June 13. Fine. L & J did acct. Then she went out for errands - I devoted am to Jane. Went over what to take, special things to look up etc. Read 19 Agava reports (1936) selecting new information. Also did 14 esp. general report, 1935. Wrote desc. of Odeion - typed "A" - at his till 3.45 or so - L & J did more Tony, finished one - began another - went 6³⁰ to legation, garden party = Legat, Cos, Ansel, Agava, Monks, - a few more - Stayed till 8. Brought Jeannette back to dinner - After she left, more Tony. Began T.

14. Fine. L, P, I off 9³⁰ to St. Andrea, where they bathed at a quiet place beyond the woods. Back about 12. Finished T, looked over rest of Acro vol. L & J more Tony. Miss Stone here for tea, H. A in later till about 8. Eve more Tony, on current one now. Finished "Faster, faster."

15. Fine, hard rain in night. Wrote Len, Ceisee, Jess, Effie, did Dip. report with L. Ste & I out c 11³⁰, I to Amlex & Pris then met her Ouida. Rather lazy p.m. & did some Tony. Read The textile, up at 7 to Dilyp. Blake says there. Davises' to dinner, also 2 MacV, 2 Dab, Schantz, mastikas on upper terrace, diner lounge inside after.

16. Fine. Maj. came at 9 & she & I went for Ri furniture. I went Am Cox. & got extra pages in L's & my passports. Back home & did bookcase cupboard top shelf & all records replaced. General occasioning on Jane Hill lunch. Read ETH III & copied an old Tony. to do with L. D Thompson brought twins to call, one shy one not. I had tea. Later I & I to ELPA then Millers (out) drove to Ford re clock (NG) got golf clubs, to Yowl. Lovely, here, had

cuzos on terrace, gorgeous sunset one of finest I ever saw. Fire some old ST, more ETH.

17. Fine, not too hot yet. Left at 9, got H, A, Lucy drove to beach beyond 50 km where road goes down, fine shingle. H, A, L batted & Lucy & I under pines. Lovely here, a perfect morning. Back for lunch. Afterward read notices of Payne in Byad. by all for arch. & an art. in Nka'Estia, all lent by Mr Petro. Cleared out more old newspapers. L, B, I went to mag. new cone; Lot, Tann, Graf F, Wald, Trist in God & Art, fine to have Metro. back. Big crowd ran many, great success. En L & I looked at some Peisene prop for B, & also looked at Jacksons Shores of Cedar.

18. Fine. A great many odds & ends to do. Out c 10.15 to Agora & went with Connie to EE and T. More towers Val wall, paved street (earlier) some 6th cent found.

New Stoa S of S Stoa, Came bright place.
Saw new things in Mus. esp Hammer
base, pottery, lead to 2 women group, grave
sl. w. peltasos etc, Prax vase in court, etc.

Back to Maron, Amlex - Changel & to
lunch Dil. Mrs Pissou, Lucy, Jo, Gladys
much talk & fine lunch. To legation, back
3.45, read O'G. L out 4³⁰ Grij, tea 5³⁰,
Mrs Miller, overlapped Mary & Jean Din
near Koro, Wanch, 2 Bend, much talk.

Red Punch in bed.

19. Fine. Did not see eclipse, though P
saw some from Terrace. Packing. Spent
most of a.m. at it. Got trunk done
a.m. L out for errands. After lunch
went about Jackson on Ragusa & Pola
hill c.4. Mrs W Hill here for tea, 1.45 in
at end, Mrs MacV & Peggy called for
Troj. things about 6³⁰. Out c 7 to
Davies to say good bye. Boys on

upper terrace, warm & cloudy. Eve L & J
began Troy.

20. Fine, warm, slightly overcast. Up early
for more packing. Out c 10³⁰ to Amlex for
tickets, lire etc & took forever. To Pris & Grij.
After lunch typed Bend's Cretan report
sent by Megaw. More odds & ends. After tea
to Dti & The Negr. Eve Troy & bathroom
cupboard. Read Shak Murders. Piel - at -
Ceyra dinner.

21. Fine. Up early to finish packing, lots of
room. Ready in good time & John
came for trunks. Left c 11.45 and
found Peter had got all passports
etc. ready. B to see us off but did
not come on board. Good cabin 16 1/2
Lovely ship, has proved delightful
voyage. Lunch as soon as we left at
1. Went around Palop. At table 15 -
with Mrs Clark, lived on Myt & Samos.

