At 9.30, FG, TC, FB, H, L, J off in Knapp's
to see Mr. Nelson's new house, part -
Laterville & turning on r. before Salis.,
then by-road & a nutty one up hill. A
charming place, old & new. Both A in
fine form. Back for 1/2 dinner = G + M/B
& A.T. & much talk till 4. Brief rest -
mac C's tea until nearly 7, when to H
for supper & stay till nearly 10. News,
too sleepy for puzzle -

2. Greyish, wrote c.s. Downstairs to
see AC before left 10.30. News 11, knit
papers, odds & ends, hats, clo' etc. lunch
here, sat later with FG & M/B. 2.45 -
Lond. news. Wrote 6 Stretes, Jane -
all went with FB to N.W. coffee R

- r Santa Fe Trail (J Brown) at Stratford. Several inches of snow. lottery tickets, races or Chev. Back c. 10. Did a double in bed.
4. Greyish, still mild. FG off 10.55, L Tel. Mr. Most of a.m. was packing & moving to 16. Lunch Pueblo. Ft sister. Nice time, back before 3- To 4:11 with L, got Pullman to Albany. Taxi back. Took scarf & pullman to GTRM. Nice call from Dr L Tuttie. Dinner solo with "RFuture," later papers, NY, Life, Symposium (Wall.) Rach. & Sym, Arensky var. on T, Albéniz Sevilla, news 11.15, then up.
5. Fine sunrise, grey pm. Read NYT

in bed. News 10 after breakfast, next H/H C. II, settling & getting room in order. Wrote L, ECT. Down for Phil. C. Tedesco March. q v, Reger & sketches, Liszt Eb (Dances Finales). Setting fire - wrote - Metman, G String, later. R, H, GTRM here for supper, library. Bound off pullmans. Food misc, read W Churchill, news, record Tech. Cone.

6. Fine. Mending etc. in a.m. To Art. with shoes, wool shop. Back before 12 to resume NYC. Pres. speech 2-2.45, very fine. To bookshop to return. Library basement ILIV 1939 NYC, - Dendra w. F McC. 14 ft 5.15, to Pearce for wool, to H. who left me to dinner n. GTRM, FB, LET, Ringe. At Hill 7.30, GTRM set up new pullmans, FB round ball. Read PM, Sun, Churchill

in salon, knit, till 11 news. MB back.

7. Fine again. Up later. News, paper. Typed Nye, Dend. etc. from ILN notes. More news. Lunch Pub. Read Lect., Lond. News 2.45 - To Main, pencils, Libr. basement verifying ILN & more up. To R at 5.15 & stayed for knit, news, dinner - to lecture Agar on Demos - US, fail. by discussion. Back 10.30, paper, 11 news.

8. Fine. Back to it - it. Wrote L, MFW. Out at 3 to Libr. verifying ILN, 12m Oskem BSA ~~XST~~ & Arch. 82. To period. 1. & found 4 priceless Punch at 5½ to 11, found CB there, her birthday, sheep & cake. Dined solo, ate MB & quest. before fire in sal. knitting, Churchill, van L, 11 news.

9. Greyish. Extra nap. Spent most of day

on vii, tidying up & revising. A. T. here to lunch with MB & me. A little knitting, then back & started on viii. Got in for a short call & brought MInnes. Went 5.40 to H & she returned for dinner. Eric NT, papers, finished Churchill.

10. Grey a.m., cleared fine. At viii - x all day, exc. 15m. lunch. Phila Arch - Clock sym., Jepson in Moz. Stopped 5.30 & did knitting & news. Pebbles, F, Mrs Holland dined with H & me. All later to Army fine lect. on democ. by (Smith).

Good moon. Read Time & more knit & van L. Upstairs & later did more Nyle. ^{and Cone."}

11. Fine. Wrote Barbara G. Worked on NS till 1.45 Lond. news. Library looking up up. till after 4. Dropped in at R's -

Back & wrote L, then to Att & stayed at
W: Gm - Strober & all had mimosas.
after - boat gave out, so back to Att &
MB wound & we sat in library till I
heard NBC (Wallace) Schub I, Prok.
Classical, Sib I. Eddie TR came
along - we stayed together. Began
M Jones, Seacoast Vanguard.

