about 7. McCrosby here for dinner. Lights ff just after she left, but on again soon after "". Bed fairly early - was hot Brand. Sleep in saloon.

27. Threatening. Slight rain off + on. Took M + D to Ambx where they met Jr + we went off re passports. Got money, tried to find Gte air service office, went to Bond Bros. re IT Club cruises with friends Cousin F had written about. To Kaufhof, to GBS - Left out of order, walked to GBS after leaving umbrella + parcels in basement. Short call on F, he + Rat L. was below, dashed down to meet her, did errands. Went first to Mrs.

- saw Vlastos' things from Varei, stunning Corfu - a room full of flags being pieced into stunning big robes. To this room - measured case for lining, Gill advised raw silk like in Sparta cases. Went to the atropis for it, also got thumbtacks, left L at Vasili's. Home 12⁵⁰ for brief bathroom before lunch, but mostly cleaning desk drawers. After lunch L took J & M to dip. Cleared up fine - I stayed home - wrote a long letter to Mrs Stewart till nearly tea time. Late tea eating remains. Looked at some of Ols before dressing for dinner at Legation. Early so Peggy & El. could be here to see the Trojans, 9 of us in all, + Beck who saved 13 at table. Much talk home before 12.

28. Fine. Took a long time getting things started but C & L, J & I went to Mrs. to see about cases. By luck got Gill - he secured Geo the carpenter et al. Took D to see G's room - after new things. Home 12.15, Jf soon to G's to see F & M a little before time for Samples' lunch = 2R, 2 boys, 3S, H, L & J, much food, drink & talk. All to Agora, L, H, J to Pet, Jr, Museum with Currie, Lucy showed us 12 to disc, beautiful white-ground one (of Omak's 40yo) found the day before, also saw pots from geom. grave we saw last week. H took L & me to tea Yannatzi's - Saw Mrs Bell, Dilys, Margal, Mam, Fairbanks, Mrs Campbell (Belgrad). Drove out on Mar. road as far as fork to Raphina, nice & green & quiet - Back c 7.15, found Missy C Bell with Dr. Quist - eve, finally got through for Books I Come, II Syri. Read I & Greece (FO book given me by Mac V).

29. Fair, some clouds. Wrote notes before breakfast. Collected - began to pack things for D + M to take. J, M, H, L, I off c. 1/2 picnic to Elencis, going first to Dr. Alvaro. for this permit. Lunched in grove beyond Dept. Then spent a lovely p.m. at Elencis. Terrible mess of things even with Rio's new book. Mrs. later. Back for latish tea, held up by Boule crowd. Quick change, L + to PBA Open Meeting, began on Mani church, Payne on Aph. + Massa excellent but out very late. F + sat with us. Dashed home, quick change dinner = 3 Simplex, Karo, Jack, Henry, H, family.

30. Fine, some clouds. Went at 10 to big re grey skirt - but again before 11 to Amex with Dot, then got money for L, to Chalmers re Delta boats,

ma Rita, Kyd, Rat to Dr to ask about market concert - track to GB, caravans gone. Petrich - L cancelled reservat. Good talk - remonstrance with F till after 1/2 hour car came. L + M had been museum. After lunch did last odds + ends packing (mostly before Orjais). Began letter to T soon after 3. F came about 4:30 for books + stayed for tea. D + M had gone Camp but back at 5. Sam Rem + boys off on "Piloria" (in Adria) at 7. Changed + read paper 8-8:30 Eve wrote long letter to B. Very sleepy -

31. Rather unsettled, showers p.m. Second failing, finished T. Took Mrs Petro to concert vice L. Aitkenom: Rameau 3 ballets, Handel Conc Gross 19, arias Penseroso, Esther - Loula Manta, Unfin Sym Oberon - Ralph - Hazel here to lunch.

Planned out dates with H. All took R. home & saw garden & house. Shower began before we reached Miss Carr's with baby lettuces. Went in for a call, brought 6 of her lett. home. Terribly hard rain. Back for tea, P in, later H.H. L - I to Arch Soc. annual reports on view. Book by S, collected a few things for trip. Eve had Schub Octet, then Brand - III.

