June 13, 1926 - January 8, 1937

June 13. Fine. L + I did acc'ts. Then she went out for errands - I devoted am to Jane. Went over what to take, special things to look up etc. Read 19 Agora reports (1936) selecting new information. Also did Rep. general report, 1935. Wrote desc. f. Odion + typed "A" at his till \$45 - or so. L + I did more Torg, finished one + began another. Went 6<sup>30</sup> to Legation, garden party = Legat, Cos, Ambch, Agora, Monk, + a few more. Stayed till 8. Brought Jeannette back to dinner. After she left, more Torg. Began T.

14. Fine. L, P, I off 9<sup>30</sup> to H. Andreas where they parked at a quiet place beyond the crowds. Back about 12. Finished T, looked over rest of Acro vol. L + I more Torg. Miss Stone here for tea, H + A in later till about 8. More Torg, on current one now. Finished "Faster, faster."

15. Fine, had rain in night. Wrote down, Connie, Jess, Effie, did Dilip report visit w/ L. She r'd out c 11<sup>30</sup>, I to Amherst-Pris. Then met her Onida. Rather lazy p.m. & did some Tony. Read The Hindu, up at 7 to Dilip. Blakeway there. Davies' to dinner, also 2 MacV, 2 Barb, Schantz, masticas on upper terrace, dinner home inside after.

16. Fine. Maij. came at 9 - she & I went for R's furniture. I went Am Cos. & got extra pages in L's & my passport. Back home & did bookcase cupboard top shelf & all records replaced. General cleaning on Jane till lunch. Read EE&H III & copied an old Tony. To do with L. D. Thompson brought twins to call, one shy one not. I had tea. Later h & I to ELPA when Millers (out) drove to Ford & closed (NG) got great deals, to tool. Lovely tree, had

oysters on terrace, gorgeous sunset one of finest I ever saw. Eve some old ST, more EE&H.

17. Fine, not too hot yet. Left at 9, got H, A, Lucy drove to beach beyond 50th where road goes down, fine shingle. H, A, L gathered & Lucy - I under pines. Lovely tree, a perfect morning. Back for lunch. Afterwards read notices of Payne in Bpad. by all for arch. ran out in Ná'tolia, all but by Mr Petro. Cleaned out more old newspapers. L, B, I went to Mayner Cone; Loh, Tamm, Good F, Ward, Triest in Ed & Set, fine to have Metro back. Big crowd saw many, great success. En Lou looked at some Peirce proof for B, & also looked at Jackson's Shore of Life -

18. Fine. A great many odds tends to do - Out c 10.15 to Agora - went with Connie to EE and T - More towers Val wall, paved street (earlier) some 6<sup>th</sup> cent found.

New Sto<sup>a</sup> S of S Sto<sup>a</sup>, Gene brought plane.  
 Saw new things in Mus. esp Hamer  
 vase, pottery, lead to 2 women group, grave  
 w. w. feathers etc., Prox inc in court, etc.  
 Back to Marom, Amlex Charged & to  
 lunch Del. Mrs. Pison, Lucy, Jr, Gladys  
 Much talk & fine lunch. To Legation, back  
 3.45, was 06. L out 4<sup>30</sup> Crij, tea 5<sup>30</sup>,  
 Mrs Miller, overlafter Major & Jean Dior  
 ne Kao, Wench, & Pend, much talk.  
 Rest Punch in bed.

19. Fine - did not see eclipse, though P  
 saw some from terrace. Packing. Spent  
 most of a.m. at it. Got trunk done  
 a.m. L out for errands. After lunch  
 real about Jackson on Raguera & Pola  
 till c. 4. Mrs. W Hill here for tea, H.H. in  
 at end, Mrs Mac V & Peggy called for  
 Troj. things about 6<sup>30</sup>. Out c. 7 to  
 Danies to say good bye. Dogs on

upper terrace, warm & cloudy. Eve low  
 began Troj.

20. Fine, warm, slightly overcast. Up early  
 for more packing. Out c 10<sup>30</sup> to Amlex for  
 tickets, tire etc & took forever. To Pitis & Crij.  
 After lunch typed Pend's Cutan report  
 early Megaw. More odds & ends. After tea  
 to Del - the Negr. Eve Troj & bathroom  
 cupboard. Read Shake Murders. Bed - at  
 Cegua dinner.

