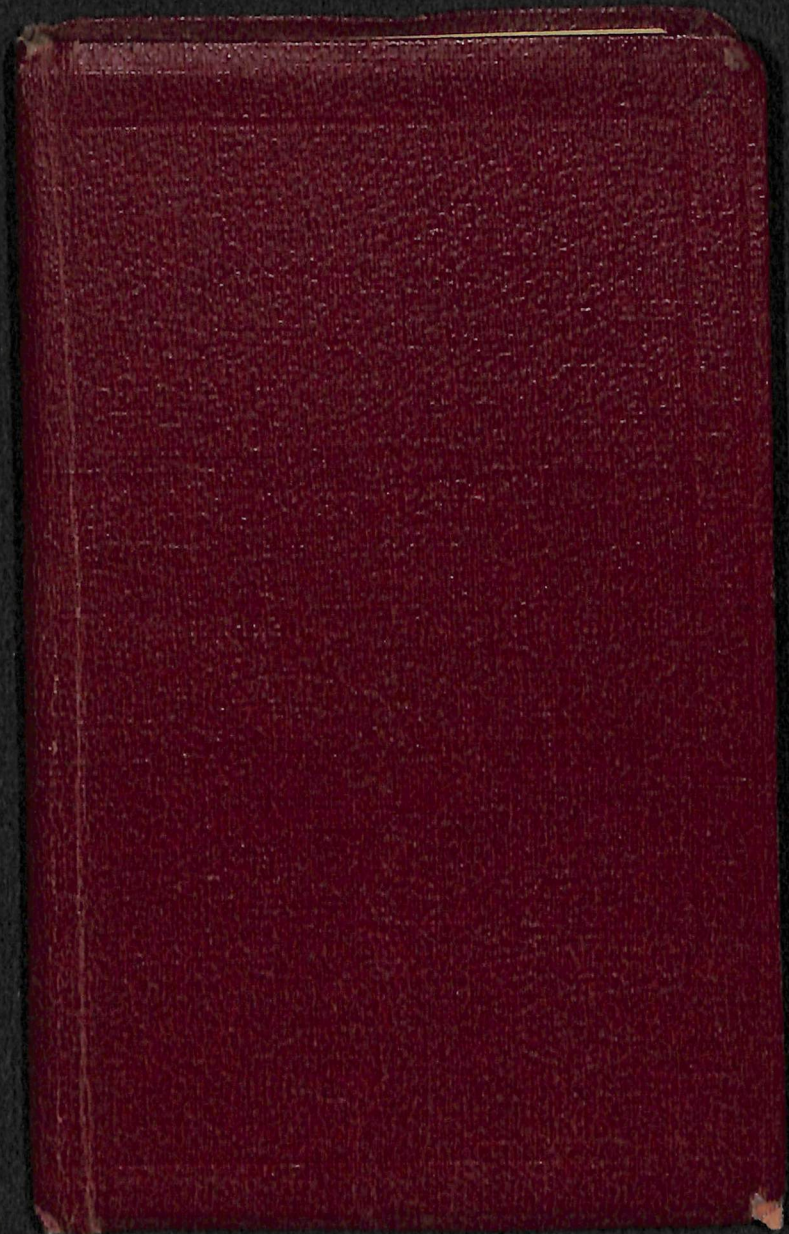


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March 29, 1940 - Dec 31, 1940

Mar. 29. Foggy & misty a. m., cleared later.
 up late & began T. lunch in Gk. rest.
 across the street. From Sparta, they had
 been at Ath. Coll. Had Garden Club
 tickets for tour & as I was clearing we
 did a round in country. Bull to vict.
 Drive, gorgeous agaveas, palms unda-
 maged. Turned r. & eventually to
 Sleg Hope, great search for Millerley
 & no luck but saw other fine old
 houses. Lost various kinds but no
 matter, saw Geo. Ag. Coll, Bethesda.
 Finally to Normsloe, oak ave. 1 m.
 long, gorgeous place, magnificent
 trees, camellias, library, boat house,
 house itself very fine (see H. & G.).
 Formal garden at back had very
 int. iron fencing, new patterns.
 Whole place lovely. Round by Mont.
 gomery to Beaulieu, 3 gardens. Mrs
 Clarke & camellias. Fine section.

