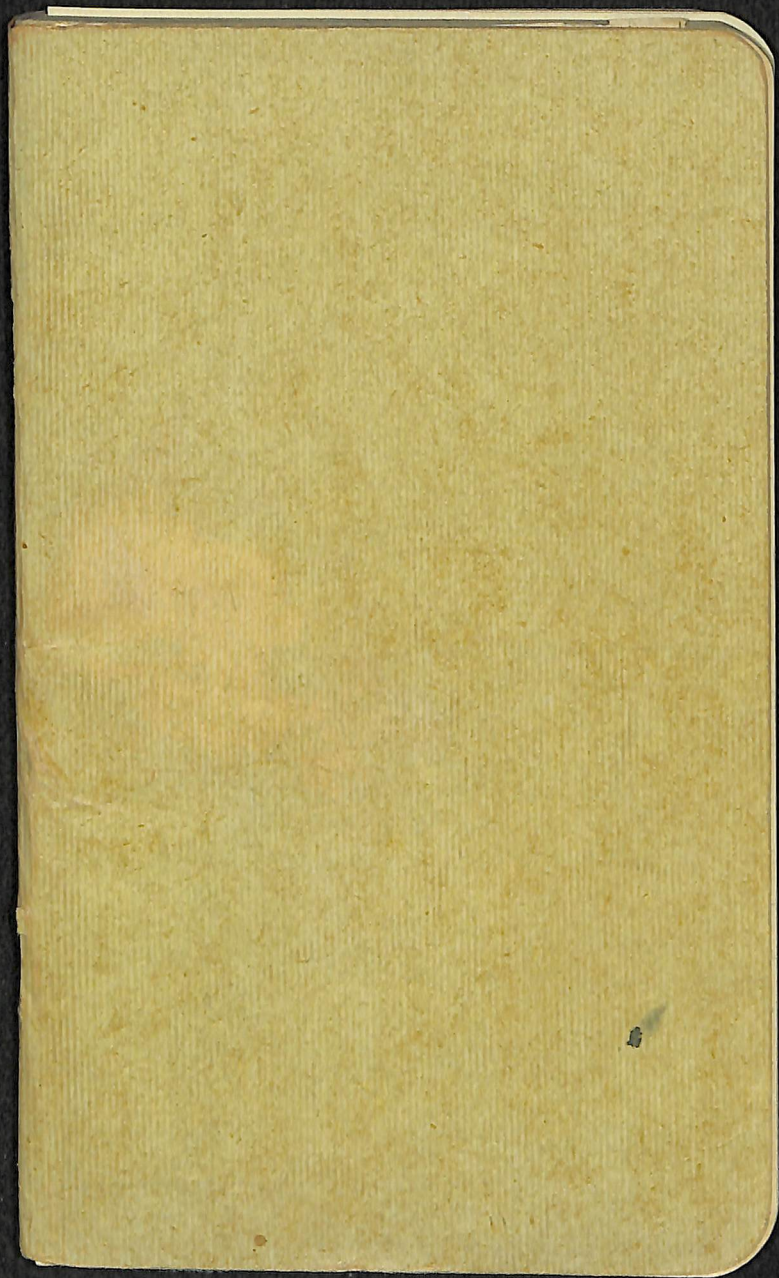

Jan. 1, 1938. Fine. Out before 11 to see procession
returning from Cath. Good place, behind sol-
diers HA + Maroni. Fine view of King, June,
Under Geo etc. Back again. Wrote 2 LT,
- G. M. - Call from P. Mazuraki. Fin. letters from.
Out c. 3.30 took B to Aust. Sch - Maz, L & J
to Paul. Then New S. to thank Mrs S.
Name day Mr S. guests there, fine vicinia
cordial. 3 pp. after a cup of tea. Began
writing Phar.

2. Fine. Wrote T, H, M. Clarke, Phys. a.m.
ESU, Ruth H. after. Out early, took Geo, Touca -
Tasso to Anagnino. Road badly cut up. Collected
shells on shore. Back for tea. 3 or 4 games later.
Br E from Rome. Eve back to J. & some Mexp.
reports - things ready for library.

