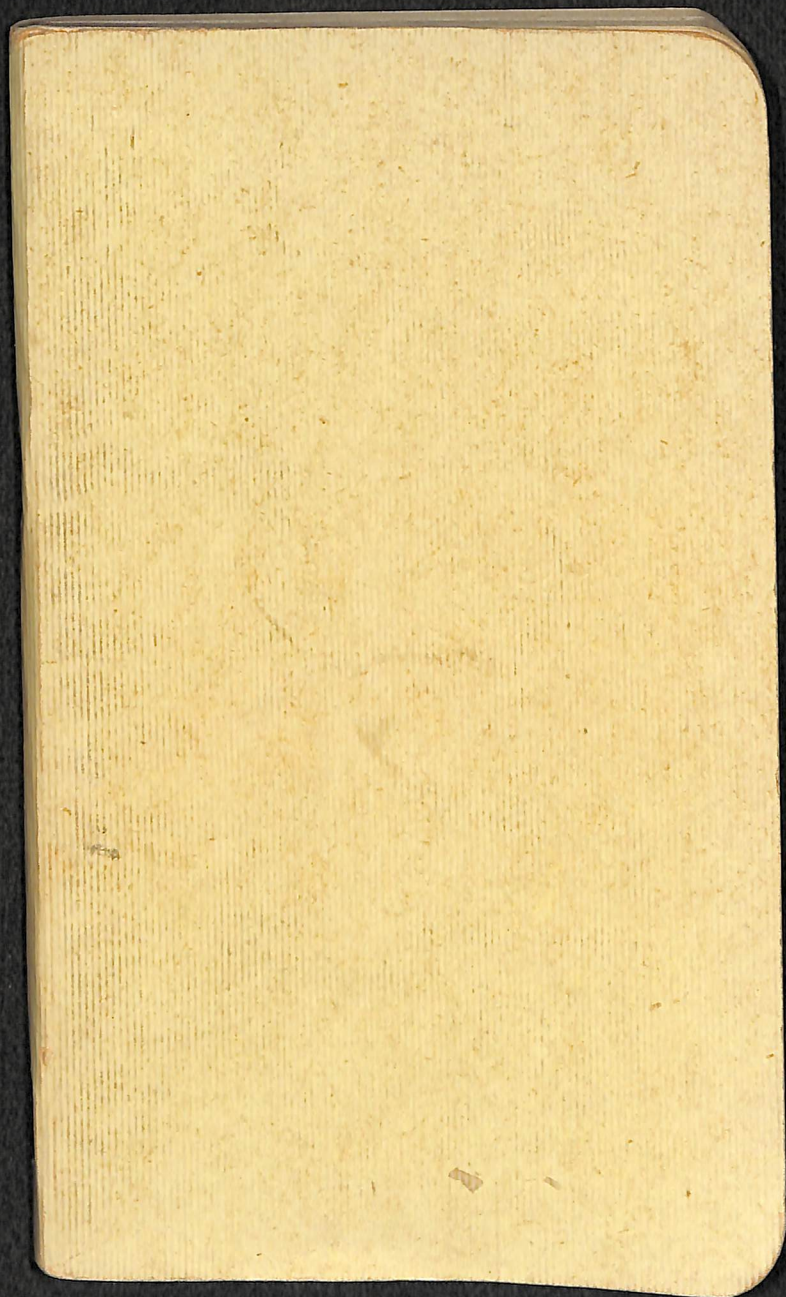

April 16, 1935 - October 27, 1935

Apr. 16. Fine, Else arr Pir 5¹⁰, up at 6, Hk for us before 7, home, leaving H, for tabs & breakfast. Cleared up mail, papers, etc. & out, errands - Orig. Took id-early all day with tidying up in desk, Times etc, mate T. Read some "4 Days" before tea. Vasilis 6³². Eve did a very little Tony - papers.

17. Fine. HV here before 9, went for H call to Parnes. Lowly, Here, not very clear distance but grand day. Took path to west, lots of flowers - grand scenery - Ouzos at Tourisime. Back H - H back to lunch. Photos of Myc, Delphi, Delos etc. after mail - Appie's birthday. Asked her to order from Hef. L - Jont 4 to "25 years of Hellas", pretty poor, as film, as history, selection of events etc. Late tea. Read Ob. in eve - finished "4 Days". St Matt. from Vienna.