12. Slightly overcast. Paper in bed,
heat 9, news 10. Upstairs early, dad.
Arch. Meister, Sib I. Domestic a.m.
overhauling clothes in - out of trunk.
Dined Sat. with Ratt & Polyx. Back
for Metr. at 3: Round Gm, Mahler D
quarantine after. Finished NYT &
knit - wrote MFW, Seaman, N, Pauline &
read more Junes. To Tonks at 7, also

Reynolds, 3 Hills, 2 Barringers, 2 Linnes,
2 Picc, Geiger, L Barbour, LET, FDN, K, nice
party, back 10:15. Read Junes in bed.

13. Fine, sunny & less cold. Cleaned out papers.
Wrote long letter T. Early lunch, some MS.
To R for 2 o'clock. She set up other half of puzzle
over, roof, 2.45 - news. Libr. couldn't find
much. Later saw several ILN. To H at
5:45, drink & talk. Dinner reading Junes.
Finished it - eve, top hole. Began Bishop's
Crime (Freeman) - knitting - Swing -
14. Fine. Trying to fin. book a.m. Up later.
To Bank after 10, cold but fine. Had
borrowed 16' Conrad Blue so looked up
& typed. Wrote B. Main & libr. p.m. to do
ILN. Horrid - chilly, back c. 4:30 - to
H 5:30. Dinner alone reading Bishop,

Finished it - eve. Also knit, talk Ted.
Sawg, up early to prepare.

15. Bright. On 10.13 to 120th, Mabell by 12.

Lunch there, N. tel. - made date for dinner. N - I via Sub. to Night Train, fine. Back c. 5 to tidy up b.
for N came. Grand jolly we - she stayed till Sawg. Limited a lot.

16. Horrid day, light snow early. Let up. Wrote L, nice a.m. with N.

Lunch TT Club, freezing rain then no left, but got over to bus. Walked day, out at 7:2 and taxi to Miss Seaman 157 E. Three sisters, a nice call. Taxi awful going, ice & slush, wind & pouring. To N. before 5. Backed & taxi across to Brooks, escorted by

diner. Elegant guest suite, dressed early, ten 6pm & I in parlor. Others: McReeves, Holmes, Chant, FGMare, Young (Kirkland) 2. Pas - ? (Hist) - Very successful party. Took latest Fran-kan short dates. to bed in bed.

17. Still horrible & messy but not raining. Took Gilm Hill c. 10.30 then via Sub to Grand C. - left bag. Way black out. Tel. Girls. Sub to Skins, then to hot for stockings. hideously messy but not slippery. White shirt - FS. Call to Benson - H & got 4 cigs. for H. Taxi to TT Club - read paper till Emily & Charlotte came, for drinks, lunch - talk 6-7:45. C Barnett here 7:30- 8:15. Got off by late train - got the

6.05 by a grand dash. Ted & others
were from home to catch up. Back
just for 10 mins - up to put things
in order. Buckham in bed.

18. Grey & dull. Slept longer than
usual. 9.30 news, up to clear out
desk etc. Long letter to L, BT Co,
TAWW etc. Some mending. Later
got out Christmas cards & made cat.
2.30-5.30. H had dinner here for LRT,
also CB & Lucy, Gt m. Totals for the eve
& 2 Kraut, & Beaufort, Drinkerattee,
Ted. Much talk till after 11.

19. Light snow, cleared. Read Buckham
before getting up. News 10 & 11 & T.
more clearing out papers etc. Phil
at 3, B Walter = Eroica, La Mer. More

papers, Br - knit. Same in eve after H,
R here to supper. Wrote L, MFW, & MTT,
N, Ha.

20. Cold & brilliant, after 9.30 news went to
coffee in Avery. Ted, H, CB, Lucy, Nic. To
Bookshop, then to PC where we heard in-
auguration, stayed to lunch. Knit a lot.
Back to Att, then errands in Pub: Lueky,
Woolworth. Back c. 3, Rex. News. Ran
over Ch I to time it. Early write in Pub.
6.45 H came & went to "Thief of Bag" at
Sanderson. Splendid film, Sabu, Veish
& other good cast. Back 9 $\frac{1}{2}$, Suring, Buck.