3. Fine. late start. Library on Deubner, Picard.
L & J to Scip. Apr. 3-5. Tea GB with JH,
also Mrs MacV. Waste both ways. Charlie M in
late to see B. Wrote up Deub. notes. Eve

L & J did many accts. Some made before dinner. Eve mostly Agona - vicin.

4. Dull: Put in all revis. acc. to Deut & worked more on XIII, chiefly typing Millers here to lunch. took till tea.

Did all possible on XIII for present.

B to AmbSch. tea, L & J here & 1 + 3 pp.

after. Caught up on Times Ob etc.

Eve Tony. on Boxing Day.

5. Fine, some clouds. Put in a.m. on I & got out & typed Tho' Dip & walls. Lunch Legation, also Shan & Rox. L & J at 4 to Mus. for presentation Mys. sword hilt from Friends Mus. Large meeting incl. Pinner Nick. Marinatos spoke on awards. Back to tea. Typed out Pomp. At 6 1/2 to Vasilii. Five STimes & 2 LN.

6. Fine, some clouds. Worked am & pm till 4 on I cutting & adding all but ATT. Had to revise & do 2 copies sometimes. L & J out

to see arrival of Premier Fridenka, on AA, but got dark so we saw almost no one else but had good view of her. Cold out & very windy - Late tea, Minnie here. Dinner ev = 3 Robinson, 2 Rankin, Olandos, Marinatos.

7. Grayish. More I, chiefly Att. & pasting rest of chapter. Out 2.30 to Aer. for P's lecture on Prop. Big crowd students, very cold. Inside nice & splendid chance to see little +, box, walls, altar & inc.

Did all about Prop ending in Pinak. Glad of hot tea on return. Typed out Att. etc for old copy. L & J pp. before dinner. Eve Times & marking in VI. Began Du Maus.

8. Fine, ^{cold} anon on roofs. Did revisions in VI typing on old version. Till 3. Out to Market. fine views of snow on Ent. Bright sunshine - Back 4.30, Ath & Anest. covered lemon tree w. blankets. L, B, J to tea at Hill School. Also Mr Raymer. Back via

Kodak - saw illum. & decorations. To
Kento for masticha, lots here. Piet
returned for a few hours. Finished cut
& paste of II eve.

9. Unsettled. Day of wedding. Gens etc. Got
out c 9.15 to H. Att, big crowds but K

12 to Tsam. for fitting, found May. There.

Missie. Back to tea. Am Sch Open
Meeting, C Morgan on Corinth 1937.
Mastika afterwards at Sch. Evl rev.
Att. More things than, papers etc.

13. Fine. To Tsam. at 10, then Am Ex - Voul.
After lunch, typed 2d copy of Act. &
did bits on I (Act) VI etc. 3 games after
tea. To concert of Quartet, Vivaldi,
Beethoven, Ravel, very good. Evl began
Tory. Later marked XIV - XV.

16. Fine. Wrote T. Concert (pik) = Haydn
"Queen's hymn, Leon III, Casella Triple Cone. w
him, Bonucci - Poltronieri, very modern & int.
Then C. conducted his "Italia." Wrote H
after lunch - FW & part E Woodruff when Geo
McF - McKita turned up for call. Home for tea.
Scarlett, A-L, Alison - Lucy who stayed
after. Fin. EW. To Euclides for nice call. Evl
Tory. stuck. Reading Pepita in bed.

17. Fine. Worked on XIV cut, paste, type till c. 12
when to Ouida. More XII after lunch. H IV
in. Out 2.45 to Mary & she Millicent L & J
had a fine walk 3.30 - 5 around Toulon. &
Omorphe Evl - back by top Psych. Then for
tea. H & R in later. Left heart. More XII be-
fore rafter dinner till c. 11 - then read Times.

18. Fine. Did some XII then L & J out
on foot via Garden, Kyd, Trip. etc along
N side Act. for general look. Then to
Act., esp old Prop. On way to mess. &

met Mrs MacV. Mrs. closing so we
did S. side Parth - later GFS came
- we heard abt. approach to Parth.
Mrs M brought us all down. At XIX till
4 1/2 - L & J 5 games, after tea. Scranton in
for masticha. Eve Tony, St N, some ST
cutting - pasting.