On to Vernon View - out to end of
point tho' couldn't find garden.
Back again to I. & H. out to hills.
Key with magnif. gables - can
in more open pine plantation.
Nice out of door terrace - chimney
lowly grounds - view. Across to
White Bluff Rd. - back that way.
In before 6. Had been very hot in
sun. Tavern for drinks & dinner.
Upstairs early - finished T.

30. Misty, sticky, rain in night -
showers later. Up later, did a lot
of mending. Made T - W - diary.
Cleared before noon - L & D took
a taxi to Pink House and had
a delicious lunch. Then got
me a nightgown, then up Aber-
corn N State - to Darnapit -
back via Ogletrope, old cem. etc.

Met N. at hotel - later we got car
- went Bull, Viet, to Thunderbolt -
got lost - went all round, golf
club etc. - back to Victory - finally
to Bonaventure. (Should turn
L. 1 m. beyond Stad.) As beautiful
as described, trees, flowers, moon.
Back to Th. - out across islands,
White marsh, Widmington, Logaretto
(saw Fort Pulaski across inlet) Sav.
Beach. Same kind of beautiful
wooded islands, fine beach, very
saw. Magnif. sunset on return.
Hot in hill after 7, then Tavern -
another delicious dinner. Met F.
Wadhams in hall. Upstairs early
& read Sav. book in bed.

31. Perfect day. Went out on my own
10.30 - Mad Sq, Wed, Midrum, St J
- up to Gaston St. Back to meet L & N
11.15 - all out. L & D went on Ogletrope.

ending at Witter with medallion balconies, back to Cheppera Sq. - Ogl. mor. - French Bacon. Met N & all up Madison - to things then - Jones, Taylor, Gordon searching for tea place. No luck so back to C&L de Luxe for good dinner. All for siesta. Read to L, out C & to Telfah with its fine rooms & furn then back from end Bull. Took a rest 5:30-7, reading. Supper Ok = Athanas. Son Niko at Bth. Coll. so we had much to talk of with him - left L & N below & up to write H.

April 1. Fine. Got packing & business done - off before 11. Went Bull to Bay - along front to Ft. W. then back - out 17. To borders Walthamoro & then 303 hunting for plantations most of which were private or invisible. Finally to 52 - 17

Could find no good lunch place, trees all in new leaf, only reds & greens. Took 174 Adams Run - Edisto - got lonely place. Over E Island to E Beach a State Park where had quiet lunch under palms on bridge. Lonely island, old Presb & Epis churches, oak avenues, pic. houses & cabins. Back to 17 - along more shady roads before Ashley Bridge. "Luey" had given N. a map with route to 64 Murray Blvd. Ft W just arriving with flowers where we did. Waited till we settled. Mrs Gerald's daughter Jean & Clo took care of us. Lonely rooms. All in car to Green Garden for tea, too late, so walk 1/2 hr. in old streets till dinner where we had a great gossip. Mrs G. here on our return - Mrs Foster in for a call. Then up to unpack & turn in.

2. Fine, brilliant day. Nice breakfast in room, settling - Mrs F came at 11.

Drove us round & met Mrs B after at
St Michael's. Later St Phil, Requiem,
Duke Theatre, Pirates' house, antique
shop, out to Citadel past big park,
old market & fine lunch (dinner). To
Dr Miller for L - he gave her a good
look over, also sleeping tablets etc. Got
taxi at Marion - back for rest 4 1/2.
N lay on my bed & I read them to
sleep with Char. book. Out c 7 on foot
to GB - met F there. Talked while
we waited, then she left. Got late.
Mrs G having poker party but quiet.
To bed early, read Lelesne's "Laud."
marks of C. Nick Mrs B. got us.
3. Mist early but burned away. Out
on foot c. 11 to meet FW. Very hot
but got taxi at Ft. S. hotel. Met
Mrs McGowan & dau. F, M, M &
out on shady back path, then
to St. Ph. & churchyard, Garden

walk to Gibbs Gallery to see Tremble
Washington. Also A Jackson, Mounse
(Morse), Calhoun, Beauregard, Montrie
(Foker), et al. Upstairs for Foker mi-
neatures. Met Nancy McC. on stair.
Good Sully, other covered by Mist. Ex.
To St John for lunch, nice & old
& spacious. Later L - N came. L had
been painting. Really hot, came
back c. 3 for siesta - I read a lot of
Char. to L - N. Cloudy out but it
cleared for sunset & we dined in
copper shop of Marion H. Very good.
N brought us back - then went to keep
L & I wrote letters. I a long one
to T.

