10. Grey a.m., cleared fine. At viii + ix all

dined with H + me. All later to Army

11. Fine. Wrote Barba Y. Worked on MS

M.B. wound - we sat in library till J

12. Slightly overcast. Paper in bed,
beat 9, news 10. Upstairs early, Ind.

overhauling clothes in & out of trunk.

for Metr. at 3: Rousoul Gm, Mahler D
quaravation after. Finished NYT &
knit - wrote M.F.W., Seaman, N, Pauline &
read more Jones. To Tombs at 7, also

Reynolds, 2 Hills, 2 Barringer, 2 Linen,
2 Pic, Geiger, L. Barbour, L.E.T, F.D.W, R, nice
party, back 10.15. Read Jones in bed.

13. Fine, sunny & less cold. Cleared out papers.
Wrote long letter T. Early lunch, some M.S.
To R for 2 o'clock. She set up other half of pull
over, wool, 2.45 - news. Libr. couldn't find
much. Later saw several I.L.N. To H at
5.45, drink & talk. Dinner reading Jones.
Finished it - eve, top hole. Began Bishop's
Crime (Freeman) - knitting - Spring.
14. Fine. Trying to fin. books a.m. Up later.
To Bank after 10, cold but finer. Had
borrowed H's Guideblue so looked up
& typed. Wrote B. Main & Libr. p.m. to do
I.L.N. Horrid - chilly, back c. 4.30. To
H 5.30. Dinner alone reading Bishop,

Finished it - eve. Also knit, took Ted.

Swing, up early to prepare.

15. Greyish. On 10.13 to 120th, Mabelly 12.

Lunch there, N. tel. - made date for dinner. M - J via Sub. to Night Train, fine. Back C.5 to tidy up for N came. Grand jolly eve - she stayed till Swing. Knitted a lot.

16. Horrid day, light snow early. Let

up. Wrote L, nice a.m. with M.

Lunch TT Club, freezing rain then no left, but got over to bus. till day, out at 72 and taxi to Min Seaman 157 E. Three sisters, a nice call. Taxi awful going, ice & sleet, wind & pouring. To M. before 5. Packed & taxi across to Brooks, escorted by

drivers. E elegant guest suite, dressed early, then to M - J in parlor. Others: M Reiner, 2 Oliver, C Gant, FG Moore, Young (Wentham) 2 Par - ? (Kit) - Very successful party. Took latest Frankau short buses. to reach in bed.

17. Still horrible & mazy but not raining.

Talk Got on Hill c. 10.30 then via Sub to Grand C. - left bag. Very black out.

Tel. Girls. Sub to Skm, then to hot for stockings. Hideously mazy but not slippery. Whiteshirt - FS. across to Benson - H - got 4 cigs. for H. Taxi to TT Club - read paper till Emily - Charlotte came, for drinks, lunch - talk 6-5.45. C Barnett there 4.30 - 5.15. Em off by late train - got the

6.05 by a grand dash. Till 11 - over
New from home to catch up. Back
just for 10 news - up to put things
in order - Buchan in bed.

18. Gray & dull. Slept longer than
usual. 9.30 news, up to clear out
desk etc. Long letter to L, BTO,
TAUV etc. Some mending. Later
got-out Christmas cards & made cat.
2.30-5.30. H had dinner here for LRT,
also CB & Inez, G & M. Tots' for the end
& 2 Kraut, 2 Beaton, Drinkwater,
Ted. Much talk till after 11.

19. Light snow, cleared. Read Buchan
before getting up - News 10 - NRT -
more clearing out papers etc. Phil
at 3, B Walter = Evoca, La Mer. Mot

papers, B & knit. Same in eve after H,
R here to supper. Write L, MFW, G & M,
N, etc.

