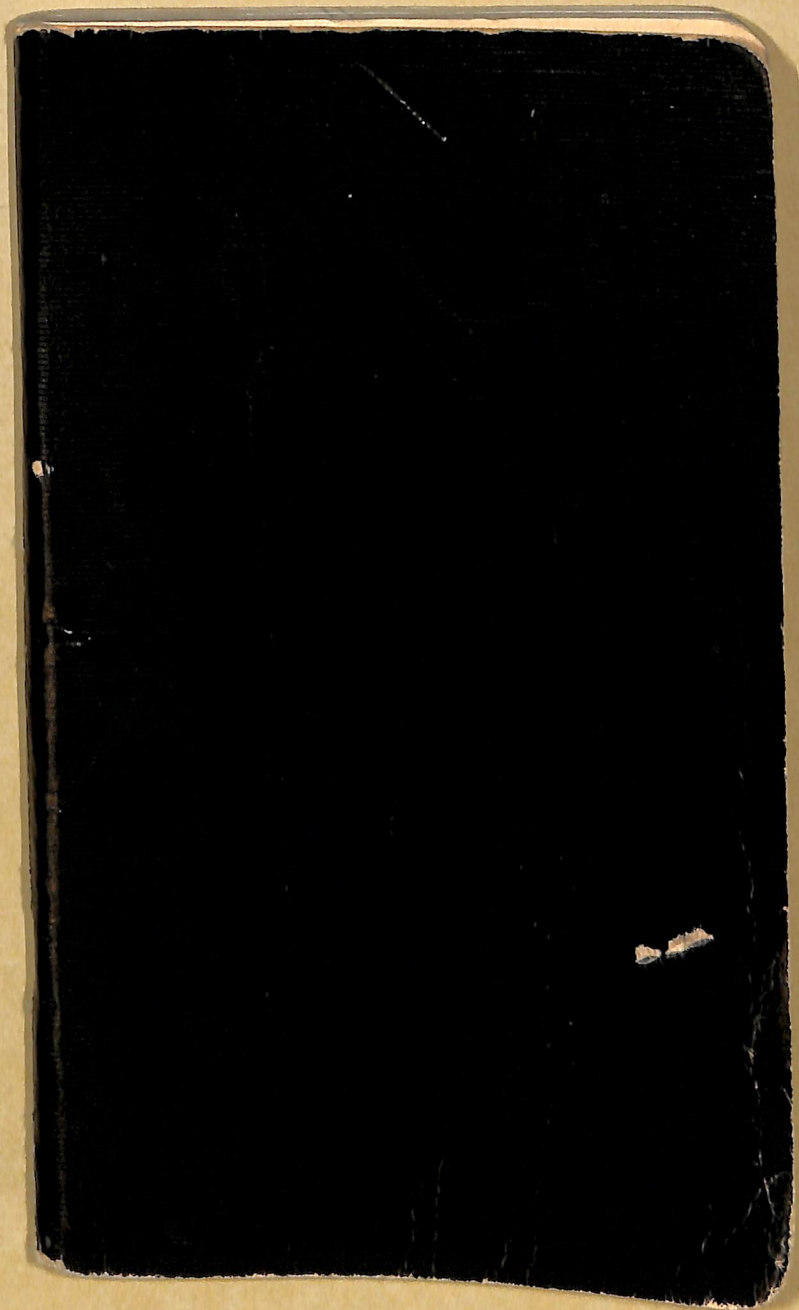


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October 28, 1935 - June 13, 1936

Oct. 28. Greyish, milder. Didn't get much done except odds & ends - pressing, suit etc. Began L. Off by 2<sup>34</sup> bus, stopped Faulk & Ode & to Mrs Hopewell, also Mrs Temple - later Miss Jones before tea. Got bus at Cent Hotel 6<sup>30</sup> through to Bilton. Tea & supper - back to Dickers com. Wrote more L in eve 8-9 until T came back. Read more procher. Had <sup>G64</sup> IV by Hayden - Brahms (B367)

29. Sunny! breezy, rather mild. Cleared up a lot in desk in a.m. More to L & sent by R. early. While T practised, I had great hoing out in room. Wrote Marjorie, K, Franer, JHK & Patrick before lunch. Read Tel after, copied Torg. cut newspapers, heard gram & d'Indy Sym, some Carmen etc. To tea 4.15 then to-rett to see Queenie & her sister Mrs Leening who now are in Rugby. New neighbours (Wine Co. et.) there also a young man, Mrs L & dau. Stayed a long time. Foundations. Early

madrigals Peter, R got car back  
from Coventry. Finished poacher. Went 9  
to Haugh's for coffee. saw pictures of  
their trip. Did 0<sub>2</sub> anagrams before after supper  
30. Fine but greyish. T went to Rugby &  
after look at papers had a go at game  
off on all 22 morning. Bridge from  
Gogroup, also at my table Brown, Mrs  
G, Maule; - at 15 Irene, Samuelson,  
Haugh. Lost 2 won 1, total loss c. 3<sup>5</sup>  
All back together in bus. Core T. to  
music rehearsal, heard some choruses  
- D'Aranyi in Verdi.