4. In out, warm. Very late start Evards,
incl. leaving necktie for cleaning & got
sandwiches etc. Met F & all of c. 12 for
Cypress Gardens via Meeting 052. This
a lot of industrial suburbs, then fine

country turned off Goose Creek Rd. to see St James's church, charming little one, pelicans, chestnut beads. Fine iron gallery, on to turn R. for C. Gard. Got there between clouds, lunch near pavilion. Then in & were paddled all this absolutely still and dreamlike, most heavenly, azaleas, daff, none, dogwood wisteria, judas, jasmine. Impress to describe but a paradise. Keiled seen much pleasures. N. took lot of photos. Took walk afterwards round park lake & over bridges. Army before too full or noisy. Back c 5 - took it easy - read Ch. aloud. Again to Marion, back c 9 - ch ch & I got stuck to wash kit.

5. Hot, but buggy. & finished picture - J to F. c 11. 30 then to Gittles & garden walk. Very hot, over 82. Met F at St J. all there for lunch. At 2

to Ft. S. Hotel, tickets for garden tour. Guide: Mrs Gittles, delightful. Most of cars but were independent. Across Ashley Rv. to Fenwick Hall, old & well restored. Very fine panelling, murals. Pictures & furniture in newspapers. Back to 61 and to Drayton Hall, never open, so great chance. Georgian, 4 cols, double ^{steps} port up. Splendid big hall, Adames mantels, exquisite classical details in cornices, mouldings etc. Mrs Gerald there with Mrs B, so we saw all. Upper floor also shown. Splendid facade towards river & lovely avenue. Too hurried & too crowded but lucky to see at all. Back to town over Cooper B. to Smead Farm. Lovely trees & setting & beautiful rest. old house, fine furniture etc. Drive to Bonnett Hall modern in Georg. style, brick & cobble fine site & arc. Drive past it - also later part - Christ Ch.

Ended at Pikes Creek, Mt Pleasant
- had tea, lovely gardens, big house
full of junk & animal skins & a
grand view over water. After 6 then
got to P.T.S. for a drink. Left F &
had light sandwich supper Byars.
Games eve. Began Road to Folly by
Ford, about Charleston.

6. Cooler & breezy. Spent some time
planning out later tour. Off for a few
errands before collecting F at 12. Over
Cooper bridge to Mt Pleasant & Sullivan
2d., past Ft. Moultrie & on as far as
road went. Saw car stuck in sand.
Back to Huck's for a delicious & most
lavish lunch. Fine place. Drove slowly
back past FTM reservation. Past at
end is 2 J. palms, great summer
resort. Round in village at MTP then
main road past Snee entrance, as
had seen smoke. Only burning off.

cut over sandy road & back by loop thro'
country. Back before 5 & left F, then for
a read till dinner. Chilly & used elec.
store. Also heat on. Out for drink &
dinner Henry but so full we got only
drinks & went to Byars. Shops open Sat.
eve, so round & round, & found Kodak
only one closed. Back before 9 & took a
walk on M.B. to end & back. Then 6 Ch.
No wash. ∴ I on top. Read L Ford.

7. Sun early, then overcast. Mending,
clearing out, diary. Wrote H. Began B.
N went to Lewis's & we had nice walk
to & from Green Garden, looking at
houses. Sun in & out. Warmer again.
Back 2.30, odd jobs, finished B. Cards
to M.B., Geo, M.F.W. Took it easy reading
Ford. Dinner St. J. Had some VII, 6
games. Dine with honey to Quar.