20. Cold & brilliant, after 9.30 news went to
coffee in Avery - Ted, H, CB, Inez, Vic. To
Bookshop, then to R where we heard an-
auguration, stayed to lunch. Final a lot.
Back to AH, then errands in Post = Luckey,
Woodworth. Back c. 5, Rex. News. Ran
over Ch I to time 'd'. Early bite in Pub.
6.45 H came & went to "Thief of Bag" at
Bardaron. Splendid film, Sabre, Veik
& other good cast. Back 9 1/2, Spring, Buck.
21. Fine. Late start. Write Marian, New
Ch I in prep. for J. Club. Late lunch,
2.45 news. Library for references. G & M
5-5.30, then to H. Dinner AH, reading

Buchan & also knitting & picking out a lot after seeing Mrs P. in pm. Swing 10 - work before fire.

22. Mostly greyish, warmer. Did odds, mtd etc. more for JC, also Ch III. Hair done p.m. Back 4.30. Finished Buchan.

To H, then R for dinner & spent eve with knitting, BBL etc. ending w. Swing. Rain, so borrowed umbrella.

23. Fine, some light clouds. Letters from T & Effie. Mostly scraps, to Library for Pub. Thurs, lunch upstairs. Wrote Bin am. & began long out to T. Began Trelawny, knit 2.45 Lond. news. J Club 4.30 here in library, CS hostess. Read Ch I, all very kind. Dined w with H

GHM, FB, M Wells, Jojo. To H after for memo. Knit etc. Back before 9. AAVV in salon, so in library. Ob, '97 Bulletin Them., etc. Left early for Swing, but he is off Thurs. Trelawny & " news.

24. Sun early, then cloudy - letters from T & L. Began L, then to chemist & libr. Hill c.l. Jamanch p.m. End of Phila. w. Pizza, Paul like. Steady snow all p.m. Ch III. Quiet eve. knit, Inf. Please, Tr.

25. Fine, sun out p.m. Mostly sorting etc. in room, cases from below etc. Write more T. Back to III for much of pm. To GHM, then R for dinner & eve.

26. Fine. Off w. My G by 10.13 to dock C. at Gisela's. So prompt 12.5 Nat I had a walk before taxi to 11.30. Good lat 2

2. Shears, Mary, Carp, Noe, Newell,
Butt, W.S., Whitehead, Bieber, Alex
Reports by RC + MB with JS as model,
Brett, Sybaris, Noe, Maakela, Newell
TC figurine, Gisela Torontiki, Alex.
Aunt. books, Irma in for tea. Got
6.30 back, later to H to fill her.
27. More snow, stopped. Day off odd
jobs, mending, finished wr. Ch III.

28. Fine a.m. grey later. Coat bags,
knit pullovers etc. More parcels
to Bank + Post 12.15-1.30. Pub, iron

29. Fine. Served up blue pullovers. Packed

Jav., also Marie. Spent eve. M finished
navy pullover + took it for cousin. R
round 2 balls + started new pull. hats
of BBBL.
30. Greyish. Same old, back rev, bags
etc. Wrote B. Did errands etc. Wrote
Huffer. Cook. + dinner, H, R, Cotton, F, B,
Marie. Nice evening till c.g. upstairs
+ did last vats + ends.
31. Fine, sunny. Wrote early + got all in order.
H came to see me off on 10.13. Taxi to

Penn. with luggage. To Sker's for alab.
-gloves, TTC to meet Mabel for
lunch - she went with me to train.
Met N. Got all luggage into tiny double
bedroom C. Very comfortable trip, smiting,
NYake, talk, guide books, good dinner.

Late to bed. Not much sleep.

Feb. 1. Greyish off & on. Atlantic very smoggy,
arr. 8.40 after break. on train. Loaded taxi
for freight station, got car at once &
off 9.40. Decided it was no place for us
to stay. Off via Decatur for Ashens
Saw a great many fine houses on
handsome Prince St. Into town & par-
ked near campus. To Holman coffee
shop for lunch. Search for Krist: needle
then round f campus or. nice old

1941. 17
Buildings. Via 129 to Macon, made quick
time, decided to go on. After food at
Talbotton pushed on to Columbus, Ma-
rely Hotel, very comfortable. Green Room
for meals. Took our time over dinner
upstairs early, read Kate Pig.

