29. Foggy - haze. Early for errands -

Very industrious writing letters a.m. & p.m.

MU, GS, CS, MFW, GNH, Geo, ECT, N. etc.

at breakfast Willis telephoned. he & Emily  
came to lunch. Lovely time with them.

Rain before they left. L to Mac.

Usual Dr Ch. in eve & some music.

30. Misty, hard rain p.m. Up late. James took over from Bill. Local errands, Pitts-ke, wash, etc. After lunch helped by Ray, packed C's clothes - 2 trunks with linen. Did 5 pr. shoes after Tea, finished another V Bridges. Music, news etc, Doubt & 2 Ch. Silver Spoon. L tel from Alice M.

Oct 1. Still moist & some rain. Up late. Did packing, odds etc. till 11:45. Papers till lunch. Wrote MPW, 13, much more prep. Got supper. 2 games cal & some music.

2. Fine. Breakfast 8:30. Did run down packing, the rest of it: Dobby washing etc. Lunch out Auto, waffles. Lino.

Lesson being laid. Did pract. all rest of my packing p.m. Wrote T. Wrote GYM u.m. Had a couple of farmed games eve.

3. Fine. Took most of u.m. on odds & ends. Gift. Mrs S. to clear house. Went to club for mail while L. finished. Left C. 11:30 via Saranac (Stone's watch) new road Tupper Lake & Thro' mts. Simply gorgeous coloring, more brilliant than last year. Lunch Tupper L. in Coffee Shop. Gradually down nearly to Utica & by road to Whiteboro, but not time to see much. Supervisor told me White portrait in Town Hall. Took 5 road <sup>Fayetteville</sup> for Syrac. Off at Chittenango but big detour up & down hill to Skam. after going thro' S. edge Syrac. Got dark &

after Stan. & Arthur had great time  
finding Nell's. Arr. 7.15. Had night  
our card. Much talk, read CMT 8.30  
on questions, late dinner & news.  
4. Fine. Forgot to mention extension to  
living room, great success. Breakfast  
later to golf club, 9 holes before &  
9 after lunch. Splendid place &  
grand day, lots of fun. Back at 3.5  
quick change. To Aub. at 7 to Mrs  
Huslet(?) to hear Mrs Clift very inter-  
esting story of their adventures to, in & from  
Eng. followed by cocktail party,  
many pleasant people. Back c. 6.  
News, dinner, Nell's movie Egypt,  
last year etc. Dominion.  
5. Fine, warmer. Late breakfast to golf

9 holes, lunch, back c. 1.30. Shower,  
repack, pack car etc. Left 2.40, along  
lake & to Stan. & route 20 & to F. W.  
Drove chair up & down. Arr. 5.15, F. to  
hospital to see Rosalie. Tea, unpack.  
Align to dinner, much talk & news.  
6. Had shower early, doubtful, in & out &  
clear by 3. Back in bed. Read papers  
& T.S. Off 11.15 to Coop. Left F at  
hop. & to Hist Soc. Mrs Mackenzie a  
nice girl showed us round & F. col-  
lected us later. To Mac. house to see  
view. Back 12.45. Lunch 1.15 Mrs  
Loesch  
Hyde, 2 Leitch(?), Walkover, Align.  
Good party. Write up diary. Tea  
later 2 Paterson, Morgan, Brown, Hough-  
ton. Another good party. A. to eat

hers & turned in early. Down at 10  
in dressing gowns for Sleep.

7. Cloudy, cleared fine. Up early to push  
break 8 1/2, Jan 9 1/2 away before 10. Fine  
drive via Cobleskill & R.V.W. bridge.  
Gorgeous day. Arr. 12.15 - Beckman  
Arms for lunch & V.C. about 1.30. Met  
many council etc. Had called at  
Billy's but L. returned later. Saw H  
& G.M. Unpacked some, have No. 1.  
Have at 4. Tea on terrace, & back  
before we finished. Rest & change &  
OS, CS, H & G.M. here for dinner &  
tuxedo after. Later to H's for drinks.