8. Terrible night, wind & rain, so up late.
Clear fine but very windy. Out before

12 to sale at Froch Shop - L got a white dress - J a white - a blue. To antique place to see desk. Met F for lunch at St. J. L & J hair done Wilds' at 2, - a few errands. Back to Gardenwalk, Gille. P.O., met Mrs Baker, rejoined L - walk back, lonely houses began etc. In about 5, N here. Had finished Ford in bed a.m. Did odds & ends, Out c. 7 drinks & dinner Henry's. In before 9 had 7 games. Read Sea Int. L.

9. Fine, breezy. Went c. 11 for Lucy & out via Ashley past gardens to Summerville, lonely road. Simply enchanting at S. with flowers, esp. wisteria, azalea, dogwood. To Mary's (Mrs Bailey) then perambled all round the town in and out just looking at places, a dream of beauty. Back for a sumptuous lunch at M's. Also daughter &

granddaughters. Mrs Hunt came before we finished. Later we went to her home, a lovely one with big lawn & garden & nice furnishings. Mr H. Here too + 2 scotties. Back to collect Lucy, pralines etc & nice drive to town, then a few errands - to Henry's for a drink. Took L home. Extra out about Denmark & Norway. Had news off - on from N's car. Latish to Bygones. Then back for usual check.

10. Fine, coolish & breezy. L & N packed in King St. to do St. M. tower - J went prowling Broad, Orange, Legare etc. Met F near Libr. but off again. All met St J for lunch. L & N return to paint. Fro to St M. churchyard, then left her & did church lot - back for them. Also a few min in Libr. Squire on Thos then 2 T. & N. Back c. 3.30 to house - a few acct's. Took L 1/2 to Dr Pratt

ok of. 22 sitting. N-J round for a few photos. Then got L. Much news after a few errands where they get reqs. Sat in car till c 7. Later got F - we went Henry's. Too full so to Rathskeller - Byars. Ground ice, walk to Light. - back 6 Ch.

11. Fine. L-N painting Stoll's Alley - I took list of prize gardens from Nem + Lesene - went prowling till 1.30 at St-J to get news - lunch. Back to home for black & out Ashley Rd. Missed turning to Old Town so on as far as Mag. Then back - Bess Ferry Rd, lovely Mrs' woods, 1/2 - to Johns Isl. - Rockville, beautiful drive. News in car, then 7 1/2 to drinks & supper at Forties. Also Gerald + Clarence - later then Baker. Very jolly, back c. 11.30.

12. Breakfast very windy after the fog blowing night. Wrote T. Began ECT. Our 12/2 L to Pratt, N-J errands. Bel + met in car for news 1/2, then lunch St. J. Began to rain, a deluge before we got in at 3. Hideous afternoon. Read last chapters of Stevens aloud. Drink with G.s. Out after 7 to Henry (ing) ended St. J. Back before 9 - more ch. ch.

13. Fine, cold wave everywhere. Wrote Staton, more on ECT. Out more. Had frocks sent to K.H. Met F. + J. + Fred round. Met Tweedy. Back to car for N + L. News 1.30 then lunch St. J. Back c. 3 - out later to Old Town road which ended in private grounds - then to Folly Beach - along road on it: Another fine dinner. Met F + J at Raths. Then St. J. for sandwiches, very slow, great scramble, then found train late. Met C 9.30.

14. Fine, cool & breezy. Took it easy for Sun.

Wrote no letters a.m. Out late to park all round. Got F for news, car in Mustang, A-C photos. Lunch Henry very late. Back Gard. walk, Gibbles, News etc & later drove to Ft. Johnson. Back c 6, scrawbled letter to H. Baths - Byars. Bridge etc.

15. Fine, breezy. Mending. After errands went again to Cyp. Gardens. Lunch on the way by roadside. Ahead of mob. Many changes in flowers no daff., few wisteria, but lots of white azalea, lilies, summer Mum last time, just as beautiful. Return via Summerville to show C. the place. Back late via Ashley road. Stopped to stack up for etc. After 7.15 news to Byars. Lunch here on return - had dirty eve till all hours.