31. Dark & dismal, some rain. Westcott,  
Jakt, odds & ends. Began L. Red come  
Jane. Cook gram. Chausson Poeme (Mendels.)  
Early supper. Music club at Ch. House  
small hall, R took us both ways. Quar-  
tets Haydn G64, Moz. Tract 2  
Scarlatti Arias with IV, fine. Rushed

back for news. but all is upset with elec-  
tion's speeches.

Nov 1. Vile day, but did clear p.m. Went to R.  
posted 3 pack. books, Parris (L's clock & parts)  
wood, dairy road mvt & back on 10. E/Hub  
here. Heard end practice. Papers - tea, Jane  
Bridge p.m. Hester's, wacker till overtaken  
by Mr Haugh. Bar table: Haugh, Sam, Glade;  
T, Maule, Hester, Hopwell. Stayed till  
late after party ended - had game Mrs Mott.  
Saw boy. Won back part of losses. Got some  
Tiramat music, songs - cho. for which we  
didn't care much. Note K, began MTV

2. Cloudy, warmer. Went fairly early with chrys.  
then to get a second Times. Cleared out  
- ditched many papers. R - I out for  
golf p.m. Tract in wet - cold. Not so  
bad as it was pretty muddy - did 12  
holes. Back for tea, got 26 N with  
Piet's Aqua pots. T - I did Times, 21st

Moreilly, Spring.

3. Fine morning, rain before night. All ff also Barbara. T-J played, & down but both fairly decent. Back in good time. Tony, was "Anagorising" which we never expected to get but did. Rent ST, O<sub>2</sub>, wrote B, H, & Tony. Some L, M Graniter before breakfast.

4. Unsettled but not bad. Off to London 9.30 very comfortable. Coffee at flat then to Gk Cos. for good interview with Romano, visa & furniture. Short time to do anything at home. Met K. Eble for lunch. Left about 3 walk St J. Put M to Am Ex. Quickly done about freight & ordering tickets. Presented into Cont. Stand (book railway). Back to flat for tea & puzzles & supper. Eve to "Espionage" most amusing show chiefly on train or. Exp. with M home very funny.

5. Fine. Out in good time to Dorothy in Blauford St for hat & while they were asking it went along Baker St to Seapridge for apartment. Back to flat, walk to 8 Shanker for lunch with Dr O'Callis & afterwards coffee in S.C.R. with a cheerful crowd. Nice chat, left early, went Shaftes, Regent etc. looking at dresses. Tea at 7, Clivia Shebban there. Left early for Burl. Home, Hellenic meeting. Sat with Joan Evans. & Talbot-Rice excellent on Iran. info. on Ck & Capt Byz. Remarks, Sykes, G.F. Hill & Sir A. whom I saw. Back for supper at no 4, to Marie Tempert, S Thondyke & A. Matthews in "Short Story" rather too ragerish, wonderful acting. A delicious show.

6. Fine, sunny morning. Begun L. Out about 10, left coat Achille, then to Buck P with crowd & saw part of wedding

procession & afterwards royal fam.  
on balcony - huge mobs, back via Green  
Park. Lunch at chauxerie under Tree.  
Back to flat, out c 3 - saw procession  
en route to St P, open carriage w. 4  
red postillions, police - guards escort.  
Friedrich L. Early tea. Sun Time Book  
Exhib. Dorset Walk. Fine show, huge  
crowd - Heard Agate, S Thordike in  
chairs. Great squash. 15 - I lost each  
other in crowd but met at Queen's  
Hall. BSE (Harty) Dan J, Chopin I  
exquisitely played by Josef Hofmann,  
Moz. K. - Finale (Direct J), Walton  
Symphony, very mod but interesting.  
Got bite of supper in interval. Twisted  
apple, not too bad. Did Til. curson.  
7. Greyish, mild fog. K. out for errands  
- I stayed in - visited flat. That  
ans. 11.15, coffee & out soon. Begun

to rain. Taxi to Leic. Sq. Th. for "Moscow  
Nights" fine film, Baur, Olivier, P. Dudley  
hard. To Corner H. for late lunch. Pouring  
K. I saw me on bus - I lent T umbrella.  
Out at "Tatler" for 1/2 hr. Then flat. Mrs. G  
made tea. Taxi to Weston J<sup>20</sup> lots of  
room. R. met me. Quiet - we went  
papers etc.