18. Fine. Up in good time. Begun B. L & S out to errands - Orij. Back at 11, quick change, H, H, L - I off on picnic to D. Pent. Very windy. Nice footpath now a poor road, for mud, so dusty & less pleasant, but very lovely at brook & monastery. At 4 P.M. met 6 loaves of soldiers out to cut grass. Home about 4, Cubs, duss, finished B. To tea at Loues', H, L, I, 2 Rob, 2 Luce, W Miller, J Shear, Pris, Mrs Morris & others. Took Luce & WM to GBS when went to see F & M at 7³⁰. Resting after great time at Delphi. H here for dinner & she, P, L, I to Acrop. Frightfully windy but beautiful, back soon.

19. Slightly overcast. L & I out by 10 to Phil with old hats & also ordered new. Back before 11 to see Mrs MacV who had a lot of wild flowers to identify. Late L in garden & I to Am Ex (passports

then GBS to see M & F. After lunch had a few minutes - then to 4th Coll, recital by Young. Tea later in Common room, Craig, 2 Pabo, Dilp. Took, Damon & a few others. L & I at 6 to Oly. St Matt. Much better than I expected, all local talent also - Knox surprisingly good. Not over till nearly 10. L went after Part 2. Late cold supper, heard last part again from Germ. stat. & still later had finale from Buda. Wrote Cousin F

20. Fine. Devoted most of am. to going through bundles in attic, weeding out, trying on clothes. To Dil. at 1 for giddy lunch of H's: 2 Robinson, Luce, Alison, H, 3 family. Great spread. Home 3³⁰. Here for tea F, M, H, had pictures of trips Mye & Delphi. L & I did Tong. before & after dinner.

21. Fine. Up in good time, wrote T. L & I to H Eirene, sweet peas, Ben concert, conducted by Georgesco: Meist, Br I, Death - Tr,

Sorcerer's App. Temp. much too slow.
Write Mahel W after lunch. Read some
Laidlaw's Delos. Joan Evans, P, H, to ka, lot
of fun. L & J did a Tong. More Delos.

22. Fine, not too hot. Read a good deal
more D, Ben & Daisy, 11th - 1. Tea Giannaki
with H, 2 Stevens, 2 DeCaravallas. H
back with us till after 7. Keather
Troy letters etc, pictures Sm - Co. Did
German notes for Venus stems before -
after dinner. Schub. Octet from violin
later read Sketch, sent by T with lot
of pictures of M. Tempest.

23. Fine. H came around before 10 - we went
to Mus. Got Gill. to show H the pinakes,
then saw his apib. - He ordered a
small archaic head. To Yann. for ves-
mouth, to Pris, Two 'Aos, 4 Bunk. Left me
at CBS for call, left c. 1 del act. Did a
few more odds with clothes, M came in

to return & get books. Went c 4¹⁵ for H - all
to ka Neqr. Later drove to Voul. & saw lake,
hd mastichas, back sunset time. Eve din-
ner: 2 Linforth, 2 Robinson, Lucy T, Alison F,
Rodney Y, H, Raeth, 3 family.

24. Fine. L & J out 10 to Phil, try new navy,
to Kodaki for AM. Home for a little, then
to Onij till lunch. Read more ASA (Co)
after. L, H & J to ka CBS with F-M, some
Euclides & Helen, Mrs. Pabis & her mother
(Aust. Baltazzi). Saw ASB a few moments,
also Joan. Had to leave early to go to Mrs
Parsons. Terrible road, grand view.
Nice long stay. Took H home - was qf
to 2nd half St Matt then Bth. said
on new local wireless, so came home
& heard it from here. Later had Bessie
viol. conc (Bessie), read St N Punch.