Sat around & packed all p.m. Also
we, lots of room on board.

22. A lazy comfortable day, did not
get up till about 11, had good rest &
read Pantomina (Goskin). Passing
Jth, Lev. etc. Corpse soon after tea, close
to shore. Began letter to T.

23. Fine again up & early & on deck, then
found had forgotten about clock & it
was only 6.15. Beautiful approach
to Ragusa. Gravisa at 8 & went
with the crowd, very well planned,
lots of cars & a fine guide. Drove
around peninsula to just outside
Porto Pile. Fascinating place, even
nicer than expected, marvelous situa-
tion, town very picturesque. Began
at Gate, then Fran Mon. then climbed
up onto wall & around one side of
city to old part, Domen Mon & so

to Dogana, Rector's Palace, Cathedral,
market & back to main gate. Then on
our own & got some bags. Out to
garden cafe for lemonade, then I re-
turned for closer look at Palace etc.
left at 11, huge success. Sailed 12, in
& out amongst islands all p.m.

Wrote diary & finished T after dinner -
Red thriller Kraw gave us, tragic just
not much good.

24. Fine, still chitney. Up in good time, on
deck & watched Trieste. Very slow time
w. passports. No trouble luggage or money
permits. Good Amlet man. Sent 2 trunks
& large case through to Vict. Nothing
opened. Only a step to Savina, room 420
having changed to high up, over bay.
Glad of tubes & clean clothes before lunch.
Shortish siesta so as to reach Cor. 24.
before 4. Short walk though good piazza

No trouble about hire, 1000 each. To CIT
21.25
- paid TCI dues 1936, to Cos. abt returns
from NY, tea in piazza. Amble came &
we settled about luggage. Back late
to hotel for guide book, carriage up to
Castello - Duomo, splendid view - Duomo
5 aisles, 2 with fine Byz mosaics but
new central one is awful, so are some side
chapel etc. Int cols. many Byz, some
old fuscous, whitewash cleared off
some. Outside has Rom. mosaic - several
cov. cols. of temple. Charming place,
garden of antiq. near. Saw sunset.
Rest before dinner, up early. Reading
Owl's Nest.

25. Fine, less hot. Up early to get bus
at 9 for Aquil. but found it had left
2 min. before at 8³⁰. Tram & back
- to find Mrs. Civ (now on Castello.)
Delighted with it: Entrance up by Cath.

9
Then down through old garden full of insect
cols etc, tomb of Winckel (terrible pseudo.
Gk relief). Mus very fine, no cat. yet.
Lower floor great fresh coll. from Venet.
area, Grotto, St Lucia etc. Had seen a few
once in P. Venet. Got here our overwhelming
number, have also Rom in oc, a good
many Gk vases, esp Cov. Later coll. upstairs.
Back to bench, wrote B. Left in good
time 2³⁰ bus to Aquil. lovely drive
along the sea most of the way - A. is a
tiny village. Cathedral fascinating
remn. of Gp. in phase at Ravenna. 5
aisles, very spacious, int. caps, fine north.
splendid mosaic floors, steps, broad
platform, more steps, seats around apse.
Put in order for anniversary in 1931
very well done. Nice old guide to ear-
lier churches, mosaics of pagan house
etc. (See book). Though open place or lots

of frogs & around short walk to Mrs. a delightful place with garden & lots of Rom things in it. For Mrs. see cat, lots of fish. Things as well as Rom, fine glass & gems. Small show. Out to Duomo again, Ben behind it & along new excav. of city wall 700m long, fine, gates. Back to town, got bus to Grado, out on island, now a causeway - To port & had remnant & watched people, only a few min. till bus came left 7.10 & back about 8.15 Grand success. Dashed in for dinner, tubs & soon to bed.