21. Fine. Late start. Wrote Marian, then
Ch I in prep. for J-Club. Late lunch,
2.45 news. Library for references. Gt m
5-5.30, then to H. Dinner Att, reading

Buchan & also knitting & picking out a lot after seeing Mrs P. in pm. Swing 10 - work before fire.

23. Mostly greyish, warmer. Did odds, new st. more for JC, also Ch III. Hair done p.m. Back 4:30. Finished Buchan. To H, then R for dinner & spent an hour knitting, BtB&c etc. ending w. Swing. Rain, so borrowed umbrella.

23. Fine, some light clouds. Letters from T to Effie. Mostly scraps, to Library for Prof. Thurs, lunch upstairs - wrote B in am. & began long one to T. Began Trellawney, knit 2.45 Lond. news. J Club 4:30 here in library, CS hostess. Read Ch I, all very kind. Dined W with H

GHM, FB, M Wells, Jojo. To H after for mano. Knit etc. Back before 9. AAUN in salon, so in library. Ob, 97 Bulletin Alum., st. up early for Swing, but he is off Thurs. Trellawney & news.

24. Sun early, then cloudy - letters from T - L. Began L, then to chemist & libr. Hill c.t. Damrosch p.m. End of Phila. w. Pizza, Rand Mac. Steady snow all p.m. Ch III. Quiet eve. Knit, drp. Please, Tre.

25. Fine, sun out p.m. Mostly sorting etc. in room, cases from below etc. Write more T. Back to III for much of p.m. To Gem, then R for dinner & eve.

26. Fine. Off 10:15 by 10.13 to duck C. at Gisela's. So prompt 125 that I had a walk before taxi to 11:20. Good lat -

28. Fine a.m. grey later. Crochaps,
press pullovers etc. Non parcels.
To Bank + Post 12.15-1.30. Pub, iron
after 2, + 2.45. More knitting, got half
done in eve. 10 H 5.30. MB had

4. Sheppard, R + me to dinner + eve
before library fire. Swing 10. Began my lie.
29. Fine. Served up blue pullovers. Baked
1 rev. Began T. Githm in for call. Fin. T.
wrote L, F. Gisela. Knit. Went at 5 to Schen.
tours to talk books with Bob. Dinner
jar, also Marie. Spent eve. M finished
navy pullovers + took it - for cousin. R
round shells + started new pull. hats
of BBs.
30. Greyish. Same odd, back rev, bags
etc. Wrote B. Did errands etc. Wrote
Kupper. Colb. - dinner, H, R, Githm, F13,
Marie. Nice evening till C.G. Upstairs
+ did last odds + ends.
31. Fine, sunny. Woke early + got all in order.
H came to see me off on 10.13. Taxi to

Penn. with luggage. To Sko's for abt.
+ gloves, TTC to meet Maule for
lunch + she went with me to train.
Met N. Got all luggage into tiny double
bedroom C. Very comfortable trip, mostly
NYers, talk, guide books, good dinner.
Late to bed. Not much sleep.

Feb. 1. Greyish off + on. Atlantic very smoggy,
arr. 8.40 after break. on train. Loaded taxi
for freight station, got car at once +
ff 9.40. Decided it was no place for us
to stay. Off via Decatur for Athens.
Saw a great many fine houses on
handsome Prince St. Into town a few
blocks near campus. To Holman coffee
shop for lunch. Search for knit-needle
then round of campus + nice old

buildings. Via 129 to Macon, made quick
time, decided to go on. After passed at
Talbotton pushed on to Columbus, Ma-
rely ⁶ Hotel, very comfortable. Green Room
for meals. Took our time over dinner
upstairs early, read Late Pig.

2. Greyish, hard showers at intervals.
Cross via Phoenix to Mont. + right high.
Mostly dell country, wet often. No idea
where we'd get to but found Lorelace
at Brenton, nice little place. Good room
+ food. Found a Mont. paper to read
in one. Arr. before 4 + had a rest + a
lot of knitting.

