

Jan. 9. Fine. Got a lot of material ready &
 then to Libr. for morning. L out for a
 few errands & left note for office. Tub at
 noon they were better. Out at 2 and
 collected dBurr & Rodney at Agua &
 went to Bari to see area excav. last
 summer beyond village by Arch. See
 halls, tombs, platforms, rich but compo-
 sit place, eroded all around, few sheds.
 On return parked with dB & took R to
 Elucis to see some sheds of his in
 Apollonia. Also saw villa with fine mo-
 floors (trid?) below Mrs. Very windy in
 both to E & pretty cold. Late tea. NW
 in. To masticha at Triant. then a
 fair number. Took Mrs. Mack. home. Ev did
 Tag. along. Finished Evng papers. Sinn.
 12. Fine. No concert. Did letters to T, H &
 Nvace. L & J checked over Exmar cards be-
 fore & after lunch. Out c 2.45 to Menidi,

windy & sharp, clouds low on Paines & rainbow w. one end in Men & one on Pent. Back c 4 & began writing up rest on AP, shield etc before & after tea. Did a lot of ref. on Paine, Davis etc. till dinner except for 4 sets with L (1-3). Eve read Swinerton.

11. Greyish. Got a good start & spent all am in Library. Ref. on Ord, Asc, Shield, Paine archit. finance etc. L had Katie & now later. After lunch more J, then L & J worked on trans. Semne's article till tea. To concert = Leorn III, Schum I, Deb Clouds, Festa, Death. T. Cond & Issay Dobroven not too good.

Took Mrs P. home. Eve read Ferg. Trans of Ath.

12. Fine. Look at IG - Ferg. Out 11⁵⁰ to GPN for F & M's rooms. Am lit, Orinda dead slow. Back late. Did some Ferg pm. Early tea, JC, AN, LN, L & J to Typographers at Royal, very funny. Took A & L home &

DC here for pp. before dinner to check Missie also come. Later did Davis + Ferg. Good Moz Violin Conc. from Park.

13. Fine. Went in good time to library. Did Thayer, Vik. etc, back about 12 & P & E had just arrived. Much better. Sat down for ^{Semne} vegs before lunch. Read some Meritt. All 4 out for a run to Vol. Back c 4.30. Geo MCF on doorstep. Here a few minutes. Quick change, tea same found. Also 2 Stevens, Alice, eta, 2 Miller, Mrs Baltagi (sister) Antoinades, 2 Lambinwudi, Stephanos, Lucy K. Took Mrs M home, here by 7 for Semne & read rest of article & got all arch. grasp. Eve read chiefly Meritt & Ferg, Times - Erica from somewhere.

14. Up early, left 9 to meet Alice M. Cold & windy. Back by 10, got Davies on tel. Tacked all a.m. Davies - P & E here to lunch. Took A back to sail at 4. (Clean)

sunny but very cold on paper. Fine to see her even for short time. Bought us a bottle of rum. Had very funny games of double after tea. Eve did some Fraz. & Tok. O.T. etc. Got a fair amt. of work done in odd times - later read Times & Ob.

15. Greyish. Had a good long morning at desk with IG, & material on OT, Er, Par. etc. Fery, Merritt et al. Little to write ^{with a bit} but much reading. At it again p.m. DRC in before 4, had some games but she left early. Some cheerful doubles now & then sandwiched in. Eve Fraz, Tony, S Times. HV in at tea time.

16. Greyish. Put in a good morning. Trying to combine on Parth, OT, Er, Nat. Fraz. Sounds like a medley. At it again p.m. L, E, P off to Boyeki. Wrote TB, to before tea. 3 eats with L (1-2). To masticha Alexandris' nice party.

E & P dining w. Parsons. Wrote T in eve. Also some notes - diary. Swim.

17. Greyish. Took Mrs Petro to concert inst. Lib. Roman Carnival, Braud V (Schubert, Zagans, Lykoudis) Path. Sym. Large Am. mail wrote H in p.m. Tea in salomaki. Part in bed till then. Hannah at 6 for games w. me, L & doubles w. Effie. Masticha at 7: Lucy, Al, Dlox, Missie, Rodney, Virg, DBurn, & Parsons. Late dinner. SPK eve = Mend. Piano Cone, Scher. Had B III from Aug, in p.m. Read a lot of Ereth. book in eve.