26. Fine, some clouds. L's birthday. Called at 5 (arrived earlier) coffee in cafe - off at 6. Bus 6³⁰ for Pola, a 4 1/2 hr. drive, country green & wooded & a great day, called Capod. out on point & many places on way. At

P. stopped Piazza Dalighieri, left coats bus office got old cat & went to Foro & saw Cruz Temple - another in back part of Municipio, Ben about to Amph. wh. we had passed on way in. Cutting ready for opera perf, full of chairs, but very fine & impressive & well pres. To Mrs. - see arch. Mrs fine, also Rom & prehist (see cat). Then to Borgo Siana, a charming place, but old restaurant no longer exists. Drove all through it - back to Foro to rest. for lunch. Later around Temple etc & back to Porta Aurea, cooled off in cafe - later back for supplies & ices - Bus left 4.20 fine return, a grand day - Hotel 840. Less tired, not so much walking.

27. Wet, packing etc. Off for SO at 12²⁵ Good comps 4-5 in II wagon Met the Shears who had got on in Ath. Rain laid dust & kept things cool & comfortable, wet

most of the way. Keat Mr. Wrenn. Had
dinner with Stead.

28. Fine, Paris 9⁴⁰ got out - drove to La
Durie - had coffee - got sandwich lunch.
Then along Blvd. to Opera, sat down - had
orange. Lovely morning, bright & sunny.
Left 10⁴², good evening, good places to
pic. Starting opened at Folders. or at Pic
where we had sent luggage ahead - to meet
us, great deal for 15 pieces & 3 passengers
in taxi. Quickly to Kingsley, room 21 w
bath. Unpacked only a little, all
dined Ruedegros.

29. Unsettled, showers. Mr. Brintoday had
written Townsend for us. L & I to Suf.
at 10 for hair. Finished quickly. Left her
there & did a few errands, incl WSH
but Pinner away. Went early to Ebell, met
Mrs Allen in hall, taking friend Mrs
Jackson to Wimb. Had drinks with them,

papers till L came late. Excellent lunch.
More shopping afterwards, Selfr. for hangers,
stockings etc, strawberries from barrow. Back
for tea & a brief rest, but mostly letters, till
L came. Went to The Seagull, very well
done. Gilgul, Evans, Harkness, Haggard,
Ashcroft. Sandwiches at Kingsl. after.
30. Another showery day. Pinner's th. for
tickets, to NW Club for brief call Jess who
is off to USA. To Marshall's got new blue
cuff band, L some flowers. To Am Ex & WSH,
Ebell for late & very crowded lunch, not
fin till after 3. Back to hotel, early tea to
M. Petherick there too, Hellenic at 5, few
of old guard present. Myres P. as add. in
Ch. Hist: idea of Time etc. Eulogy of Mac-
millan. Saw his family after. Coffee at
Stewart's back about 7.15. To Ottobaker
in The Frog & found he was ill, so changed
to club - & went to Venus Cinema instead.

Sandwiches later.

July 1. Unsettled - showering again. It generally
is after breakfast for short call. To G. pal.
for tickets, Aquascutum for 2 coats for
Trot. Got them from Pamela, and got a blue
wool coat & skirt & L several things.
To R. Claver for pillowcases & L got a
dressing gown. To Joan's where she got a
blouse. Left things at Achil. Also Pils
to wash at laundry near hotel. Bus 25
to Stewart for lunch, Meyowitz en route.
Dull out so to matinee "Love from a
Stranger," Vesper & Day, capital thriller.
Tea here, letters to Sam, Gmst, M. Crowitch,
Alice S. To M. Home & Godfrey in "The
Fugitives" most amusing - Sandwich after.

2. Still wet. Errands a.m. Porter baby's
dentist, cabled Uncle B, went to
Midland, Woolworth's etc. To Am Cos
for tickets for 4th July reception,

to P. Robinson, L. globe, to B.M. met
Cisela, after I renewed ticket. A crowded
but very gossiping bench at Lyons Or Cerv
House. Left her at B.M. packed, early tea,
5 o'clock things +, fine rainbow. Arr 6²⁴ taxi
to Waver. Left things, had sherry, all in
fine form. For dinner Sir S. Cockrell & Mr
Fitzgerald (Sepia Exc), nice time, much
talk.