8. Misty, Men cleared. Wrote L, Effie before  
breakfast. Spent a.m. indoors, papers, pres-  
sing, Jane. After lunch R. called for  
Marc, Men to Plaza hoping to see Starbo on  
screen, news changed, wedding pictures -  
G. F. Hills "Look up Layk" very funny. Met  
Tate on return bus, late tea. That back  
at 7. We did Til, read R. Tomie - Delius  
(Hartman)

9. Wet, clearing. Wrote K, Mabel G, Hesper. S.  
before breakfast. T. off for popping day  
boxes. Tawny chrys. to church. Papers &

Jane rest of a.m. All out golf in p.m. -  
did 9 holes. Cleared quite decent but  
muddy. Back good time for tea. T & J did  
Times puzzle & an Everyman. Eve read Delius.

10. Fine, some clouds. Wrote Riste, B, & Trace,  
Bedford, H, did all sorts of nasking etc.  
R to church parade so T & J did  
some Torg. in morning. Out after  
lunch to golf, did 9 holes, dark  
early, good game, rather muddy -  
Back about 7<sup>30</sup>. After tea got the  
rest of Torg, read papers, also in  
eve. Strutton III did Quintets Dvorak  
- Froulten, Silk in Schub, Schum  
etc. incl Froule. Eve had Verdi selec-  
tions & BBC v Williams F. min. sym  
Elgar I.

11. Armistice Day. Misty at first. Then  
cleared. Up 5<sup>30</sup> and T, R, J left 6<sup>15</sup>  
for Wrath Silvie. Stopped on way at

Dun Cow & saw Simpson, took him with us.  
Good crowd there and so at breakfast. Sat  
between Mr & Mrs Frost. Frost responded for  
visitors. Old crowd, Bussy, Eadon, Quar. etc  
New. Some songs by Tim & another. New  
laud song. Noon. Big feast, health to old  
- new dukes, 4 new. Back soon after 9.  
Rather unsettled morning, but papers,  
write H, read Jane etc. P.m. bridge at Booth-  
royd. Picked up by Warford & "Wander".  
Others there were Mrs B, Mrs W, Mrs half & J,  
Mrs M, Middle, Brown, Trot. Barbara took  
T's place when T left early to see Hoskyn  
about R. Must start holiday Friday.  
Got lift back. R out at Legion dinner.  
Did ev. & others, finished Delius. Of  
course it was Censtaph since we had  
from 10.20 on. Very impressive.

12. Fine. Off for London, train comfortable  
but late more than 1/2 hr. So stayed



wrote to Hill after 12. Got new umbrella<sup>07</sup>  
at Pounds'. Met Piet - office at Cui. at 1,  
also Cecil & Sibyl Sanderson & all had an  
excellent lunch - cheap time. Went to  
Amber & drew cheque, paid tickets &  
£10.8. £400 £34  
freight, then back to flat for early tea.  
BSA meeting at 5, saw Dilyp, Blackway &  
france, Austin Jenkins, Evans, Alan  
who sat with me, then Lorimer, talk  
afterwards with her. Got Hill in chair -  
Blackway on tumb at 10.0. much  
good material well interpreted but a  
dull lecture. Back 6.45, supper in.  
To "Call of a Day" very amusing. Fay  
Compton & Owen have in chief parts.  
Crossroads on return.

13. Rain in night, but cleared. Stayed in  
Hill Tann. about 11. All had coffee -  
then T & I to Bourne & H. looking for Shik  
Amy Blatt. All gone, walk to Neale.

romans, had none, then to Vogue where they  
Tel - found out. Taxi to Wilbraham House,  
Dr Lindley Scott with whom novel. Star.  
No one staying. Beautiful house, old  
furniture, Chinese, porcelain, terrace-gar-  
den, Byz. col, well kept, sculpt. reliefs etc.  
Delightful party, others: 2 Murray whom  
we had met at Sir HHS private view  
last year. So good to see Mr S again. He  
looks very handsome though he says not  
well. Delic. lunch, much talk, turn in

over puzzle, so to bed. No rain all day.  
14. Election Day. Wet underfoot, but dried.  
Off 9.30 to Seeps. for hair at 10. Letter  
to Whitehall Th. for tickets, tube to  
Walthamstow & Red Vic. for more. Back  
at 12, cleaned up & off to lunch at  
H.S. Nice time, first mother & the  
girls - recitals, then at lunch

Sir H. - still in studio after wards. Saw  
lots of lovely things, some S. France, a  
few Greek, also book by son. Took parcel  
for Beryl. Stayed in 19 from NPCA. to  
Sadler's Wells, Boris ticket, back to flat  
before 4, Mrs G gave me tea. Back on 5<sup>20</sup>  
had begun to drizzle, wet on way & in  
Rough. R met me & I had time to  
change before supper when we had Mac  
pleasant. Eve heard part of Gerontius  
Dismond, Nash, Foreik. but had to get into  
room but too much election yet.  
15. Cruik - very windy. Made up diary.  
Hard rain by breakfast. T & R got off for  
Salcombe about 10, well loaded. Spent long  
time clearing out newspapers. Wrote JAKT,  
Macau, Fraser, Risk. Took 2.30 bus, left shoes  
Allen, went to PO, to Alderson for bridge. Had  
cleared somewhat. Other H ofenell. Temple  
nice time, stayed late, but 5 min, came

out even. Back about 7. Eve heard "Eden End",  
Stems on kitchener, BBC (Sargant) Bach  
Fant. Aug. C Min, CF Sym.