8. Greyish but fine. Break. in bed at  
9, papers, unpacking - G & H & we off  
at 12 for Goose Point - Jan for lunch.

Many trees, hydroplane etc. Big feast.  
Lonely drive through back country &  
round in @ Pleasant Plains, beautiful  
foliage. Back c. 5. H & G had chatter.  
Hans & us to supper, then to studio  
& saw C's latest, oils & water. Back  
about 9.15. Began Double Postmail  
(Clos, G.M.).

9. Fine but sultry. To Post c. 10.30 & to  
Dr Cook. Packed her dress to Brewster  
on foot for exams, Lueckey, 5 & 10 etc.  
& to Dr Easton 11.45. Lunch Tea Shop -  
Back to C 1.30, saw V. Thompson re  
registering Anne - Lola. Back to A.H.  
Began T. Got R. and had drive in back  
country, N. Hack, Hopland, Fish., So. Rd. &  
got her back for 4.30. Tea on front terrace

with MIB. To H. for drink & dinner wms.  
Get take GYM, FB, AK. Saw many others. In  
H's room after.

10. Fine, brilliant but hot. Up early, to pack  
- left 9.15 via Potk bridge - 9W, behind  
W. Point - out again river road, Hask. At  
Myack stopped Mary's but out. Eng. c. 11.20  
To deSheres with L's fur cape & she orders  
a blk. coat & so did J. She got blue dress.  
Lunch Mary Eliz. To Esther's Hill Geo. at  
2.30 - 4 for hair. Back to E for tea. Dams  
Pauline in later. All left c. 6. Spent  
night at Jenny's. Bill there car -  
own some of A's portraits. Rem at 10.

11. Fine, less hot. Up early & all H for NY  
at 9, left car in 57 garage. Taxi to BT to  
then F-Simon for blouses & blk. skirts -

for me. To Bent's for walking shoes. Met Lat  
L & T. about 12. Bus to Met. & poked round  
a little. Lunch with Gisela Janna in the  
court. Karo's "Sat." late, did not reach Met.  
Hill after 5, looks very fit. We left 5.20 &  
were in Htt in 2 hrs. for quick dinner.  
Fine going but muggy in dark. Hazel  
over after dinner. Up early to unpack &  
read in bed. Chiffon Scarf.

12. Fine. L off at 9 to Dr Coste. Paper. Walt  
T, B. Odds ends. Out 2.30 with H & G  
drive branching off Wash. Hollow to Pine  
Plains & back via Nibroot. Lovely  
country. Left H. G to Tea Shop, L to den-  
tist - joined us. GB here to dinner. Eve  
took H & to Concert, Leonard, Statton,  
Crouch, Wms. Sonatas from Paradise to



Waldstein. To H's later. Back 10.15.  
13. Gorgeous day. To Main c10, bookshop,  
coffee in class. Office, all Dept, Lee  
GMM. Then to golf, 1 round fine  
out. Made date with Frank. Lunch  
H.H. Tubo, off c. 2 1/2 taking GMM + GS +  
stopped bet. N Hack + H. Junct. for  
G + L to paint. GMM - I slowly  
drive in country, Clont, Verbank  
+ loop. Tea in Pub, G too. L + I to  
sports shops but no luck shirts  
or pullovers. GMM + M here for din-  
ner. Late near Hudson River.

14. Threatening. Off 9 to Dr C with  
L. Began to rain. To Wallace, hockey  
but n.g. Out again c10 raining  
hard. Dug out winter clothes. Let

up. GMM in for short time, Ben Library  
+ looked at -Class. Pee, JLT etc.

Cleared fine. Out at 2 for L to finish  
painting + I sat in car + wrote GMM + FW.

Back 3.30 + to tea 4.30 in Off. P. given by  
H + G with loads of our friends. Big  
crowd + lovely party. They were here at  
H.H. for dinner + we spent till 6.45 in H's  
Sat in upper hall + read Hudson. Later  
Town Grid Murder, L Ford.

15. Gorgeous day. Not too early for  
Sunday. Papers - Off before 11 with  
H + G, Pot bridge, west side to King-  
ton, S. side reservoir, across to  
fountains, round s. + n. end + to  
Woodstock by back rally. Lunch  
Houses Garden. Big crowd 20 May

late getting it but delicious.  
 Charming old house. Back to  
 spot we had selected & L & G painted  
 while H & I walked in woods.  
 There saw finer foliage. Back  
 via New Path. Here before 6, & to  
 H's for cocktails. Back to apt to  
 change. Wrote B. At 9 heard part  
 of music concert, Back, Goldmont. Sup.  
 in Pub. Nudson, Ford.