3. Tremendous rain c 4, still wet when we
went to Thomp. Lane to Needlework School
& saw tapestry of Windsor for the Castle -
Fascinating to watch, 5 workers. Lots of other
pieces being repaired, most int. place. On to
Fitz to see 2 new wings, 1 I had not seen,
Chetworth ideal, large, square heavy -
To lower regions for Gk things. Later to
Arts - saw improvements, incl. basement
works. Bus back to lunch. Saw new books
Julius, Ashmole, Mrs Cook. Terrace before

tea. Lisa delighted w. green frank & Ra-
gusa purse. After tea walked to Reid's
(out), West Rd, Libr, Clare, Kings, Market,
home after noon. Bus back. Aunt - we
finished looking at plates in Mrs C, Read
Arch. on Arch St. in Sic - S. Italy in bed.

4. Fine, lovely morning. More "Clicking
of Cuthbert". Off on 10.15 train, hotel
before 12, letters office, Post, Alice etc.
Tel. office at Forest Hill²⁵²⁹. Lunch Cannon
to Reg. Park to see Queen's Rose Gar-
den, lovely. Ran into notes p. P.O. file.
Walked a good deal. Got threatening,
went to Fourth of July reception at Em-
bassy. Lovely house & huge garden,
very well done, notes there, but no one
we knew except M Skellman & M Cronitch.
Back about 6, note from office re P
on latter train - might be in afternoon.
R. L. & I out to Reid. from 7.30 - 9.30

waited till 10.30 for EOP but they did not
come.

5. Fine, actually more than things. Tried to
connect with EOP, tel. here & there. Left note.
To Temple Church, lovely music. Back
12.30, another note to office, Ray came at 1
& stayed till 2. Off to Kingly's in p.m. We
went Eble for late & quiet lunch & to
Abbey at 3 to hear Bach's New London,
fine, even with piano for organ. Eble for
tea, K came. Hopad for G.M. JAKT who
were away as it turned out. All went to
No 4 about 6 & did Tong. till 10, with a
few refreshments. Real papers in bed.
6. Greyish. Out c 10 to Aquas. for fittings, to
RRC for bedspreads & I got linen pack.
Am Ex, US lines, WSL - Unaid, saw Pin-
ner. To Eble - had M & D Patrick & K to
lunch & good talk. After to Myronits,
gave L. Tong. for birthday, Con. G. for tickets,

Make bus place - back to hotel to write
up diary - try to do a few letters.
Wrote T, B, Alice, Mabel G. Did not
finish till after 7. K, L, J to "Frog," but
Harker still out & they returned money. To
Cri. to L Braithwaite & N Pilbeam in "Lady
from La Paz," not much as a play, but L B
irimitable. Sandwiches later, read the
morning papers in bed.

7. Fine but grey. Took it easy, read papers,
K in for call. To GWR re Kingsbridge
tickets & luggage. L got tickets up &
we packed 2 Revs. to send ahead on Thurs
Lunch Edl. & Curzon for "Phantom Gondola",
picnic food at Lyons. Back to Kings. for
tea. Wrote T. To K's write Tony. & sup-
per. Actually got all but one letter.
Back before 10.30 & to bed to read the
papers.

8. Fine. Late starting - To GWR for

seats, Aqua. finished L. To Woodworth
for washbags etc, Marshall's stockings L,
L - 5/6 in. blue sandals, Edl. GWR, JAKT
to very late lunch, huge mats. Saw Edna
Maisee C
Moffat, the GGM's Cusdys, & one of GMM's stud.
Back early to hotel, more packing before tea.
Wrote H, V, Mabel G, Van B, A Reid. K, L, J
to Por. Garden where we met Alice S
for Russian Ballet - Sylphides, 3 Co.
Hat, Fann, Igor, all fine - Best was
"Mascine" as the miller. Supper chase
after to Rend (shut), Cow House Ox & Tot
where we had a funny time - Lovely
night & walked back.

9. Wet, a humid day. Papers & then K.
M - J Perbeck came 11.30 & we went to
St Albans in the rain - nice drive -
Lunch at same nice place, then to
Theatre (closed), side road & around
by Watling St - down walk past wall,

fence & gate, stopping under umbrellas.
Back for close view of Abbey & return by
same route as Green Line, but gone out
via Barmst. Back before 4. did some on
bank till tea. Dined with ^{was 6971} G.M. & J.M.

Note from Mabel that Q Marie had invited
herself to lunch, so over off for Fri.

10. Showery. L & J to G Smith's with files
to be cleaned. Caught in rain on return,
but did bus & taxi. Took Mavis to Achille,
to Amely & Edle where we met Alice
for lunch & a long talk after ward.
Back to pack. K to tea c. 5 & returned for
7³⁰ dinner. Wrote H in interval, (also
Mrs Stewart. More packing later.