16. A perfect day, bright sun, mist, cold -  
Out 10 to village, posted 2 book parcels Ath,  
ordered taxi from Harold, flowers here on  
return, yellow chrys., took Rem, went all  
around garden, lovely out. Took 2.25 to R.  
Faulkner's bill, another book package,  
Parrin's L's pearls + bill, Over, shoes from  
Allen - other odds + ends 3.20 bus out.  
Took camera + coins to winter bag, across  
fields for tea at 4. After Mrs W's Jill  
came too, nice quiet time, bag pleased  
with things. Mrs W. gave me a lift to  
Long Barns. In about 6.15, light BBC Pr.  
cine etc, Eve at 8 went to Naught's for  
bridge, nice 4, tea about 10. Several  
nibbles. Lost about 2<sup>nd</sup> good time.

17. Wet, horrid day. Did heaps of clearing out.

Much grief at non-arrival of papers, but  
I put in a busy time and wrote to T, K,  
B. Too wet for Kate so I took letters to PO  
about 2.15 found papers on doorstep. Back  
for lots of music of r on, Rich III, etc.  
Casals conducting Prelude: Finale Tost,  
Pastorale: Sardana (Garuda) Br II. Did  
Tory. of r on + got all but one corner -  
Under H are.

18. Uncollected but not too bad. Took 9.30 bus  
walked to LNER + to Oxford 10.13-12.21, very  
wet in fields, flooded to lakes all around  
Banbury + back country - Both Macaers at  
station, both fine. Lovely time, sun out  
on arrival, view from balcony. Delightful  
time, much talk. Master drove me  
to Oxford. Left umbrella. Wat - at Ban, 1/2  
hr, tea, open platform. One hr. at road-  
ford, luckily had Bellona. Dry at Rugby  
- caught 7.10 bus. Heard Martin Brown

on drama, misc. Mikel-Band, Griller in  
Mo2 Bp, R Boughton Ob. r things, R Bigg,  
Summer Landscape, poetry in newspaper  
but think H Whitbread n.g.

19. Fair, sun out for a time. Got Princy to  
help move trunk to T's room. Packed  
a lot, wrote T, J&K, Winnie C, also  
Rumer & Evans. Her husband's addresses.  
Took 2<sup>nd</sup> bus, dashed to Allen's with  
books, to Midland, Paris with L's clock,  
Mrs Wardrop. Also Mrs Woodments,  
Miss Casack, Greg, Miller, Temple, Taylor  
lost 1/11 then got 6d. Bad cards, Jolly  
tea, great scramble at end, had to get  
6<sup>30</sup> bus at Cent Hotel. Rain, tele-  
phoned Miss Slade again and agreed  
not to go to Whist - Dine - till eve-  
ning time by fire. BSc Midland,  
Schub. Or. in Ermin, Sym G Mich. Haydn,  
Mackenzie. Play "Boomerang Set"

pretty poor. LSO Rosamunde, 2 Min-  
Sch Brahms, H. Handel, Mids & Nat,  
Debussy Petite Suite. Real China  
clippers - did pay. Forgot to say I got  
Tong. on them - posted them.

20. Dull grey, wet, showery. Went to Leam.  
9<sup>30</sup> to LMS, 9.55 train. Walked through Pump  
R. Gardens to Botley's for L's gloves, all  
gone, got a new too good pair - another  
at Woodman's, posted in BStones, Botley  
Pump R. for coffee, back Rugby 10.40.  
Police Station, got 1.15 bus. More  
packing, more Master (umbrella arr. in  
a.m.) K. Brown Conc: M Plute, Dvorak  
(F), Sala in Schum's cell conc, Eulen.  
Stopped in middle of it to go to Kaurick  
Wagh - Mauls. Meckleyjohn. Then more  
to pack and write in eve to Macan, Fuller  
FG, Son, H trace. Endless to do.

