lots shown here were immediately above bedrock and not necessarily connected with any graves. They come from between 5.40 and 2.25 M. - so high because some i.e. KF-126 represent removal of a grave as well as the material beneath it.

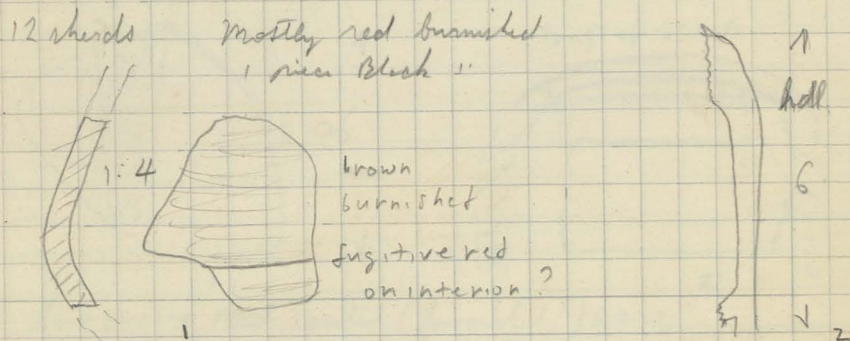
KF-103, KF-99 are levels above KF-109 not directly connected with graves (p. 75 ff)