18. Slightly overcast. Spent nearly all day on Jane, disentangling Ereth. etc. Part of p.m. went over Parth revisions with L. Out 12 to Orida. Part in bed but better. DRC in 6³⁰ when L & I returned from tea at Ev. ME, D. with Mrs Matt. Had Quets with H - 2 with L. Eve worked on Er. revising J. B III from Buda, Bach, viol. concerto (short) Reiner cond.

Very beautiful.

19. Slightly cloudy. Got in a good morning on bus. Soap, Frax, J etc close compar. work. After lunch did some Semne with L till 3:30. Out for walk, met WM & we went around Garden. L, E, I to tea with J Beer to see the twins, most engaging - nice flat. L & J to Odessa the Quarter, Hayden G. m. s, Beth F. m. s, Dr. F. Good. Found E had bought us freesia - chocolates. Eve did more Ex + OT. Slow but progressing. A then. from Gen. El. came p. m. & put in order. Had Rome: Board, Beth IV, Prosepiece, Pines.

20. Fine. Beautiful day. Got good start & did OT & Ex. (Jud) while L with Katie. Out c 11:30 to Agora & went over Arthur's sec. with him, to see small st. foundation. Much activity clearing all 10 S p houses. Lunch at Ag. View later all over area from roof new sec. Alison's photo quarters. Back early & noticed till 4:15. L & J 3 acts,

Then v. effie. H & A at end tea. L, E, J to lunch meeting Morgan on 1936 Cor (have done a lot) Bronze on St Paul, Bipar & market. Saw a lot of arch. there. Saw v. Skene's. On return got E from 4:15 Tim. where she had gone out. Home. Eve read Ferg. Had Petridis G. Dan car from Saltun (Bard-Borg) but may cut in.

21. Fine. Worked on Ex. till after 11 when L & J went to Mus - saw Phila. about photos & Semne for MS & pictures of her amphora. Went to see to, very fine, in geom room. Picked up MZP en route. To Ouida & back by 12:30. Out early about 2:30, L, P, E, J to Markop., Brauron & P. Rapti. Back by 4:30 did more Semne with L. Tea at Skene's, masticha at K. Katerinop. to meet Mrs. Mercati, who had to go to Kuph. for files. Mrs. Pali, Pali, Empir. - Tourmand. - the Criva - at Sker. saw more drawings &

GPS lent us his new Hesp. proof to bring home. Eve, Effie - I worked with L on traces until about 12 but got it done.

23. Fine. Annoula came up to refit - new dress sent yesterday eve. Worked am on Ev. but spent part of it doing final on Semne which L. took to Ag. to be typed. L, E, I to lunch Marj. DTC with flu. Big party - Jeanette, Mrs Wright, Mrs Nev, Miss Binns, Binny, Millicent, Pris, Gordon. Later to Kelly's recital in Cole, Punch, Boeck etc. Back for tea. To Friends of Grace G⁴⁵ in G Za. nifi's new Byz. house. Delaudo on 1956 camp at Silk. Several new things, incl. arr. of Museum. Mrs Zithon eat with us. Good mixture arch. et al. Mashed afterwards. Eve worked hard on comp. Dins. & Ferg.

23. Greyish, windy. Had a busy day getting notes into shape - a few typed. Ev & OT. also began Stevens on Aer. L, E, I to tea with ALWR. Back for 3 games before dinner. Waste Ten. Had Beeth IX.

24. Greyish, windy. GPS until L - I went to concert. Schurich back. Handel Fireworks, Werner Eng 2 from Oly. suite, not much liked, Rame Dr Child, Br IX which I fell. Bought P Taylor home. Put in a good pm after writing H. Except for tea & p.p. singles (P) & doubles, & Ten before dinner, worked on GPS Acrop together with J.