25. Fine. Annona here & fixed for L, also
buckle on my grey lace. To Phil. -

tried old dyed navy. To Amby for money & found mix-up about L's ticket on "Sat." Went to L. Hall for her, has to wait - till Costa bought passport. Dash to Amby but Archie had gone, so back to L.H. Paper after lunch, then for H - to Amby at 3 - saw Arch. Later L & I went to Guial's on an errand, found they had gone to Prague so returned via Keph. & left things at K. Milan's. H here for tea, saw her G.M. B.H.H. etc. L & I out before 7 to Peterp. for ⁶⁵marce. for sleepers. Also full for a lovely navy - white c.d.c. Back to shoe place M ⁶⁰⁰ as dress slip-pers. All very close & heavy - done 7th Eve tried some Toy. but sleepy - Met Leon II, Emperor (E. Nuy) for IX from Prag - Read H₂ & ST.

26. Greyish, muggy. Grolw TB, Baltz. H

Came in before 11³⁰ & we went Amby, not ready, so to Gian. to wait; still no passports. Took H to L.H. In pm. all 3 left c 2³⁰ & went via Piacenza to get permit-stamped, then Phal for "Saturnia" Peter had all ok & sent Spiro on board with us. L's purse friend fixed up good cabin for H, to herself. Had a look around, remounts & back before 5, home for tea. Met H.H. on the steps as we came in - later to Epit. at STA. Good procession later. Caught up a few papers later. Reger & Minkat, Breslau.

27. Fine. Tel from W.M. before breakfast & call w. long talk re P & Uncle H. L & I went later in morning to legation, then to Rodas, Bondi's at for children's chocolates, to GB to hunt up E Fodick. Talk with her, then saw F.M. Bought EP back for lunch with us. Left c 3 & took her GB, got F.M. & went to H. Merkou. A perfect afternoon, lots of flowers, new trees etc. Back for tea at Cecil. Home soon after 7. Quiet -

evr, cleared up lots of old papers - Began
"Lost Horizon". At midnight out on
balcony, lit a light candles.

28. Fine. Great Easter. Amusing tiny
dolls from Piet - wrote T, 4/13. Had to
lunch with Celia R., in colonnade, 3 Dr.,
3 Pioneer, Alex III, 2 Lowe, 2 Linforth girls,
Pussy, Bacon, Huey T = 17, very cheery time.
Back to settle down to more letters etc.
Wrote R. - Went for Fr M - took to Euclides
five times, N. on Byz mus. Late dinner.
Sch. conc. from someone, Paula, "Lost H"
tried a little Tony.

29. Greyish. Showers in night. Divided the
day between letters, H, Dr T, notes, and
News items which I typed for L. Out
3⁰⁰ to Marousi on errand to Sotir. Found
both home. Name day, Geo (Anastomus till
after Easter). Great news. Box engaged
to Sedgwick. Back in time for tea to

which came Fr M. Brought us 2 Fletcher +
3 Sayers, shall have a feast. Also got "Oly - Six"
- Jett "Thuc. Ath" ordered from Heffer, so read
a lot of latter before & after dinner.

30. Slightly overcast, warmer. Wrote GMM while
L. edited News St. Went to GB at 12¹⁵ for fare-
well remount with Fr M also go off on "Prov".
Lunch with Ralph, 2 Linforths, Young. In
garden after. Did a lot of reading in Thuc A.
ff. on. Tony. before & after dinner.

May 1. Fine, rather muggy & partly overcast.
Wrote Miss Chapman. L & J out to Paris (shut)
Hermst (Buckle) & box (passports) brought her
home & went to Mus. to see Phil, much
upset about empty case & still more so about
cost of key. To Gill, each on the other. Lunch
Amelch garden 20A, 2 Mather, very amus-
ing in many ways. Home till tea, read
more Th Ath. After tea around Δ (very dry)
& to Negv. Found J & as we were leaving

in came 14 who had left flowers for us.
No papers, exc. Enq. Read Obs in eve -
ThA. Scraps of music, no programmes.

2. Greyish & heavy. Went c 10 to Quij, all
ready for me. Joined later by L. Took her
home. Call Dk, walk back via garden. More
things ready for trip, cleared out a lot of
chif. drawers etc. For tea: 2 Marner, Vase B,
3 Bunnell, Piet - later, also HV. We four had
masticas 7.15. Times & L N in eve. Early
to bed.