3. Misty + grey but roads dry, weather
improved. Mobile before 12 + this to
Theodore, sandwich Grant. On to Elgin.

Gulf by c 2, sun out, lonely. nice
room, grand view, baby radio, 170
paper. Fine rest. Wrote H a long account
of our trip. Excellent dinner, then
knitting by big fire; poor reception
of swing. Finished "Pig."

4. Fine, a perfect day. Late break. Then
a nice walk round the estate - lonely
drive to Gulfport, news in car. Did
a few errands, lunch Markham coffee
shop. Left c. 2 & so fine we went
to Biloxi & back via Miss town & got
a bag. purse. Sat on veranda read
Sun. NYT, more knitting. H began
sock with new needles. Came in with
cold, more paper. Wrote T before &
after excellent dinner & fire.

5. Fine but less brilliant. Took it comfortably & left c. 10.40 for lonely early drive to T.O. where we arrived at 709 SIC. 1.15 and got settled, then out to McAlanney, Holmes (sea), Royal up & down fine walk. Large mail when we arrived. Old La. until dinner, a good one. Lastly till c 9.30. Reading PS reader.

6. Wet. L-C arr. before 8/2 in great form
after fine trip. All break together,
then they unpacked purchases,
lots of nice things. H & C out to
photo place. Finished T. All out on
Royal (H). Lunch SIC. Lazy pm. knit,
began Death at the Helm. L-C out unaccu-
mately to Mrs. Eve sat round & then

bridge in 727. No cards.

7. Unsettled, cloud later. Rained at 6 by fire in Roy & St L, rest Tor. There are were last year. Then 4 - dried or went to Merleau for Sym. tickets, then Royal. Lunch County and Kitchen, nice fire. To Cabildo etc - back via Chartres. Slack till dinner. More bridge - news etc.

8. Grayish, still cold. Breakfast across at Hotel. All ff 9.45 for Bayon la Fourche via go + Bridge. Less wild than expected, very flat. Some good old houses, ex. bank nearly to Donaldson across to Woodlawn. Madewood. Both fine Ionic, former in very bad repair. Lunch Hotel Don. good. Across ferry - back via 1, Burnside St. Hurricane

terrible damage to trees. Uncle S. all gone but piles of bricks. At Lutcher cut back to 61 + return soon after. Good dice, chilly. Began death in expectancy. Knit, bridge was, better cards. ~~Marini~~
131 III, Liggett Cradle & Gram, today dances.

9. Fine, some clouds, up very late. Rest in bed till 11 + wake. Break. in cafe. Got nothing done etc. N. round 2 balls. Wrote H. L + C out to lunch but we needed none. Walk to Audit. lonely out, to Metrop. conc = Serail, Schum. C maj, La Mar, G Min 1^r. Fr. Simply gorgeous, encors = G string, tongue (which?) Drov. Dance. We walk back, in after 5. Began T, then helped to tie up Great packages. Dined Antoine's. Dick's

note to RA resulted in personal escort to private room full of pictures, auto-graphics, cartoons etc. delicious pompano, omelette soup w. birds on top, capi diabolo, good dry Graves. Great success. Back c. 9.30, farewell bridge, news, knit. Forgot to put in for Fri. about four drive to City Park, walk P r back another way. Much lay out in gardens, azaleas etc. in street strips.

10. Fine. Up at 7. Wrote most of B. All off c. 10 along Gulf. Grand for drive. Lunch Bungalow at Biloxi, then to Ocean S. and Gulf Hills. Back to Edg. Left c. 3 stop Gulfport. NO c. 5½, brief rest, out to Patio Royal for a good dinner & quickly back for C to get train at 9.

Did more packing & more to 727. Still reading N Marsh.

11. Fine, up early & break. w. V. at Halsom. All packed and off at 10, Bridge rd the rest of the way, Houma, B Black. lunch Franklin in Peck's. Some fine houses before & after. Pretty village, good houses both sides Bayou Teche all the way. Nice trees. At New Iberia went S. 445 to Avery Island with its fine gardens, camellias mostly over, azaleas beginning. Early for most birds esp. white herons - egrets. On New I. to see "The Shadows," garden open. Old Weeks house, & Tudor. cols, see Saxon & Suydam. Owner Mr Weeks Hall saw us & came out, tripod, asked us in for coffee -

much talk. & delightful artist.
Stayed till 6, then on to Lafayette &
stayed Gordon, very comfortable room
& good food.