16. Fine, lovely day again. Got F soon after

10.30 r off to Magnolia. Gorgeous show of azaleas, lovely place, acres of garden, beautiful river views etc. Spent rest of a.m. There, then left L & C at Hunt's & F, N & J got a breezy place in shade for lunch. Met at Mary's at 3, proline. To Middleton which is superb, land-scaping splendid. Arrives to river. One old wing left. Magnificent azaleas, & camellias, mostly gone. Had nice negro guide, also a place - Provided all round, expected tea but it was closed, so we sat in garden chairs. Back c 6. Packed a little. Out late to F Marion for dinner, slow - poor. More parking.

17. Fine. Up in good time for last things & packing car, etc. Stopped in town for PD, sandwiches, F fan, gas etc. so left c. 2 & had fine run to New Bern

via 17 Ocean Highway. Kept right on not stopping anywhere except not far from Myrtle beach on by road to a nice open pine wood with jasmine - iris - breeze. Road goes Georgetown Wilmington, etc. Reached NB at 5. Green home a delightful hotel - nice rooms. After cleaning up N, C, I had walk to see a few old houses. Back c 7 - cocktail on veranda. Excellent dinner. Bridge etc.

18. Fine, but warm & sticky. Got packed & drove a tour round town & saw a lot of beautiful houses, esp. the best ones on E Front over the water. Red brick with fine porches etc. Followed route on booklet. Took R 17 to Vanceboro, 43 to turn off to Tarboro. Lovely old town - S has admirable old house. What a welcome! We

had a gorgeous time & sumptuous lunch with steak & raffles, and such a good gossip. S not changed a bit. At end c. met sister of Jim Arrington whom he'd known in Macd. Left c 3. by 44 & 301 over the border, out of plant-tobacco country & found trees much less forward. Via Petersburg to Richmond, 6.30 - to Jefferson, lovely big ^{200, 234 - 5} rooms. Nice comfort old fashioned. Latin dinner, nice music, up for a few rubbers. Rain. Motel F.

19. Hard rain in night, misty. Late break with L. Decided to try home. Nice drive via 60 through pretty country & more ups & downs than usual. At W. went first - to Univ. to see Wren Building which is a beauty both facades & finely set with queen in front - Bokantout stat. an amusing pseudo - Rom. or relief of

Indian - Virginia. Town done over
very like Eng. village, well restored
that - notably, hard to find bench
place. A & I went to Burton Church
during visit, admirably done over
Simple & impressive. Finally got
bench Colonia. Next to Gov. Palace
which is a splendid place, they
have done it - all over from old
places etc - filled with wonderful
furniture. Began to pour while
we were there so had to miss gar-
den etc. Great business getting car
A & C drove party - A disciplined
the futile parking man. Drove
round & saw outside. Let up to
Crafts, near Inn - Lodge. C & I in
to Capitol also finally done, much
dignity & elegance. Closing time,
so back with showers on - 7p -
Cuzoo & room upstairs, good dinner.

21
up fairly early for bridge till 10.45.

22. Trinity again. Decided to take a
chance so got off c 11 for Jamestown
via S, nearer river & bordering a lot
of plantations. Very pretty. Got hot
sandwiches then to the site - it is
a splendid place - saw J Smith,
Pocahontas, church, old building etc.
Delightful site. Shorter. On to
York town, no rain here - went via
W. and magnificent park way. Y.
is a charming little place, lovely
situation, several old houses left.
L, C, I in York Hall, Nelson family,
restored very well & with big
lawns & garden. Monument ra-
ther a horror but what a site.
Too late at W. except to see a few
more outside, back R. 6.30, party
though had rain. Day in R.

cells had room - line before dinner
o some bridge. Managed somehow
to get a letter written to T. before
dinner - in a.m. Packed a little
Bed 12 o Polton.

21. Overcast, cold - blomy. Packed
break. with L, plans for trip. Out
c. 11 for tour of town incl Pol's house
o Cap. into which we got - had
good idea of building o portraits.
Wrote H. before lunch. Off 5.5 at
filling station broke muffler - had tank
leak. Left car, taxi with priceless di-
ver did Mon Ave o new residential parts
then Baile Abbey m. Comp. portraits o
fine murals by . Back for
car, not ready. Returned to Jeff. o got
cards - played bridge before o after an
early dinner. Away at 8 - moonlight
drive to Charlottesville. Too bad not
to see more. Arr 10 at Monticello Hotel.