25. Grey, a few snowflakes. Spent nearly all day on J, still in thick of Ev, OT, Op. etc. Marj, Jeanette, Mrs Wright, Mrs Gordon here for tea. Had 3 games with L after. Eve more work, chiefly Ferg.

26. Grey, drizzle now & then. Another industrious day, getting slowly along, have done a lot.

began to find it clearer. Did several
rounds briefly - Mus. being done over, but
got in, such a mess. Home to lunch
showed garden etc. Cleared quite fine
took them to Mar, then Glyph. - to pier
soon after 5. Back for late tea. Had 7
games with L(3) - P. before dinner. Be-

finally got coll. case. House c 11, nice
& cool, sat & talked. Karo in 12³⁰

^{with R & hotels.} nice vista, Ob, 2h N, Punch. Got
5^{1/2} tea Davis garden, then L - J
Anky - Miss B to Helleniteo.
L & J later to Schantz, cocktail

party on his terrace. Here for dinner,
2 Kent, 2 Gordon. Coolish in eve.

18. Fine, still warm. Still many delays abt
passports etc but finally done. Took Miss B
to Piss, hot out so returned. Dinner to
lunch. Brief rest of 3^{1/2} for Piraeus.
Went on boat, nice cabin. On return, Anky
rasile while L saw painter. Er P in in
eve.

19. Fine, still hot. Spent most of day packing
etc 11³⁰ - 1 in Anky grand finale, tickets,
Tourist line, money etc. Karo in for short
farewell about 6. Out c. 7 to Ath Cell to see
Wrights from Roll. in Davis' garden.
Later to Neqref. H & J in. Eve all the
left overs to do.

20. Fine. Up 5³⁰ & of c 7.30, all packed in.
Splendid drive via Thebes, Bralo etc.
Roads remarkably good, many flowers
still. Lunch on mt. overlooking Stylos, &

under a big plane near spring. Lots of
cattle too & several men on way to get
a *Par. sikor* from small church. Nice breeze
& had a rest. In plain, oleanders covering
whole fields. Thru 'Lamia' & northward.
On mt. near small *Tham* (or *Othry*?) were
resting on a slope when there came a
terrific hailstorm. Fled for cafe & sat in
car under trees till over. Rushing rivers

21. Fine off c. 7.45 for Elaeona, wads
good, country green & fertile. Went thru
Tynaro but didn't stop for ongo. Took
road around mt. Thru beautiful
green valley. All fine country, various

small villages, Servial (pretty) to Kozani -
Arr c. 11 - stopped for wire & engine, then Ptolemais
& towards but not to Amyntaion, Lake, then
up & had lunch high up in some locust trees
near railway. Decided to push on as we had
such a good start. Got lost by turning too
soon before reaching Florina. Grassy road to
village, fine costumes, they said rd. to Monast.
but we were afraid of no bridge so retraced
way & went to edge of Florina, pretty, & a
very sketchy but authentic road to Arta
the frontier. No trouble, officials polite &
agreeable, all passports, car, money etc O.K. So
into Jug. & they too were very civil. Not any

but did not stop & pushed on for Ochrid.
Splendid country, Resan one village, after
we had done a splendid mountain
full of beech woods, hickory, all very green.
Road finely engineered but narrow, curvy.

met 2 couples, car broken down, battery
which Ash. fixed. Hard storm meanwhile
fine view Lake Prespa, then another mt.
not so high & around it & finally Ohrid
about 8. Hotel Bellevue, 22, 2d floor
over lake, grand breeze - unpacked -
washed a little before dinner, incl. The
famous trout. Have to eat shakely
German. Very sleepy & turned in early.
22. Fine, glorious view over lake. Did
not get up so early. Made coffee, & out
for a bath. Then dressed, café by lake,
to the village - Hotel manager took us
to bank but they didn't know exchange
so he lent us 500 D & said to send it
from Skopelji. Got as a nice boy who
took us to all the sights, Turkish
quarter w Khan, then up higher to church
w. very fine carving, then up inside the
city gate, old blocks - misc. built in,