21. Wet & vile day, packing all the time &

left-out c. 11, flowers, Rugby, boucle, over  
 back to Jo's before lunch. Charming house,  
 she - Bunny, Thel. Three letters - packs.  
 Did some pressing a.m. Took long time -  
 went up about 6. to dress - all lights  
 went out. Kate around with candles, light on  
 in 1/2 hr. or so. Master & I in Cotton's taxi to  
 Grand for Mrs Thomson's party. Nice cozy  
 sitting room, 3 tables: Alderson, Arkheim,  
 Temple, Everett, Woodworth, some more I  
 forget - some strangers. Supper in middle.  
 Good time tho' lost off. Master stayed to  
 a dance & I got back c. 11.30, still very wet.  
 Got practically all packed but 1 cov. bag.  
 22. Fair but grey. Up early 8.15 - breakfast,  
 over to say goodbye to Angles, Howard & 4's,  
 Percy helped, 9.30 train slightly late but  
 made up, no excess. Called to 4 - left many  
 things with Mrs G, took trunk - shoe Rev.  
 to Victoria. Master Th. for ticket, based to

flat, unpacked a little, had a remount -  
 Lunch latish Carn. to Hill St c. 4.11 3.30 -  
 Saw Barnett - subscribed 2.2.0 for BSA.  
 7.30 to Ad. Rd. tea Risks. 4 in bed, 2 much,  
 K very feeble but quite all right in mind  
 not day - Keitha carrying on nobly. To  
 Ede for light supper & ill. papers till 7.30.  
 To W. Th. "Timon of Athens" / poor play -  
 very badly acted. Ernest Nixon most type of  
 old-staggy. Settings - costumes ridiculous,  
 Got glad to go for here will never be another.  
 Back c. 11.30 & K arr. from Oxford about 2  
 mins, earlier. Talk only, too late for pub.  
 23. Fine, no umbrella all day. Didn't hurry  
 about getting up. Went 11 to St Mark's - met  
 Winnie C. for coffee - much gossip. Met K  
 12.30 Brasserie for lunch. Went to Home  
 for supplies. Back to flat for a little -  
 then to Bowls at Wells. Met Mrs Bell  
 here - Ronald Stair very good, all well

done, orig. Trans. version. Very long.  
Got out Kingsway to see Stoll house of 39  
stks, huge green, back for early supper.  
tea. Nice time. Got CS - to Poly to 39 Stoll  
letter even more first time. Also price  
film on Ceylon. Back soon after 11. Read  
papers in bed.

24. Fine, sun out. Latins for Sunday, wash  
up, - letters. Coat Mite done, posted to  
L-T. Got papers on way to A. Hall.  
Beucham, Bath IV, Piatiq. Drock,  
Fair Hair Perth, Rom. Carnival. Back  
late, to Conway Hall, S. Place concert,  
London Trio, Drock, solo by each, also  
songs Makena, too long. Left before  
end taking Watsons to supper.  
Not much else left after they went,  
but read Obs - ST - began Torq.

25. Fine. Began H, cleaned up, out to Illi-  
col funeral procession, got on Comb.

off. North. Sol + on parapet so we saw  
it all well. To Lyons for provisions, back  
to get ready JATT and May Patrick  
to lunch. Nice party. <sup>hand up.</sup> Later to Esle  
where had H Fraser - J Evans to tea.  
Supper in flat - to "Anthony + Anna",  
not as good as might be. Sat in bed -  
dit Torq. till all hours.

26. Fine. Got work. Wired L, copied Torq.  
Went to picture near Pic @ to see pro-  
cession. Met to Mrs Griffith Esle for  
lunch. Later finished H, wrote B,  
Postons. Walk to Supr. for nets etc, to  
tea Mrs Renner. Early supper, Old  
vic "Three Sisters" excellent. A final  
crossword.

27. Fine, brilliant day - up 6<sup>30</sup>, ff at 8  
to Rich. to register luggage. <sup>6-8</sup> No crowd,  
lovely sunshine almost - to Paris  
New duel + drizzle. L met me at

station. On to Bedford, nice room.  
305  
Out to tea at Penny. Back for bath  
& change, dined in & took it easy  
in eve. Good sleep.

28. Showery long sleep, up late - to  
Ushine with L's things, to Louvre.  
Many improvements but sculptures  
are closed. Lots of nit-jewellery  
etc & gold sauce boat (wavy shape).  
Long time in early rads. Back  
to lunch & pack. Write L & K. Sent  
cheque Bidd. in L's letter. Very tired,  
tea upstairs. Left c 6<sup>30</sup> for Simplon.  
Good double s/q. Got wine & nake in  
station & had picnic supper, things  
from La. Left 7.40. Reading Billon.

29. Fine, cold at Domod. No trouble pass-  
ports, enquiries everywhere about money.  
Fine snow mt. Late coffee in comp.  
Milan c 10, fine across to Venice &

Trieste ending with gorgeous sunset.  
Began Gaudy night. Left Trieste about  
dark.