16. Fine. L to Cook 9.30 & I did B.T.C.  
 Big picnic, making in A.H. so we  
 cleared out for the day. Out after 10  
 for round of golf. Finished at main  
 before 12. Took boat to road. Went via  
 Carmel to Brewster, lovely country.  
 Wooden Boat at C. closed for season

so to Gay Nineties, very attractive. Then B.  
 village & a long chase for Ryder farm  
 which was fun to visit again & Miss R.  
 did the honors, charmingly remodelled  
 and most attractive. Back via Parley  
 - L to dentist at 5. Finish Nudson  
 eve. Color off with Mrs. Kial.

17. Fine, slightly overcast. off to Fair,  
 Splendid drive by Bond. to near You-  
 hers where we were sent thro' part of town,  
 Brook & after many turns over White  
 Stone Bridge, fine view N.Y. & Sound. Fear-  
 fully cold & windy. Dodged round & finally  
 passed Roosevelt Ave Field B7. On foot by  
 bridge over 1137 St. to Fair. Much finer  
 than I expected. Can't describe. Went to G.C.  
 pavilion, then long tramp to Turk. rest. Great

couldn't get waited on. Met Dakyer. Back to Belg. for lunch - fine view fountains etc. To Italia, huge waterfall, fine whit. Bus to Market pieces - met Alma. Mag. rif. Show but freezing cold. Later got tea Budw. Tried Gen. Mot. but long mob, Swedish, fine, City of Light NY illum. All sorts of places, nearly blown to bits. Met Bill, Esther, Jenny at Turkish, drinks & dinner - to 9 at Lighting on fountains, very beautiful & gorgeous. All most blown to pieces. By time we reached car it was nearly 10. Got our key & got on Bronx bond. Got across to Elmford & onto our own & made good time. In c. 12.30.

18. Fine, brilliant, less windy. L to Cook

9/2 - I read papers till her return. To Main with books, H for mail, got GS & to Prof. I did a round & they painted till 12.30. Working - odd jobs after lunch. Wrote TB, T, a very long one. Tea with GS, the Bests & L in upper hall. L had tooth out so could not go to H. for cocktail or CB for dinner. Others were Edna, Haley, Mrs. French & Polyx. In CB later. To Lilian, L here, supper upstairs - did 2 Doubles.

19. Fine, breezy. Mending, papers etc. Off 10.30 Main errand, got G at 11 - she & L painted. I had a lesson with Frank. Finished off with Mrs. Neah, wrote Liz after lunch - did Bunker's aut with L. To Classical Club 4.30, tea

• Splendid talk on AIDS by GMM. H, L, G, GMM & I to Marie's for cocktails - then dined with her in AH & nice talk after.

20. Fine, mild. L to Cook 9.30 - I to Fieldkill  
- Mr B. as notary for signatures on Ine Tax claims. Left 9.45 for Englemont gorgeous drive Route 9, Bear M. Park, Lake Suffern - across. In Scherer by 12 - L had coat fitted. Mine not ready, got a blue & black frock. Collected Dave for lunch. Pat flat a moment. Lunch M. Eliz. Met D's old lady. Took flowers to cemetery - left D. Collected blue dress - fox from de B. up Pal. ave - back all the way by river road. 3.30 - 5.30 Pot Bridge. Got a Memo. Act by 6. After dinner sat with G & A Buechard

later to H's. Back early & read paper - fin. Death in the Home (Berkeley).

21 Fine. Off at 10 for lesson with Frank L finished painting. Sent documents to BTO. Back to AH - off even after 11 on picnic, GS, A Buechard, Mrs Torker. Out W. Hollow - 82<sup>A</sup> and Sixth branch road. Very windy - A grand feast - New painting - The other 3 in one place - 2 in a more sheltered, made good pict. Sat in car - read NYT, began B lefts. 3 to Library for 2h N, back to AH, tube, mending, finished B. Got H. at 5.45. to Coffee Shop of Nelson House for early dinner. cat 7 to Stratford to "No Smith Goes to Wash." Pouring when we got out, but J. rescued us. AH all quiet after party

When we arr. at 9.50. Still raining.