3. Fine, clearer air. Shower in p.m. Ralph
in c 10, then L & J to Mus. - arr. most of
available. Things. Left her Quij - did
errands, Amby tickets to Coast. etc.
Miss Rivera & Karo here for lunch. Packed
later - Alex & Celia in to say good bye
but wouldn't stay tea. Out before 6 or L
to Quij & J for shippers, Vasili. Eve
Times, some things for Trip. Finished L & H.

4. Fine. Did some packing, then L & J to
Mus. Put pots in, saw Plato's things in
room up stairs. Left early - did errands,
Amby etc & GB to find F Dudley's Miss
Ogden but she was out. Piet came home
at lunch time to say good bye. Many
errands to do before leaving c. 3. Soon
on Helouan, good cabins 75-76. Tea, 7p
at 5, lovely p.m. beautiful part Sun.
Silly show at cinema.

5. Fine, after a very dull night.
Passed Troy c 6.45, couldn't see hill
or house, but all coast view fine -
Chauak before 8. Stayed in bed for
breakfast & "unnatural death" begun
night before. Up c 11, on deck, remarks
before early lunch. At table with
Miss Crowell (Rocky.) very int. Write
long letter to B. on Gk cond. Dotted
c 5, Ediet & Carolyn met us. Slow

getting off on acct. porters but had
good Hagenhit-man - no trouble at
customs - Hussein with car at hand.
Lovely drive, wist. - judas. Alice -
Miss Burns on doorstep. Unpacked
before very jolly supper with EF, CW,
CA, Mrs P, Miss B. A, L, J. Bridge
afterwards EF, EF, CG.

6. Fine, cold. ^{write T in bed.} L, Alice rd off c. 10 for
town. Parked at Ott. Bank for L's
L & C, then errands. Back streets to
place for drawing paper, taxi to Baker,
walk to Tok. - left parcels - coat. to
Gt Co for visas, huge crowd but Lam-
bers most kind when he found out
about us. To Natta re boat Sat. to
Chanak. Walk Harty, met Mrs Gillespie
in street, to P Palace - lunch with
F-M. Samples here, had lunch -
Margot to Dr Si. All hot coffee

together, then went with F-M to Mrs.
Aziz ill with grippe, but got over cards.
Saw bronze things, esp serpent, Hadrian,
much Palest. Syrian Cypri pottery -
To museum app. tiles, plates etc, to
Hittite museum, walk via St Ewens
to St Sophia. Nartex looks splendid
with crosses exposed. Huge targets now
down from interior. Tommy working in
S. gallery. Saw him afterwards -
L-J back to Tok. for tea - Hussein came
for us. Back soon after 6. Brief pause
tubs etc. Caddy supper here = 2 Skin-
ners, 2 Moorhead, 2 Pully, EF, A, L, J.
So good to see S. again, talk Grace
for hours. Lovely party.

7. Fine, cold. Real more D'Sayers in bed,
up late, wrote H. Lunch PP with
Samples, up late in their salon. Out in
good time to Call. to change before tea.

Mrs Miss Menroe, King, Ruggles, Mitchell
Gillespie, Campbell, Moorhead, de Vries,
Skinner, F-M, many family - Bridge
in Prettyman's. Eventually with Mrs
E, C Wright, Ruggles, broke up c 7³⁰.
Extras out for buffet supper - Comp.
bet Gillespie, Owen. Cherry Party.
E. Fine, not much warmer. Went c 10³⁰
to St Soph. & met TW in gallery. Very
impressive up ramp, huge galleries
Saw 2 triple mosaics, on E-S. E =
Christ, Comp. head on his right, S = Ch
J Boat on left. Very fine middle 11¹⁵.
Out to Golden Gate to look for
Miss C's clinic but couldn't find
it - fine drive. Back to PPr left big
roll paper for Samples, F-M in -
we said good bye. To Party, Tok
where Miss C came - had lunch.
A.M, Mrs P, called for us, picked up