30. Greyish & sun alternating. Did not  
come to life till after Belgrade. Dull  
& muddy down Morava but fine colors  
of trees & shrubs, mts. Nothing special  
to record, very comfortable all the way.  
Early dinner before Salonika. Dark  
here, no scenery such as the Temple  
etc.

Dec 1. Fine, lovely sunny morning, snow  
on Idlicum, Pann. etc. Up about triumph-  
idea, gorgeous scenery. Papers at-  
breakfast, demerol cabinet. Arr. a  
little late, c 11. Met by John Cook,  
Asst. John Amey. Very rough but  
polite customs man, all ok. Very  
early previous day at Chengheli.  
Home about 11<sup>30</sup> all fine. New man!

Eugenia. Got partly unpacked before lunch. Much mail but little of importance, looked it over after lunch, more unpacking - tub. Home lonely in garden after lunch. Tea by ourselves but M. in for much talk after, then Tania. Got end Augusteo with Death - Traus. Lovely Brahms from Hamb. in eve. Acad, & Cone (who?), I Sym which I followed with score. Beds fine.

3. Cloudy, mild. Long sleep & up late. Then a horrible time with aects. Out to Amby & Philippe & Henderson. Ph. fine about doing hats quickly. Most of p.m. unpacking & sorting, sent tea. Very kind, had us up. Dinner - to Olympia, Hubermann in Tisch, Selius, Beeth. Had to sit in front row, but her had more respect. Huge crowd. Saw lots we know. Out late - to Pynch

dinner with Davise, Ralph, & Jeanette & Misses. Much talk, back c 11.25.

3. Greyish, mild, windy. Wrote T.H., K. Did not go out at all in am. so much to do in house. Read a lot about - Agora in Ithaca. After tea to Kypiat, then Negs, then Vasilis. More Ag eve.
4. Perfect day. Didn't get started till late but went to Amby where we met Land, & Ado, Archicte & then to Acropolis. Nike Temple down but bastion seems untouched. Perfect up there. Met Xenoph. Bl. here. To Kelop. to saw Dr. & Dr. M. After lunch began Aunt C, then out errands - to Elucis, road crossed for Barbara. Wrote TB after tea. Eve to Aid. Rex at Nat. Good in general but not too impressive. Aid too old of fat.
5. Fine, some clouds. Began letter Aunt C.



HA in write note but we kept her. Costa  
took appl. for permits de séjour. Finished  
ECT began May 6. Piano tuner here.  
Addressed envelopes Am Xmas cards  
after lunch. Out c's<sup>30</sup> to P Taylor's to  
tea, also Manj, MecV, Morton, Gauss, Taylor,  
Gleich, Coult, Firth & many more. Much to  
eat. Back before 5. Eve did env. again  
till about 11.45 - add. all USA - put  
in cards. Still lots to write in way of  
notes.

6. Fine. Good out in Proia about archaic  
Stat. metope from Hera T. More Xmas prep.  
L - J out c 11 to Quij with many things.  
Glad to see us, new rooms very nice.  
To Pris, help etc, Alex for Xmas supplies.  
Worked on cards after lunch till 3<sup>30</sup>  
met at 4 Regr. at Palla for Rieffers  
in Romania. Not as good as others, tho'  
he was, too German, but clever duplication

Negr. back here for tea, found Mrs Stevens  
here. Much talk. Broke up soon after 7 -  
read papers till dinner. Eve put stamps  
(3 each) on about 200 envelopes. Respighi  
from Florence, Sinfonietta, G. of Shuba.  
7. Fine. Had an orgy of cards and  
letters most of the day. Sent off  
about 200 by John and more in pm  
by Cath, hdkts etc in some, notes in  
some. Also letters to CBS, M.F.N., Jess,  
waile, G.M.H. Stopped in middle of  
day when Beck called to take us to  
lunch at Glyphada, his new house.  
Picked up 2 at Ots, Norton Fellow &  
Mem. of Finian. Com. Had a very good  
time, all interested in music & good  
talkers, very late beginning. Charming  
house, delicious lunch, fine party.  
Not home till 4<sup>30</sup>. Bet. tea & dinner  
did Tony - got it. Letters in eve.

8. Fine. Up earlier. Wrote H. & L.  
went to Flower market, also Mallory.  
To concert, all St Saens, Hercules, Omph,

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### SENATOR ORSI

### A GREAT ITALIAN ARCHAEOLOGIST

Mrs. Arthur Strong writes on information kindly provided by the Societa Magna Graecia:—

It is doubtless owing to the political preoccupations of the hour that the death of the illustrious archaeologist, Paolo Orsi, which occurred on November 8 at Rovereto, has passed almost unnoticed. Yet his loss will be felt in the world of learning far beyond the boundaries of Italy. Orsi was born in 1859 at Rovereto, then in Austrian territory, but, his studies being completed, he chose, out of loyalty to his Italian origins, to settle in Italy. His monographs on the Trentino and a volume on the Cave of the Idaean Zeus in Crete revealed his rare gifts of scholarship.