22. Cleared & began to dry, cloudy, some sun.

Up early, break at 8 in room, ff 8 1/2  
via 376 - parkway, splendid drive -  
arr. Penn. Stat. 10.20. Long wait - Hill

11.30 train, met only Bieber. At P.

Junct. TLS & Geo E. were there to

meet us, found Gisela - Dianna  
had come by car with A Butt. Others:

Müller, Noel, Meritt, M Thompson,

Rodney, Katz, Jos. Cocktails first, then

to Inn for banquet. Place cards - list

of C's photos, Duell more large photos

& water col. of Tang, OIB on E slope &  
root near Thake & on N slope, odd sauct.  
w. groups of small acyphoi, Dick on cond.  
at Antirich, TLS reunion of Agona with a  
magnif. place. Sumptuous tea & off at  
6 = Gisela, WSD, Bieber, L & J. Not so fast  
a train, 7.22, Jas. here & left by 7 1/2 and in  
A4 by 9.30 - to Pub for sandwiches. Good  
going on Parkway + Manchester. Going via  
E. Highfill. Read NYT Hill late.

23. Fine, cold. L to Cook at 9.30 & did odd  
Hill return at 10. Lesson Frank 10.15.

Met GS & all to Pok. Got 2 for. striking  
Lucky, met them at Bank having run  
across Mrs. Moulton & B French. G & J to  
coll. & L to Easton who took out upper  
tooth. A & J lunch Pub, G & M came

along. All in keases when L returned.

Soft lunch upstairs. I took GB - G.M. out at 2 1/2, to NYC to order L's tickets for Sat, then up to Rhinebeck, very brilliant - clear, fine of Catskills.

Back before 4. Sent off 2 lots of books to F.V. L - I tea in room, then Doubt.

H to dinner, modest site in coop.

After she left L - I did more Doubt in upper hall - Early to bed.

24. Fine, gorgeous day. Up before 7 to pack left 9 for Northampton via Gt B, best. field - avoided large places. Splendid drive, quick time arr. 12 - found FG in office. L - L unpacked - sat in P's rooms till five at 1. Lunch / Mary M - Back for Benedictines.

Off 2.30 for Boston via Amherst & Concord, splendid drive, park way W-Boston which we reached at 5.

Getting dark, passed Puritan, much I way to get back. No word L or Geo.

Went out for him first - 424 Beacon, but not there yet, then 208 Newbury - found him. Back to P. - up to 7.25 - unpack -

Tel. Liz, away 2 days - just back -

had not got wire, nor had Geo. Read NYT before dinner which I had in old Boston room. Later round to see Geo, much talk, escorted me back.

Much better than last year. A lot of diary to catch up before writing T.

25. Fine, warmer. Breakfast in bed. NYT. Out 10.15 to W Medford to Liz's - spent most

a.m. before her fire in delightful study,  
cup & sherry. To town to Amalfi rest.  
for excellent lunch. Museum for brief  
call Caskey who showed me splendid  
torso of Kouros. Met Geo at 3 after his  
reading. Out to Perkins & saw his John,  
then took Liz home. Back to Newbury  
St. about 5 & with Geo till 7. Dinner  
French rest, very good. Left 7.07 & got  
to Worcester 8.03. Began to rain, 25 m.p.h.  
traffic, very long getting through. Wet  
roads, flat tire before Leicester -  
quickly mended. F.G.'s about 10.30.  
Drinks before fire. Skitt- in glass  
room. Hard rain.

26. Misty drizzle, break c. 8 & off 9.15 by  
Huntingdon Rd (O's going). Some

rain & much mist in river valley & mts.  
GFB, Sharon, clearing all the time & seen  
on last part. Til. near America to Easton  
not started till Fri! Off at 12.30. Met  
H. on doorstep. Lunch here, wrote F.G.  
after unpacking. N. up for call. Wrote H &  
& Geo. L to Cook at 4. Late tea in Pub.  
Kate & Janet here before dinner, which we  
& G had together. To Chatterton's where IC  
showed 4 reels colored movies mostly of  
Greece. Fine show. Several students, H, G,  
I.R., Ringe & a few more.