12. Sun in & out. Left 9.40 on 43-25
for St. Martinville. Acadian House
in Park, well restored & full of old
things. Talkative Miss L - acade-
dian. Silver man from Conn. told
us a lot of addresses. In village
St. M. church, grave - mom. of Evans
behind it - E's oak on 13 acres.
Across via Olivier's shop to Pine
Aley, & oaks, gorgeous trees. Back
to R. King, lunch Azalea Court,
a model one. Left c. 2 via Lake
C. over Texas line to Beaumont.

First hotel too near railway. La Salle
good, coffee room excellent. Turned
in early. Cloudy late pm - rain in
night - Terrible wind earlier in pm.

13. Fine, breezy, sunny. Left 9.45 via 59
to Port Arthur, much shipping. Passed
many oil wells & tanks, cattle &
cowboys. 87 to Fort Belvoir - ferry
to Galveston. Fine sea front drive.
Lunch 2 Bits, kept by Gks. - Ann. Bus.
carried before 3, fine rooms 7 floor on
sea. Unpacked some & rested, also a
lot of diary to write & more on T, which
is piecemeal. Posted T, - card to H, after a
bus ride round town & tea at Greeks on
pier opposite. Terribly windy. After
dinner the Hostess talked to us about

our travels, wanted to get reporter but he
was out so she tel. Max knitting.

14. Fine, cloudless day. Choice tel. from
H. before breakfast. off 9:40 via Hwy,
-35 Angleton, w. Columbia St. Part way
on ranches, marshes, little pine woods
etc. Lunch at Green Lantern Palacio
on the water. Bontonians who know
Galap. On part many bay, woods &
to Corpus Christi - Nueces right on
front. Entrance to town rather awful
but other part nice. Very good hotel
Have 645, 644, overlooks basin w/
several bombers - 1/ren naval base.
Arr. before 5 - got unpacked & settled.
Nice dining rooms, esp. green one,
chintz lounge etc. Sat knitting,

no books or swing, so returned to kni-
15. Gorgeous dawn & sunrise. Watched it
from bed. No hurry any time - all out
c. 11, L to workshop. Who took out kinks,
N-+ to Mex. Co. for permits. Most
polite, Mex. lit. tract in town for small
errands, shrine, City Hall, Ch. j. com.
& more folders. Back before 1. nice
lazy p.m. reading, almost asleep,
good det. Eve explored hotel, then
comfortable finish to foot of pullout
& L set up the back.

16. Fine, slightly overcast. Late breakfast
for Sun. Much planning etc. wrote
it for noon air mail, made up diary.
Began tent C. Lunch - a walk on
beach w. good view of town. Fin. ect.

Heard part N.Y. Phil. Conf. Cables to G.W.M.

MFW. Finished Marsh. Read "Acadian
Legends." Ere usual knit: Tunic.

17. Sun in - out, cloudy. L to & Ray-
fin. Tunic, wrote R, F, B before lunch.
Fine p.m. & took drive all along
front, nice houses, fine views. Later
to N Beach and around by country
roads. On before 5. Read Lafitte.
Ere knit & up by 10.

18. Misty early, then fine day. Nurse
at 7.30 for L's tea. Late break.
Out before 11 via q to CC Lake Park,
lots of wild flowers & birds. Lunch
at small place Sandia. Man from
Rochester. Back 3.30. Tid up books,
wash dishes. Ere upstairs early to

pack.

19. Scirocco. Nurse before 8. Packing
done before breakfast, many odds &
ends. Left a lot at hotel. Away 10.55,
by mistake on q. Ran across to 44 at
Robstown to Alice, then q. Country very
flat, veg, ranch, oil, scrub. Lots
of wild flowers. Lunch on moonlike
country, had picnic kit & new trays.
More rolling towards Laredo, arr 3 1/2.

Plaza Hotel, Span. style, attractive.

Terribly sticky, muggy, windy. Town
dec. w. flags for festa & well lighted
at night. Unpacked squashed
clothes, tub, good rest. Terribly
sleepy but tucked up w. dinner.
Knit in lobby, up for 10 news.