In 1888 he successfully competed for the post of inspector in the Museum of Syracuse, of which he was soon afterwards appointed director. He declined the offer of more than one brilliant university post in order to remain at Syracuse, where, in consequence of his epoch-making discoveries of the Siculan civilization and of the Greek cities of the island, the museum was to become one of the richest and most interesting in the country. The exploration of the Neolithic villages of Stentinello, near Syracuse, and of innumerable burial grounds, enabled him to distinguish four periods of Siculan culture from the early Chalcolithic age of the second millennium B.C. to the fifth century B.C., when the Siculan culture was submerged by the Greek. In the Greek field the results obtained by Orsi, whether on the historical side or on the

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In 1907 he was appointed *soprintendente* of Calabria and Basilicata. In Calabria he discovered the important pre-Hellenic sites of Torre Galli, near Monteleone, and of Canale, near Locri, which, according to Alberg and Randall-Maclver, mark a decisive date in the study of the pre-history of the peninsula. At Locri, where he laid bare, among others, the only specimen of an Ionic temple so far known in Magna Graecia or Sicily, he discovered the superb and now famous figured *pinakes*. Orsi's notable campaigns at Caulonia, Hipponion, Medma, and at the shrine of Apollo Alaios, near Ciro, were in part financed by the Società Magna Graecia, of which he was president up to the time of his death. The precious material from these finds will, it is hoped, shortly be exhibited in the museum now under construction at Reggio-Calabria—a standing memorial of Orsi's services to the archaeology of Magna Graecia. The Byzantine churches of Calabria were also studied by Orsi, who published a fine volume on the Basilian churches of the region.

In order generously to endow and help the cultural institutes and the social services of Syracuse and of his native Rovereto, he lived for 40 years in a small inn; his life, indeed, was one of continuous sacrifice that he might devote his own modest income to his archaeological campaigns. When, after the War, he returned to Rovereto, now restored to Italy, it was to find his paternal house despoiled by the Austrians, and his rich collection of antiques, his library, and his scientific correspondence scattered to the winds. He was a member of the Accademia del Lincei, and was made a Senator in 1924. Among his many foreign honours was that of honorary member of the Society for the Promotion of Hellenic Studies.

Found base of 22<sup>d</sup> pitnos. No spectac. pottery but well started. Mustafa back before 11, got Mr J in by 7.00 & off on bus. Read Mangham Cos map. before dinner. All ready for bed early.
10. Fine, stiff N wind. Nothing doing till breakfast. Mended blue slip, did some washing, made list. Horrid cold in head. L & I worked on pottery most a.m. Took it easy after wash, M got extra blankets, so I stayed in & read very good Jews & slept. Got

dull & chilly in pm.

cleared all around big stone to S.  
Read Times in eve, 2 numbers.

17. Fine, very windy. Nothing doing till 8<sup>30</sup>  
Sunday heat. Worked with Sat on

inventory after L has marked small things. Wrote T after lunch. Back with D until tea, did a lot. L & J had short walk after tea, down road & back via D & M. Wrote H before dinner. Cooler. Eve looked at <sup>Gaz.</sup> Rev. <sup>Beany's lab</sup> des ~~EG~~. (Remzi's).

18. Cool, cooler, strong wind. L & J at pit, under lee of N wall. Spent almost all day there with Gafa except when I made H. after lunch. Finished Picard's résumé in Gaz. A. B. A. in eve.

19. Fine but windy. Still in NW corner. Emin got prob. floor level in trench. Men working in NE corner now, also Shaim on peak EG. Worked with Gafa all a.m. but very briefly after as we left at 2<sup>30</sup> to dress to go to Chaouac. Had been asked to concert, but

to kill.

31. Fine, warm. Sunday, not up hill for  
20, did odd jobs before breakfast.  
Spent a.m. mostly on pitting field  
& rest of day in house & got a lot

more sheds disposed of. Grate T after  
lunch. After tea on veranda reading  
"DuPonts". Eve looked through pictures  
in Uncle B's Assos. Br II Sym.

June 1. Fine warm. Hottest so far, but breeze.  
Leveling on N area, gradually to level  
of trench. Some Nye sheds. Sorted a  
lot more pitting on field in a.m.

No excitement later. Br II conc. eve.

2. Fine, warm, s. breeze, sticky. Finally  
getting heaps of stones near pithoi  
cleared away. Wall to Dörp's well  
cleared at side. Found city wall E  
of E wall. More sheds a.m. Still at N  
side of trench all p.m. Br III eve.