19. Fine. Wrote F.M. Worked on XV till 12, then
Onida. More till nearly 4 then L & J drove
to Voul. before tea. Later had 3+1 games w. L
& B w. Piet - Eve read St ST - a letter Tony,
then marked XVI - XVII - Earlier typed notes XIV, XV.

20 Fine. Hold out my old hat box, then
to work on XVI most of the day until
4.30. Also filled in some gaps in XII.

who is leaving. Later to Davisi's -
stayed a long time after the party
was over. Back c.g. 15. B had out
Cor. & out with Geo McF. L & J had

3 games before P. B came in. Discussed
wed Parth. later.

21. Greyish. no day for outside lectures. Rain
later w drizzle. Worked on XVIII & XIX till
after 4, then 3 games L. To tea M Carty &
Washburn, B. in later - L & J to Vasili.
Eve chiefly Tony. 'Gt Journey.

22. Grey out. L & J out after 10, got anem. &
cog. left them at C.B, then to meet F.M
on automatrice, also T.L.S. & Co with a
big delegation to meet them - At hotel soon
after 11, both fine - Took old rooms 633, 615
then all out & talked over vermouth till
after 12. Put in a good p.m. till 4.30 on
XSI which got done etc. some revision
Storren's wall & knace. 3 games L before
tea. L, B, I to Aust Sch. good papers by
Raubitschek on Jedic. Some. & matter on
Kunke's relief. Big crowd, incl King. Eve
mainly looking thro Proleg & Thomis.

23. Grey, drizzle. Began T before all & went to concert, Marsick Cond = Corcoran, New World, Mons. Night on MT, Thibaud in Mozart D, Marsick Land. T. at his best. After lunch T, H, Martha. dug out a lot of notes, lib. etc. Bradshaw & Kelly in c.s. when we were dressing, saw them a little. Tea DMR, smallish party, that late. Pat Morgan's for caricature - Eric Tony & some "Small Talk."

24. Unsettled, windy. Worked on holes in XXI etc. for short call on F & M before lunch. Now XXI & come XXII after. Kelly & Bradshaw here for tea after archid: lect. 13 to Cor on 6 Autom. Mrs Paton for late call. Back to work & bill dinner. For 2 times, Tony, saw Mrs Stevens again.

25. Fine! More XXII. L & J out latish for Mrs to see new gold cups, now in v. case. 3 of them, one v. high handle, two small ones

Also had a look at towers, much cleaner. At XXII after lunch when M & N came w. flowers. Out c 3 - got M - drove to Marat. fine view. Eub. snow, got anem. on snow. M to tea & also Miss Haspell full of news of digs. Letter to Czech Legat. Eve LN, Punch, S Dow.

26. Fine. Finish typing Notes XXII. Had good day, did XXIII & XXIV. Call Marie S. 3-4. To GB for tea with F & M, then all to Thibaud, Piel met us there. Beuth. F, Viotti Amin, Chausson Poeme, Clair de lune, Saltarelle (Wieniawski) Rondo Cap (S.S.) & encores. Back c 9. Eve ST & more Dow.

27. Fine. Off to Thebes at 9. To BSA & got Young & his daughter. Thebes before 11 & spent till 5 etc. for lunch at nephews' restaurant. Cold in Mrs., much to do with lighting etc, but I took several photos. Back to Ath. fine drive both ways, lovely sunset, plenty of snow. Left plates Emil, took them BSA &

here at 7 for some tea, change - then on
xxiv before & after dinner, making, cut-
paste most of it.

28. Fine. Spent a.m. on xxiv, all but notes.

Here for lunch: Mrs Baepner, Miss Crowell,
Miss Carlisle, Mrs Maurice. Later typed
notes. F-M here for tea & all to Am Sch
for Shear on Agora. King here. Went
early - CM had saved fine places for us.
Back about 8. Eve Times, Ob & some Tong.
Jup Sym. from somewhere, also last night:
Ruch & Cox.

29. Fine. Did fillings in from 9/2-11, then
out via garden, Marinop, old streets
to DK, & back. Gorgeous morning.
To Aer. 2 1/2 for lect. beginning at
Beuli & ending at OP, all over hunting
blocks. Lasted till 6. Very windy & much
colder than a.m. L went early, left F-M
& in for tea soon after 6. B exhausted

L & J to marticha at Triant. nice party -
Eve Times & looked through new JHS.