27. unsettled. Break, write K-J. Papers, some  
packing of L. To Main, then down & got hat<sup>10</sup>  
at Boxford. Early lunch, L to Easton 1.30 & J  
to Library. Mostly read Punch & Agh. Back  
by 3.30 & L here with teeth. Out. Got H &

tea at Phil's for Mrs Davis. Back 5 1/2 -  
 Double till 6 1/2 dinner, H, G, K, J, L, J. To  
 Hungarian eve, very good, Hava vidis,  
 Book coloratura, pleasant dances by child  
 den. Later to Tonkeses, also 2 Chats, H,  
 G, K, L - I. Back before 11. Puz. in bed.

28. Wet. Break 5.15 - L to Cullerud at 9.  
 Read paper. Rain let up. L back by 10  
 - we went to gym. for golf, but F.  
 not here so found him on Sunset -  
 L got clubs in Inez's office. Helped L  
 pack before & after lunch. GS, K, J, L - F.  
 Hate of about 2. Tea with MFB, then  
 8 pieces - L & V to station - etc of  
 J. H. Taxi back. H here to dinner & we  
 spent quiet - we by her fire & read  
 detection story. "This is what happened".

Back early to H & read more.

29. Fine, perfect day. No hurry, breakfast,  
 some packing. Off 11.30 with Garneley &  
 Lind. to meet Mabel. Still in Room 1.  
 Naged here for dinner w/ Mrs L. Mrs L  
 - I took M for round of campus 2 1/2 - 4  
 all over the place & back round lake.  
 Saw Hud. valley speech exhibit very  
 good. Found moving in prog. When I  
 came in. Now in 18. Quick change  
 - to H. at 5 - for cocktails. Buffet Tea  
 & talk Lind. & Jones after. Upstairs  
 early. Finished N Y Times, then bed &  
 finished T. I. W. H. (Toddlay max).

30. Grayish, rain later. Break with MFB  
 8.30. Out Cg. 45, also Mrs L, to Avery -  
 left them for coffee & went to Frank.



Met Dem c. 11 in Bookshop. Called on  
M Mac C. Back to Att to change - GS  
- M Mac C. here to lunch & talk. Up to 16  
c. 3 and wrote L - made up diary.  
Very wet. M - J to see Gorm at 5. Dined  
here & talked after & upstairs early. Be-  
gan M D letters, One Pair of hands.

31. Wet, horrid day. Went with M for  
10.45, which 40 m. late so sat in station  
11/2 to M D for hair file 1. To Wilson  
for garage receipt. Back to take lunch  
in Pub. Unpacked trunk & all other  
luggage, dreadful job. At 5.45 to M,  
cater were Gorm, Marie, & Clarke, Radio.  
Read Monica in upper hall.

Nov 1. Fine. Out c 9.30 to di Gunnaro with  
blue coat to shorten. Looked in shop

windows but didn't see anything - Back to 15.  
Wrote Gorm H. Chat with MB. To library & left  
Jane in drawer of Lat. Sem. Found Bicker's  
Theatre & read 1 ch. before & 2 after lunch.  
Lunch with GS in Davison, also 2 others -  
Back at 3, wrote L, Alice S, Jess. Journal  
Club 4 1/2 in Student room Att. Giddy tea by  
Gorm. H read chap. on Ling from her book.  
Dined Wmo. with Gorm, H, Inez, Phil. To  
Hi afterwards, much discussion of Soft.  
& Equip. Back 8.40. Rest a little Monica,  
wrote ELT. Little Anne & friend came.  
2. Fine, some clouds. Up early to join A at  
breakfast. Paper errands, Frank 10.15.  
Back to Att - wrote long letter T.  
Lunch Pub. Golf EC at 2, was a real  
disgrace to F, but fine out. 1 up.