3. Fine, strong N wind. Johnny super-  
vised getting both pithoi out safely &  
parked near by. Ibrahim began  
taking down wall running E-W. Forgot  
to say fell in pith. 1 or 2 yesterday.

Wire from Tiaro not coming. Did a lot more stork p.m. Clearing down S. side, found partridge nest = 13 eggs. Obr. took off top courses of wall. Getting deeper in E to I. Read "Strange Cargo", Fletcher -

4. Fine, warm. Still going S areas, inside, E to north room, many storks Galip on scarp. 3 more pith. there. L - I packed good things - hat box after lunch, sent by Mustafa. Emin in very profitable layer. Did some visits to M. Jerry, Fog etc. Turk. Gen. & family came c. 6, for wounds. Read papers, early to bed.
5. Fine, hot. Lots more pitting all a.m. from Emin. Galip doing scarp, not much there, cleaned 3 pith. L & I each did some packing a.m. Knocked off at noon. More packing, tubs -

Left c 3.30 for Chauak. Fine day. Did unloads, customs n. Stook & to Bacon's for tea & much talk till c 7. Whit - Lee escorted us to pier, waited 1 1/2 hrs. Tuna Remzi - Oley paid us a call. Got on "Amini-male" at 8<sup>30</sup>, fine moonlight. Cabin 26/27 very comfortable, also an excellent dinner. Could only see lighthouses at Gal - Katak.

6. Fine, no hurry about getting up. Coffee in bed, reading "Ripeness is All". On deck c. 11, met the Moncks. Fine sail in. Arr 3<sup>30</sup> not too hot, passports slow customs quick. Met by Peter & cuth. On way stopped bar. to make appointment. Found B. here, ankle better. Mostly tea & mail, to bar 6<sup>30</sup>, back clean. Pies in. Talk eve, mail, clearing up.
7. Fine, more unpacking, sorting clothes etc, clearing out desk. Wrote T, did



accounts with L, more clearing debt.  
Hed out in innumerable newspapers from  
wrote H. Dott Thompson along about  
tea time to see how B. was. Stayed to  
tea, then H to tennis - I much tact. Out  
around Nov. Mar. & later, B, L, J. h. I  
to Negv. after wards. P back for dinner.  
L. I started Tony. after, but she got  
too sleepy - lots of Punch, J. L. N. etc. to  
read.

8. Fine. Have abandoned 5 a.m. rising.  
Went to Phil. in good time, Am. exp. u  
boat tickets, met Mrs. Pearson there, Pris,  
ordered pyj. for T, Petrop for material.  
Rushed pm. with odds & ends & more  
papers. Tea with Mary, Homer in  
later. Jeannette out. On return went  
to Acrop. plateau for sunset. Eve Tony.

9. Fine. Got things together for clearing,  
again to Phil. Kauf. for Pfuhl, back

in good time, write to before lunch. Mid,  
Rombud, Mrs WB after. To Orij at 4, Negv. to  
ka. Drove to Bogjati after wards, fine clear.  
Keph. Eve more Tony, J. L. N. Punch, etc.

10. Fine, small showers in night. Did not go  
out but spent a great deal of time going  
over clothes to take & leave, hatbox, shoes  
etc. to visit Phil & Orij. Home Merlier sent  
book with G. songs & I spent until ka copy-  
ing roads into Raval, very slow & careful  
work. At ka when in came Oliver, Kiao &  
Sindair (note to Carl). Broke up before 7 -  
B, L, I went to hotel. Went to near Kou's  
temple & saw new excav. of O building &  
some adjacent rooms. Eve Tony.

11. Fine. Wrote Merlier before breakfast. Wrote  
H. Mac, Jo, out to Pris. with final order  
for pyj. To Epig Mues & met Oliver to  
see his reconstr. & misc. Took him to Ag.  
& saw iron Apollo, Calo but fine & very

skillfully reconstructed of more than  
200 frags. left L at Orij. Back here.

Read Ob & tried more Torg. with L. Read  
Hesperia, Report on 1935 incl. long  
art. by Olive on insect. Read current  
Og. & Cor. reports that had accum. Mrs  
Stevens here tea, lent her 3 books.

Read some <sup>2 ch.</sup> WH new Que Fiction  
before & after dinner. Read 5 Times.

12. Fine. Off at 10 for Neqr. & took H & J  
to Glyph. to see the house they have  
taken for summer. Then to Voul.  
where H & L bathed, J & J eat on sand.  
Back in time for L to go to Orij. Read  
old ST, then Jud. wrote it. To tea with  
Mary. Also (Thompson) (Coast) Phuman,  
Mrs Sissons, Mme Paspati, Mrs Alex,  
Mrs Paton. Stayed for oysters & books  
about 6. Brought Jean & Shaffer in to  
Ath. Got another Torg. Cor Val.