30. Fine. No concert. Up late. Wrote T
-H before lunch, Son & May P. after, books
w. L, clearing up SE. Gray & cooler. Out 5:15
to 4th Col to see the boys do Tempert,
interesting though heretical, well acted -
Back late. Eve L & J finished Tong. &
I read some in H & V's Const. book.

31. Gray & dark, drizzle. Worked on xviii, made,
cut & did W ped. Also got L to read xix. To
tea with F-M at K. Geo. fine new room w.
window. All to concert, Knappertsbush, young
& energetic: Egmont, Moz 2, Don J, Buth VII.
Back late, was Homby.

Feb 1. Grayish. Working on xviii, M in about 11/2 -
& we had a great bout on H T's Stoa. cleared
fine during a.m. B & J to his lecture 2 1/2-4 1/2
on Parth. left M, Young & friends on way
back. Later got F-M & took to School tea.

- Brought L back anem. & fessias from Mem.
 Eve much talk on Parth, germ photos etc.
2. Fine. Spent most of day industriously
 on XVIII, A.P. & E. Fed. Mrs Skoers in c. 4 to
 ask us to dinner. M & F here to tea, also
 Marie S. later L on H. after Mohr's exhibit.
 In top form. Marj, in later a left her after
 the others. Eve marked XXI. M. Hess, Moz C. m.
3. Fine. Spent a. m. on XVIII, as far as O.P.
 L out errands. Some XX cutting, then out 3.30
 walk H.A., Oly, Gard, Del. A few drops on
 way back. L & I tea Brownie's, P. joined us
 there. Left Antonides on return. Eve
 ST, then part of XX reading music on -
 Fra2. on O.T.
4. Showery. Worked on XX intro, I & II the NP.
 Lot of typing. Too wet for Aer. 20 more p.m
 for an hour. Off 3.30 to Ath C for quartet
 some Viraldi - Busch. as at concert. Nelly
 & The Papadims. for tea in common room.

- Took Marj & Mill with us to Book Club
 meeting. H & R met us there, business con-
 tinue. Took tents home. Eve began Targ.
 Had Br & Cone, Narsan & Hayden Rome.
5. Wet. a. m. on XX, S.P. & much disputable
 material. L read some more chaps. B to a
 lunch-committee at Ath C. Worked till 3.30
 or so. B games pp. with L. To tea Mrs Paton,
 also 2 Horsfield, 2 Robinson (Loyd) Mrs Mon-
 jeato, Sebastian, Harrison, & Davis. Back to
 O.P. & collected F.M. & out to Davises to
 see moving pictures Cell - mastiche. Very out.
 case of M.H.
 vile night. Read Times & finished Hornby -
6. Still wet & windy. Began T, then concert
 with Knappf. Meist, Fantasia in Schum,
 Tristan Vorspiel - Liebestod, Busch II. Best
 in Wagner. Great enthus. After lunch
 finished, T, H, Midland. 3 pp. when L & A
 came. Quick change. Then F-M. much
 talk. Later all but L to Euclides.

4. T in great form. Back late. Eve first 3 chaps "20 cent Muscivorus", Straw, Straw Elgar... Beque "Helen's Tower."

7. Still out. More ~~XX~~ incl OAT + drastic cuts. L + J went over XVIII, XIX, XXI after lunch - J typed some revisions. Some pt. till tea, F Stone here. L + J to Vasili. Eve Box II from Leipzig, also Enrica. 2 Times + some Helen's T. Finished Joyce W's "Pereus" in bed.

8. Wet. Cleared out a lot of papers. Discussed with Distr. with B. L + J did XVIII and began XX. Stopped c 4 for some games. Tea w. Mrs Robinson, F, M, & Stenkinson, ^{with Mrs} Vera, at R. Geo. Prince Nich. died late a.m. Big crowds out. Back c 7.30 + few ref. for notes in XVIII before dinner. Pict out. Eve J + S on Sagittarii, some up in Rein. Rip. de vases. Later Helen's T.

9. Still unattached. XX Distr. wrote, typed + passed muster. Did XX with L till tea

Lesson. Made alterations + addit. Meame after lunch to paint - with L + J cleared up mon XX + XX, F also here to tea + we went to Brit. Cinema to Le Stigme, another bridge. Called at Germ Sch. for B but he had left. Eve read Ob, ST, JLN.

