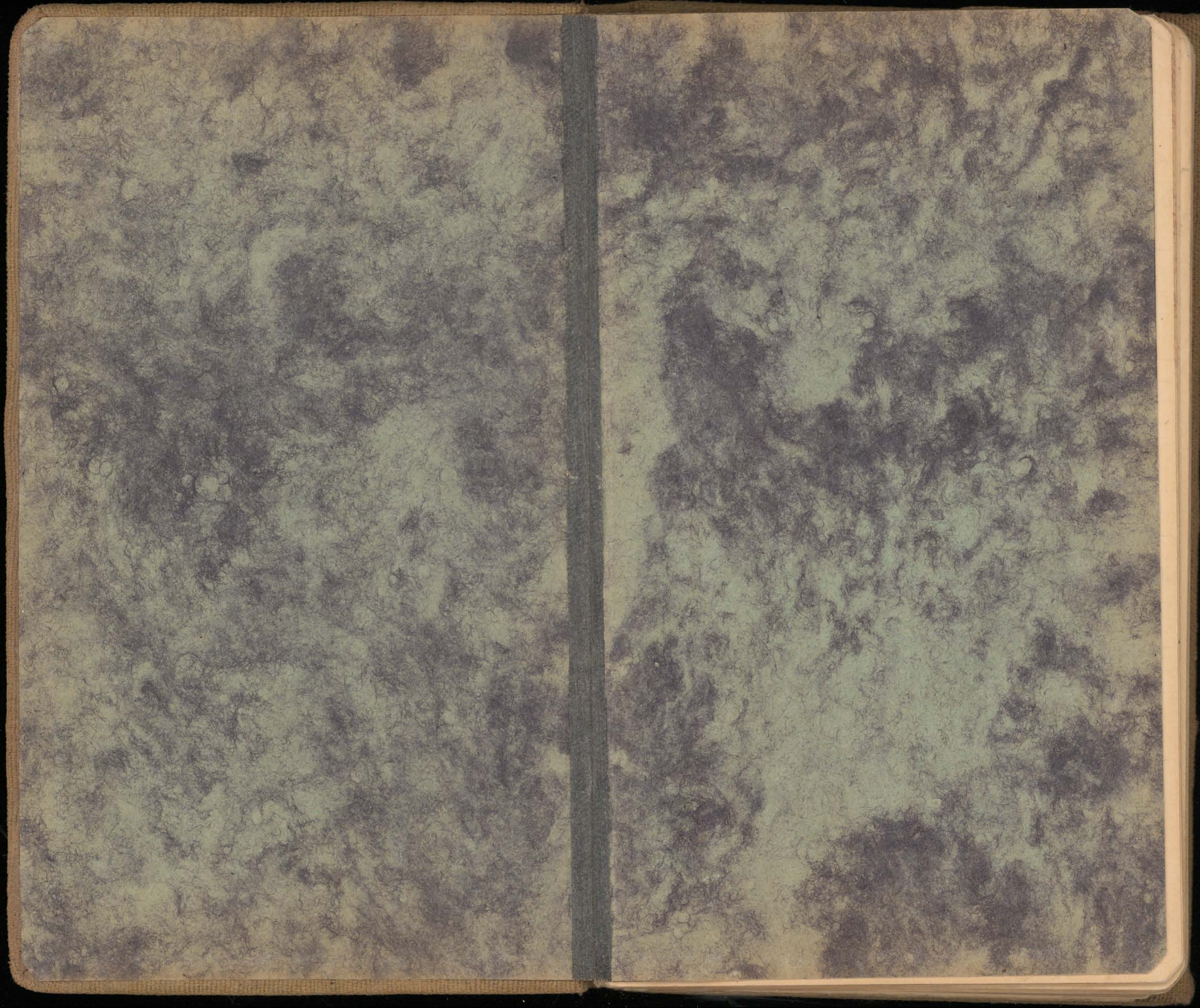

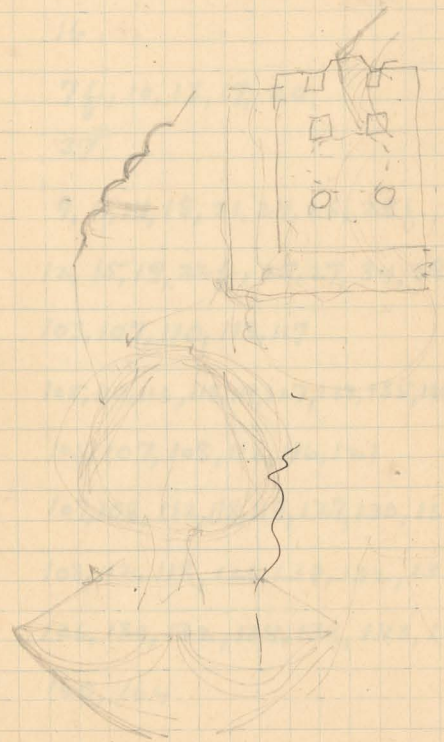

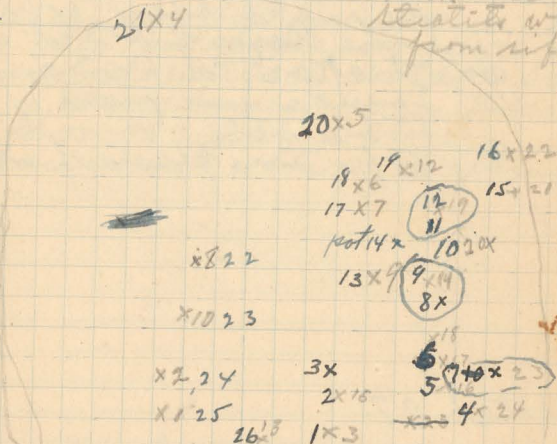
Seven men working to clear the tomb  
 In clearing out the door small pieces  
 of carbonized wood was found and  
 some potsherds in the next to the  
 lowest course of stones.