Mrs Boydok & went bazaars, not on
our roads. Very chilly, fighting off cold
as well as hoarseness. Back for Latic's
tea. Dined with Owen, first leaving
Pratt. at Robt Ed. At dinner = 2 Camp-
bells, Trakke, 3 of us, Owen. Lovely
fest & fine dinner, home in good time.
9. Greyish, warmer, cleared fine. Did
not go to C. in morning, took it a
little easy, finished 7 Men (Duffing)
did scraps. End of Assen. speech
(Tunc) college lunch + Monroes, Eto,
2 Rothbarts, 1 other from RC. All for
coffee in A's after wards. Off at 3
took Mrs M, P, & Fisd. - by various
ways to Therapia to see Battagis,
early call with them. Return by
wound about back road, heading out.
Back at 6. Dined Emb = 4 of us,
Campbells, 2 Gill, Dr S, 2 May, Ruggles

Mitchell, Corp, 2 King, ^{near St. R.} 2 at Indian Club
& way (been a lot in Ath). Nice party
wake up early.

10. Slightly greyish, clear later. Spent
am. lazily at coll. till about 12 -
went to Am Hosp. to see Margot, then
to Embassy for lunch, just the 4,
spent all day packing except for a
drive out by back road to where I go
habitually to walk. Back to Emb. for
tea & escorted out to coll. by RPS who
gave us cigs from Ankara conference.
Supper upstairs, A, Mrs P, L, J. All too
exhausted for bridge in eve, went
to bed fairly early - 11:15 am.

11. Fine. Up early to pack & got it done
before breakfast. Left c 10 - went for
Margot, Alice, Mrs P, L & J. To St Soph.
but it was closed so took M around
Hipp. - Blue Mosque, then they left us

at Mus - we did part lower floor, the
oases, Cross etc. Taxi to Natta where we
met the others - took M home, then back
by c 12 when C Gurney brought a Turk.
girl whom L. filled up with inf. about
arch. study in USA. Lunch in dining
room. Left c 3, got Mrs Gillespie, hosp. for
Margot & she & I went on, met L & Mrs G
on pier, that horrible place across
bridge where boatmen are such rob-
bers despite good wages hit man. Got on
"Bartini", small & full of soldiers, but
we 3 had gynaks. & were comfortable. On
deck till too cool, then small salon
wh. we had as dining room for picnic
supper. Began "Box Hill Murder."

12. Fine. Up c 6, Charat 8, went along-
side dock. Off soon, must. There & all
to Bacon's - Uncle B top form, Mrs B
in bed, up later. Much talk, Miss

Calvert gave us breakfast - flowers. All around garden, animals etc. Long time to get P. de Saj. returned - left c 11. Uncle B rejoiced over JET. Splendid dive out. M has new Chev. Had 2 cars for all the stuff. Arr. lunch time, all on deck, incl. Forsdyke who had to leave after lunch. Much unpacking - settling before tea, then he wanders to State + saw where dump has been cleared, tremendous lot done, Mainw hill, N. side Jerry I city houses - wall, E (Carl) F (Jack) G own own. Read a lot of old papers to catch up. Now in eve, new Comm. Remsey Bay. 13. Very muggy. Started in early. Have Halim - Aziz, + 2 others temporarily for carrying. Began clearing across W. walls where Levey had made good stratif. plan, also on S wall where we

found another good one under it. Keeping things along as best as pos. Very heavy + oppressive all day, better later. Finished "Box H" before dinner. Evened papers - began "Inspector Kelsey's Dinali". 14. Windy, sun in + out. Grad. clearing down, Aziz went home ill after breakfast. 3 men. Levey down wall - then we took it out. General Gall, + 3 aids came before lunch. Had them for coffee - wrote Min Burns - made up diary. L + J held up a long time until C. was free of visitors, so we took out most of X after he came + Halim cont. taking .10m. ends down. Cool in eve, sat around reading detective story. 15. Fine, an ideal day, sun. Breeze but not too much. Clearing beyond orth. wall, another pit, which I dug out - found full of carbonized vetch. Got

sieve from Johnny after lunch, but they were the devil to do. Got a large number in cig. box. Finished clearing pith. Halim & red socks took up stones bet E & E' after C had photographed them. More officers around in a.m. work slow bec. only one besides ourselves to cut. Began letter to B before dinner ^{mostly} _{fin} late in eve. Had Bach Toc. & Fugue, B minor suite, E♭ minor prelude.