2. Greyish, hard showers at intervals.

Cross via Phoenix to Mont. - night long.
Mostly dull country, not often. No idea
where we'd get to but found Lovelace
at Brenton, nice little place. Good room
& food. Found a Mont. paper to read
in eve. Arr. before 4 & had a rest & a
lot of knitting.

3. Moist & grey but roads dry, weather
improved. Mobile before 12 & then to
Theodore, sandwich Grant. On to Edg.

Guest by c 2, sun out, lovely. ^{had} nice
room, grand view, baby radio, no
paper. Fine rest. Wrote H a long acct
of our trip. Excellent dinner, then
knitting by big fire; poor reception
of Swing. Finished "Pig."

4. Fine, a perfect day. Late break. Then
a nice walk round the estate. Lovely
drive to Guepport, news in car. Did
a few errands, lunch Markham cof-
fee shop. Left c. 2 + 20 fine we went
to Biloxi - back via Murgtown - got
a ^{knr.} bag. purse. Sat on veranda read
Sun. NYT, more knitting. A began
sock with new needles. Came in with
coal, more paper. Wrote T before
after excellent dinner - fire.

5. Fine but less brilliant. Took it com-
fortably - left c 10.40 for lovely easy
drive to N.O. where we arrived at
SIC. 1.15 and ⁷⁰⁹ got settled, then out to
M. Blanche, Holmes (tea), Royal up -
down fine walk. Large mail when
we arrived. Old La. until dinner, a
good one. Lorry till c 9.30. Reading PS
reader.

6. Wet. L & C arr. before 8/2 in great form
after fine trip. All break together,
then they ²²⁷ unpacked purchases,
lots of nice things. N & C out to
photo place. Finished T. All out on
Royal (Fil). Lunch SIC. ^{Many cards} Lazy pm. Knit;
began Death at R. Helm. L & C out uncer-
tainly to Mrs. Eve sat round. Then

bridge in 727. No cards.

7. Unsettled, cleared later. Roused at 6 by fire in Roy + St L, rest Tor. There we were last year. When it dried we went to Merlin for Sym. tickets, then Royal. Lunch Courtyard kitchen, nice fire. To Cabildo etc - back via Chartres. Stacks till dinner. More bridge - news etc.

8. Grayish, still cold. Breakfast across at Holsons. All ff 9.45 for Bayon la Fourche via 90 - Bridge. Less wild than expected, very flat. Some good old houses, vs. banks nearly to Donaldson across to Woodlawn. Madewood. Both fine Ionic, former in very bad repair. Lunch Hotel Don. good. Across ferry - back via 1, Burnside etc. Hurricane

terrible damage to trees. Uncle S. all gone but piles of bricks. At Lucher out back to 61 - return soon after 5. Good dice, chilly. Begun death in ecstasy. Knit; bridge etc, better cards. Torcanini 13/11, Liggat Cradle to Gram, Tuesday dances.

9. Fine, some clouds, up very late. Read in bed till 11 woke. Breat. in cafe. Got nothing done etc. N. round 2 balls. Create H. L-C out to lunch but we needed more. Walk to Audit. lonely out, to Metrop. conc = S email, Schum. C maj, La Mar, G Min P.F. 6 simply gorgeous, encores = G string, Fugue (which?). Dron. Dance. Nice walk back, in after 5. Begun T, then helped to tie up Great. packages. Dined Antoine's. Dick's

note to RA vacated in personal effort to private room full of pictures, autographs, cartoons etc. Delicious pompino, omelette soup. w. birds on top, café diabolo, good dry Graves. Great success. Back c. 9.30, farewell bridge, news, knit. Forgot to put in for Fri. about five drive to City Park, lake P & back another way. Much lay out in gardens, azalea etc. in street strips.

10. Fine. Up at 7. Write most of B. All off c. 10 along Gulf. Ground for dirt. Lunch Bungalow at Biloxi, then to Ocean S. and Grief Hills. Back to Edg. left c. 3 stop. Gulfport. NO c. 5 1/2, brief rest, out to Patio Royale for a good dinner & quickly back for C to get train at 9.

Did more packing & move to 727. Still reading N Marsh.