7th 5th
Rooms, esp. clothes cupboard tiny after J.
but grand view from Room. ^{Cold.} Hotel very full.
22. Fine, cold, clear, very windy. Went a.m.
to Michie's Tavern - near P. Henry Lind,
fascinating old place. Then to Monticello
cells which is far finer than all desc.
Splendid setting, lawn, garden - House
not orig. o interesting, full of genuine
Jeff. relics. No big stairs, gallery hall,
movable bed, dome over salon. Grand
views to Ch. from long paved roof to
study. Honeymoon terrace cov. on
other side, shops below. Stopped on
way up at family graveyard. To both
have planned by J. for Monroe.
Fine box o trees, cart. by Piccini.
House looks small but has fine
rooms - also old furnishings. Ad-
dition planned by J. never seen by
M. Fine view over to Mont. A fine
interesting morning. Hotel for

late lunch. Out soon after 3 past
Clark stat. to Univ. which is a beauty
with new buildings all in keeping.
Older ones round Lawn, esp. Rotunda
& colonnaded ones which have hou-
ses at intervals. Went into 2 with
escort of pers. wife, garden notes.
Very Eng. in effect. In old tr. arcaded
rooms saw Poir 13, Wilson's 31. Drove
all round & over r. to ball field
with arched seats. Fine town, lots
of nice old buildings. Court House
opposite us. Back for brief rest till
dinner. L.C. met some Cin. people
Also stayed till c. 10. Read Garden
Ruffl. of Richmond News, then
bridge & then C's epic of Florida
town. Then Dot telephoned Kano
wreck to be married Wed. with
C's help. Read Dalton.

23. Warm, not too clear but fine.

Fortunately it lifted before we did Sky
Line. Got packed & on way out stopped
at antique shop & got decanter + Scotch
label for present to send by C. Then
across to Afton & trail which now is
c. 100 m. long (3 sections). Splendid
drive, up & down to some extent but
not above c. 3500. Saw much more
rain reflected, sun in and out & one
great valley, Shenandoah. After one
failure got lunch Lodge Big Meadows
nice inn. Wide views on both sides
& back & forward mt. masses. Not
any apple blossoms ready & on mt.
leaves hardly started, bare as
autumn, cold also. A grand run.
To Geo. W. in Winchester, nice hotel.
Had drinks before C. had to leave
7.30 for bus & train. Late dinner
turned in early.

24. Unsettled, showers. Drove

round town seeing sights. Two double houses opp. our windows. Went to Ft. Loudoun, very little left, Gov / head-quarters, cemetery, lots of nice old houses. Then R 340 to Berryville then N. to Fairfield. Mrs Richardson q1, remind us. Lovely old stone house, gardens & stables. Saw orig. grant by Fairfax. Belonged to Warner Washington, also cottage with daughter in law, marvellously modernized in best taste. Very attractive ladies who took us - Berryville for lunch in drug store after seeing Audley, Kelly Curtis redn part of it. Added to & now belongs Mr Jones - is full of pictures of horses, also a rare lot of Brit. furniture, but the redn parts are fine. R 267 South to Carterhall, large park, fine big

columned house in splendid position, not shown. From Milwood R 50 to near Redie - or branch to Oak Hill built by TJ for J Moore, a fine big house, high cols - porticos each end, terraced garden, park, beautiful interior, esp. 2 large rooms on garden front. On to Alex. and out on R 1 to Penn Dam which proved to be a de luxe auto court meant for over night only as it had no place to put things. Nice little brick houses, bath, heat, gas. but not for several days. Went via Mt. Boul. to trash - over bridge by Lincoln Mem along to 17 - Conn. to Woodlough and - Hardman Park / that huge - apo- laustic but ¹⁰ not ³¹⁰⁻³¹² too dear, could have for 1 night only but very glad for that. Cleaned up - good dinner,