April 1. Fine but cold & windy. Went up for H - oh, L - I started c 8⁴⁵ for Corinth. Beautiful drive down, coffee on both. At Cor. went to B's house then S Stoa where Howland showed mosaic floor & further work. Then to Mrs. Met Semper there, also Dick & Agnes. Did sculptures & all but vase room. Picnic lunch in SW shops, sunny place out of wind. Samples also. Back to

Mus. & later to see Hall, road lady, - red orange glycos. Then fine drive to Myc in time for tea. Very cold when we went to Acrop., hard wind, black clouds & lots of snow on all big Pl. mts. Gorgeous flowers at Myc. Did gate, circle, houses, palace via N. side, meg. etc. Later with men guard Panagitsi to Att & Clyt & Aegisth. H greatly impressed. New dining room at hotel has stove. Pleasant Bill at another table. Terribly cold upstairs (to) but has hot water & much bedding. 2. Fine, gorgeous sun in room. Up 7⁴⁵ breakfast outside in the sun. Mrs. Ure + 3 girls + 2 boys at another table. Left C for Acros road good, bridge finished, to Kephalaria, to Naxolia Museum. Gives fine impression, first Myc room in perfect order, also 5 smaller things on top floor. Misc. staff probably to go below where they are putting building

in order. Dugos in plateau, then on to Epizd. to which road is mostly fine, except a few patches with stone. Lovely at 7 AM, but very windy, went to theatre, too cold to sit, so lunched in stadium which was all grassy & flowering. Through arch under road to precinct & walked around pretty well, to Prop leading towards town of Epizd. L-14 went to mus. - I prowled some more before joining them. On to Tigris for a good look around with Karo's plan. To mosque for a late tea, lovely sunset but not same reward. Effect of previous eve with gold light on Vanilia. 4. Fine, L & I did accs. etc. She ff at 10 to Oruig - I began letter to Aunt C. Out 11 thro' garden to Tourism (mudels), Honky, fourth, Gf at 1, 2 to see Fr M. Much talk till L came just before 1. Did a few odds

✓ ends after lunch waiting for MS to turn up. Got M Satir & nice - out to Chios' to see Marath. pottery-house in rock. ravine, very charming, garden library etc. Pottery - a small amt LH (parts of big pot) lots of geom. with some distinctive local designs, b.f. like the some Hellenistic, prob. no Cor. Saw plan of cent. etc. Dora - Mrs Winter there too & all stayed for tea. Back about 6³⁰ & up to see Hazel & talk over our doings. Got a letter to B written in odd moments. Looked over papers etc - after dinner had go at Tong. f 2 weeks back. Handel, another Cor Gr, Water Music, then to Rome for Resp. Batt. Triptych, Niki Satyr, Rivers Snow maidens, Faun, Tristan. At 11³⁰ got from Main Fouillee Quinkt. ^{Terrible dust}

5. Fine. Went off in good time to

Mus. - I finished Aunt C's letter, then via gardens ^{Very windy} to Kaloplatan) out to OB till lunch time. Afterwards wrote Alice M & Mrs Skinner (at 3³⁰ got A and all to Bth. Coll. to see Beaufort, Haydn, Dorotea - Tea afterwards by R. at Danies. Later brought H here & saw her photos, then to Vasili. Eve read & back numbers of NY Times. Good Bach etc in eve.

6. Fine. Scurried around & went 10³⁰ for Young who took me to rehearsal of St John Passion, 10³⁰ - 2³⁰ fine & very int. Soloists Schnatz, Adai, Russell, Rosin Wien & Buda - Home 2⁴⁵, began T after lunch. H, F, M here for tea, also Dth. Eve collected for trip, papers, etc.

7. Fine. Off for Delphi. L, H, I, just before 9. Stopped a few minutes at Elia Theræ. Thibescii for an hour in Mus. Nice old guard. Camera guide very

useful - Addition at rear, new archaic room & above it one with a lot of rings from Halae etc. Some improvement in general case. Lovely in garden. Left 1/2 lunch at Lion. Large crowd children, nice woman friend Mrs. Splendid drive on, lots of snow. Stopped Amphi for beans & coffee. On Delphi zigzag above Chrysor burnt out a wire, but no harm & small delay. Good welcome at Apollo, have 17-16. Excellent dinner, L & I had a walk afterwards as far as Mrs. Lovely starry night.

Early to bed -

scrambling by paths, Mus. till 12.

Speech by Tindalou to French party after lunch - Sista. To Anchora by a frightful road, lots of snow. It took pictures in village. Back to Castel for tea. Hotel - out late a walk up lower street, back alleys, school, upper street, balcony for sunset.

 new with Masters. Past Th. up to For. 9th
 terrace, walk down. Tea, To Gym + Stad.
 Good stay "4 days wonder" eve. Fine moon.
14. Another perfect day, breezy - Good start
 - with M up to Cynthis + all sights
 en route, back to Inachos, Seap., etc via
 coop to house by c 11 for veges. To Po. for
 photos, house on hill, stat. ch. in am.
 PM did quarter by sea, Heron once
 more. Both days Mrs. after lunch.
 Mrs. has been enlarged and not yet