21. Fine - up early to finish packing, lots of  
 room. Ready in good time - John  
 came for trunks. Left c 11.45 and  
 found Peter had got all passbooks  
 etc. ready. B to see us off but did  
 not come on board. Cost cabin 161/2  
 Lovely ship, has proud delightful  
 voyage. Lunch as soon as we left at  
 1. Went around Palops. At table 15 -  
 with Mrs Clark, lived on Myt - Samos.

Sat around or talked all p.m. Also we, lots of room on board.

22. A lazy comfortable day, did not get up till about 11, had good rest - read Pantomime (Gaskin). Passing 8th, Ler. etc. Came soon after tea, close to shore. Began letter to T.

23. Fine again up-early - on deck, then found hat forgotten about clock & it was only 6.15. Beautiful approach to Ragusa. Gravosa at 8 & went with the crowd, very well planned, lots of cars & a fine guide. Drove around peninsula to just outside Porto Pile. Fascinating place, even nice than expected, marbleas situated, town very picturesque. Began at Gate, then Fran Mon. then climbed up onto wall & around one side of city to old port, Dower Mon - so

to Dogana, Rector's Palace, Cathedral, mosque & back to main gate. Then on our own & I got some bags. Got to gondola cafe for lemonades, then I returned for closer look at Palace etc. Left at 11, huge success. Sailed 12, in & out amongst islands all p.m. Wrote diary & finished T after dinner. Real thriller train gave us, tragic but not much good.

24. Fine, still sticky. Up in good time, on deck & watched Trieste. Very slow time w. passports. No trouble luggage or money permit. Good Ambro man. Sent 2 trunks - large case through to Vict. Nothing open. Only a step to Savoia, room 420 being charged to high up, over bay. Great of tubs & clean clothes before lunch. Shortish siesta so as to reach Crel. St. before 4. Short walk though good Rizzoli

No trouble about hire, 1000 each. To C17  
 - paid TCI dues 1936, to Cos. abt returns  
<sup>21.25</sup> from NY, tea in piazza. Tram came &  
 we settled about luggage. Back late  
 to hotel for guide book, caught up to  
 Castello - Duomo, splendid view. Duomo  
 2 aisles, 2 with fine Byz mosaics but  
 new central one is awful, so are some side  
 chapels etc. Int cols. many Byz, some  
 old frescos, white wash cleaned off  
 some. Outside has Rom. mosa & several  
 cor. cols. of temple. Charming place,  
 garden of antiqu. near. Saw sunset.  
 Rest before dinner, up early - leading  
Owl's Nest.

25. Fine, less hot. Up early to get bus  
 at 9 for Agnolo but found it had left  
 2 mins. before at 8<sup>30</sup>. Tram & back  
 - to fine Mus. Civ (now on Castello.)  
 Delighted with it. Entrance up by Cath.

Then down through old garden full of inc  
 cols etc, tomb of Winckel (terrible pseudo-  
 Gk relief). Mus very fine, no cat. yet.  
 Lower floor great prof. coll. from Venet.  
 area, Gorizia, Slavia etc. Had seen a few  
 once in P. Venet. But here are overwhelming  
 number. There also Rom inc, a good  
 many Gk vases, esp Cor. Late coll. upstairs.  
 Back to lunch, wrote B. Left in good  
 time 2<sup>50</sup> bus to Agnolo. Only down  
 along the sea most of the way - A. is a  
 tiny village. Cathedral fascinating  
 remn. of Ap. in Classe or Ravenna. 3-  
 aisle, very spacious, int. caps, fine north.  
 splendid mosaic floors, steps, broad  
 platform, more steps, seats about apse.  
 Put in order for anniversary in 1931,  
 very well done. Nice old guide to see  
 her churches, mosaics of pagan house  
 etc. (See book). They open place w. lots

of frogs & around short walk to Mrs. a delightful place with garden & lots of Roman things in it. For Mrs. see cat, lots of pub. Things as well as Roman, fine glass & gems. Small stone boat to Duomo again, then behind it & along new recar. of city wall soon done, fine, gates. Back to town, got bus to Grado, out on island, now a causeway - To port & had remnant of natched people, only a few min. till bus came left 7.10 & back about 8.15. Grand success. Dashed in for dinner, tubs & soon to bed.