- Back before 4, change, Libr. Ch IV  
Bibles. H here to dinner & I went  
here afterwards. Began F Iles  
"As for the woman," sent by Ottom  
3. Fine, cold & frosty early. To F. at  
8.45, did better. Back to my  
office & read NYT, then coffee &  
H, Phil, Ted, Pat, Katzenebogen &  
Richards. H & I lunch Prob.  
Walter L. & Mabel. To Library & read  
to end VII Bible, also ILIV, S. 23-50.  
Back before 5 to tub & dress. To H 5.45  
for drink. To Millers for dinner, also  
Ottom, H, F White. Back after 7. Finish  
Iles (prov).  
4. Fine, perfect day. Began Mickey Finn.  
Papers, began B. Stop to see GS - do

- errands, H's office. Cigs came from Liz.  
97 lunch. Grand showing with 15 here.  
GS, MacC, Tweedy, Reimer, Thompson, Mc-  
Lellan, Lind, Taylor, Burchard, Ferris, Sti-  
vers, Brackett, Whitney. Gay lunch, then  
a circle to talk & hear Marie, Nancy &  
me. No J went off by train, set up as a  
campus tour, G room. 10 to dinner &  
much talk after on Troy. Big delega-  
tion spent night.  
5. Dull, rain began c 11, then a deluge & a  
terrific storm. All had gone but  
Lillian. H took her & me to Mrs. before  
L went to Co's & H & I to E Carter to see  
Nina Borany. Terribly wet walk back.  
Lil. off 3.30. Read NYT, did odds,  
water L & Stennely. H to supply

6. Fine early, dull later. Picking, Frank, 10 - I in Pub for lunch. Off to my on 3.33. Lovely trip. Arr. for late tea with M. Then got settled. Lucy, Eph - Little A. to dinner. Tack of south with E. afterwards.

7. Fine. Nice variable time with M. Then to PS - got 2 blouses, small things L - T. Met Trill at T.H. Club for lunch much talk - then to "Mr. Chips" - back for tea. A bill will be our chauffeur. Back at 7 for supper with M. a nice evening - Uncle L.

8. Fine. M - I to Met. to see Life in America. Fine, didn't finish.

9. Brilliantly clear but very windy. Left M coming down with cold - went to Altman's for shoes, belt, suede - sports. Met Jean - Alice at T.H.C. for lunch. Both fine. Left at 3 - up to M's to dress for small tea. Goldstein, Mastry, Gatt, 3 Moore, McKaine, K. Reilly. Had a fine time. Dored Teller - Mrs. Prokes, lots of lovely things.

10. Fine. M better. Returned to Met. Street later for her shoes, ng. To Philharmonic

 tory performance, Barb. Met Ethel  
 Richardson afterwards. Late tea

 Harkness to Marinatos on Car-  
 cults in Cuto, excellent. Saw  
 many friends there. Back for Swing  
 at 10, finished "Case of Late Pig" &  
 packed.

11. Fine. Armistice Day. Left 10.45  
 after fine visit. Lovely trip up. At  
 c. 12, room still occupied. Lunch  
 at H's & good talk. Back c. 2 & all  
 things moved in - things unpack

& settling. Changed - to see G.S. Nagel  
 had 2 Fernandos here for dinner & in  
 her room after. Back before 10.

12. Fine. Very lazy & no hurry getting  
 up. Read paper, did mending etc.  
 Under Nobel & Denny (Savane). H,  
 G & M - I dinner with Inez also  
 C.S. - Polyx. Saw ill. p. book after.  
 Had a hilarious time. Rested  
 a little, long letter to L. H & G here  
 to supper but left fairly soon. Got  
 out quick & read some.

 cooker, hall - recept. rooms either side. NB  
 all this house splendid pres. of plaster  
 work. Ceiling, central orn. done on copper &  
 dome decov. in copper moulds. All timber  
 hand hewn, casted wonderfully. Out houses  
 etc. blown down - ruined; orig. roof still  
 strong on G. Domes have small cols in  
 top; went onto roof - the ring for rain. No  
 use trying to describe. See H & G, Nov. 29  
 On E thro Selma to Montgomery. Hard  
 to get good picnic place, windy, paved.

At M. saw Confed. White House, opp. Cap.  
fine building well art. In Lynch's statue.  
at ch. plom. got copies of book at A.  
wrote some houses. Saw some good  
old ones in busy city. On to Tuskegee  
(It was day before we saw all the lovely  
daffodils, after Dem.). Found it - a  
nice little town. Frank Harris hotel,  
simple but comfortable. Had a walk  
hill down - U. etc.