16. Fine, another grand day. Bergier here yesterday. Cleared around work - took out all but one. Got another man, he & Halim finding floor lumber. Did a lot with the "chopper" available. Went to see Mrs S, ^{with} horses. Maj. Lee here to lunch. Letter FG said Dr T died Apr 22. Finished B letter after lunch. Spent p.m. chopping busily near orth. wall. Day's

work got a good deal done. Took it easy after tub. Reading "Farewell to Fifth Ave", some in eve too. Brahms III.

17. Fine. Being holiday did not get up as early as usual. Cleaned shods before breakfast, spent a.m. sorting shods, outside - trying to make joins inside. Wrote H. Shods again in p.m. in and out. Got all bags done & cleared up many of last year's, but no joins. Out on veranda before dinner. Read IAr. in eve.

18. Fine but warm. Chopping hard till breakfast, changed to thinner clothes & chopped again till lunch. Visitors from yacht "Landfall": Mr & Mrs Paul Hammond, Mr & Mrs Lady Rachel Stuart. Here to lunch. Very hot p.m. so did not chop long, getting down to III a floor. Wrote T before & after dinner.

19. Fine, warm but breeze on veranda. L, H, J

inspecting Halim's kitchen garden when
Skinners arrived, a.m. boat, Kemil's car.
Splendid day with them. Spent a.m.
going the rounds with them - Carl.
Mrs S. siesta after lunch, out seeing
trench hill after 3 then talked Mr S on
veranda till tea, much gossip about
C should pretty warm, mess etc. I here
for dinner, off before 10 to get boat.

20. Fine but fearfully windy, chain straps.
Trench A all day, down more
than 1 m. but on ~~the~~ floor yet. Neutley
arr. in a.m. doing rounds of excav.
in parts of M. Another pit this before we
stopped p.m.

21. Fine. Breezy. Still going down in
Trench A. L-J cleared face of wall
and Emin cleared around corner for C
to photograph. Jerry found baby's skull
in I house, under stone slab. Wrote

Alice after lunch. Trench A in
afternoon, not to bottom. Work
cont. on taking out the "hump". CF
Breint. in eve.

22. Fine but very windy & colder hill etc.
Trench A till a floor level, more
hump, studied a little Turkish.
Saw Mrs S's house, kitchen etc.
Began taking out pit. to extend Tr A
to N. wall. Small hrs wall in it
(centre of I.). Mended coat after lunch,
fearful job.

23. Fine, breezy but not violent. Got
I wall in ext. of Tr. A. Began trench
from A to N wall. Wrote Piel, to
send by Neutley who left after lunch.
Cleared up on "peak" towards SE, dis-
turbed earth. Halim killed snake. Leary
drawing section Tr. A. till tea time. Emin
in tr. at ab. 2 to A. Got all in order

to leave over Friday & Sat. Read "Craig
Murder".

24. Fine. Got up early, 3 pr. shoes before
breakfast. Sorted seeds a.m. out in
even. Did little inside, too busy.
Wrote T-H. Spent rest p.m. before
after tea in pottery room. Read a
few papers after. Finished Craig.

25. Fine. Spent a.m. in & out on seeds
also till after 2, then into & left 3
for Charak, lovely drive. Went to
pharmacy, Mittal, then Bacons. To
Kirk with Uncle B for much talk
re Jeth, Dinsmoor, Ash Parth. Uncle
B's Dixon boy, etc. Later had tea
with Mrs B, Miss C, Maj L under
tree. Tried to get into Mrs. but it
was closed, also tried in Halitali
to see Shabim's garden but he
had not come back. Home for

dinner. Eve read Scheide's Priene
with Uncle B. Back to Fugue,
Part IV, poor.

26. Fine. Emin in trench, found wall
marked on D's Plan VI, Halim out on
peak. 2 more pits. After lunch read
more Priene with L made washing list.
At 3³⁰ went through fields w Remsi B.
to see his moales, geom good designs
1 cent = stag 1 = red legged bird, nice
patterns & colors around. White, 3 red,
yellow green. 3 in room to which steps
led, one with GK insc. of donor of family.
Smaller rooms beyond. Had to see D's
large mysterious system. Brick mf?
Yaya there. Back for tea. Eve read P. &
saw some C's ill. & prof. Herdum.

