

5938 - Bust of woman. Head not bad, eyes almost, nose aquiline, mouth slightly thin. Hair parted, falls in waves, even back towards on mounts [broken there].

5939 - <sup>from</sup> torso & knees, heavy ridge on abd.  
Pub. streaks.

5940 (in W + T) Headless, some abd.,  
streak very small legs & feet -  
5941. Firm hair down, very side up -  
+ large keto

5942 Upper part torso. Hairless on  
head mod. fair

5943-44 Upper firm torso

5945 - Sealed firm torso, flat, (sm).  
Keto, mouth nasal, one side abd.  
Pub. streaks.

5949 - Sealed firm, broken above knee, no  
head or r. arm, fat, keto bracts, yellow  
grey clay.

Impression of interior  
same as Romanesque

<sup>high up</sup>  
Cathedral in form of  
Gothic type (in plan).  
Possible that architects  
50 years ago thought they  
were built by W. architect.  
Pointed arch, etc., bases  
like 200 yrs later in W.  
Gothic

bright yellow traces  
systematically -  
Magdalen monuments,  
Persian centre of  
Hellenism + Islam  
art.