10. Brilliant! rather cold. Spent a.m. largely on scraps, WSD, etc. All off early to Acc. pm. for B on Erech. + some OT. Had to leave by 5 on acct tea F + M. Took them down with us. Later to GPs, also Helen E + Contessa de Lion. Much talk. Not back till nearly 8. Times + Helen's T. in eve. Helen's Suite, 30-ero etc from Breslau.

11. Fine. Worked hard a.m. on old Part. Cable Mable G. to get unath. To Florianus after lunch, then GPs for F + M + to Mar. Dam, organ in Tomis no. On to tea at Sati-viades, also Rox + Stan, Dna, Mrs Melissini, Mrs Petro, Vaci's man student. Dined

Legation, also F, M, 2 Davis, 2 Howland,
Schultz, Beck.

12. Fine early, shifts - late. Then to GPs 10 1/2
- had fine places on steps to see all
procession of Prince A's funeral. Very
impressive. Bar later, rain, back in
taxi. After lunch chiefly on ~~xx~~ & got
most of it - in shape. Stopped c 4 to go
to Fleriano & Anix - collect L from Orsida
Had 3 games before dinner, then began
Tony & worked on it - eve. P. out. Fin
Volue's T.

13. Wet am., hail, thunder, wind. Sun out by 11.
Wrote T & H, GNM before lunch. Out c 3 -
left B at Aerop. then to Psych. with cards
Phot. & Foster, then Chalaudri & Moni Pent.
Back c 4.15 & had 5 sets before tea. Out c 6
to Millers, then GPs, upstairs. Eve another
go at Tony, but before dinner went over ~~xx~~
for omissions etc & in eve also did NBD

on Older Park. Read 20th Cent Mus, on
Ranch.

14. Fine. St.V. Spent a terrific a.m. revising my
own typed ~~xx~~ to fit other, also notes. Mrs
Heron here to lunch, took her later to Sam &
to Mary's for early tea. Ci boat repaired, so
left Mrs H at GPs & met "Foscari" c. 5/2. C
in good form, no delays back quickly. More
~~xx~~ until dinner. B on Aer. till c 11. Had
Dr vid Cone from Wien - I Sym. Lcip.

15. Fine. Worked chiefly on ~~xx~~ & XVIII notes etc.
Geo Mylonas. Invitations?
B's archit. class here for tea, about 10 - 12 of
them. Later L & J to Nelly Evelpides' mas-
ticha, mostly medical lot, Papad, Theodoris,
Lyloudis, Stiganiade, several pleasant stran-
gers. Eve Erica from somewhere. Read part
Murder in Sun, Freeman.

16. Fine, cloudy still a.m. Went at 11 to Aer.
after getting Aer. notes ready. Found B, C &
Wagner doing photos, blocks all off. Digging

around circuit-wall S. of Parth. Checked up a lot in Mus, still in a mess. GPS showed me sites of statues, in part on sides Parth, also grille places in w. portico. Took him & C down when L-keeper came. Fine pm. So L, C, I went past Boyaki - had a pale view of Delph, having gone first to Dim. Collected F-M for tea. Before & after dinner L & I checked up on Omar cards, then Ob & 2LN. Had Back Suite, by variat from Bradae, later Bush. G Fyfe & new Schum connect (d'Arany;) from London.

17. Fine but more wind. Worked on Kell, Dim. Founder, "Petersch" etc. L & I read over last of SS. She & I to Danise's for day at home. Bought Wilbers back. Dined Skeris, + 2 Meev + 2 Robinson. Saw GPS new restor. of w. facade Parth.
18. Fine. Gathered up loose ends, put in more ins. in ST (at-end) - some from

Left B & C at Ther. pm - went by back road on to Vari - back to Phal. Tea with Ikeg.

Took old Tony. - after help finished it. Read Buchanan Aug before & after dinner. Cortot from Brada, Schum & Sym variat.

19. Fine. Started working out letter to Cep.

About 11, F, M, L & I to Kaisariani. Lot work & much chasing. L-M painted, F & I walked around head of valley part where spring. Lovely out, not very clear but fine views.