11. Fine, up early & break. w. N. at Halsom. All packed and off at 10, Bridge & go the rest of the way, Houma & B. Black. Lunch Franklin in Peck's. Some fine houses before & after. Pretty village, good houses both sides Bayou Teche all the way. Rice trees. At New Iberia went S. 445 to Avery Island with its fine gardens, camellias mostly over, azaleas beginning. Early for most birds etc. white herons - egrets. In New I. to see "The Shadows," garden open. Old Weeks house, & Tudor. cols, see Saxon & Snydam. Owner New Weeks Hall saw us & came out, tripod, asked us in for coffee &

much talk. A delightful artist.
Stayed till 6, then on to Lafayette &
stayed Gordon, very comfortable room
& good food.

12. Sun in & out. Left 9.40 on 43-25
for St Martinsville. Acadian House
in Park, well restored & full of old
things. Talkative Miss L. Acadian
dian. Silver man from Conn. told
us a lot of addresses. In village
STM. church, grave - mon. of Evan.
behind it. E's oak on 13 Ave.
Acorn via Olivier's shop to Pine
Ave, + oaks, gorgeous trees. Back
to N Shrig, lunch Azalea Court,
a model one. Left c. 2.20 via Lake
C. over Texas line to Beaumont.

First hotel too near railway. LaSalle
good, coffee room excellent. Turned
in early. Cloudy late pm & rain in
night. Terrible wind earlier in pm.

13. Fine, breezy, sunny. Left 9.45 via 59
to Port Arthur, much shipping. Passed
many oil wells & tanks, cattle &
cowboys. 87 to Fort Belvoir. Ferry
to Galveston. Fine sea front here.
Lunch 2 Bits, left by 6.30. Arr. Bea.
career before 3, fire rooms ^{7'8} of floor on
sea. Unpacked some & rested, also a
lot of diary to write & more on T, which
is pieced. Posted T, & card to H, after a
bus ride round town & tea at Grecks on
pier opposite. Terribly windy. After
dinner the Hostess talked to us about

our travels, wanted to get reporter but he
was out so she tel. Max Knitting.

14. Fine, cloudless day. Choice bel. from
H. before breakfast. Off 9.40 via Alvin,
- 35 Angleton, w. Columbia etc. Part way
on raucous, marshes, little pine woods
etc. Lunch at Green Lantern Palacios
on the water. Boatmen who know
Kelap. On part many bays, woods to
to Corpus Christi - Nueces right on
front. Entrance to town rather awful
but other part nice. Very good hotel
Have 645, 644, overlooks basin with
several bombers. Ven naval base.
Arr. before 5 - got unpacked & settled.
Nice dining rooms, esp. green one,
Christy lounge etc. Sat knitting,

no luck w. Swing, so returned to knit.
15. Gorgeous dawn & sun rise. Watched it
from bed. No hurry any time. All out
c. 11, L to coast. Who took out kinks,
N + to Mex. Co. for permits. Met
polite, Mex. Lit. back in town for small
errands, shine, City Hall, Ch. floor.
w. more folders. Back before 1. nice
lazy p.m. reading, almost asleep,
good det. Eve explored hotel, then
comfortable finish to front of pull over
& L set up the back.

16. Fine, slightly overcast. Lake boat.
for Sun. Much planning etc. Write
H for noon air mail, made up diary.
Began Aunt C. Lunch & a walk on
cliff w. good view of town. Fin. ect.

Heard part NY Phil - Unifin. Cards to GMM,

MFW. Finished March. Read "Acadian
Legends." Eve usual knit: Time.

17. Sun in - out, cloudy. L to 8 Ray -
Fin. Time, wrote B, F, B before lunch.
Fine p.m. & took drive all along
front, nice houses, fine views. Later
to NB beach end - around by country
roads. On before 5. Read Lafitte.

Eve knit - up by 10.

18. Misty early, then fine day. Nurse
at 7.30 for L's Kat. Late break.
Out before 11 via 9 to CC Lake Park,
lots of wild flowers - birds. Lunch
at small place Sandia. Man from
Rochester. Back 3.30. Tied up both
Kari dove. Eve upstairs early to

pack.