11. Fine. Did last packing, left a lot in the
hotel. Off soon after 10 for Pad. Train
terribly full so changed to 1²⁵ & were
comfortable, lunched on the way. Nice trip,
hot papers, St. N., & Murder in Meesp. Got

to Kingsbridge soon after 4. R met us &
quickly to Westcombe which is charming &
they have done wonders in a short time.
After tea got unpacked & settled. So much
& books & such a lot to see.

12. Wet, a horrid morning. Celebrated Sun-
day by late breakfast and general
poking around. Three copies ds after lunch
so spent a fine time with Tony before &
after tea. Finished Christie.

13. Showery off & on, some fine sunshine -
Went in steam with R. to Salcombe c. 12
village that up to fine view near little
park. A few errands. Fine p.m. & had lovely
drive to Dartmouth via K, SSands & all
around coast. Tea Merry Monarch, walked
along harbour, lots of shipping - lovely view,
not seen since 1915. Back a different way
nearly to Totals - then turn. Real papers
etc. in etc.

14. Showery off & on, mostly fair, I went to S for Club Meeting in a.m. Read some of Jenkins's Dad. to L while she did knitting - P.M. went in car by road about road to Ladies Club & had. lots of bridge with Mrs Chester, tea & here. Many rubbers, lost 12! Walked back via hill ^{with me} & field paths, Reading Death of a Ghost.

15. Showery - L & J had a nice walk round the cove to below farm in am. Nice walk to S. after tea by field paths & Devon road with fine views. Later a shower and double rainbow, inner one very brilliant - with ends in creek spanning the house. Finished Ghost - see.

16. Fine. Drove c 11 to S. Fell down & bumped knee & foot, ^{L then to Wau, Skewart, V13.} not too bad. To Port Head where B & Marjorie bathed; L, Mrs Gifford & J a walk Courtney, very fine, to where cliff path begins. Took it very easy pm.

with foot up reading Behold Hers' Poison. R off for a sail. T, L, I had a go at Everyman from book in eve.

17. Unsettled. Wrote letters. Effie, H, B, Hughes & Kingsley - Took all morning at it & part of p.m. Showers off & on. kept quiet - with foot up. T & R walked to S. in afternoon & I stayed here. Read part Crystal Stoffer. After tea L went to S - brought back Tid. Did puzzle in eve.

18. Horrible weather continues, frightful wind, rain off and on. Wrote Uncle B. Read T a lot of family correspondence. Spent most of p.m. playing Cut Throat except when the Realilt man came for orders. R went to S, brought back a Tid, puzzle in eve.

19. Unsettled, clearing? Wrote to M.H. L, T & J had a good afternoon with Tony. one more chg. A fine eve. Papers after supper.

20. Mostly fine. Did some washing, shoes etc, odds

ends. L & J to S. after 12. Got blk curraw jam
books for train, family enamb. Nice walk
both ways. 3 Geffneys here for tea, very
pleasant, nice time. Cut throat later. Ready
Mansfield Vict Troy. Also did Tel pug.

21. Fine, some clouds. Did some packing,
helped T with books. L, T, J walked to & from
S for bridge at club. Mrs Chester, Geff-
neys, Ross Clark, Wicks, Lister, Miss Ship-
hall. Very nice time - Tel pug. etc.

22. Fine. Left 11, all 4 for Kingsbridge -
got nice corners in through carriage to
Pad. which we reached 4²². Had tea Kings
dote to unpack from Achille, Smith etc
& washing trunks. Not too pleasant in
eve. Had dinner hotel & turned in early.

23. Wet, cleared later. L to Sep. at 10 ~
to Amby, tickets at Globe, ^{put in} Midland, ⁶⁰
met L at 11. To Dibs. where L got
blouses & I found bargain navy silk

wool frock. Back to dress, lunch at Rabus,
with F.W. & M.C., then to vic. to meet Carl at
3²² but train late. Ran across Dibs, there
to meet Shelby. To Ladies A-N tea visit
van B's much talk. Back to Kings, C
already there. Later all Dominion at 6²²
to "Secret Agent", late dinner by Mrs.
Wrote K, T.