Nice quiet rooms, fruit bats below.
22. Greyish mostly. Packed & out soon
after 10 in taxi to Uncle Ho/Mary
for short call. Then L. of Cong. to
see L.B.H. whom we caught resting
for train, looking fine. Splendid
exhib. of photos of houses, Mobile,
N.O., Demop, Charl. etc. Hispanic
room, big Robbies with mural
top., also publications, lower
floor. Met Mr. in L.B.H.'s office.
To Tully Ho - Hobb's met us for
lunch. Looks same as ever. Back
to hotel, got car packed & off
before 3 via Rock Creek Park to
Lincoln, very impressive, also
effect of G.W. obelisk in pool.
To Arlington, Lee's House - very
known Soldier also very fine.
Left C. 4 & got on Bond. missed
of R. 1 but cursed my lilly

new suburb & got to R. 1 - Ann D.
for mail. Before then had stopped in
Alex. to see Christ Church & Ma-
sonic Hall. Then to Fredk. to Prin-
ces Anne, lovely ^{225, 226} rooms for a stay.
Good dinner, early to bed. Terrible
gas from street. No more -
26. Fine, some clouds - Not much
sleep for anyone so up lateish.
Garden Club in hotel so got
general ticket & notices. To Mar-
ket, done like old one, booths from
neighboring plantations. To Mercantile
Apoth. shops full of delightful odd
things, Rising Sun Tavern, Dog-
get House, N.B. wall paper. Back
to lunch - It gave out so L & J
out before 3 to Mary W. house, a
charming one - saw pageant MW
received Lafayette in garden. Also
G.W. & Martha in old coach.

To Kenmore, Lewis, fine house + 2
 outer buildings - Fine mantels -
 plaster ceilings. Can't describe all
 here but have lots of pamphlets.
 Later to J. M. M. M.'s office - room
 full of relics, desk for M. D. T.
 Back after 5 - read T. J. Liberty
 till dinner. Wrote T. J. off - on -
 then made up diary. Turned in
 early. read T. J. L.

27. Perfect day. No work. Out with N.
 walk over to Kenmore - went all
 through it - again in leisurely way
 with no crowd. Then to mons. of
 Mercer - Mary W. Left N. at Mary's
 house - back c 12.15 for "net" before
 lunch. Finished letter to B. Out
 early p. m. for splendid drive, 17 to
 near Post Royal - 207 by Madison
 bridge over Rapp. to Belle Grove of
 Mad. family. Now owned Hookers -

we were shown round by great grand. p. for-
 mer owner. Most unusual with pedimented
 wings added - skillfully joined by curving
 colonnettes. Also curving doors in 4 p.
 wings. Beautiful house, well rest. in
 best taste, terraced garden to river.
 On till got to R. 3, nice farms & wooded
 country, turn off to Stratford, Lees, now
 used as a plantation. Chief outwashed
 char. is groups of chimneys at ends.
 Fine big estate, lawn & gardens, shop,
 offices etc. House n.b. beautiful big
 hall, doors front & back - ends, fine ::
 Got a pamphlet about it - Bought dish
 for M.B. On to Wakefield, Gov's birth-
 place. Tall obelisk, new house in old
 style, splendid position over Pope
 Creek, garden, wood etc. Later to Long
 House for tea. Took return via Colo-
 nial - Potomac beaches, but something
 not work till 8. Drinks, late gard

dinner. Early to bed & rest.

28. Fine, another perfect day. Up late with paper, diary etc. Write Mr. O'Bill, Gannay. Mr. Hobbs & Donald came for lunch. Later we went to Kinnross again as L. had seen it only tentily. Ended with tea in kitchen. M-D off after 4 & we walked back - Lonely out but all rather forlorn & took it easy with MT. Later some TifE

29. Fine, another brilliant day. Sorry to leave F.C. 10.30. Stopped at Agnes Church, a lonely little brick structure on hill. Very unusual doorway & belfry. Church looked but could see beautiful triple window in chancel, pulpit, gallery panelling etc. On to Podunk Ch. also lonely site. On one of rest, old but much simpler. Turned off for MT Vernon. Lounge & fine man

expected. Elaborately packed for mats of triffles, well arranged. Much resting on grounds. (See map.) Grand site, houses full of lovely things but too slab, mantels etc. Not had been gifts.