26. Fine, some clouds. 1° birthday - Called at 5 (awake earlier) coffee in café - off at 6. Bus 6<sup>30</sup> for Pola, a 4½ hr. drive, country green & wooded - a great day, called Capo. out on point & many places on way. A

P. stopped Piazza Delighieri, left coats bus office got old cab & went to Fao - saw Cruz Temple - another in back part of Municipio, then about to Amph. wh. we had passed on way in. Getting ready for opera perf. full of chairs, but very fine & impressive & well pres. To Mrs. - also deer arch. Mrs fine, also Roman & prehist (see cat). Then to Bordo Siana, a charming place, but old restaurant no longer exists. Dashed all though it - back to Fao to rest. for lunch. Later around Temple etc - back to Posta Area, cooled off in café - later back for supplies & ices - Bus left 4.20 fine return, a grand day. Hotel 8.40. Very tired, not so much walking - 27. Wet, packing etc. Off for SO at 7<sup>25</sup> Good enough 4-5 in it wagon Met the Ghears who had gotten in Ath. Rain laid dust & kept things cool & comfortable, wet

most of the way. Met Mr. Krenn. Had dinner with Stears.

28. Fine, Paris 8<sup>40</sup> got out - drove to La Durie - had coffee & got sandwich lunch. Then along boulevard to Opera, sat down - had orange. Lovely morning, bright & sunny. Left 10<sup>40</sup>, good crossing, good place to taxi. Starting opened at Folies. or at taxi where we had sent luggage ahead - to met us, great taxi for 15 francs & 3 passengers in taxi. Quickly to Tingley, room 21, no bath. Unpacked only a little, all dined Rudegros.

29. Unsettled, showers. This birthday had written Townsend for roses - so I to Supt. at 10 for hair. Finished quickly - off for town & did a few errands, incl. NSL but Pinner away. Went early to E&E, met Mrs Allen in hall, taking friend Mrs Jackson to Brins. Had tomato with them,

papers till L came late - excellent lunch. More shopping afterwards, Supt. for bananas, stockings etc, strawberries from barrow. Back for tea & a brief rest, but mostly letters, till it came. Went to The Seagull, very well done. Gielgud, Evans, Charkiewicz, Haggard, Ashcroft. Sandwiches at Tingley. after - 30. Another showering day. Prince's th. for tickets, to A&W Club for brief call Jars who is off to USA. To Marshall's got new blue cuff purse, & some flowers. To Amherst W&H, E&E for late a very crowded lunch, not full. till after 3. Back to hotel, early tea to M. Petherick there too, Hellenic at 5, few of old guard present. Myres Pres add. on Ch. Stein: idea of Time etc. Eulogy of Macmillan. Saw his family after. Coffee at Stewart's back about 7.15. To Gattacker in The Frog & found he was ill, so changed to theater & went to New Cinema instead.

Sandwiches later.

- July 1. Unsettled - showing again. It generally  
is after breakfast for short call. To Apal.  
for tickets, Aquascutum for 2 coats &  
Trot. Got them from Pamela, & I got a blue  
wool coat & skirt & 2 cervical things.  
To Rr Cleaners for pillow cases & I got a  
dressing gown. To Jap's where she got a  
blouse. Left things at Achit. Also Piss  
to wash at laundry near hotel. Bus to  
to Stewart for lunch, Negroni en route.  
Dull out so to matinée "Love from a  
Stranger," Rosier & May, capital thriller.  
Tea here, letter to Son, Amst, Mr Cronbach,  
Alice S. To Malone & Godfrey in "The  
Fugitives" most amusing - Sadhu after.  
2. Still wet. Errands a.m. Porter baby's  
blanket, cabled Uncle B, went to  
Midland, Woolworth's etc. To Am Cos  
for tickets for 4<sup>th</sup> July reception,

to P Robinson, L gloves, to BM - met  
Crisda, after I renounced ticket. A crowded  
but very gossipy lunch at Lyons Or Car  
House. Left her at BM, packed, early &a,  
5 o'clock things +, fine rainbow. Am 624, taxi  
to Waces. Left things, had sherry, all in  
fine form. For dinner Sir S. Cockerell & Mr  
Fitzgerald (Sonia exc), nice time, much  
talk.