24. Fine, cool at first, took umbrella. L & C to
tailor & J to L & M R & then met them. L & J
to Ladies Gallery Hq C (Patrick-L) & heard
part of debate on Cattle Bill. Had to leave
12.45 to see Samples at 2 Charges St.
Rodney Robinsons & C, already here.
Able to sumptuous lunch at Berkeley.
Samples to Chriswick, C to tailor, L & J to
Aguas. Back to Kingsley. C left 4.15 for
Cambridge. L took skirt - Ag. - J to
K, books all over front room, bedroom
nearly done. Took her to Kings for tea.

L & J packed from 6-7.45 - quick change
- to "Call it a Day" - Sandwiches after.

25. Fine, up early. Wrote Perkiok-L, did
packing, left nearly every thing here.
Sent 2 clocks - watch to Parnis. "Off"
to Liverpool St. It met us here. Good
comes on 11.55 as far as Thetford. No
rest. car, got tea & buns at Elze. Wait-
Thet. till train for Harling Rd, shows
Piel - met us - we were at Kingfisher's
in no time. Everything looks fine -
huge tea, nice fire. Got out for an
hour - we unpacked; milt up diary
while L knitted. Later E took L & me a
fine round including Merton Hall
before supper. Sat around fire in eve.

26. Fine. Took our time about getting up.
Showers now & then. Out in garden - L, P,
E, J out before 12 to Crims' Cross, a
lovely drive, New Vicars field was to

hurt. Saw new flint-mine, then driven
into the big one by long iron ladder. Just
about as I thought it would be. Very inter-
esting, lovely site. Back for very late
lunch. For tea there came Henry & Miss
Prince from Camb. P took us out - incl.
Betty Walker, via Harl. & woods, Thet. to
Brandon to Flint-Knapper's Arms & we
saw the work-shops & lots of kinds made.
Got 1 blk arrowhead, 1 yellow, 1 flint-leaf-
shaped knife. Lots of rain first part of
drive, clear later, rainbow - fine. Not
back till 9.30 for huge supper. More talk
eve.

27. Fine, lovely day. Packed. E & P took us to
10 Road for 11.19, Camb-12.52. Lunch Matt's
Cafe, wages' about 2^{1/2} ^{hours}. Unpacked, tea
early. Family + Charlesworth (John's) a
cherry soul who drove me to New-
ham in little blue car about the cut

of Piet's. Meeting small (Strachey, Miles, Stewart, Cook) but most satisfactory and encouraging. Mrs S drove me back - Had time to look at Payne-Young's history (have a copy now). Nice quiet dinner & evening.

28. Fine, off on 9.25, Kings. before 11, got out. Lunch Hughes - St., also both girls - very nice time - Rain came on - L got rain coat Barber's, - each got leather hats Dr. T's. To Eble when Kriegers came to Ka. Alice joined us later - Left her on way back. ^{6/11} L & I to 'Frog', a rare Miller, Gtanks a scream - Back to Kings for sand.

29. Unsettled, L fighting off a cold. Carl back before 11, I did a lot of errands till after 12. All three lunch with F Skirto & an old bird named Beagly. Lovely garden behind house.

K in for Ka, she, L & I did Tony. before & after dinner & got it. C. went with Sem/les & Robinsons but I stayed in with L & M had a nice time. Wrote Effie, Helen, Son, A Reid before tea. To Bert in eve late.

30. Rather unsettled but not out. Went to Ag. for L & other errands. Later to B.M. to call on Forsdyke & see alterations. In a lot of parts I'd never been before. L, C, I lunch Fuller's Oak Room, back to park. Moved things to K's before tea. She came later for tea. L & C off about 7.30 for Walterloo where K joined us. Saw them off at 30, Manhattan train. K & I by tube & bus to Mowlake for nice call & much food. Home 10.45. On good old sofa as usual.

31. Wed. Out before 10 to Times Club re T's subscription. Poked around 2^d hand

till time for Beane. Walter met K at
Tiroler for "Petr. Forest" much better as
a film than a play. L Howard very
fine. Also "Nobody's Fool" E. Horton, very
funny - K out to K. Had mine across,
- back to get settled, wrote T^h - made
up diary. Rain stopped. Reading the
papers then K returned. Settled on
sofa and read "Crime Conductor" while