Back c. 1.45. Tried to straighten out a few more points in Aer. esp Eng, which am revising. ^{Annals F.S.} L & I at 7 to Vasili. Eve papers Aug.

20. Drizzling. Wrote T, H, G/MH. Cleared out many papers etc. L & I rearranged detective stories. Read some ST. Mrs Mousie here to tea (SC had sore throat & couldn't come) H & V also. Then call G Baker & her husband, Pierson, F & M in for a little, also Daniel. Up to early dinner in Loring with the students, much

talk after - Back by 11, market home - Real
Punch in bed.

21. Windy, unsettled. Got rev. done in XII
on Evg. - cooled up a lot in Ind. & at -
After lunch did XIX on Philop. Tea GtB
with F.M., Robinson, Stason, Rox, Marie S., Mary
Stenson. Later F, M, B, C, L & J to con-
cert of Gt songs, fine - Soloists Althe Papa-
constantinova & Phrosoo Koricola, she partic-
good, fine cho. like evzones, violin, clar-
mand-organ. Great success. Back late.

Saw all new photos of Park. Real Aug.

22. Unsettled, cold. Washington's Birthday -
Worked on XIX (Philop.) & further revs. Did
some XII later with L. Big tea 5 1/2 - 8
pract. all Americans. 91 + family. Buffet
supper after - L & J had a go at Tong, but
made small progress. Began "Forever
Ulysses" by Rudonacchi.

23. Fine. Left Acc. for a time & began further rev.

I & II. Out c 11 for good walk. Gard, Kyd, Trip.
Aup & down via Theatre. L & J out 3-5 a fine
drive to Laurium, pract. whole road good
now. II after tea, then tub & Ulyss. Dinner Davis,
also F, M, A Pallas, Calvo, Foster.

24. Fine but very windy. More Diatr. from sup. given
by Lucy. Then I & II rest of day, started to
copy II to show H.T. After tea L & J looked
up some words & did Tong, a horrid one. Din-
ner GtB with F.M., also Shear, 2 MacV, Rodney,
2 Morgan, 2 Yung, 2 Davis, 11 Euclides, & 5 of us -

25. Snowflakes, sun trying to come out. Did II
most of day, many add. sps. etc. L & J read
rest of XII, XIII & part XXIV in p.m. F-M to
tea - all to B's lecture on O.P. at AmSch.
Great success. Five Ob, 5T & some JLN.

26. Fine, some clouds. Did II till after 11, then
L & J to Glyph. near Poop. & J had an
hour's walk while she painted. More
typing II until tea & after - John Wright

here for tea. Dined GB with Robinsons,
also 2 Dumbabin - Neuziger -

27. Greyish. Up late. Wrote TH before
lunch. Did J's book with L. All 4 to
lunch Reuter's, also Robinsons. Sump-
mous spread, nice apt. L & J tried
Tory. Miss Stone here to tea. Cone Rome
w. Br III. L & C to Euclid. Finished Ulyss
before dinner. More Aug. in eve.

28. Greyish, chilly, windy. Stayed in & went
over all 1937 Ag. reports looking for ad-
ditions. Changed typie ribbon. L & J went
over rest of XXIV & XXV after lunch. Went to
Tram. with her for her fitting 4.30. Begun af-
ter tea to address envelopes. P back c 7/2
we sat around with drinks. Eve had Coriol &
IX Sym. from Buda. Read 2 Times & Aug.

Mar. 1. Still greyish. Worked on I till 11.30 when
to Onida with Fenwick post. To GB, F

to Ombla, lovely - cool. Later to

27. Fine, warm. Did a lot of packing
from 6 on. Out after 8, L painting on
balcony. Did walk, some shade & a

good breeze - Down by Place, & to Domin. to
see ²N Ragusa & Titian. Repairs in progress.
Took shady by ways to top & in - out. Met
L in Stradone, many bells, celeb. at Orthodox
ch. Got bracelets - L a doll. To Dom. again,
then cefi by sea & saw Eng papers, Times,

dinner full of variety. At Sinj passed Tomisl
where stopped last year, glad to go on to

Grčac lunch, swasting hot & glaring, got
fish from man under tree & cont. into
county. Found a nice little oak wood.
& children came but couldn't even learn

July 1. Glad to be cool. Up late, break on terrace below,