3. Tremendous rain c 4, still wet when we  
went to Thomp. Lane to needlework School  
- saw tapestry of Windsor for the Castle -  
Fascinating to watch, 5 workers. Lots of other  
pieces being repaired, most int. place. On to  
Fitz to see 2 new wings, 1 that had seen,  
Chatomoth Head, bronze, square many -  
To Lower regions for 6th things. Later to  
Art - saw improvements, incl. basement  
rooms. Bus back to lunch. Saw new books  
Jellicoe, Ashmole, Mrs Cook. Terrace before

tea. Lisa delighted w. green park & Raguana piece. After tea walked to Reids (out), West Rd., Libr., Clare, Kings, Market, lovely afternoon. Bus back. Amst - we finished looking at plates in Mus C. Recd  
Arch. on Arch Sc. in Sic - S. Italy in bed.

4. Fine, lovely morning. More clicking of "Cuthbert". Off on 10.15 train, hotel before 12, letters Effie, Trot, Alice etc.

Tel. Effie at Forest <sup>2829</sup> 14511. Lunch carav. to Reg. Park to see Queen's Rose Garden, lovely. Ran into mols of P.O. file. Walked a good deal. Got threatening, went to Fourth of July reception at Embassy. Lovely house & huge garden, very well done, mols there, but no one we knew except M. Hartman & M. Cronich. Back about 6, note from Effie re 7<sup>th</sup> on latter train - might be in afterwards. 5. L & I out to Reid. from 7.30 - 9.30

Waited till 10.30 for E&P but they did not come.

5. Fine, actually wore their things. Tried to connect with E&P, tel. here & tele-left note. To Temple Church, lovely music back, 2<sup>30</sup>, another note to Effie, Reg. came at 1 & stayed till 2. Off to Kinfolks in p.m. We went E&E for late & quiet lunch & to Abbey at 3 to hear Brahms Horn Sonata, fine, even with piano for organ. E&E for tea, L came. Hopet for Gilm. JAKT who were away as it turned out. All went to No 4 about 6 & did Tog. till 10, with a few refreshments. Real papers in bed.

6. Greyish. Out c 10 to Aquar. for fittings, to R+C for bedspreads & L got linen flock. Am ex, Wshines, WSL & Leonard, saw Pinnes. To E&E - had M & D Patrick & L to lunch & good talk. After to Mayowitz, gave L long. for birthday, Con.C. for tickets,

Motor bus place - back to hotel to write up diary & try to do a few letters. Wrote T, B, Alice, Mabel G. Did not finish till after 7. K, L, I to "Fox"; but Harker still out & they returned money. To Crib. to L Braithwaite & N Pittock in "Lady from La Paz," not much as a play, but L B is imitable. Sandwiches later, read the morning papers in bed.

7. Fine but grey. Took it easy, read papers, K in for call. To GWR re Kingsbridge tickets & luggage. L got ticket up & we packed 2 Rrs. to send ahead on Thurs. Lunch EBB. Cigar for "Phantom Condor," picnic food at Lyons. Back to Kings. for tea. Wrote T. To his writing Tony & supper. Actually got all but one letter. Back before 10.30 - to bed to read the papers.

8. Fine. Late starting - To GWR for

seats, aqua. finished L. To Woolworth for washrags etc., Marshall's stockings L, L - Skin. blue sandals, EBB. Coat, JKT 4<sup>1/2</sup>" to very late lunch, huge meal. San Edna <sup>Maisie C</sup> Moffat, the GGM'cords, & one of GMM's stud. Back early to hotel, more packing before tea. Wrote H, N, Mabel G, Van B, A Reid. K, L, I to Mr. Gardner where we met Alice S for Russian Ballet = Sylphides, 3 Co. Hat, Farm, Igor, all fine - Best was Massine as the miller. Supper chase after to Rend (short), Cow House Ox & Tot where we had a funny time - lovely night - walked back.

9. Wet, a horrid day. Papers & then K. M - D Perfect came 11.30 & we went to St Albans in the rain - nice drive - Lunch at same nice place, then to Theatre (closed), side road & around by Watling St - down wall past wall,

force + gate, stopping under umbrellas.  
Back for close view of Abbey + return by same route as Green Line, but gone out via Barnstaple. Back before 4 + did some on trunk till tea. Dined with <sup>Wes 6471</sup> G.M. + J.H.K.

Note from Mabel that Q Marie had invited herself to lunch, so ours off for tea.