to St Clement, fine brickwork, high situa-
tion. Sent to get unlocked, whole primary
school let out & gathered round. Old men
let us in, very dark, hard to see fresco -
In both churches fine frescoes & lion feet.
Around to S Sophia, 3 barrel vaults, looks
very old, mosque later, fine old Byz. tiles
built-in, 2 green slabs in floor. 2 narthexes,
fresco left, there & in church, but esp. in the
upper floor. Very fine church, fine arched
windows, colonnades etc. Churches here are
all brickwork, generally oblong - dome -
travelling all a.m., back 12 for lemonades out
by lake. Lunch - odds & ends & a siesta.
Off c 4 for Steti Naum, drove along side of
lake, splendid, partly by shore, part a
fishing village with strange boats, up
& around in hills. St is close by Alb.
frontier, fascinating site & fine old church.
By quiet creek got Ok. speaking monks.

Very fine Pantok. in dome, many frescos
 some much damaged. Tomb for crosses w.
 many offerings. Went to new church, w. a
 lot of awful mod things. To rooms for
 Alex & Marie, kept just the same, but
 ribbon & wreath. Cherry conserve & coffee
 later. Frontier, customs more on hand.
 Met others from hotel. Took mule back
 with us to Ochr. Terrible cloud burst
 on way, slippy mud, saw a boiling
 torrent. Work men here, helped w.
 stones, waited for it to subside a little

 storm, road dusty before Ochr. Splendid

22. Fine, perfect morning - up early &
 cafe out of doors at 6³⁰ - Off @ 7.
 Much pleased with our stay there.

Magnificent drive, after Stuga, went part of
 on wrong road & well started for Albania,
 then back to right one. Though splended
 gorges, high banks, cliffs, well wooded,
 rushing river. Bad washouts in places,
 quick repairs. Roller in river. Two very
 fine gorges with big open valley between,
 grand boat basin for river. Then up & down
 country, 3/4 day, fairly open, splended

27. Fine. Had grand heat getting up late. Took short walk in town before lunch, breeze - vermouth on terrace. Lunch in garden, long siesta, real Sanford Scandal, mate T. Out for a walk when cool. Met Ark. air opened up. Went down to harbor, later up hill w. to get view. Cool in garden, turned in early.

28. Fine, still warmish but a breeze. Out in good time, found town gay with

back early. Clear - sticky. Real Dad

I thought. On island, 2 bridges. Stopped by park
behind Cath. apse, a fine one w. arches. On to
Sq. & found huge woods, church crannell so
did outside, Loggia, town hall etc. Big court

Bridge & fence amusing. Huge crowds on foot, so passports were slow, but no difficulty, & nothing opened. Very fine road to Trieste. Arr. 5:35 at Sav.
Same nice room. ⁴²⁰ Tea upstairs & got tubs & settled till dinner. Early upstairs
12. Fine. Out c 9:30 to shipping office to fine boat for Ath. Finally to GK Cr. & got timetable Frinton str; first to C.I.T. renewed T.E.I. for 1957, Credito Ital. w. tourist line, changed dinars elsewhere. Left L's films, walked around a lot. In cafe for vermouth before lunch then for Mario but none in town. Wrote letters in regista hour, finished H, T, Giardet, Van B. 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13. Fine. Got away c 8, good drive to Venice & arr. before 12. Fine garage w. incl. Venice. Gond. to Regina. Expected yesterday - Hat mob, good but no bath. Nice & breezy. Lunch, vista hill c. 3. Surprised not hotter. Gond. to Tintoretto Expos. in Pal. Pesaro, a magn. place. Wonderful show, 2 floors, lots of loans. Fine cat (see). Back on steamer to S Marco, tea in Piazza. Went to Amaly but closed early. Looked for slippers for L & got a pair things. Book for early dinner & gond. to P. S. Treviso to see "Il Bugiardo", delightfully done in a wonderful setting, lighting, costumes, acting. Big stands for effect, wonderfully fine background. Walked back by devious ways.

inside, raised choir, crypt w. many
cols, tripart. roof, cloisters. Finally on
to Garda, Sirmione¹⁷, very hot but had a
rest + dinner out of doors. Too hot
to get much idea of mt. but very
lovely. Grand dinner altogether, but
call it a day. Glad to stop for a little.