22. Fine. Mrs Harris took us to see Alex.  
house another in the book. Col. all  
round, also palm. ornament over win-  
dows - fringe. Fine old contents. Mrs  
A. most hospitable. To Inst. - drove  
round campus - saw Dr. Carson's exhibit.  
To hospital for Negro Veterans, band

work, nice girl doing AM at NYU looked out  
for us - got scarf, bag etc. On via Phoenix  
Columbus (time changed) another picnic.  
To Albany where there had been fearful  
cyclone destruction on high hotel all  
night. Sheets full of cars. Sailed in  
from Albany, then out for walk - found  
lovely old house with scaffolding for  
repair - Columns formerly all round.  
Met owner Miss Whitehead on steps  
& heard much from her about cyclone  
& hotel, which is in Albany folder.  
23. Fine, drove round town to see ruins,  
then via Tipton - Wraycross - Country  
more swampy - wooded. Long delay  
on bridge before Brunswick on acct.  
repairs to road. Nice town, are in old

Oglethorpe about Savannah style.  
Went shopping for Easter cards etc  
before cocktails & drinks. Then  
ch. in old parlor.

24. Easter, fine, some clouds. Up  
late went to service at St Mark's.  
Wrote FB before lunch. Were having  
lunch where FG & co. arrived, very  
quick men. Good gossip upstairs,  
hard shower, jokes, mate etc. All  
out later for walk to Court House  
& park, Gloucester St to cemetery,  
No bar, so opened ouzo. Ch eve.

25. Clear, cold & windy after rain.  
Off c. 10 for S. Simon a fascinating  
island which we drove all  
round & also to Sea Island to

Cliviers. Tables gone, nice place but  
cold. Drive along length of island  
then back to St S., Bloody Marsh &  
Fort F. or Oglethorpe. Fire trees, esp  
oaks. Saw golf, lighthouse, beach  
etc. Then back over causeway & up  
17 to Santo Domingo Park made  
out of an old plantation. lovely  
for picnic in the sun. Then up to  
Butler Island to look for F Temple's  
house but has been torn down. On to  
Darwin & ride road through country  
& out on pier for view across to islands.  
Back c. 4.30 for a "net" which was  
darning, writing FW & diary. A  
few games in eve.

26. Fine. Decided we'd show FG some

of Florida so left 9.40 for Jax.  
 Then along St. J. river to GC Springs,  
 a lovely place. To PO - get address -  
 back to see house, on corner, on river.  
 Met the man who bought it. To cem-  
 etery, - N took photo. On road for Pa-  
 catka - roadside picnic, then the  
 P - W St Aug. Along square, NRT,  
 sea front, post, gate, school, Ponce  
 a good general idea. Florida all  
 green now with new trees, looks  
 fine, wisteria, dogwood etc. Back  
 by beach road, dunes, beaches to  
 J. & got to B. at 7 before dark -  
 296 mi. Had well earned drink &  
 dinner - upstairs early.

27. Greyish but fine. Had a lot of last

things - packing to do, so started 11.30  
 Took 17 - out past Butler, etc. Lunch in  
 funny little place by Ogeechee river. Got to Sa-  
 vannah c. 2.30, De Soto. Left L for a bit & B

 out in car round beautiful town. Breakfast -  
 squares, Bay road, round parks. Low House,  
 Grant, Lafayette (Owens) much driving round.  
 Tavern before dinner in Flamingo - Satin  
 lounge after. Got roses for L when we went  
 back pm, also library books.

28. Grey. Went to Beaufort for a grand  
 time. Refused to take on way, no one hunt.  
 Out 17 to junction, Garden's Corner, across to  
 Royal I. - A series of islands & inlets. Thro'  
 Burton to B. Lovely old town, lots of old  
 houses, fine church St Helena. We went  
 in & out, along front, over causeway to

Ladies' I & St H. Hard rain most of  
time, lunch under trees by road. Got  
as far as Frogmore, then decided to  
turn back. Had a great day in  
spite of all. Series of deluges & down  
pours, noise ran to Edge. Got back  
c. 5.30 & actually a bit up as we  
dashed into hotel. FG brought Mrs  
I. Lady as present. All ready for  
Tavern, also had dinner there  
very picturesque. Sat round &  
talked until time to go to station  
with FG. Left 10.30.