19. Scirocco. Nurse before 8. Packing
done before breakfast, many odds -
ends. Left a lot at hotel. Array 10.55,
by mistake on 9, then across to 44 at
Rtotoon to Alice, then 59. Country very
fine flat, veg, ranch, oil, scrub. Lots
of wild flowers. Lunch on moonlike
country, had picnic kit - a new tray.
More rolling towards Laredo, arc 3 1/2.
Plaza ^{1017, 1003} Hotel, Span. style, attractive.

Terribly sticky, muggy, windy. Town
dec. or. flags for festa - well lighted
at night. Unpacked squashed
clothes, tub, good rest. Terribly
sleepy but bucked up w. dinner.
Knit. in lobby, up for 10 news.

20. Thick mist - good sleep. Breakfast
upstairs. Out c. 11 to ^{with MP} Abba re car
insurance, money etc. To Hamil-
ton H. about festa. Walk round
town, funny mixture, border town
every kind of shop. Nice lunch.
Read Ob. Out c. 3 to C. from. -
Hotel, got NY Times. Back c 4,
diary - write T. Brief rest - out
6.15 for Hamilton where we went to
festa banquet & then saw dance
on roof. Sat next Capt Ryan a sailor
gen, Mrs Brennan very kind at dance.
Capital show which we enjoyed.

21. Rather misty, showers off - on. No
hurry, packed. Left c. 11 via bridge &
no trouble customs. Off for Monterey

Flat scrub, small bushes, lots of wild
flowers, esp. mimosa & yellow bush, red-
blue very like anem. No distant views.
Lunch Power's about half way. Then up
over 2200 pass, misty but no trouble,
fine drive in spite of macker. N. c 4
and to Colonial, St. keeps much Sp.
habitat in furnishing etc. Room on sq.
³⁰³

N. mt. view then clear. Had a good
rest. Bar, good dinner. Knit - in
lounge.

22. Foggy but not raining. Long sleep.
out before 11 to explore town, shops,
market etc. Got TV. a jade & silver
necklace for birthday. Found sq. bag
for H in market. Lunch San Juan,
Munie, Cath Sq. etc. Siesta. H.

Cards to MB - Luc, C. Eve watched the dinner dance - Mex singers in gay costumes, talked to some stray ladies - Did a bit on knitting till c. 10. Finished

PS Murder.

23. Unsettled but occasional sun. Out to park, cathedral, promenade. Luskah S. Urute Cotton, card CS. Out c 4, after U, S Ant. paper etc. for walk round town. Saw one nice church - back via shops. Dinner S. truck in square - saw more fern ground, sat & watched till 9. In upper hall w. Sun. paper - knit -

24. Fine! a miracle. Had a grand drive to Saltillo, brilliant, breezy - sunny. Mountains in jagged ridges,

deep glens & ravines, razor edges - Color like Greece but shape entirely different. Varied country, mostly scrub - open semi-desert. St Caterina, Pass of Dead. S. deep picturesque town. To Casa Colonial for lunch. Peristyle, + atrium like Pomp. A private house converted. Round fine park - avenue, silk factory where N. got a rug. Fine cathedral, slab carving. Larkly drive back - to Huasteca gorge off road from S.E. wonderful rock formations. Odd shops - restaurant, P. Back c. 6. Dinner S - walk round square. Knit: Larkly girl from Dayton.

25. Cloudy again, wet early. Up late - ON - c. 11 for errands, L got fine basket etc.

Light lunch S. cafe. Took long walk
solo all round town. Much like
what we had seen before. L & D down
stairs on return. Began B. Read
S but Exp. Cook & dinner S. Walk
round sq. Rather drizzly. Fruit in
Palm room, hideous din on terrace by
a ruffian. Out to walk. Ready The
Lodge (Blowndes) in bed.

26. Grey again. Waited till it got
better, collected picnic lunch off c 11
to Sabina Hidalgo. 45m. flat straight,
then pass, out in mist-cloud. Showers.
^{wrong, this was last week}
Lunch Powers', where also is a shop
To Villa Santiago, El Cercado - my hat
was n. to HT Falls. At gate found