Clearing of interior continued.

With 3 men we began to dig  
 down to steres, one digging with  
 knife, one carrying out, one sifting.  
 Immediately on the steres  
 floor was found a layer of black  
 soil, ashes, charred bones  
 & pot sherds ca 1-4 cm thick.

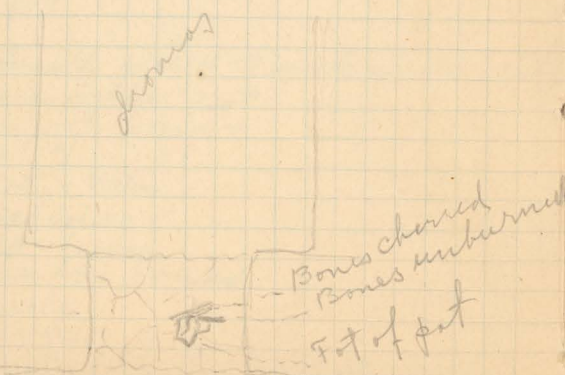

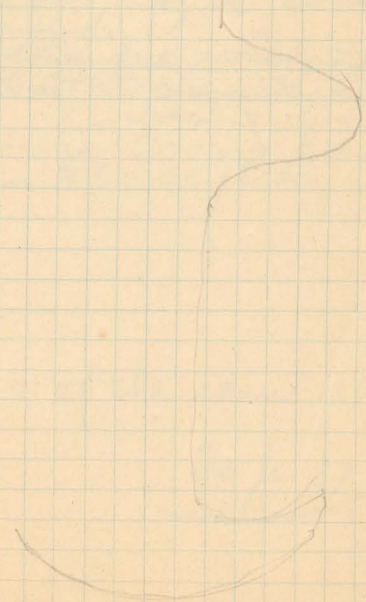

3 men - A piece of bronze was found in the door on the right side 45 cm. high from the bottom of the door. Handle of bronze cup (?) Potsherds were also found in the door.

The tomb appeared to have fallen in above the door. Began to dig above. Large stones were found above the chamber inside the door. It became necessary to cut thru above the door.

P.M. Six men working. About the center of the tomb, 1.20m deep small pieces of bones were found, which looked like parts of a skull. They are probably from a turtle shell. Bones of animals, sheep(?) also found near by.

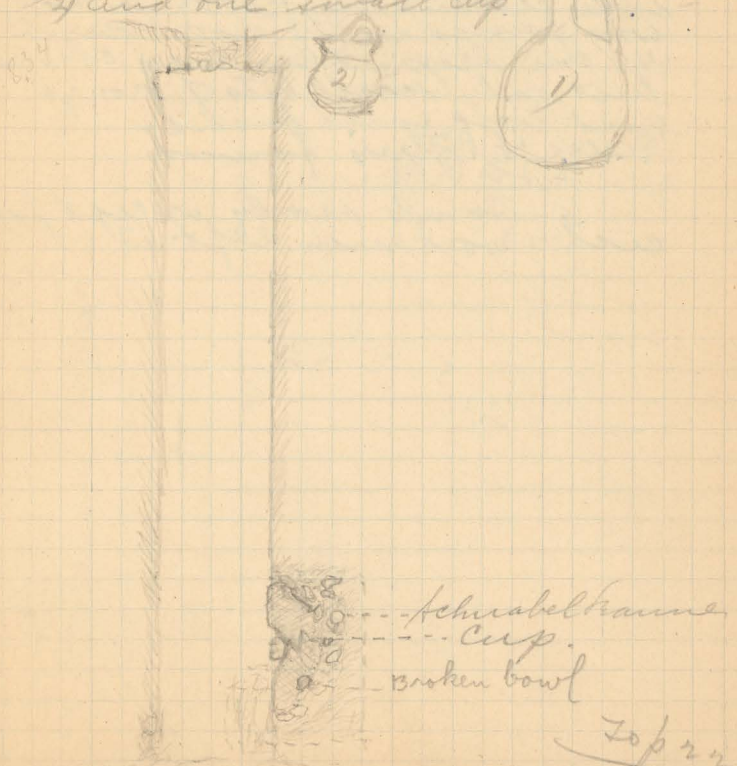

General appearance of Tomb

Stereo had fallen from above.  
Just inside door and going  
down to left (i.e. S.W. corner) is  
heap of stones and yellow  
earth.

Conjecture is that opening  
the tomb in L.H. 3 times right  
hand rear corner (N.W. & N.) found  
covered w. fallen roof so that the

(yellow) + stones  
fresh earth fell to right. Under 47.  
This layer of yellow earth mixed  
then & there w. fallen rd stereo  
we find a layer of black - seem-  
ingly burnt. This black layer  
varies in thickness from  $\frac{1}{4}$  to  
3 or 4 cm. Bones show blackening  
carbonization of a sort but  
not necessarily active burning.  
Pots in S.W. corner + S. an-  
of fine L.H. 2 pottery - gold in  
same area of same period.  
No pots have yet come to  
light in area covered only w.  
stereo. Near door are L.H. 3  
pots.

The pile of stones at inside  
of entrance is about 80-90 cm.  
in height & extends about half way  
across the tomb.

Black layer seems to extend  
over entire tomb.

Fallen stones are probably  
from upper part of door.