20. Thick mist - good sleep. Back
upstairs. Out c. 11 to Alabá re car
insurance, money etc. To Hamilton
H. about festa. Walk round
town, funny mixture, border town
every kind of shop. Nice lunch.
Read *OB*. Out c. 3 to C. f. Com. -

H Hotel, got *NY Times*. Back c. 4,
diary & wrote T. Brief rest - out
6.15 for Hamilton where we went to
festa banquet & then saw dance
on roof. Sat next Capo Ryan a rau-
ger, Mrs Brennan very kind at dinner.
Capital show which we enjoyed.

21. Rather misty, shawed off - on. No
hurry, packed. Left c. 11 via bridge &
no trouble customs. Off for Monterey

flat scrub, small bushes, lots of wild
flowers, esp. mimosa & yellow bush, red-
blue very like anem. No distant mts.
Lunch Power's about half way. Then up
over 2200 pass, misty but no trouble,
fine drive in spite of mists. N. c 4
and to Colonial, st. keeps much S/
tradit. in furnishing etc. Room on sq.
³⁰³
³²³ N. mt. view when clear. Had a good
rest. Bar, good dinner. Knit in
lounge.

22. Cloudy but not rainy - long sleep.
- out before 11 to explore town, shops,
market etc. Got T. a jade & silver
necklace for birthday - Friend sq. bag
for H in market. Lunch Sanborn,
Meinic, Cath Sq. etc. Siesta. H.

Cards to Mrs - Lucy C. Eric watched the dinner dance - Mex singers in gay costumes, talked to some stray ladies - Did a lot on knitting till c. 10. Finished PS Murder.

23. Unsettled but occasional sun. Out to park, cathedral, promenade. Lunched S. Urte 6 AM, card CS. Out c 4, after 0½, S Ant. paper etc. for walk round town. Saw one nice church & back via shops. Dinner S. truck in square - saw more from window, saw & watched till 9. In upper hall w. Sun. paper & knit -

24. Fine! a miracle. Had a grand drive to Saltillo, brilliant, bumpy - sunny. Mountains in jagged ridges, deep gashes & ravines, razor edges -

Color like Greece but shapes entirely different. Varied country, mostly scrub - open semi-desert. St Caterina, Pass & Dead. S. itself picturesque town. To Casa Colonial for lunch. Peristyle, + atrium like Pompei. A private house converted. Round fine park - alcove, sunpi factory where V. got a rug. Fine cathedral, slab. carving. Long drive back to Huasteca gorge off road from St. L. wonderful rock formations. Odd shop restaurant, P. Back c. 6. Dinner S - walk round square. Little Lively girl from Dayton.

25. Cloudy again, wet early. Up late - out c. 11 for errands, L got fine basket at

Light lunch S. cafe'. Took long walk solo all round town. Much like what we had seen before. Went down stairs on return. 12 noon 13. Read S. Am. Exp. Pack - dinner S. Walk round sq. Rather drizzly. Triv in palm room, ridiculous din on piano by a ruffian. Out to walk. Ready The Lodge (Blondes) in bed.

26. Cloudy again. Waited till it got better, collected picnic lunch off c 11 to Sabina, Hidalgo. 45 m. flat straight, then pass, all in mist - cloud. Showers. wrong. This was last route
Lunch Powers', where also is a shop To Villa Santiago, El Circado - my bed was n. & H.T. falls. Cat gate found Ramon Flores nice boy who went

with us, very zigzag. Out to walk by path along brook. Falls fine - bunch here. After return to main road went a few miles S. oranges etc. Clouds - splendid light & mt. effects. Back c 4½. Too good to stay in, went sq. Pack & dinner S. Wine shop. Triv - lodges.

27. Cloudy a.m. Pack, off c 11. Fine drive back, sun in & out. Resty on pass. Drive Powers', picnic after in car. Sun on plain - Customs 3:35 - 4:30 but easy in end. Plaza same rooms as before. Fin. P.

Glad to have bad news again. See upstairs early after a few rows.

28. Fine, sunny, breezy. Got my I. off 10½ for down Rio Grande, 83. First part