10. Showery. L + I to G Smith's with fees to be cleared. Caught in rain on return, but did bus + taxi. Took things to Achille, to Amlex + Esse where we met Alice for lunch + a long talk afterwards. Back to pack. It to tea c. 5 + returned for 7<sup>1/2</sup> dinner. Wrote it in interval, later Mrs Stewart. More packing later.

11. Fine. Did last packing, left a lot in the hotel. Off soon after 10 for Pad. Train terribly full so changed to 1<sup>25</sup> + were comfortable, lunched on the way. Nice trip but papers, 24 Nov, + Murder in Mesop. Got

to Kingsbridge soon after 4 + R met us + quickly to Westcombe which is charming + they have done wonders in a short time - after tea got unpacked + settled. S. down + back + such a lot to see.

12. Wet, a horrid morning. Celebrated Sunday by late breakfast and general poking around. Three copies Obs after lunch so spent a fine time with Tony before + after tea. Finished Christie.

13. Showery ff + on, some fine sunshine - went in pram with R. to Salcombe c. 2 village street up to fine view near little park. A few remarks. Fine p.m. + had lovely drive to Dartmouth via K, SSands + all about coast. Tea Newy Monach, walked along harbors, lots of shipping - lovely rice, not seen since 1915. Back a different way nearly to Totnes + then turn. Read papers etc. in inc.

14. Showery ff & on, mostly fair, went to S for Club meeting in a.m. Read some of Jenkins's Dad. To L while she did laundry - P.M. went in car by round about road to Ladies Club - had late bridge with Mrs Chester, tea there. Many rubbers, lost 12! Traveled back via hill field path. Ready deck of a Ches.
15. Showery - L & I had a nice walk round the cave to below farm in a.m. Nice walk to S. after tea by field path & down road with fine views. Later a shower and double rainbow, inner one very brilliant - with ends in creek spanning the house. Finished Ches-ee.
16. Fine. Drove c. 11 to S. fell down & bumped knee & foot, not too bad. To Boat Shed where R & Marjorie bathed; L, Mr Gifford & I a walk Country, very fine, to where cliff path begins. Took it very easy p.m.

- went foot up reading Bethold Kene's Poison. R ff for a sail - T, L, I had a go at Everyman man book in eve.
17. Unsettled. Wrote letters. Effie, H, B, Hughes Kingsley - Took all morning at it & part of p.m. Showers ff & on. Went golf - went foot up. T & R walked to S. in afternoon & I stayed here. Read part Crystal Shaffer. After tea L went to S & bought back Tel. Did puzzle in eve.
18. Horrible weather continues, frightful wind, rain off and on. Wrote Uncle B. Read Ta lot of family correspondence. Spent most of p.m. playing Cut Throat except when the Real silk man came for orders. R went to S, bought back a Tel, puzzle in eve.
19. Unsettled, cleaning? Wrote to M. L, T, I had a good afternoon with Tony, one word chg. A fine eve. Papers after supper.
20. Mostly fine. Did some washing, chores etc, odds

1. ends. L + J to S. after 12. Got bet currant jam books for train, family errands. Nice walk both ways. 3 Geffreys here for \$10, very pleasant, nice time. Cut throat later. Ready Mansfield Vict Trag. Also did Tel puz.

21. Fine, some clouds. Did some packing, helped T with books. L, T & I walked to from S for bridge at club. Mrs Chester, Jeffreys, Ross Clark, Wicks, Lister, Miss Shippall. Very nice time - Tel puz, etc.

22. Fine. Left c 11, all 4 for Kingsbridge - got nice corners in though carriage & Pad. which we reached 4<sup>30</sup>. Had to strip dots to unpack from Achille, Smith & Co & various trunks. Not too pleasant in we - Had dinner hotel & turned in early.

23. Wet, cloudy later. L to Sup. at 10 ~  
to Amherst, ticket office, Midland,  
met L at 11. To Dels. where L got  
blouses - I found bargain navy silk

~ wool pock. Back to dress, lunch at Rabus with FW + NC, Ben to Vic. to meet Carl at 3<sup>30</sup> but train late. Ran across Barb, here to meet Shelby. To Ladies A + R tea with van Bi much talk. Back to Kings, C already there. Later all Dominion at 6<sup>30</sup> to "Secret Agent", late dinner by us. wrote K, T.