27. Fine, still hot. Spent all day till 4
digging out pits 15, some good frags.
no whole pots. Had in pit, feet in

dump, filthy but amusing. Good grey
pots up behind where out. were. L & Hal
cleared them. 17 pits. 20 far. Cutting
central section down to level of pass.
Sat on veranda till dinner. Br II Pi-
ano Conc. eve. Finished Prime.

28. Fine, still very hot. Began summer
hours. Up 5¹⁵, work from 6. Did not
dig, much to watch on clearing central
front sect. to floor. Another pits. Did
a lot of sherd sorting late am
after tea. Comm. had 2 guests to
lunch, Sir Charal Mus + girl, only
Turkish. Sent 2 pieces luggage in
by Mustafa. Eve took it easy till dinner
all on veranda after, Br I, gorgeous

29. Fine, very hot. Out in good time -
dug out pits 16 before 10³⁰, tried to
cool off a little. L & J packed after
lunch & she wrote up notebook.

Watched others dig p.m. also some
sheds in house & out of doors. Going to
lower level in block N. of Tr A. All set to go
in a.m. when Must. arrived at dinner
time with messages couldn't stop boat.
Had Br III & sat on veranda.

30. Fine, hot. On job again early. Emin clear-
ing pits 12 & found what we thought a
child's skull, much excitement. After lunch
one of Jerry's experts came to clean it &
showed E. how to do it, also Halim on
side but he was working to get contin-
g wall II(?) but cross-wall & or wall.
Proved to be 2 goats but got large parts
of a splendid big bridg. to like Art's.
Real papers before dinner & eve had
Br bird. concerto.

31. Terrible wind in night, gale & dull
a.m. so Must. thought it would be bad
& didn't bring extra cars & we called

off the picnic to Neandria. Didn't work too hard, most sheds + up - on all day in pottery house. Building on additions progressing rapidly. Siesta hour finished "Course from Mystery." wrote Trot before dinner.

June 1. Fine, a perfect day. Maj Lee out for breakfast at 8. Jerry called home. Samples + Lee stayed home from picnic. Off before 10, 2 cars = L, J, C, 2 Ramsons; Margot Jack, Leney, Gatt. + Com. Splendid drive to milit. rd. near Thymbra up in mts - along valley of Peamander. Splendid views, lots of pines, oak woods etc. Stopped Ezzine obt. permits, then on by bad country roads through several villages - oaks to Karambul. Got a nice little lunchback to go as guide, division map. Picnic in

lovely place, despite ants. Cars up past village - got peasant boy to take up to Neandria across, after detour to see big rocks, 2 of which had *Tismenos Dios*. Strange medley grotesque rock formation - fertile valleys, lots of trees - up to aer. on which nearly whole circuit 12 cent. walls, many towers, several gates. Not full but good breeze, almost a gale on top. Very fine. Not much of temple which has a row of cols. down center. Coarse stone (granite?) pinkish tinge. Perh. had wooden cols. Fine up above, blue hill c + ³⁰ - down to cars at lunch place. A few oranges then back to K. where we were treated to coffee etc. Lovely drive back, marvellous views, from top saw Sam, Myt, Ma, Tendo etc, lovely sea views. Grand day -

- Back about 6. All too tired & dirty to do much in eve. except Trebs.
2. Fine, hot, some breeze. Hunted in dump near pit. 15-16 to see if any of red cup, no luck. Hal. & Em. still cutting down front sect. floor all day. Found 19th pit. Levy around to measure & add pit. & walls to plan. Wrote it after lunch. Began Cards chap. summarizing up the Tombs.
- Poked around to see what corn. bet W wall & lower (II) to N of cross wall. Read part "Bear Man's Death" in eve.
3. Fine, N wind. Worked a.m. again near 15-16 & got one good shed of red pot. Digging much of day out on peak. Another pit. before closing time. One has Br "Double Conc." Cool & eat indoors in eve.
4. Fine, cool, N wind. Cut down on peak