24. Fine, cool at first, took umbrella. L + C to tailor + I to LNER + Ben met Rem. L + I to Ladies Gallery H + C (Patrick-L) + heard part of debate on Catta Bill. Has to leave 12.45 to see Samples at 2 Clarges St. Rodney Robinsons - C already here - had to rememberous lunch at Berkeley. Samples to Chiaristi, C to tailor, L + I to Agnes. Back to Kingsley. C left 4.15 for Cambridge. L took skirt - Sq. - I to K, books all over front room, bedroom nearly done. Took her to Kings for tea.

L + I packed from 6 - 7.45 - quick change  
- to "Call it a day". Sandwiches after.

25. Fine, up early. Wrote Patrick L, did  
packing, left nearly everything there.  
Sent 2 clocks + watch to Paris. Off  
to Liverpool St. It met us there. Good  
concern on 11.53 as far as Thetford. To  
rest. car, got tea + buns at Elgy. Waited  
Thet. till train for Harling Rd, Shores.  
Patt met us + we were at Elgy by  
in no time. Everything looks fine.  
Huge tea, nice fire. Went out for an  
errand + we unpacked; wrote up diary  
while L knitted. Later E took L + me a  
fine round including Merton Hall

before supper. Sat around fire in eve.

26. Fine. Took our time about getting up.  
Showers now + then. Out in garden - L, P,  
E, I out before 1/2 to Cranes' Cross, a  
lonely drive, non-taxis field was to

here. Saw new flint-mine, ran down  
into the big one by long iron ladder. Just  
about as I thought it would be. Very inter-  
esting, lovely site. Back for my late  
lunch. For tea there came Kenny + Miss  
Prince from Cumb. P took us out incl.  
Betty Walker, via Hart + Woods, Thet. to  
Brandon + Flint-Trapper's Arms + we  
saw the workshops + lots of weird made-  
got 1 blue arrowhead, 1 yellow, 1 flint-leaf-  
shaped knife. Lots of rain first part of  
drive, clear latter, rainbow - fine. Not  
back till 9.30 for huge supper. More talk  
eve.

27. Fine, lonely day. Pack. E + P took us to  
10 Road for 11.19, Cumb 1252. Lunch Matt's  
Cafe, was about  $2\frac{1}{2}$  <sup>cents</sup>. Unpacked, tea  
early. Family + Charlesworth (John) a  
cheery soul who drove me to New-  
ham in little blue car about the cut

of Piet! Meeting small (Strachey, Misses, Stewart, Cook) but most satisfactory and encouraging. Mrs S drove me back - had time to look at Payne-Young hastily (have a copy now). Nice quiet dinner & evening.

28. Fine, off on 9.25, tennis before 11, got suited. Lunch Hughes St., also both girls - very nice time - Rain came on - I got rain coat Barker's, - each got leather hats <sup>6/11</sup> Dr. T's. To Ebbw when Kriegers came to tea. Alice joined us later - left her on way back. L & I to "Frog," a rare Miller, G started a scream - Back to tennis for roundn.

29. Unsettled, L fighting off a cold. Coal back before 11, I did a lot of errands 4/11 after 12. See Alice lunch with F Hirsts & another bird named Beagle - lovely garden behind house.

K in for tea, she, L & I did "Frog" before & after dinner & got it - C. went with Semple & Robinsons but I stayed in with L & we had a nice time. Wrote Effie, Helen, Son, A Reid before tea. To Butlin eve late.

30. Rather unsettled but not wet. Went to Ag. for L & other errands. Later to PM to call on Forsdyke & see attractions. In a lot of parts I'd never been before. L, C, I lunche Fuller's Oak Room, back to park. Moved things to tea before tea. She came later for tea. L & C off about 7.30 for Waterloo where L joined us. Dow Dem off 8.30, Manhattan train. L & I by tube - bus to Mortlake for nice call - much food. Home 10.45. On good red sofa as usual.

31. Wet. Out before 10 to Times Roll Club re T's subscription. Parked around 2<sup>nd</sup> hand

DSC in later, 3 games with Mr. Lucy, Al, Misie in for oregos. Typed out a couple of Tong. & did one - part of another in eve till

midnight when we cut the tojita - wished Marika & Eng. Happy New Year. L got the 100p. in tojita.

6. Fine. To Libr. in am. chiefly on Bth Part. looked up a lot. PM to funeral of Mr Fairbanks in Evan. church. Seat a mess. Met DK after & all drove to

home, good chance to talk to her. Mrs Matt here for tea, bent her Brauguet & doge L + I to fine Busch recital.
